60 YEARS

MARKING THE 60TH ANNIVERSARY OF DOCTOR WHO – THE MAN, THE WOMAN, THE SHOW, THE MOVEMENT

Asking celebrities how they remain so youthful has become par for the course, but none has achieved as much ongoing success and vigorous relevance as the great Doctor, who at 60 is looking pretty fresh.

On Christmas Day, the Doctor's latest regeneration will be revealed, but not before some highly anticipated TV specials for the show's anniversary in November.

Making his grand return as the fourteenth Doctor, fan favourite David Tennant is set to wow once more for three anniversary episodes. The Scottish actor originally starred as the tenth Doctor from 2005 until his final episode aired on New Year's Day in 2010. Catherine Tate will also reprise her role as the Doctor's companion Donna Noble, with Neil Patrick Harris also joining the cast.

Though Patrick Harris is a newcomer to the *Doctor Who* fold, his character, The Toymaker, is not. First appearing in a now classic episode titled *The Celestial Toymaker*, from the show's third season in 1966, he was originally portrayed by actor Michael Gough.

The Toymaker is a memorable antagonist owing

to his whimsical yet sinister demeanour and his ability to create intricate and deadly challenges for the Doctor and his companions. The character's distinctive appearance and personality have made him a notable figure in the show's lore, one that aligns perfectly with Patrick Harris' dramatic and theatrical flair.

NOT THE BOX

One of the greatest success stories for the BBC, *Doctor Who* began in 1963 when Sydney Newman OC, the corporation's head of drama, tasked producer Verity Lambert OBE and writer Anthony Coburn with creating a TV science fiction series. Their vision gave birth to *Doctor Who*, a show that would combine history, adventure and futuristic concepts in a unique way. William Hartnell portrayed the original incarnation of the Doctor, a mysterious Time Lord with the ability to regenerate. The Doctor, along with his granddaughter Susan and two teachers, Ian and Barbara, travelled in the TARDIS, a time machine that looked like a 1960s British police box on the outside.

The series is listed in the Guinness World Records as the longest-running science fiction television series in the world, with Tom Baker holding the title for starring in the highest number of episodes – a whopping 178.

> Despite its popularity, *Doctor Who* faced a significant hurdle in 1989 when it went on an extended hiatus. Aside from a TV film in 1996, the Doctor would not be fully regenerated until 2005.

> > This was the beginning of the show's modern era, helmed by writer and showrunner Russell T. Davies OBE and starring Christopher Eccleston as the ninth Doctor.

> > > The most recent revamp of the series sees Davies return as the showrunner, taking over from Chris Chibnall who

introduced Jodie Whittaker as the 13th Doctor. Hot on the heels of his 2021 success *It's a Sin*, and with *Sex Education* star Ncuti Gatwa playing the 14th Doctor, Davies is in a fine position to return the show to its noughties glory.



SHOWCASING HIS PASSION FOR CONSERVATION AND EQUALITY

hen His Majesty King Charles III was crowned, he thanked the public for their • 1p coin: Hazel dormouse... which has seen its kindness and encouragement, and vowed that he and Her Majesty Queen Camilla would rededicate their lives "to serving the people of the United Kingdom, the Realms and Commonwealth".

Putting his money where his mouth is, quite literally, the edge inscription of the new £2 coin reads 'In servitio omnium', which means 'In the service of all'. It was taken from the King's inaugural speech on September 9, 2022, and chosen by him • 20p coin: Puffin... 10 per cent of the world personally.

The coin is one of eight that have been unveiled by The Royal Mint, ranging from 1p to £2. Determined to distinguish his reign from that of his beloved mother, the King has also embossed them with another of his great passions: nature.

Featuring endangered species from across the British Isles, such as the puffin, the red squirrel and the bee, along with flowers and the oak tree leaf, the coins reflect His Majesty's devotion to conservation and equality.

Here is the full list:

- population halve since 2007
- 2p coin: Red squirrel... expected to blend into the colour of the copper coin
- 5p coin: Oak tree leaf... a rich habitat for biodiversity in woodland areas with a long monarchic association
- 10p coin: Capercaillie... found in a small part of Scotland and threatened with extinction
- population is on the UK's coastline
- **50p coin:** Atlantic salmon... at threat from river pollution and habitat loss
- £1 coin: Bees... 250 species found in the UK • £2 coin: National flowers – a rose (England), a daffodil (Wales), a thistle (Scotland), a shamrock (Northern Ireland)

The coins will replace those designed by Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in 2008 and may be in use by the end of 2023, but The Mint has confirmed that all existing currency remains legal tender.

How to make a Christmas CUTLERY POUCH



over your cutlery with Christmas cheer with this simple and stylish craft. All you need are a few materials and some basic sewing skills and you are good to go!

YOU WILL NEED:

A sewing machine or needle and thread A rotary cutter or pair of sharp scissors A ruler Cotton fabric fat quarters in your preferred Christmas colours or patterns 2 x pieces of festive ribbon or trim (optional)

HOW TO MAKE:

Step 1: Cut your fabric

To create your pouch, you will need two pieces of fabric in contrasting colours or patterns. These need to be cut to 38cm x 12cm.

Step 2: Decide on your layout

One piece of fabric will be used to make the inside of your pouch and the other will be used as the flap. Your cutlery will lie on the inside fabric and be covered by the outside one.

Step 3: Place your fabrics face to face

Next, place your two fabrics face to face. If the flap fabric has a pattern, this needs to be placed upside down. Using a 10mm seam allowance, stitch around the two pieces of fabric using a sewing machine or by hand. Leave a 4cm gap at the bottom for turning.

Step 4: Clip the corners

Clip the corners of the fabrics, making sure not to cut the stitches, then turn the pouch the right way in. Pop out the corners using a pencil and then iron gently to smooth out the fabrics. Sew up the gap.

Step 5: Add ribbon or trim

If you want to add ribbon or a trim, lay out your pouch and sew the pieces of ribbon or trim to the edge that will turn up to make the flap.

Step 6: Complete the pouch

Fold the flap over with a 13cm measurement and iron it in place. Carefully tuck the ends of the trim inside and pin it in place. Sew all the way around the pouch as close to the edge as you can to create a top stitch.

Plans for 150 new homes discussed at meeting

Plans for new homes and a care home in Billericay were discussed at a Basildon Council (BC) Planning Committee meeting last month.

The proposal from P&A Investments Ltd and PD Developments Ltd was submitted in September last year, and would require the demolition of two dwellings at numbers 41 and 65 Potash Road to allow for the development of 150 dwellings and a 50-bed care home.

BC discussed the plans at a meeting on Wednesday, October 4, having previously rejected the application. However, P&A Investments and PD Developments lodged an appeal with the government.

In the meeting, the committee reiterated that the plan has been refused once again. This is owing to the fact that "insufficient information has been provided in relation to roosting bats and the mitigation approach and compensatory measures for any loss of hazel dormouse habitat".

It also stated: "Insufficient information has been provided to determine if the development would be safe for its lifetime and pose a threat in terms of flooding to future occupiers of the site."

The agent for the applicant has been contacted for comment.

Councillors urge Network Rail to 'eliminate the pigeons'

Brentwood councillors are urging for something to be done about the pigeon problem under Shenfield railway bridge.

At a meeting at the end of September, councillors Keith Barber (pictured below left) and Thomas Heard (pictured below right) argued that the lack of anti-pigeon features under the bridge has led to a significant amount of pigeon faecal matter, which they say is hazardous to the health of residents.

Cllr Heard said: "Cllr Barber and I were pleased to incorporate suggested amendments from other councillors to make the matter something that we could all endorse so that we can, as a united council, apply pressure on the legal owner of the bridge to do the right thing and spend the money necessary on permanent measures to eliminate the pigeons.

"It represents a substantial threat to public health. What compounds the frustration surrounding this matter is the repeated attempt to engage Network Rail. We must act swiftly and responsibly."

Network Rail has been contacted for comment.



BURGHART for BRENTWOOD

Alex Burghart MP for Brentwood and Ongar



∧ s a historian, I take every opportunity I can to visit Aand find out more about local places of historic interest, and I am now compiling them on my website in Dr Burghart's History Notes.

Brentwood is known as being the site of the start of the 14th-century Peasants' Revolt - an event now commemorated in the name of the newest pub and microbrewery on Kings Road near Brentwood Station. I know the brewery/pub has just expanded and is on my list for a visit and a pint.

Some 200 years later, William Hunter became a martyr as he was burnt at the stake. He is commemorated with a stone memorial off Wilson's Corner roundabout and in the naming of William Hunter Way running parallel to the High Street.

In times to come. Brentwood's former White Hart Inn - now the Sugar Hut - may be remembered less for its history as a coaching inn for travellers, and more for its part in The Only Way is Essex TV series.

Brentwood and Ongar's wartime history is fascinating - you can still see the remains of Second World War airfields in Willingale and Matching Green. Just last

month. I laid a wreath at the site in West Horndon where two USAF B17 bombers collided in mid-air in bad weather while trying to return to their base in Suffolk 80 years ago, killing 20 young airmen.

The local churches are always a great source of less well-known historic information, and my Friday constituency days are always made better by a guick visit to a village church. I have described them previously as "a stone and mortar history book", with memorial plaques to the local great and good, and stained-glass windows dedicated to the memory of the brave and fallen.

Sometimes a building catches my eye, or a blue plaque, like the one on Lloyds Bank on Brentwood High Street declaring it to be the site of the world's first ATM cashpoint. If you know of any small but significant historic places in Brentwood and the surrounding villages, do let me know and I will add them to my constituency visits for further investigation.

Exploring the expansive corners of Hatfield Forest

n west Essex on the border of Hertfordshire lies a treasure trove of natural beauty: Hatfield Forest. This enchanting forest, once a royal hunting ground, is a special place where age-old landscapes have been preserved and history echoes through every leaf and branch.

The forest, which spans more than 1,000 acres, features coppiced trees, ancient wood pasture and shimmering lake, making it a paradise for nature lovers, walkers and picnickers alike.

Hatfield Forest isn't just about natural beauty, though. It was preserved as a hunting ground by William the Conqueror and is steeped in centuries of history. It's a living, breathing relic of medieval England, and stories of past royalty and deer hunts are woven into the very fabric of the woodland.

Boundary disputes have dominated much of Hatfield Forest's past, and these dividing lines remain intact to this day, despite the fact that renowned landscape designer Capability Brown was invited to modify elements in the 18th century.

In later times, the Victorians explored agricultural use, and during the Second World War, some parts of the forest even came under military occupation.

These days, the expansive setting is carefully protected by the National Trust. offering accessibility for locals and visitors alike, who are invited to have a picnic in the open grasslands, enjoy the tranquillity of

the lake, or take a leisurely walk through the ancient woods. With the latter in mind, there are a number of designated routes that can be traversed through the forest, although some of the trails can become guite muddy during the winter months.

Regardless, Hatfield Forest, which is also marked as a Site of Special Scientific Interest, provides a beautiful escape from the modern world.





The perfect ROAST CHICKEN

rom how to create a classic roast dinner to carving it up to get the most meat out of it, the below will guide you through each step.

TO ROAST THE CHICKEN You will need:

1 whole chicken | Half a lemon | Butter | Salt and pepper

Method:

- > Pre-heat the oven to 200°C/180°C fan/gas mark 6.
- Take the chicken and remove any giblets that may be in the cavity. You can, of course, buy whole chickens with the giblets already removed.
- > Put the half lemon into the chicken cavity and smear butter over the whole bird.
- Season with salt and pepper.
- Cook the chicken uncovered for 20 minutes per half a kilo, with an extra 30 minutes for good measure.
- To make sure the chicken is thoroughly cooked, give the legs a prod to see if the juices run clear,

or cut into the breast to see if the meat is white.

TO CARVE THE CHICKEN You will need:

A very sharp carving knife Carving fork Chopping board (preferably with a well to catch any juices)

Method:

- > Remove the legs: Use the carving fork to hold the chicken in place and cut across the skin between the breast and the leg. Pull the leg away from the breast and use your knife to cut through the joint. Repeat on the other side.
- > Remove the wings: Repeat the process above pull the wing away from the breast and cut through the joint. Repeat on the other side.
- > Remove the breast meat: Carefully run the knife down the centre of the breastbone to cut through the skin. Run the knife down the breastbone, cutting the meat from the bone.
- The rest: Pick off any remaining meat to use in a pie or soup or freeze in a container for another day.



After a huge year, Kylie Minogue AO OBE is revving up for the grand finale

with an ITV extravaganza, *An Audience with Kylie*. Few of us can boast of a career of more than three decades; even fewer can achieve such a feat in the cut-throat music industry, and one in a billion can do it with the grace, style and panache of Kylie.

revival going in Britain's gardens, front and back. A trend that came to the fore in the nineties has seen something of a revival, with an increase in sales of rocks and alpine plants. Add in pebble mulches and gravel, and it's clear we are refreshing our garden spaces to add height, texture and, dare we say it, perhaps the odd splash of cascading water.

As for how to style your perfect rock garden, a slope obviously helps. If you don't have one, fear not – you can create a display by banking rocks closely together, filling in gaps with brick, stone or rubble to create a defined ridge.

It's a good idea to look for local stone – this will add character and provenance to the garden; and while many varieties may be expensive to buy, searching locally online may well bring about cheap or even free sources of stone. Let rocks develop a patina of age – don't clean them or they won't look authentic – and bury them about a third of the way into the ground, tilting backwards, allowing space for grass and plants to flourish around them.

How to create a rock

Now all you need to do is pattern surroundings with what you choose – an evergreen, such as miniature conifers will create vertical interest, while smaller shrubs will keep layers of interest even through the cold winter months.

Drought-tolerant plants such as sedums and sempervivums are also a good idea, while trailers, such as creeping rosemary, creeping thyme or aubretia, will guide the eye across the structure.

Finally, for texture, add some contrasting shapes – spikes, slants, velvety leaves – plus smaller bulbs, such as wild tulips, daffodils, snowdrops and crocus. With your work done, sit back and admire!

hile many might scoff at the idea of the UK being a warm winter getaway with gourmet food, it's a top holiday spot in the bird world! That's right - as temperatures drop elsewhere, large numbers of our feathery friends flock to Britain.

MAJESTIC GEESE AND SWANS

Leading the parade of bird visitors is the fabulous pinkfooted goose. When the temperatures dip in Iceland, and food gets scarce, the geese fly to the Faroe Islands, rest a bit, and then head to the UK. Similarly, Bewick swans head over from Siberia, while whooper swans make their way from Iceland.

VIBRANT COASTAL LIFE

Every autumn, the UK's beaches and wetlands burst into life with a big mix of wading birds from northern Europe. the Arctic, Russia and northern Canada. These include lapwings, dunlin, oystercatchers, bar-tailed godwits, redshanks, and grey plovers from the Arctic.

INLAND VISITORS

Moving inland, colourful Bohemian waxwings, with their distinctive crests, black eyeliner, and peach-tinged plumage, fly in from Scandinavia. You can sometimes spot them in large flocks in berry-laden bushes in towns, car parks and gardens. And it's not uncommon to see large numbers of dainty goldcrests with a radiant yellow stripe along the top of their heads. Despite weighing no more than a ten-pence piece, this remarkable bird journeys across the North Sea to spend its colder months with us.

Other northern European visitors you might spot in your garden include redwing and fieldfare - both types of thrush.

When spring comes, the birds fly back to their homelands to breed. Given the warming world and milder climates in their nesting territories, these winter visitors might one day no longer grace our shores. So let's all appreciate them a bit more - while we still have the opportunity.

















ricket undoubtably has universal popularity. Combine this with its intricacies, its longevity as a game, the ease of online betting and the variety of bookmaker markets, and you have the potential for foul play, on an international scale. Take Pakistan's 2010 tour of England, for example; a series that became the centre of a sting by the *News of the World* (*NoTW*) where its reporters secretly filmed Mazhar Majeed, a British bookmaker and agent, giving bribes to visiting players ahead of the Lord's Test.

Money was offered on the proviso that two Pakistan fast-bowlers, Mohammad Asif and Mohammad Amir, would deliberately send no-balls at agreed times – known as spot-fixing. Even the team's captain, Salman Butt, was in on the scam.

The *NoTW* exposé ended with jail sentences meted out to all four, with the three players also receiving lengthy bans.

While the idea was brazen and reflective of the global gambling market, it was not the first time it had happened. Between 1994 and 1995, an Indian man referred to as 'John the Bookmaker' handed over cash to Australian stars Mark Waugh and Shane Warne in exchange for pre-match weather and pitch information.

'John' soon upped the ante, requesting team selections and tactics, but the duo refused. The Australian Cricket Board became aware of the allegations and the action taken was to fine each player privately.

In the aftermath, the Aussies claimed that Pakistan captain Salim Malik had approached them with bribes in exchange for losing matches. While their own credibility as witnesses had evaporated, the story was pursued, and former captain Malik received a life ban in 2000.

In 2023, cricket's abundant riches implies spot-fixing should be less appealing to players, yet the lure of a payday is always there.

Breast reduction is a cosmetic procedure to remove excess fat and skin from the breasts making them smaller, better shaped and more uplifted.

The procedure can relieve physical symptoms such as breast discomfort, neck ache, backache, shoulder pain, skin irritations under the breast fold, painful pressure from bra straps and difficulties and discomfort during exercise.

What happens during breast reduction surgery?

There are several different surgical procedures for breast reduction. Excess skin and fat is removed. Your breasts are reshaped, and the nipples are repositioned. All procedures result in a scar around the areola (dark area around the nipple) and each method results in additional scarring. Your surgeon will discuss each procedure with you and together vou will decide which is best in your particular case. Breast reduction can also be used to correct asymmetry (imbalance) of your breasts.

Going home after breast reduction surgery

Patients often go home the same day as their procedure but may need to stay overnight. You will have dressings on your breasts and there may be drains (plastic tubes). The drains are usually removed before you leave hospital.

You will be given post-operative pain killers and instructions regarding your dressings and any stitches you may have.

Most patients are mobile from day one and return to normal activities within six weeks. However, everyone heals differently. Be sure and discuss your return to work with your surgeon.

The results of breast reduction improve gradually over time. Your breasts should become softer and more natural as the healing continues.

- Numbness or persistent pain on the outer part of the breast

- Uneven shape: Your breasts will change shape after reduction surgery. There is a chance that they may end up slightly lopsided, lumpy or with uneven nipples

STEP-UPS: Step up and down from a bench | Continue for one minute, rest and repeat three times Add weights if you want to challenge yourself Upgrade to a box jump where you jump up and down with two feet rather than alternate feet

PLANK: Adopt the push-up position | Push through your hands and squeeze your body, engaging your abs Hold for one minute, rest and repeat three times.

tamin D makes sure our bones, teeth, and muscles stay healthy. It also helps our immune system. And some studies suggest it might even help fight low mood and fatigue.

From early spring to the end of summer, most of us get all the vitamin D we need from our skin reacting to sunlight. And you only need to be outside for around nine minutes a day if you're lightskinned and 25 minutes or so if your skin's darker.* But what happens when you're stuck inside and

summer sunshine is a distant memory?

The government recommends that we all take a daily vitamin D supplement in autumn and winter. There's not enough sun around, and you can't get all the vitamin D you need from food.

Some groups are advised to take a supplement all year round. This includes children aged four and under, people who can't get outside, and people who wear clothes that cover most of their skin when they're outdoors.

Adults shouldn't take more than 100 micrograms (4,000 IU) of vitamin D daily, and children aged one to 10 shouldn't have more than 50 micrograms (2,000 IU). However, for some people, vitamin D could still be harmful even when taking less than the maximum recommended dose. Always check with your doctor if you are worried.

f your bling is looking more dull than dazzling, then these tried and tested DIY cleaning techniques are just what you need.

HOW TO CLEAN STERLING SILVER 1. Try baking soda

For severe tarnish, mix three parts baking soda with one part water. Wet the silver and then apply the paste with a soft, lint-free cloth. Work into the crevices, rinse well and buff.

2. Apply toothpast

Toothpaste is a mild abrasive and therefore ideal for cleaning silver. Simply apply a dab to your silver jewellery and rub gently with your finger or a soft cloth. Rinse and buff.

HOW TO CLEAN GOLD (WHITE, YELLOW AND ROSE) 1. Use ammonia

Ammonia is a powerful cleaner so is best used for occasional deep cleaning rather than frequent use. Add one part ammonia to six parts water, soak your gold jewellery for one minute, rinse and gently pat dry with a polishing cloth.

2. Soak in warm, soapy water

Fill a bowl with warm water, add a few drops of washing-up liquid and leave to soak for 10-15 minutes. Use a soft-bristle toothbrush to dislodge dirt, rinse and dry.

JEWELLERY TO BE CLEANED PROFESSIONALLY

Gold and sterling silver can be safely cleaned at home. However, more delicate metals, such as platinum, should be cleaned by a professional. If your jewellery contains precious stones such as diamonds, sapphires or rubies, you should stick to mild soap and water.

HOW TO KEEP SILVER AND GOLD JEWELLERY LOOKING Its best for longer

- Store your jewellery in an acid-free, closed container.
- Do not leave your jewellery in direct heat or sunlight.
- Avoid your jewellery coming into contact with chemicals.
- Remove your jewellery before bathing, swimming and exercising.





SEALPUP SAFARI

ave you ever yearned to see fluffy white seal pups in their natural habitat? If so, a trip to Blakeney Point in north Norfolk could be up your street.

Blakeney Point is home to England's largest grey seal colony – and winter's a great time to visit. From the end of October to mid-January, around 4,000 pups are born – and you can't fail to spot some.

What is Blakeney Point?

Blakeney Point is a four-mile stretch of pebbly beach with a backdrop of dunes, salt marshes and mudflats. It's one of England's 220 National Nature Reserves and is looked after by the National Trust.

Can I walk there?

You can walk to the point from the car park at Cley beach. But it's not for the fainthearted. It's a fourmile walk, mostly on shingle. But if you're fit and love nature, you're in for a treat!

What's the best way to get there? The most exciting way to get a closer view of the seals is by boat. Several companies offer seal-watching trips from nearby Morston Quay. You can travel there by car or on the Norfolk CoastHopper bus service from places like Sheringham and Cromer.

The boat trip will take around about an hour. Just remember the boat trip is for viewing only; you can't land there.






