AMID THE RELEASE OF HARRY AND MEGHAN'S TRIO OF PROJECTS, WE LOOK AT HOW THE 'SPARE' AND HIS WIFE HAVE BEGUN TO TELL THEIR TRUTH

Since their unexpected flight from both British shores and the working Royal Family in January 2020, Prince Harry and his wife Meghan have caused quite the stir, constructing a new narrative that neither they nor the Royal Family can be certain of recovering from.

First came a biography of the pair, *Finding Freedom*, written by close confidante Omid Scobie, which hinted at unease within the royal ranks. Then, in March 2021, their shock interview with TV talk show maven Oprah Winfrey aired to global comment on both sides of the Atlantic.

Since then, things have been reasonably quiet and calm as the Sussexes have settled into their Los Angeles lifestyle and adjusted to family life with their two children, Archie, aged three, and 18-monthold Lilibet. However, as several multimillion-dollar deals reach their point of fruition, our red-headed prince and his raven-maned wife are once again back in the spotlight.

Last month, their six-part Netflix documentary *Harry & Meghan* was released, which saw the Duke and Duchess of Sussex attempt to tell their side of the story. Capturing the couple from their earliest days together right up to the period after Prince Philip's death, the series has certainly split opinion. While some find it to be insightful and informative, others believe it to be shocking and villainous. Or in some cases, opinions have flipped completely, and those who might not have supported them before have now gone to the other side and have begun to empathise with the pair.

To add to any nerves the Royal Family may have already been experiencing, Harry's book, *Spare*, is released this month. The title alone conveys the Duke's deep disconnection from his own family, one that doesn't appear as if it will be healed anytime soon.

All things come in threes, and Netflix has announced it is also behind the couple's other new project, entitled *Live to Lead*. It showcases inspirational figures – from climate change activist Greta Thunberg to New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern, to South Africa rugby star Siya Kolisi, the first-ever black captain of the side. Harry was inspired by the efforts of Nelson Mandela, and true to the former president's lifelong aspirations, the series of interviews is positioned to offer hope, vision, perspective and understanding... arguably at a time when the world needs it most.

Hopefully Harry himself will find in 2023 ways to reconcile what has been a turbulent and heart-wrenching year for the royals. He and Meghan's latest moves won't have done much to repair relations, but his transparency and clarity over how he feels hard done by may indeed act as a line in the sand, from where a new vista may emerge for the outliers, even if he questions the possibility of that.

"I've had to make peace with the fact that we're probably never going to get genuine accountability or a genuine apology [from my family]," says Harry in the documentary. "My wife and I, we're moving on. We're focused on what's coming next."

Such sentiments have been uttered by many of us regarding our own families, and unequivocally this shows us that when it comes to matters of the heart, the Windsor family, for all their wealth, prestige and glory, really are just like the rest of us. But is this family's broken relationship past the point of repair?

Pooh was named after the teddy owned by author A.A. Milne's son, Christopher Robin – who also stars in the Pooh books. But the original drawings were based on Growler, the teddy owned by the son of the book's illustrator, E.H. Shepard. Milne's tubby creation made his first appearance in print in a 1924 edition of *Punch* magazine. And two years after that, the first collection of Pooh stories

appeared in an eponymously titled book, *Winnie-the-Pooh*. Piglet, Eevore, Kanga, Roo and Tigger – as well as Pooh – were all based on

toys owned by young Christopher Milne. But Owl and Rabbit were the author's own inventions.

The Hundred Acre Wood, where Pooh and his friends lived, is Milne's version of Ashdown Forest in East Sussex, where the family bought a house in 1925. Perhaps Pooh's most outstanding achievement was inventing the game of Pooh sticks. Standing on a bridge over running water, each player drops a stick on the upstream side.

THE STORY BEHIND BRITAIN'S ICONIC VACUUM CLEANER

e's not the most aesthetically pleasing member of the household cleaning family, nor the most powerful, and as far as cutting-edge technology goes, he pre-dates even the era of the mobile phone and internet connectivity.

Yet despite all of that, our love affair for Henry lives on, more than 40 years since the compact and affordable vacuum cleaner was launched by Numatic International.

Its founder, Chris Duncan, first started toying with his vacuum cleaner concept back in 1969, when he dressed up one of his standard vacuum cleaners with a Union Jack, hat and smiley face during a particularly long night at a trade show.

The response from visitors was a revelation for the inventor, who discovered that taking an inanimate object and giving it a personality enchanted people who were looking for something different from the standard cleaning devices.

Of course, the cleaner plays its part where performance is concerned

too, using large-capacity microfibre dust bags encased in a shell that is built for longevity and durability.

Since the machine was officially launched in 1981, sales continue to accelerate and now frequently exceed the one million mark each year. While Numatic has never advertised the machine, nor does it employ the services of a PR agency, an estimated 20 million have been sold in the UK to date.

Henry isn't the only named machine in the range. Previous versions have been called James, Charles, Nuvac, George, David, William, Edward, Basil, Wendy, Harry and Jack, while limited-edition models have been launched for B&Q, Screwfix and John Lewis.

It has also led to spinoff designs, notably the Henry and Hetty Spray Mops.

In 2023, it is the only massproduced consumer vacuum cleaner still made in Britain, and has made its founder a millionaire many times over. **Carpets Direct**

Sure, you can save energy by investing in a new boiler, solar panels or roof insulation. If you've got the funds, they'll make a real difference. But these days, most of us don't have the money upfront. And what if you rent your home? Here's our round-up of the best ways to reduce your energy bills – without shivering like crazy or going broke.

CHECK YOUR HEATING

Turn your thermostat down a degree or two and see if the temperature's still okay. Turn down radiators in any room you don't use much. And don't have the heating on when you're out.

HOME

& DIY

If it's not too chilly, put on some warm slippers and a jumper before reaching for the heating switch. If you're reading or watching TV, curl up under a cosy throw.

DON'T LEAVE APPLIANCES ON STANDBY

Don't keep your electrical appliances on standby mode. This goes for TVs, game consoles, laptops, printers, microwaves, electric cookers and phone chargers. And remember, devices with an LED panel, clock or light still use electricity even when they're switched off.

IN THE KITCHEN

Wait till you've got a full load to use your washing machine and run your programme at 30°C. Avoid using your tumble dryer whenever possible – it'll use a lot of electricity even in eco mode.

Only put on your dishwasher when it's full. And don't overfill the kettle – just boil the amount you need for your tea, coffee or cooking.

IN THE BATHROOM

If you can, take showers rather than baths and limit them to four minutes. You'd be surprised how much less water you'll use. And don't leave taps running – that goes for the kitchen, too.

CHECK THE LIGHTS



Choose energy-efficient LED lightbulbs. They cost a bit more, but they save energy and money in the long run because they use 90 per cent less energy than conventional halogen bulbs. Oh... and don't leave lights switched on when you don't need them.

BRITISH BUSINESS Survivors

FIVE AGE-OLD BRITISH COMPANIES STILL WITH US TODAY

Substitution of the second state of the second

The oldest surviving British company is The Royal Mint. It opened in 1279 and, for several hundred years, was based at the Tower of London. In the early 1800s, it moved over the road. But by 1975, it had completed its move to its current home in Llantrisant, Wales. The Mint makes more than 3.3 billion coins and blanks yearly – for the UK and more than 30 other countries.

With the dwindling use of cash, the Mint has expanded into other areas, including precious metals investment, historic coins and luxury collectibles. And it's doing pretty well.

Cambridge University Press, the world's first publishing company, was founded in 1534 and publishes academic and educational texts.

Moving down the years, Royal Mail, as it's now known, was founded in 1586. For almost 500 years, it was owned by the state. But by 2015, it was fully privatised. At one stage in the early 20th century, the company had 22,000 pigeons. And someone's gone to the trouble of counting how many elastic bands it currently uses to bundle mail – apparently 342 million a year.

Barclays Bank was founded in London in 1690. The institution's long history is contained in an archive of photos, letters and curiosities housed in the Barclays Group Archives in Manchester.

In 1706, Thomas Twining bought a coffee shop in London's Strand and began to sell tea. Back then, tea was very costly. But Twining spotted a trend. And when he started selling loose tea leaves, as well as cups of the beverage itself, business boomed. By 1717, he'd bought additional space next door – and the shop's still open for business today.

Plan for 200 homes approved despite rejection

Plans to build 200 homes off Kennel Lane, south of Billericay, have been approved despite an earlier rejection by Basildon Council.

The plans were initially rejected after the application was first submitted in December 2020, but were approved on appeal to the government Planning Inspectorate last month.

In its statement, Basildon Council said: "It is recognised that weight and importance should be attached to the benefit of delivering new homes, particularly where the supply is constrained, as it is here. However, it will be argued that such benefit here is not sufficient to outweigh the harmful impacts."

Pointing out that the borough was only meeting

two per cent of affordable housing needs, the Planning Inspectorate investigating officer said: "There is a persistent trend of a significant number of people being unable to access their own affordable home in the borough unless suitable, technically unconstrained, well-located housing sites which are capable of meeting those needs are brought forward. "The evidence before me demonstrates an ongoing

"The evidence before me demonstrates an ongoing and extremely bleak outlook for local affordable housing provision for a further protracted period.

"The capability of the appeal proposal to contribute significantly to addressing the existing and predicted affordable housing shortfall within the next five years attracts considerable weight in favour of this appeal."

Tributes paid to 'dedicated' family man

Billericay resident and firefighter David Lambert (pictured top left) has passed away aged 46 following a cancer diagnosis last year.

Brett Shohet, a friend of David's, said: "He was a dedicated father and a family man, besotted with his children and tremendously loyal to his family.

"He loved to go out and would have a conversation with anyone."

At Southend United's 2-2 draw with Altrincham on

Saturday, December 3, David's family and friends wore specially made scarves and t-shirts emblazoned with his nickname, 'Elmo'.

Brett added: "The memorial couldn't have gone better. The club was amazing with how they helped.

"We got personalised scarves and t-shirts made. We had a picture of him printed, a testimonial piece in the programme, and the announcer read out the statement at half-time."

A statement in the Southend United programme said: "David and his family have been coming to the club for more than 30 years and he was a well-known, loveable character in the East Stand, as well as the far post bar.

"He is being remembered here today by his family and friends."

New environmental partnership to clean area

Anew environmental enforcement partnership was Alaunched last month to help reduce the amount of waste, litter and fly-tipping in Billericay.

Basildon Council has partnered with Waste Investigations Support and Enforcement Services as of December 1. to help keep all areas of the borough clean and tidy.

The decision comes after a successful trial, when more than 7,000 fixed penalty notices were issued by enforcement officers for waste offences. The majority of these were for dog fouling, littering and fly-tipping. Individuals identified as suspected of fly-tipping or

littering can be issued with a fixed penalty notice in lieu of prosecution of £120 for littering or £400 for the unauthorised deposit of waste.

Councillor Andrew Baggott, Leader of Basildon Council and cabinet member for enforcement and public order, said: "There's never any excuse for dumping rubbish and this new contract will help us hold the people that do to account.

"We want our residents to be proud of not just the area they live in, but the borough as a whole, and our enforcement teams are working across all areas to make that a reality."

Road to close for two months for gas works

A Billericay road is to close for two months from the end of January while gas mains replacement works are undertaken by Cadent.

Hillhouse Drive will shut from its junction with Perry Street to its junction with Hillhouse Close from January 30 to March 31.

The road has previously been the subject of several complaints by residents and councillors owing to its poor surface quality. Earlier this year, councillor Anthony Hedley said that the road did not meet the criteria for emergency repairs, according to highway authorities.

He said: "As far as I am concerned, the repairs are

justified, and I intend to continue to ask for the road to be resurfaced."

A statement by Essex County Council said: "The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while mains replacement works are undertaken by Cadent.

"An alternative route is available via Stock Road. Orchard Avenue, Perry Street and vice versa (access only into Hillhouse Drive).

"Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure."

Family escapes fire thanks to alarm

The fire service has reminded residents to install smoke alarms after a fire broke out at a property in Billericay in the middle of the night.

Essex County Fire & Rescue Service crews from Billericay and Wickford were called to a residential property on Mill Lane, Ramsden Heath, on December 15 at 3.33am. The building's residents had evacuated the house after being awoken by smoke alarms.

Upon arrival, firefighters reported the ground floor as being smoke logged. Officers entered the property wearing breathing apparatus and the blaze was extinguished shortly afterwards.

It is believed the fire was caused by an electrical fault. Though the family was able to escape with their

lives, they have now sadly been left homeless as a result of the smoke damage.

Watch manager Andy Smith, from Wickford Fire Station, said: "This incident really highlights why it is so, so important to have working smoke alarms at home. The residents were all asleep upstairs, unaware there was a fire developing downstairs. Their smoke alarms saved their lives.

"Please make sure you have at least one working smoke alarm on every level of your home and test them weekly. If you haven't got working smoke alarms, we can fit them for free. Get in touch with our team online at www.essex-fire.gov.uk/book or by calling 0300 303 0088."

Council rejects plans for 44-hectare solar farm

Basildon Borough Council's Planning Committee has refused an application for a solar farm the size of 60 football pitches on green belt land in Billericay.

Submitted by Boom Power Ltd, the application was for a 44.22-hectare solar farm in Crays Hall Farm.

Representatives of Boom Power and Crays Hall Farm said the site had become plagued with weeds and was no longer sustainable as a business, and that using the site for solar energy would provide an opportunity to address the climate emergency.

However, the application was rejected at a council

meeting on November 30.

Billericay East councillor Andrew Schrader said: "I don't believe that renewables alone are going to get us to the level of energy security and self-sufficiency that we need and that's why I'm dubious that things like massive solar farms present adequate justification for the sacrifice of green belt that we're talking about." Billericay East councillor David Dadds said: "That is absolutely beautiful green belt land. I am shocked that there could be a proposal to destroy that."

Boom Power Ltd has been contacted for comment.

BURGHART for BRENTWOOD

The devastating effect of motor neurone disease (MND) on individuals and families has been brought to the forefront of our attention recently by the well-documented experience of former professional rugby league player Rob Burrow, as the disease has taken his movement and voice from him. This follows the sad death last year of Scottish rugby union player Doddie Weir. MND affects the brain and nerves, and 5,000

people in the UK are thought to have the condition. There is currently only one drug licensed in the UK to treat MND, Riluzole, which slows the progression of the disease and extends someone's life by a few months.

A small group of constituents who are affected by MND are in regular contact with me about government funding for more research, so it is

good to start 2023 knowing £50million has been made available to meet those requests. This will be used to fund specialist research centres and partnerships with leading researchers, and to accelerate work on the most promising treatments.

The government will cut red tape in order to speed up research into MND across the UK, with immediate investment so NHS patients can benefit from cutting-edge treatment and medicines. The National Institute for Health and Care Research and Medical Research Council will work together to ensure proposals are referred to the most appropriate scheme for consideration at the early stages.

It means some of the UK's best scientific minds are battling to find treatments – and one day, a cure – for the devastating condition that is MND.

DANNY DYER'S EXIT FROM *EASTENDERS* MARKS ALMOST A DECADE OF THRILLING DRAMA IN THE SQUARE

hat Danny Dyer evolved so admirably from regal cockney to Queen Vic landlord Mick Carter is one of the more celebrated evolutions of British celebrity culture.

The East London-born West Ham United superfan has waved goodbye after almost a decade on Albert Square – a solid commitment to E20 and the drinks industry that has seen the once-derided actor and presenter rise to the cream of the soap opera fraternity.

Dyer emerged as a spiky, punchy, salt-of-the-Earth type who passed up an interest in usual working-class opportunities to embark on acting classes. Bullied at school for his passion for drama, Dyer soon had the last laugh, appearing in *Prime Suspect 3* at the age of 16.

Terrestrial gigs in *Cadfael*, *A Touch of Frost*, *Loved Up*, *Highlander*, *Soldier Soldier* and *Skins* followed, before his big film break came in *Human Traffic*, an iconic coming-of-age clubbing movie that also saw the emergence of John Simm.

Soon after, he was asked to front Bravo documentary series *The Real Football Factories* (a real-life take on *The Football Factory* movie he had previously starred in), which proved to be a big hit in an era where terrace casuals were still prevalent in the Premier League and beyond (as the subsequent *The Real Football Factories International* proved).

This was followed by *Danny Dyer's Deadliest Men*, in which he interviewed Britain's most notorious gangsters.

He turned down the chance to join the cast in Walford in 2009, citing fears of being too exposed in the public eye, but having experimented with a number of low-budget film projects, was lured to *EastEnders* in 2013 as Queen Vic landlord Mick Carter.

Enjoying a bevy of controversial storylines, he has clinched three awards in the role, including Best Serial Drama Performance at the National Television Awards. Along the way, he has made the change from the rough and ready hard man of the Square to someone capable of carrying through a wealth of poignant and emotive storylines. Having spent years develping his skills, he now looks to take that forward with other projects.

"EastEnders has been amazing for me," says Dyer. "I'm grateful for the beautiful years I've had there. I'm going to miss the people massively."

Talking about what comes next, the 45 year old says: "I know the landscape has changed slightly, but I want to go out there and have another go, and the only way I can do that is if I decide to walk away from the job."

Dyer will next be seen in a four-part Channel 5 drama called *Heat*, for which filming is to begin shortly in Australia.

PRUNED

f you want to enjoy a good fruit cycle, you need to prune your apple and pear trees over the winter. For those who are new to fruit pruning, this stepby-step guide tells you all you need to know.

GET THE RIGHT TOOLS

You need to have clean, sharp tools that are designed for pruning, such as secateurs, loppers or a pruning saw if you have a larger pear or apple tree. Make sure you sharpen them before use.

CUT BACK SUCKERS AND LOWER BRANCHES

Use secateurs to cut back any suckers. These are unwanted shoots that grow near the base of the trunk. Also, cut back lower branches as these do not get sufficient light to bear good fruit.

REMOVE DEAD OR DISEASED WOOD

Remove all branches with discoloured or flaking bark towards the base of the branch by making a cut above an outward-facing bud (one that is on the opposite side of the stem to the main trunk). If there are no buds, remove the entire branch.

CREATE A VASE SHAPE FRAMEWORK

Ideally, you want four or five main branches that help p

to create an open vase shape. If you have more than five, remove some at the base by cutting 6mm from the branch collar – this refers to the bulbous area that is attached to the trunk.

Avoid removing more than 25 per cent of the branches in one go as this can affect the tree's health and fruit production.

REMOVE CROSSING OR RUBBING BRANCHES

Remove any branches that are growing into the centre of the tree as this will allow for better air circulation. If two branches are crossing, keep the one that best retains the vase shape of the tree and remove the other one.

SHORTEN THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S GROWTH ON EACH BRANCH BY ONE-THIRD

Cut just above an outward-facing bud on each main branch so that new branches grow outwards. This will help the tree to develop into a healthy shape and prevent congestion.

JANUARY 20, IS NATIONAL CHEESE LOVER'S DAY - HERE'S HOW TO CELEBRATE

eeling a little cheesed off? Well don't despair, for Friday, January 20, is National Cheese
 Lover's Day, giving you carte blanche to celebrate and indulge in all your favourite dairy delights.

Not surprisingly, Britain is a nation of cheese lovers. Whether

it's a humble checkar samie, a saucy slice of Welsh rarebit or a fancy fondue dip, the average Brit eats 30g of cheese a day and there are more than 700 cheeses produced in the UK.

Around half of sales are cheddar – named after the famed Cheddar Gorge caves in Somerset where the cheese was once stored to ripen – but we're still partial to more exotic fromages such as mozzarella, parmesan and feta.

HOW TO CELEBRATE

With such a thriving cheese industry in this country, it couldn't be easier to indulge in this Wookey Hole-iest of days. Most major supermarkets now boast English-made gems such as Wensleydale Blue and Red Leicester, but it's also worth seeking out some lesser-known treats from your nearest speciality cheesemonger. Or, if you're really enthusiastic, you can head to your local dairy farm where they will likely have a shop selling their creations.

Not only is cheese incredibly tasty and diverse, it's also highly nutritious. A great source of protein, it contains vitamin B12 (which is vital for red blood formation), and a matchbox-sized slice provides one-third of an adult's daily calcium requirement.

So don't be sheepish – make like a mouse and treat yourself to a little of what you fancy. Whether red, yellow or blue, in moderation, cheese is very good for you.

f you're thinking about staying in this Valentine's Day, shellfish offers a decadent and delicious centrepiece for a romantic meal for two.

However, if you're unsure what to serve for that special someone come February 14, here are five of the most popular types of shellfish, as well as how to serve them.

OYSTER

Oysters are the most nutrient-rich shellfish available and also the most expensive. With a reputation as an aphrodisiac, oysters have a gooey texture and a salty flavour. Most commonly served raw on ice, you can fill their shells with lemon, butter, hot sauce or a zingy mixture made from shallots and vinegar. Alternatively, they can be grilled, baked or fried.

MUSSELS

One of the easiest shellfish to prepare and cook, mussels are usually steamed in flavoured broth or sauce. Mussels need to be kept alive before they are cooked and can only be refrigerated for one or two days. Any mussels with broken shells or ones with open shells and that don't close when tapped should be discarded. Enjoy moules frites (steamed mussels and fries), served with a huge chunk of crusty bread.

CRAB

Crabs take a bit more effort to prepare and cook, but it's definitely worth it as you'll be rewarded with tender, delicious meat. You can boil, roast, steam or grill crab and this shellfish is commonly used in dips, pastas, seafood dishes and salads. White crab meat boasts a meaty texture and a more delicate flavour, whereas brown meat is softer with an almost pâté-like consistency.

SCALLOP

Another highly tender and succulent type of shellfish, scallops make the perfect starter. Boasting a rich, buttery flavour, you can choose between small and sweet bay scallops or big and bold sea scallops. Pan-seared scallops with peas and mint are our go-to recipe at any time of year.

LOBSTER

Known for its melt-in-the-mouth texture, lobster is the epitome of elegance. Lobster can be cooked whole, and the most succulent meat is found in the tails, legs and claws. Try garlic herb butter lobster tail as a delicious starter or lobster risotto as a main course.

To mark the occasion, why not create some beautiful paper lanterns? Plain ones can look gorgeous, but choose rabbit-printed paper or add some decorations for a bit of extra festive fun. You could even adom your lanterns with homemade. bunny features, such as ears, eyes and noses.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Some sheets of paper (A4 paper makes a lantern about 20cm tall, and A5 paper makes a lantern about 1.4cm tall). You can use different coloured or patterned paper
- > A ruler, pencil and eraser
- > A glue stick
- Scissors
- Extra decorations such as stick on shapes. sequins, braid or ribbon (optional)

- Fold your paper in half lengthways so you have a long, slim rectangle.
- Draw a line parallel with the long edge, where the two sides of the paper meet. This line should be about 2.5cm away from the edge.
- Starting about 2.5cm in from one of the short edges, draw a series of parallel lines across the rectangle, from the folded edge up to the long line you've just drawn. These lines should be about 2.5cm apart.
- Cut along each of the short lines.
- Erase any noticeable pencil marks, then unfold the paper.

- 6. Run your gluestick along one short side of the lantern. Form the paper into a tube shape, then alue the two short sides together.
- 7. If you like, decorate your lantern or add a ribbon or paper handle.

The lanterns look great strung along a piece of ribbon or string!

BEN STOKES OBE HAS TRANSFORMED HIMSELF AND THE GAME OF CRICKET

t's only five years since Ben Stokes OBE found himself facing not just exclusion from the sport he loved, but also potentially a prison sentence, having been charged with affray outside a Bristol nightclub. The incident – in which the brilliant all-rounder was defending a homosexual couple – cost Stokes his place in the 2017/18 Ashes team, and sent the Durham cricketer on a journey of self-discovery that, ultimately, has led him to the heights he finds himself at now.

Stokes roared back from the Bristol incident, inspiring England's 2019 World Cup win, batting sensationally at Headingly in that year's Ashes to win the third Test when all seemed lost, and being named Player of the Series in South Africa that winter.

Last year, Stokes was instrumental in bringing England T20 World Cup glory, yet it is his ascent as Test captain that is truly captivating a nation at the moment.

England clinched an away Test series in Pakistan – a country in which they had only ever won two matches in their entire history – yet it is the manner of the cricket being played that truly reflects a new dawn for the sport.

'Bazball', as it is referred to, is a driven, dynamic and outlandishly positive method of playing the game, the like of which five-day Test cricket has never seen. This cricket revolution epitomises not just Stokes' captaincy, but also his approach to life itself.

As inspirational English sportspeople go, there are few who can rival Stokes' efforts.

Further proof of this was offered when Stokes was named as runner-up in the 2022 BBC Sports Personality of the Year Award. Though he didn't win, his nomination is evidence enough of his incredible success. cinch

EHICLE INS

Thile no one expects to be involved in a car accident, these types of incidents can happen in the blink of an eye and, if you don't know what to do next, can cause you untold stress and expense.

Here's everything you need to know about DOI HAVE TO MAKE A CLAIM AFTER AN making a claim following an accident.

WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO MAKE A CLAIM?

If you are involved in a motoring incident with another person, you should do your best to obtain the below information on the scene:

- > Their full name
- > Their vehicle registration
- > A contact telephone number

It can also be a good idea to find out their address and details of their insurance provider. If there are any witnesses, try to get their details as well. When you phone your insurance company, they are likely to ask you for your policy number, so make sure you have this to hand.

WHEN DO I NEED TO MAKE A CLAIM?

Although it can vary from one insurance provider to the next, typically you have 24 to 48 hours to inform them if you are involved in a motoring

accident. This is regardless of whether the incident was your fault or caused by another party. Where possible, you should call them while still at the scene.

E CLAIM F

ACCIDENT?

There is no rule that says you have to make a claim after a road accident, but you are required by law to tell your insurer about what has happened.

DO I NEED TO CALL THE POLICE AFTER A CAR ACCIDENT?

According to the Road Traffic Act, you must report a car accident to a local police station within 24 hours. You can do this using the nonemergency number 101. If there is an injury or the road is blocked, call 999 immediately.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T WANT TO MAKE A CLAIM?

You may choose not to make a claim. This will allow you to keep your no-claims discount intact, although you will have to pay for any necessary repairs to your vehicle yourself. It is worth knowing that, even if you do not make a claim, the other driver involved may still do so.
