The 1980s were a dark, crusty, sometimes snuffly period where noses were concerned. Despite being accompanied by the radiant Princess Diana, Prince Charles's hooter was seemingly on the front of every newspaper, Barbara Streisand's snorter was helping her to the top of the charts, and even the striking coal miners found themselves at the septum of nostril-led nastiness... 'What do you do if the government gets up your nose? Picket.'

But then, in 1988, something changed. Richard Curtis – for so long sticking his finger up the schnozzle of the establishment courtesy of his iconic *Blackadder* character – paired up with occasional funnyman Lenny Henry to start a new fundraising concept that had comedy at its heart.

It was called Comic Relief. It invited celebrities to challenge, entertain and host; it offered schoolkids and community leaders the chance to get their creative juices flowing; it implored TV watchers to dig deep for the less fortunate in society; and rallied around TV editors to free up screen time and resources for a total tee-hee takeover.

It's now a project that runs every two years, with merchandise, oneoff specials (such as *Comic Relief does The Apprentice*) and outwardbound pursuits (notably this year it's a wealth of celebrities, including Jade Thirlwall and Leigh-Anne Pinnock from Little Mix, *Strictly* judge Shirley Ballas, former MP Ed Balls, and TV presenters Dan Walker, Anita Rani and Alexander Armstrong, climbing the 19,000ft peak of Mount Kilimanjaro). There's also a showpiece event at Wembley Arena, with 2019 welcoming heavyweights from the comedy world: Jimmy Carr, Rob Beckett, John Bishop, Romesh Ranganathan, Alan Carr and others.

And let's not forget the noses themselves – 11 new stonkers such as Sir Schnoz III, The Abominable Snoseman and Hairy Nostroll, all of which can be brought to life with augmented reality on your smartphone through the Red Nose Day app.

Since Red Nose Day 2017, nearly 15 million people across the UK and some of the world's poorest communities have been helped, and an estimated two-and-a-half million of those are children and vulnerable adults.

While the project uses Red Nose Day as its centrepiece – and in the past 30 years has raised over £1billion for charitable causes – the charity's work stretches well beyond putting a lump of foam on the end of your nozzle. Right now, the organisers are reaching out to anyone

who wants to get involved ahead of the big day on March 15. A mobile phone Red Nose Day giving page is a simple and hassle-free platform for raising funds – past that it's just a case of how far your imagination will take you in dressing up, performing, baking, physical challenges, parties, applebobbing... anything goes for the red nose.

From raising £15million in its first year, to a record high of £108million in 2011, the growth in Red Nose Day's popularity has been Pinocchio-esque. Can it reach new heights – or is it lengths – this year? With your help, perhaps.

The first recorded reference to the day was in 1686 when the writer John Aubrey called it 'Fooles Holy Day'; and 12 years later, newsletter printer Ichabod Dawks wrote: "Yesterday being the first of April, several persons were sent to the tower ditch to see the lions washed."

That particular prank continued into the 18th and 19th centuries where those easily-led were invited to view this supposed annual ceremony... only to find that they been sent on a fool's errand.

Since the invention of the TV, the BBC have tested out a number of 'ideas' on the nation, including their famous spaghetti plants - which was so successful, viewers wanted to know where they could obtain one of their own - and 'Smell-o-Vision', where smells were to be broadcast alongside programmes!

For a simple prank of your own this year, buy a packet of a sandwich biscuits, such as Oreos or custard creams, and replace the filling with toothpaste. Offer them around your friends, family, or even work colleagues and wait for their reaction.


Textured Thes

kay, so Chinese stole a march with their adoration for fengshui, but look sharp and get tidying, because Marie Kondo is here to change all that.

Marie Kondo is the clean gueen wowing homeowners with a message that is as full-on as it is reserved. Is it her slight frame, her softly-spoken voice, or perhaps just a persona that almost effortlessly pushes homeowners towards minimalist magnificence? However she does it, the impact of her KonMari method - inspired by the spiritual practice of Shintoism and built on the premise of surrounding oneself with things that bring joy and satisfaction fairness... plus a little help from Netflix - represents a genuine cleaning revolution.

"It comes down to making home a warm, joyful place," she says, attempting to crystallise what, for some, is a seething, simmering mass of mental and physical torment, all brought about by a failure to be able to stay on top of housework.

"There are many different strands to what we do,

but to condense it, we represent what is contained in a house in five distinct sections: clothing, books, paper, komono (kitchen, bathroom, garage, miscellaneous) and finally sentimental."

Kondo, 34, who originates from Tokyo but now lives in LA with her husband and two children, asks people to decide if an item sparks joy or not. If it doesn't, it should be thrown away.

She also believes the house has its own part to play. A petite woman with an abundance of energy - the Mary Poppins of cleaning as she has become known in some guarters - will always thank a house for allowing people to exist and flourish in it... that is, before binning its contents in a whirlwind of cleaning expertise.

Subsequently, Kondo has been embraced by an ever-increasing global gathering of home junkies, spreading warmth, homeliness and a joyful Japanese aesthetic across the Western world.

And as for that language barrier ... "Let the cleaning do the talking," she says... and it does.

Adocumentary explaining the police investigation following the death of a Brentwood woman has been aired on ITV.

The documentary, which aired on February 14, depicts the final hours of Aimee Spencer and the twists and turns of the police investigation.

The documentary also explored the impact it has had on Aimee's family and the heart wrenching decision her parents had to make to allow doctors to turn off her life support machine.

Called The Death of Aimee Spencer, the documentary, fronted by Katie Piper, follows the police investigation into the mysterious death of Aimee who fell from the window of a seafront flat in Brighton.

It delves deep inside the investigation, using interviews with detectives trying to solve the case, bodycam footage from officers who were at the scene, and footage of key developments to piece together how Aimee - an adult film star and webcam girl came to fall to her death from a first-floor window.

The case begins when police arrive at the regency flat in Chichester Terrace in July 2016, and find the owner Daniel Lewis apparently in a state of druginduced intoxication while Aimee fought for her life on the way to hospital.

Eight days after the fall, Aimee's family take the decision to turn her life support off whilst the police undercover many oddities about the night she fell and the lifestyle she led.

Her mum Jean said: "If she did survive the potential for her to be severely mentally affected and physically affected was high - extremely high.

"Would it have been the same Aimee that we knew and loved? Of course it wouldn't, it would have been a completely different person."

Katie said: "Once you've seen the footage and listened to Aimee's parents and the police, you realise there are twists and turns in the story.

"I think you experience a lot of emotions and you change your mind about a lot of things as the programme unfolds.

"Formally you could say I was the presenter, but I think because it's a documentary and it's a real story that happened to a family. I became something of a listening ear and somebody who was sharing that experience with Aimee's family at a time when they let us into their lives. For me as a mother and a woman myself it was something I became passionate about." The documentary can be watched online on the ITV Hub app.

Mother hopes to raise profile of daughter's illness

Amother from Brentwood is hoping to raise awareness of her daughter's illness.

Alice Milliken's daughter Sophie became unwell on her fourth birthday after suffering with a cold. She was unable to walk properly, bend down or stand.

Alice explained: "She found walking up stairs hard because her muscles seemed to be asleep.

"After being sent home a couple of times and put on strong medication for a water infection we noticed she wasn't using her left arm.

"With this and the left side still not functioning properly, we were admitted to Basildon Hospital."

The family were at the hospital for just over a week where Sophie underwent tests, scans and X-rays.

Alice continued: "Sophie was diagnosed with

Acute Flaccid Myelitis (AFM) which is hugely rare but becoming more common, which is why my daughter is now being used in a study to research more into the illness."

AFM is a condition that affects the nervous system, specifically the spinal cord.

Alice said: "From some of the other parents I made contact with, we were relatively lucky.

"She continues to have physic and we have been told her left side will always be weak because of the scaring due to the inflammation in the spine.

"My daughter was a healthy three-year-old. She had never been in hospital and rarely to the doctors.

"We just feel lucky at how far she's come, it could have been a lot worse."

BURGHART for BRENTWOOD

recently had the pleasure of arranging a mock Parliament for local sixth formers. This is a debate held along House of Commons conventions and is an excellent way of introducing young people both to the workings of Parliament and to the processes of formal debate.

This, I feel, is more important than ever. Online platforms have made public argument a far more prominent feature of life than it was in my day. Too often this is conducted through short caustic comments conducted without reference to accurate information. Learning how to make your case in an intelligent, convincing and civilised manner is an essential life skill that more young people should have the opportunity to learn.

In was in this spirit of bringing mature debate into the open, that I hosted the first of what I hope will be a series of mock Parliamentary debates for sixth form politics students from our local secondary schools. Twenty-eight young people from Brentwood County High School, Anglo-European School, Shenfield High School and Brentwood School, were kept in order by none other than the Deputy Speaker of the House of Commons, Dame Eleanor Laing, MP for Epping Forest.

The students were divided into two parties, the Stars Party and the Stripes Party, with the Stars forming the government and the Stripes the Opposition. The motion was "This House would legalise assisted dying".

Parliamentary debates involve many rules and protocols, and the students soon got the hang of "bobbing" (standing up to try to catch the eye of the Speaker so they will be called to speak) and "interventions" (formally requesting to interrupt the person speaking to make an additional point in the debate). After some excellent speeches and interventions the motion was passed by the narrowest of margins – not unexpected for such a difficult subject.

It's clear our local schools are fostering students interest in politics and debating, and I hope this will prepare more young people to stand up and speak out on what they believe, and not join the nasty culture of hiding behind anonymity on social media.

Prolific burglar jailed for 12 years

A burglar who targeted Brentwood has been jailed for 12 years. Billy Francis, from London, was charged in July last year with burglaries in Halstead, Buckhurst Hill, Brentwood, Loughton and Gravesend, and an aggravated burglary in East Church, Kent.

There was a burglary at a house in Mascalls Lane, Brentwood, on July 20 in which two cars and a large sum of cash were stolen.

The 33-year-old was charged with five counts of burglary, one aggravated burglary, and making off without payment in Romford on July 23.

He was also charged with dangerous driving, taking a vehicle without the owner's consent, driving other than in accordance with a licence, driving without insurance, failing to provide a specimen for analysis and criminal damage.

Francis pleaded guilty to the offences at Basildon Crown Court on February 14 and was jailed for a total of 12 years. He was also banned from driving for eight years. Detective Sergeant David Wilkinson, of Brentwood CID, said: "Francis is a brazen and prolific burglar, but forensic tests and CCTV played a key part in helping us identify and catch him."

Burglar who stole £50k of designer clothes jailed



Aburglar who targeted a home in Hutton has been jailed for more than three years.

Edward Williams broke into an address in Chigwell overnight between 8.30pm on October 7, 2017 and 6am on October 8, 2017

Around £50,000 worth of designer clothes and shoes were taken. Less than a week later on October 13, a woman in her 40s came home to her address in Hutton to find someone had tried to break in to her house. When officers carried out a search warrant at an address in Rainham they found a number of items of designer clothing which was later confirmed as belonging to the victim in Chigwell, a woman in her 20s.

Analysis of mobile phone cell sites also revealed Williams' phone had been within a mile of the address in Chigwell at the time the burglary took place. Officers spoke to Williams on January 5, 2018 and he appeared at Basildon Magistrates' Court on October 11 where he was charged with burglary, attempted burglary, and theft.

Williams, 35, of no fixed address, pleaded guilty to the charges at Basildon Crown Court on Monday, February 11 and was jailed for three years and four months.

Father writes book following son's death

∧ father who wrote a book about his son he lost in a Acar crash says he was "delighted" to see it printed in time for the 10th anniversary of his death.

Adam Lawley, from Ongar, was returning home from work on November 21, 2008, when he lost control after deer ran onto London Road in Stapleford Tawney.

Last year on the ninth anniversary of Adam's death, dad Stephen Lawley launched his e-book You Make Me Better on Amazon.

It proved popular, selling 200 copies in the first two months leading to him aiming to get it in paperback form ahead of the 10th anniversary, which he succeeded with.

Talking to VISION, Stephen said: "The e version was already available and has been a big success on Amazon. I was truly delighted at that, but getting the book in a format that you can touch and put on the shelf, and into libraries, was extra special for me on Adam's 10th anniversary.

"Writing the book, allowed me to put my thoughts down on paper and deeply investigate my own feelings and belief systems about loss and life itself.

"Adam's short 21-year life would not be in as much vain if other's got something that improved their life. This was a key focus of the book.

"Kathryn, my wife, plunged herself into her art and incorporated Adam into all her art work. She had London Art exhibitions and had guite a following.

"It was five years after Adam, when things were raw, but not as raw, that I got this insatiable urge to write.

"I was waking every day at 5am and could not stop writing. In the end I had to control my new passion to two hours per day seven days a week for the following two years.

"I never wrote in with others in mind. It would have been impossible for me to continually think of others while writing it, this even includes my closest friends and family.

"I felt I had to stay true to myself, and Adam and be as honest and open as possible, and let my feeling out. This is hard for anyone but especially me as a man and who has lost his son."

Sure enough, she and boyfriend Jack have had their fair share of ups and downs, but embracing her father's dogged spirit has, thus far, ensured the couple have moved mountains in terms of surviving a permanently high-profile existence. That time in the spotlight was lengthened further by reality spin-off *Jack and Dani: Life After Love Island*.

Speaking of mountains, her next challenge is exactly that... climbing Mount Kilimanjaro for Sport Relief. "I'm not going to lie – I am bricking it," she says. "All I know is that it's a really big mountain and it takes ages to climb. I've never climbed anything before."

To follow, Dani has a book release set for April. Her self-improvement guide *What Would Dani do?: My Guide to Living Your Best Life* is an optimistic, positive slab of advice and experience. There's also the maintaining of her record-breaking clothing range – her collection for In The Style drove half a million visitors on its day of launch, with over 70 per cent of stock sold in just 24 hours. AVINGS

EAT PROTEIN WITH EVERY MEAL

Drink – In recent years, tart cherry juice has really come to the fore as a rapid healing drink against the ills of arthritis. In a recent US study, participants who drank around 250ml of tart cherry juice a day significantly decreased symptoms of osteoarthritis and inflammation, compared to those who took a placebo.

Evencise - As with any sort of whole-body improvement, exercise must play a part alongside diet and hydration. Movement plans for arthritis are many and varied, but you

need to focus on low-impact aerobics. strength training, regular stretching and subtle building of muscle mass.

The good news is many of these exercises are subtle and discreet consider an office chair as apparatus to do seated push-ups against, take short walks. practise Pilates, yoga and Tai Chi. Also consider water-based exercises, low impact movements - such as in cycling - and suspension training. Combined, these natural remedies can significantly lessen the impact of arthritis.







ravelling the length of the country or just popping to the local shops... regular maintenance is essential to avoid motoring melancholy.

One: TYRES

Check there's a spare tyre, a jack, its handle and the wheel brace for your vehicle. Remember too, the minimum legal tyre tread is 3mm. Make sure tyre pressures are correct – this will help handling and avoid you using excess fuel. It may also keep you on the road.

Two: LIGHTS

Check all of the lights, indicator, brake, dip, full beam and fog individually. Ask someone to stand out in front to help you make sure there are no faulty bulbs. Alternatively park by a clear wall or shop window in the night to see for yourself.

□ Three: WINDSCREEN

Make sure windows are washed and clear, and top the water for the windscreen wipers. Also check the wipers for any wear and tear... a smear on the window is the clearest sign your wiper blade needs replacing.

Given Four: OIL

Check engine oil or things may overheat. Do this

by checking the dipstick when the car has been dormant, and ensure you're on a level surface. Top oil up via the cap and don't overfill.

Five: FAN BELT

Check the fan belt for any cracks or slippage.

Six: RADIATOR

If your car has been bought within the last decade, it should have the overflow bottle marked with a minimum and a maximum water level. Older vehicles will have a radiator cap. Make sure the engine is switched off and cool, then top up with an equal mix of water and antifreeze coolant.

Seven: EQUIPMENT

Always have emergency equipment in the car – so, torch, screwdrivers, pliers and adjustable spanner. Fire extinguishers are always useful, and your car should contain a medical kit and reflective jacket if you breakdown, plus bottles of (unopened) water.

AN ORIGINAL ENGLAND ICON

he passing of Gordon Banks in the middle of February offered the nation a chance of reflect and admire arguably the most iconic keeper the England football team has ever had.

Across two World Cups the Sheffield-born stopper wrote his name into Three Lions folklore – first, repelling West Germany at Wembley in 1966 as Sir Alf Ramsey's men lifted the Jules Rimet Trophy; then four years later, in Mexico, making a seemingly impossible save to thwart the great Pele.

In truth, England's World Cup win on July 30, 1966, was built around 10 other footballers, and as for the best save ever, it's doubtful... and these are facts the impossibly modest Banks reminded people of regularly in what is half a century since.

His humility was only one part of his character. Banks was a dominant, strapping, resilient, battling keeper from an altogether different era, where footballers were everyday folk, and retirement often led to opening a pub rather than going after the much-vaunted 'media work'.

He starred for Leicester City at the time of England's greatest game, and despite surprisingly being allowed to leave the Foxes little more than a year after that Wembley win, went on to make almost 200 appearances for Stoke City, prolonging his international career until the age of 35.

His retirement from the game was ultimately forced on him after a car crash in October 1972. He lost the sight in his right eye, and with it, the ability to perform fully as a keeper, despite stints thereafter in the US and Ireland.

Although he took up coaching and management roles, his experiences were never going to match those as a player and he left the game, returning later as an ambassador for Stoke City and regular member of the Pools Panel.

Banks passed peacefully away in his sleep on February 12, 2019.
