

FUNDS OF PRIDE IN THE UK AND ELSEWHERE

t's perhaps surprising to note that Pride, a collection of events that celebrate the progress

and popularity of the LGBTQ+ movement, actually

comes from a place of conflict.

Certainly, our modern interpretation of Pride and, by association, LGBTQ+ Pride Month, which took place in June, is one where people can express their sexuality in a way that brings it into mainstream conversation.

It wasn't always like this. Back in 1969, and under the moniker Stonewall, a series of riots around Manhattan provided a watershed moment. The name referenced the Stonewall Inn, a gay bar in Greenwich Village where transgender people rioted following a raid by police.

Looking now at the way Pride is encouraged in al its forms, it's clear we have come a

long way since then.

In the UK, parades in London and Brighton are some of the most popular of any live events held to celebrate Pride. Across the pond, various US presidents have committed to referencing and promoting Pride Month, while corporations the world over throw their collective marketing might behind that familiar multicoloured flag.

What's more, last year the United
Arab Emirates supported the LGBTQ+
community in a way they had never before
by raising the rainbow flag to celebrate Pride
Month; and with the World Cup due to be held
in Qatar at the end of the year, the Middle East remains under
significant pressure to uphold its renewed pledge for dignity and
equality.

These days, Pride is more than a dress code, a parade or a festival. It is a 24/7 lifestyle that encompasses people of all different persuasions, in pursuit of respect, tolerance and understanding. And it's a battle that's being won.

ART THERAPY

with Repecca Sicardi

WHY REBECCA SICARDI'S DESIGN VISION IS GOOD FOR THE HOME AND THE MIND

Te can all relate to a piece of furniture, or a space, or an entire house transporting us to a place of mindful calm, but designer Rebecca Sicardi took the concept one step further when launching her interior design business in 2017.

Despite studying History of Modern Art at Manchester University, it was only when she began decorating her duplex apartment in Hackney that the concept of satisfaction and gratification really came to the fore for the designer, who prioritises subtlety, restfulness, neutral shades and strippedback finishes in order to promote a place of sanctity, harmony and calm.

She explains: "I don't think it's a secret that most of us will respond well to relaxed, subtle shades and tones, and they really are at the heart of what I create as a template for thought.

"On top of that, I will add context, detail and stimulation in the form of statement pieces or effects that really stand out."

By the designer's own admission, it's not a revolutionary way of thinking; however, in an era where we are impacted by so many modes and messages, reconnecting with sanity, clarity and a sense of clearness could be the ultimate antidote to the world's ills.

The words 'sensitivity' and 'sanctuary' permeate so much of what Sicardi styles, with pastels, wood, stone and rattan offering a base on which everything else can be constructed.

As for Sicardi's recommendations for others looking to follow her design style, she suggests always checking colours carefully, especially 'off-whites', valuing texture and materiality over almost anything else, and using a pared-back palette as a starting point before adding on top, while always telling a story through the art and furniture you select.

She adds: "Don't expect it to work first time. Persist with what feels as if it might work, because with persistence, it will."



ould your cushions do with a makeover? High street cushion covers can be expensive and a little generic, so why not design your own? We love this simple yet bold abstract cushion design that anyone can create at home with just a few craft essentials and a little artistic flair.



YOU WILL NEED:

One cotton cushion cover | An abstract face template (you can find these online) | A pencil A piece of cardboard the same size as your cushion cover | Black fabric paint Thin paintbrush | Ironon foil in your choice of colour | An iron | A tea towel

HOW TO MAKE:

STEP 1: Print out the face template

Print out your chosen face template onto a piece of plain white paper and carefully cut out the different parts of the face. Alternatively, if you are feeling artistic, you could draw your own abstract face design and use this instead.

STEP 2: Draw around the template

Position the template pieces onto the front of your cushion cover and draw around each one using a pencil. Take your time with this step as accuracy

STEP 3: Paint the face design

Place the piece of cardboard inside your cushion cover - this will stop your paint bleeding through to the back of the cushion. Using a thin paintbrush and the black fabric paint, carefully paint the face design and then allow to dry fully.

STEP 4: Create the lip design

Use the template to cut out a pair of lips from the iron-on foil. Set your iron to a cool setting with the steam off and then place the lips onto the cushion cover. Lay a tea towel on top of the lips and then gently iron until the foil has bonded with the fabric. Remove the tea towel and allow to cool before peeling off the top carrier layer of foil.

Police tackle issue after 'numerous complaints'

Police have been carrying out patrols outside a Billericay school in a bid to tackle problem parking. Quilters Junior School, in Laindon Road, has teamed up with the Billericay and Wickford Community Policing Team to tackle the illegal and dangerous parking which has plaqued the area for more than a

The school has previously written to parents in a plea for more sensible parking, but following "numerous complaints", police visited the school on May 19.

Headteacher Michael Wade said: "Where people are parking on the kerb, it is affecting visibility for other drivers and for children and parents.

"If someone is on the kerb outside the school, you haven't got line of sight down the road, so a driver would have no reaction time should a child. God forbid, step out into the road.

"Occasionally, parents have bumped up the kerb onto the pavement, and other parents have reported to me near-misses where drivers have not seen children whizzing along on a scooter or even just walking on the pavement."

Since their visit to the school, the police have been carrying out patrols during drop-off and pick-up times.

A spokesperson for Essex Police said: "On May 19. officers from the Billericav and Wickford Community Policing Team attended Quilters School following numerous reports of illegal and dangerous parking.

"These measures are put in place for your and your children's safety. Please park responsibly."

Residents given priority to purchase homes



New homes in Billericay are now complete – and local residents are being given priority to buy them.

A total of 30 new homes have been built at Monarch Place by Sempra Homes, the council's house-building company. The new one- and two-bed apartments are all available on a shared-ownership basis.

The development provides parking for residents and visitors, and all the homes exceed national space standards and have achieved Secured by Design Gold Standard.

Councillor Jeff Henry, non-executive director of Sempra Homes, visited the development alongside Sempra and Basildon Council officers on May 31 for a tour to mark its completion.

Cllr Henry said: "We are committed to providing more much-needed homes for local people. These stunning new homes make use of what was previously a derelict site, to deliver 30 one- and two-bed homes all available for shared ownership with priority to borough residents."

The Irons will make the short trip to Essex to face off against Town, who were crowned champions of the FA Women's National League South East Division One last season - sealing the title after winning 20 of their 24 matches in the competition.

New Hammers boss, Paul Konchesky, will make a

return to New Lodge, having previously been assistant manager of the men's team in 2020.

Ahead of the new season, Town have already signed Sophie McClean (pictured right with team manager, Scott Chickelday), who has previously played for Spurs, London Bees and Crystal Palace.

Delighted to make the move. Sophie said: "I'm really excited for the challenge, and when the opportunity came up, I knew that I wanted to join straight away.

"As well as my experience, I hope to bring lots of energy so hopefully I can get some goals and assists."

Bank announces closure of High Street location

Another bank in Billericay is set to close after Barclays announced plans to shut its High Street branch.

It has cited a "change in the way people do their banking", with 86 per cent of customers in Billericay now using different ways to bank.

The branch, which is among several to shut across the country, will close on August 24.

It is a further blow for Billericay, after HSBC and NatWest both announced plans to close their branches in the town later this year.

A spokesperson for Barclays said: "The decision to close a branch is never an easy one. However, customers are increasingly using alternatives to branches to do their banking.

"As a result, we are seeing a sustained fall in branch visits across the UK.

"This is reflected at the Billericay branch; there has been a 29 per cent reduction in counter transactions in the two years to March 2020.

"In addition, 86 per cent of our customers at the branch are also using different ways to bank.

"We will work with customers and provide alternative options to ensure they can continue to manage their money and receive financial expertise."



"Since opening for the first time, we have been lucky enough to see so many new faces taking part in our amazing sport."



Water company fined after sewage flow

↑ water company that allowed untreated sewage Ato flow into a river from a treatment works in Shenfield has been fined £300,000.

Anglian Water appeared at Chelmsford Magistrates' Court on May 26 following an investigation into the incident, which took place in June 2016.

The Environment Agency (EA) was called to Shenfield and Hutton Water Recycling Centre, a sewage treatment works, and it was found that all three pumps had failed following a fire.

As a result, untreated sewage was flowing out of an emergency overflow into the River Wid.

In the following days, investigators found 5,431 dead fish and invertebrates at many different sites along five

Further investigations found that the pumps being used by Anglian Water were almost 40 years old. The bearings on another pump had failed in 2013 and, as a result, Anglian Water sought funding to replace the bearings on the other two pumps. However, only two of the three pumps were refurbished.

Anglian Water pleaded guilty to causing an unpermitted pollution discharge.

Environment manager at the EA, Andrew Raine, said: "The fine handed to Anglian Water shows polluters are made to pay for damaging the environment. Anyone caught breaching environmental laws faces enforcement action, up to and including prosecution."

The pupils, care home residents and staff were invited to feed the lambs, while Performing Pets owner, Des, also provided a lesson on hand-raising lambs.







Calling all SHOPPING ADDICTS

In a recent study, London has been named the second best city for shopping in the world, with an overall shopping score of 8/10. The results come just days after the capital was crowned the third most popular city on the planet.

HOW DID THE STUDY SCORE EACH CITY

The study analysed cities all around the world based on the number of shopping locations, number of fashion shops within one mile, number of shopping malls within one mile, number of boutiques within one mile, and number of designer boutiques in the city.

HOW DID LONDON FARE?

London ranked in second place due to gaining the second highest number of shopping locations (1,221) and its number of boutique stores within one mile (102). The researchers were particularly impressed by London's variety, saying: "London is one of the fashion capitals of the world,

and its place as one of the world's most ideal cities for shopping is well established."

The study also revealed that London has a whopping 19 Rolex retailers.

WHO TOOK THE TOP SPOT?

Tokyo was crowned the number one shopping city in the world, with an overall shopping score of 9/10, boasting an impressive 1,970 shopping locations and 240 shopping malls and fashion shops within one mile. Paris took the third spot, with Sydney, New York and Boston also ranking strongly.

WHO CAME OUT WORST?

Vienna was named the worst city to shop in the world, with just 267 locations. Munich scored nearly as badly, with only 15 shopping malls and six boutique stores within a one-mile radius of the city centre.

SUE BARKER CBE CALLS TIME ON WIMBLEDON AFTER THREE DECADES OF IMPECCABLE SERVICE ue Barker's decision to step away from presenting duties after this year's Wimbledon championships has perhaps sounded another death knell for the BBC, whose pursuit of relevance in an everchanging media landscape continues to take away more from the organisation than it gives. As far as the 66 year old is concerned, Barker appears to have reached this endgame herself, rather than having the rug pulled from under her, as she did last year when, after 24 years of A Question of Sport, the Beeb's drive for diversity and representation saw her ousted from the show. And of course, there is an argument to say that freshening things up is a necessity. After all, the BBC's Wimbledon coverage seems to largely feature stars of a very bygone era, the 1970s and 80s, with the likes of John McEnroe, Björn Borg, Billie Jean King and Martina Navratilova representing a generation of expert summarisers that few young tennis fans can relate to. That said, the A Question of Sport experiment, now fronted by Paddy McGuinness, has failed as far as viewing figures go, and BBC executives will no doubt be wary of that as they begin to search for a replacement for someone who many feel is irreplaceable. The BBC will have some faith that possible new presenter Annabel Croft, or perhaps Clare Balding CBE, or Andrew Castle, can go a long way towards filling the void, even if Barker's contribution and presence has always been huge. Not only does she convey events with brightness, humour and warmth, but she makes her guests feel reassured and comfortable too. That mum-like demeanour feels increasingly rare in an era of television where high-octane, maximum impact entertainment is the norm, and her ability to play that out across other projects, including Sports Personality of the Year, plus athletics and Olympics coverage. sees her regarded as one of the very best of a generation. Of course, the presenter was a brilliant tennis player herself back in the 1970s. She turned pro at the age of 17, and captured the hearts of the nation three years later when she won the French Open, defeating Renáta Tomanová in the final. On home soil, Barker reached the Wimbledon semi-finals in 1977, but was surprisingly beaten by Betty Stöve. She retired aged 28 after a series of injuries, having claimed 15 singles and 12 doubles titles across her career, and seamlessly made her way into the media world, initially with Australia's Channel 7. After three years at BskyB, she ioined the BBC in 1993. In 2021, Barker was presented with a CBE for services to broadcasting and charity, having previously been given an MBE in the year 2000 and an OBE six years ago. What lies in wait next for the broadcaster, who is married to landscape gardener Lance Tankard and lives in the Cotswolds, is unknown, but what is certain is the fact she will be in high demand.

HOW TO PREPARE BANANA LEAVES FOR COOKING

- > Gently wash the leaves and then cut off the thick spine.

- > Place on a chopping board and cut to the desired size.

- > Banana leaves are porous, so if you are baking, place the leaf packets in a pan to catch leaking juices.
- > Banana leaves freeze really well. Blanch first and then wrap in greaseproof paper and place in freezer bags.





WHAT IS BUBBLE TEA?

Bubble tea can be served hot or cold, but always in a transparent cup and with a thick straw so that the pearls can be seen and sucked up with ease.

WHAT DOES BUBBLE TEA TASTE LIKE?

There are lots of different flavours of bubble tea that you can try, and you can even get various flavours of tapioca pearls. These pearls have a chewy

consistency that is somewhere between jelly and chewing gum.

HOW TO MAKE BUBBLE TEA

You will need:

Tea | Milk | Tapioca pearls | Honey or agave

How to make:

- Bring 3 cups of water to the boil and add 1 cup of tapioca pearls.
- Simmer until the pearls float to the top.
- Brew your chosen tea and allow to steep for 5 minutes.
- Chill the tea in the fridge or pour over ice to cool.
- Place the cooked pearls in a tall glass.
- Add honey or agave to sweeten if desired
- Pour your chilled tea two-thirds of the way up the glass.
- Add a splash of milk if you want a creamier drink.
- Stir and enjoy with a thick straw.



STINKING IRIS: Although this may not be the most pleasantsounding plant, stinking iris can actually make a very beautiful addition to a shady garden, especially in autumn, when its large seedpods split open to reveal orange-red seeds. Plant in full shade for best results.

WOOD SPURGE: There are many different varieties of spurge, but our favourite has to be Euphorbia amygdaloides var. robbiae. From late spring, this pretty plant bears lime-green flowers above dark green leaves. Plant in dry, shady spots such as underneath trees or along woodland borders.

SHOWDROPS: Snowdrops appear at the end of winter and bloom beautifully for weeks until your spring bulbs start to flourish. Delicate and dainty, snowdrops thrive in full shade and particularly in heavy, moist soils.

BELLFLOWER: If you are looking for a plant that will attract bees and other pollinators to your garden, then bellflower is a great choice. Ideal for growing at the back of a border, this attractive plant displays clusters of purple-blue bell-shaped flowers from summer through until autumn.

FOXGLOVE: As a woodland plant, foxgloves thrive in dappled or partial shade, so they do require a little bit of sun. There are many different varieties to choose from, with colours including bright pink, purple and peach.

- > Improve the soil with lots of organic matter before planting
- > When planting under trees, remove any dry, impoverished soil between the large roots

HORTICULTURAL HERO

THE CONTEMPORARY GARDENER WHOSE PATH IS WELL DEFINED

In a post-COVID era where we appreciate the benefit of outside space in ways we have probably never done before, the appeal of young, energetic, stylish gardeners has never been so great. With that in mind, it's easy to see why Tom Massey has found himself riding a wave of popularity.

The London College of Garden Design graduate is best known as presenter of Your Garden Made Perfect, a show that uses virtual reality and the ideas of rival garden gurus to shape horticultural solutions for frustrated homeowners.

The success of the show has led Massev into fronting a variety of other projects, from hosting parts of the Royal Horticultural Show to being asked to design and install a moveable orchard near the Olympic Park. He also works privately for a number of clients.

"I think people are really starting to appreciate the flexibility of their gardens in a way they have never done before," he says. "There is so much technology that we can bring into our outside spaces, from lighting to entertainment systems to eco-friendly heating solutions, meaning longer nights outdoors rather than always having to migrate inside.

"Gardens have always been peaceful, restorative places, but making them social spaces too is a new trend that is great to see."

When designing gardens for private clients, Massey likes to combine lawned areas with statement architecture, often guiding the eye through the space, as if going on a journey. From wildflowers to wrought iron, his contemporary ideas are striking a chord with a new generation of homeowner.

He explains: "In the past, gardens had to be soft, flowing, purely natural spaces. While that's great for nature, it's not so practical for people.

"In my opinion, we should give ourselves the freedom to live in our gardens, using materials and ideas that are attractive and offer us the opportunity to relax."

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND OUR KIDS' PERCEPTION OF MONEY

here's no parent who hasn't encountered the incessant pleading or hopeful yearning of a child who, while being commended for his or her persistence, has desperately failed to appreciate the value of something we all need perspective on - money.

While in the past the subject of finances was one largely kept clear of kids, experts now believe it's of real value to educate our voungsters as far as the daily cut and thrust of cash goes.

To do so, it is key to understand what our kids perceive as the value of money. It follows, then, that we can better manage expectations if we pinpoint their perspective. For instance, children under the age of seven will understand the concept of money and its function, but only later do they gather the sense of exchange, the idea of borrowing and the fact it comes in various forms.

Past the age of 10, kids glean how work interacts with money and the fact it can be preserved with good habits (or lost easily with bad ones). With that in mind, having a jar where kids can save money, see it accumulate and then spend it on a reward is one of the best introductions.

Parents or guardians should also use a scheme of rewarding tasks (or commissions) rather than the typical pocket money format where, effectively, a child is rewarded no matter what they do.

The importance of giving should also be emphasised, as well as opportunity cost - "If you buy this, you won't be able to buy that."

Early money management offers great practice for later life where, as we will all testify, temptations become much greater.







Andy Murray WINS WIMBLED®N

ach month, we look at one of the most significant events in British sporting history. This month, we go back to the day when Andy Murray fulfilled a life's ambition at Centre Court.

 In the modern era, men's British tennis failed to live up to expectations for a long time. Players such as Tim Henman and Greg Rusedski teased and toiled, but in all honesty were some way short of mounting real and repeated Grand Slam challenges.

When Andy Murray turned pro in 2005, immediately there was something different about this sparky, confident, sometimes arrogant Scot. Buoyed on by a fiercely supportive mum and partner, he had an allround game that, on the right day, and on the right surface, could challenge anyone.

That day came on July 7, 2013, as the then 26 year old strode out onto Centre Court in the Wimbledon men's final. Only Novak Djokovic stood between Murray arresting a 77-year wait for a men's British champion, and the opening exchanges proved the ride wasn't going to be easy.

Even so, Murray broke his opponent to take the first set 6-4, then recovered from 4-1 down to win the second 7-5. Victory was soon one game away, and as BBC commentator Jonathan Overend said, the arena represented "a cacophony of support, elation and fear. That noise, in those 90 seconds, will never, ever be heard again. So loud, so impassioned, it was like Murray was about to play the final game of his life."

Murray held his serve, and his nerve, to take the final set 6-4. Victory was his.

Of course, Murray repeated his feat three years later, and in a rich spell of success – which saw him rise to the top of the world men's rankings - also took the US Open title and made it to six further Grand Slam finals.

JAKE DANIELS BECOMES THE UK'S FIRST OPENLY GAY FOOTBALLER IN THREE DECADES

They say young footballers go about their craft with a sense of fearlessness, and that's certainly the case where Blackpool forward Jake Daniels is concerned.

The 17-year-old, who signed pro terms with the Championship club in 2022, is yet to make a league appearance for the Seasiders, though he has singlehandedly cultivated more column inches than any of his vastly more experienced teammates by coming out as the English Football League's only gay footballer.

For many years, conjecture over the possible treatment of gay footballers - in an environment where terrace banter very often crosses the line between acceptable and not - has clearly led to a huge number of gay footballers afraid to fly their true colours.

That's what makes Jake's revelation all the more brave - namely that someone right at the start of his football career has the confidence and honesty to nail his LGBT colours to the mast and

declare, as would Gloria Gaynor, "I am what I am".


He said: "I can't really put a date on it, but I was probably five or six years old when I knew I was gay, so it's been a long time that I have been living with the lie.

"Now is the right time to speak. I feel like I am ready to tell people my story. I want people to know the real me.

"I have been thinking for a long time about how I want to do it, when I want to do it. I know now is the time. I am ready to be myself, be free and be confident with it all."

The UK's first openly gay footballer since Justin Fashanu way back in 1990, Jake is correct in his assertion that attitudes and values have changed. And while the late

Daniels has been roundly praised shows just how far society has come since then.

Going forward, the threat of a full EU ban on Russian energy imports could see the cost of fuel climb even higher above the record prices we've seen - around £1.83/litre for petrol and £1.88/litre for diesel.

Even as recently as 2017, filling up at the pump was more than 30 per cent cheaper, and back in 2005, the amount we spend today would have got us twice as far down the road.
