



A dalliance with design that has lasted 50 years

icky Haslam has assumed many guises throughout his life - designer, show horse breeder, global socialite, friend to the stars. The inspirational designer even waited until his 73rd birthday to release his debut album, finally indulging one of his boyhood daydreams with the assistance of industry heavyweights such as Nick Mason (Pink Floyd), Helena Bonham Carter, Bryan Ferry and the late Cilla Black.

But it is clearly for his immaculate take on style and fashion that we have become most absorbed in Nicky Haslam's work. The Buckinghamshire-born icon has been the creative auteur and driving force behind London institution NH Design, and while he admits his workload has reduced in recent years as he fights against the idea of retirement, his hunger for interiors has never abated.

"We're slaving away on a wonderful house and a wonderful restaurant in New Orleans, a big project in New York, a place in the south of France outside St Tropez, plus some wonderful penthouses in Park Lane, with 360-degree views of London. We're busy."

The designer, who has written for *The Telegraph*, *Vogue* and *Tatler*, and has properties scattered across London, believes the key to good interiors is detail and control. He fills space with objects, blends styles without fear and constructs a 'lived-in' vibe that is brave yet relaxed.

"People are still looking at image and opulence, but these days there is much more attention being paid to comfort and possessions, probably because we are working so hard and we just want to be settled in our own spaces.

"Minimalism is old hat as far as I am concerned. Just surround yourself in what feels right. Don't splash colour around or re-wallpaper because everyone else is doing it; instead, be inspired by things in your locale – reflection is important – and want to learn. Even having practised design for decades, I am still picking up new ideas."

TIME on our side

The time-bearing standard that defines the world, and it's just an hour away.

any of us go through the odd moment of wishing we could turn back the clock, but the power of time is something only very few have ever had in their command.

And yet, the meeting of 25 nations in Washington DC 135 years ago this month will always be marked as a monumental moment against which we've been setting our watches ever since. On October 22, to be exact, the great and the good at the International Meridian Conference decided that the Royal Observatory in Greenwich would become the site of the Universal Time meridian of longitude.

It's positioning of Greenwich Mean
Time (GMT) as a standard bearer for the
world is most probably a reference point
that will never be changed. Subsequently, the
delineation of world time zones has always been
either plus or minus a specified quantity of hours –
the furthest time zone being that of the Baker and
Howland Islands in the Equatorial Pacific, which rank
a full 12 hours behind us.

Of course, these time zones are subject to significant shift. When lines marking time boundaries are drawn on a map, a number of peculiarities can be found, often arched around small islands.

The most extreme example of time difference is at the Diomede Islands, which sees us return to the Pacific. Big Diomede dwarfs Little Diomede, which sits two-and-a-half miles away. With one being the

furthest east you can go and the other being the furthest west, and the international date line running down the middle, they are, in effect, one day apart (21 hours, to be exact). That means if you stand on one with a pair of binoculars and look at the other, you are viewing tomorrow... or is it yesterday?

More pertinently, given that one is owned by Russia and the other by America, the Diomede Islands appear a chink in time even GMT won't be able to resolve.



Daughter's heart beats strong as organs help save lives

ABrentwood mother says her daughter's heart still beats strong after she made the decision to donate her organs to others after she died.

Maxine Forrest, of Mayfield Gardens, lost daughter Sophie, 26, in February 2018 and, after donating her organs, she has helped save five lives.

Sophie spent her final days in the high dependency unit at Queen's Hospital in Romford after a suicide attempt at home.

When it was confirmed that she would not recover, her family knew she had wanted to donate her organs and carried out her wishes without hesitation.

Maxine said: "We were pleased that Sophie would live on by giving other families their loved ones back. Her heart still beats strong.

"I received a letter telling me that five successful transplants had taken place, and I also received a beautiful letter from one of the recipients, thanking me and letting me know that he had his wife back, and his little girl had her mummy back.

"Sophie will never be forgotten, and she is also cherished by the families who have their loved ones as a result of her donations."

Sophie had left no specific instructions about organ donation; however, through conversations with her cousin, the recipient of a kidney transplant, her family knew it was what she wanted.

Ensuring your family are aware you want to donate your organs after you die can make a huge difference. Your loved ones do not have to make the decision themselves, and have the comfort of knowing they are carrying out your wishes.

It was the compassionate care of hospital staff which led Maxine, 66, to become a patient partner, working with the NHS to improve care for other patients.

Maxine added: "When we went to say goodbye to Sophie, we were treated with the utmost respect and compassion

"The nurses even plaited Sophie's long hair and cut it, alongside her brother Drew, who had long hair at the time, to donate it to the Little Princess Trust, which makes wids for children with cancer."

Maxine and Drew also attended a special ceremony at Essex County Council where they were awarded the Order of St John due to Sophie's donations.

Appeal as body of dead pony found dumped

The RSPCA are appealing for information after a dead pony was discovered in

The body of the pony was discovered dumped along a footpath in the Dudbrook Road area on Tuesday, August 13.

A member made the sad discovery at around 5.40pm and contacted the RSPCA.

The pony was a Piebald cob breed and she was not

Although the pony had blood in her nostrils and mouth, there were no obvious signs of what the cause of death may have been.

RSPCA inspector Jessica Dayes is investigating the incident and said: "We are very grateful to

the members of the public for providing valuable information for this investigation and for their compassion when discovering this poor pony.

"It is heartbreaking that this poor pony has died and been dumped like rubbish. It is believed the pony would have only been there for a short while.

"While we do not know the circumstances surrounding the death of this pony, we would be keen to hear from anyone who may have any information or who may have seen anyone acting suspiciously in this area. We are also looking to see if any CCTV was in use in the area.

"We would urge anyone with information to contact us in confidence on the RSPCA inspectorate appeal line on 0300 123 8018."

New appeal in attempted murder investigation



Arenewed appeal has been made on the BBC's *Crimewatch* to find a man police want to talk to over the alleged attempted murder of three people in Brentwood in 2017. Essex Police are still trying to find Martin Stokes, 25, after three people were rushed to hospital when they were hit by a car outside The Sugar Hut, in Brentwood High Street, at around 3.10am on April 2, 2017. This followed a mass brawl outside the nightspot.

They were all taken to hospital with serious injuries, one with serious internal injuries including chest injuries, broken ribs, a collapsed lung, fractured spine, and lacerations to his liver and head.

Police believe Stokes, 25, has links to London, Hertfordshire, Manchester and Ireland, In June, eight men admitted affray and were given suspended prison sentences, fined and ordered to complete unpaid work totalling 880 hours in connection to the fight.

However, the best season in the FA Cup under the club's current name came in 1969/70 when the club reached the Third Round.

They beat Football League club Reading 1-0 in the First Round. Hendon 2-0 in the second round before a record crowd of over 4.000 saw them lose 1-0 at home to Northampton Town.

The season before, the club reached the Second Round, where they lost 10-1 at Southend United.

In recent years, the club has exited the cup in the qualifying rounds.

In July, he travelled to Panama for his second round of stem cell treatment which improved his energy. reduced hand shakes and helped him feel stronger.

However, following two heatwaves in the UK, which exacerbates his symptoms, and a bout of shingles, he is now looking ahead to January when he has his

To fund the trips to Panama, Liam's care and the stem cell treatment, a huge fundraising effort has been ongoing with the latest target of £40,000 set.

He told **VISION**BrentwoodOngar: "It's been tough but I remain positive. I have been given steroids by the doctor to reduce inflammation as that's a big problem with multiple sclerosis.

"The treatment in the summer did make a difference but heat adds to my symptoms and after two heatwaves in the UK it hasn't been easy.

"I'm lucky to have Kayleigh, she is my angel and there has been lots going on with fundraisers.

"There is more coming up as well with a virtual race night in November and a Christmas fair which takes place on December 7. I am grateful for all the support I aet."

More and more of us are using online banking these days, and this has a knock-on effect on the services being offered by banks on the high street.

While some banks have chosen to close less used branches, Barclays bank has decided to run a pilot scheme to attract new customers in areas where it is now the last bank in town. Its Shenfield branch is one of those in the pilot project, with local residents and businesses being offered help to switch their banking to Barclays. In return, the bank is stepping up its visible presence on Hutton Road in Shenfield by getting involved in community activities and running banking and fraud awareness workshops in the library.

Sadly fraud and financial scams are all too common, and it's often older people who get taken in. It's an issue Lloyds Bank in Brentwood have identified and are taking a proactive approach to protect their customers from the less savoury members of our society who prey on vulnerable, lonely or elderly.

I visited Lloyds in Brentwood to meet senior branch manager Sally Young and branch manager Stephen Willner who were able to tell me about some of the scams they've come across. I was shocked to find out criminals committing fraud have been known to accompany their victims to bank branches and quietly intimidate them into withdrawing or transferring huge sums of money. Thankfully, bank staff are trained to use the Banking Protocol, which is a partnership between banks, police and trading standards, and which can provide immediate support when branch staff identify customers who may be being defrauded.

These are customers who have always done their banking face to face rather than online, and the Lloyds staff I spoke to were proud they knew their customers well enough to be able to identify if something odd was going on and banking behaviour changed. We live in changing times, and I am pleased our high street banks are doing their best to protect their customers from scammers, both on and offline.

Grow your own veg, get fit and socialise







To rond OR POND?

THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY THREE MILLION GARDEN PONDS IN THE UK, BUT SHOULD YOU JUMP ON THE BANDWAGON?

Ponds are aesthetically pleasing

Probably the most obvious benefit and the reason why people are tempted to install a pond in their garden is that, put simply, they look good. Think colourful fish, exotic plants, waterfalls and statues.

They provide relaxation

On the simplest level, the soothing sound of water can create instant calm in your garden.

Opportunity to encourage education and interaction If you have children, a pond offers a great platform for discussions about nature. Watch tadpoles turn into frogs and spot any birds that come to visit.

As with any open water, you need to be vigilant and take the necessary precautions when any small children are in the vicinity. If you are worried about your children or grandchildren around water, then perhaps a pond is not for you.



ore commonly known as the snowdrop, Galanthus is one of those flowers that can brighten up your garden (and spirit) after a long, cold winter by signalling that spring is well on its way. Materialising en masse, snowdrops can create a white blanket of beauty across any garden or woodland area.

What type of plant is Galanthus?

The snowdrop is an herbaceous plant that belongs to the Amaryllidaceae family. It is recognisable by its snowdrop appearance that appears early on during flowering between January and April each year. Each snowdrop can grow to approximately 7-15 cm tall with each bulb producing two leaves and one flowering stalk.

How many different varieties of snowdrop are there?

There are 20 different snowdrop species including the Galanthus Nivalis which you are mostly likely to see in your local woodland area, the Galanthus Atkinsii, recognisable by its honey scent and longer outer petals and the Galanthus Magnet, a hybrid variety that sports an unusually long and elegant stalk.

How do I plant snowdrops?

Great for beginners and pros alike, the snowdrop is a hardy plant that is easy to grow and flowers quickly; plant in October for flowers in late winter/ early spring.

- Find a spot in your garden where the soil is well drained and there is moderate shade
- Plant your bulbs 3 inches apart, with their pointed tops 2-3 inches below the surface
- Water well directly after planting

What does the snowdrop symbolise?

The name Galanthus Nivalis actually means 'milk flower of the snow' but has gone under many other names over the years including 'February fairmaids' and 'Candlemas bells.' The flower is said to symbolise purity, optimism, virtue and sympathy, making it the perfect plant to kick start a new season.

t's fair to say foxes and worms come in for a fair amount of flak. Our auburn bushy-tailed buddies are a peril for chickens and rodents, while the slimy worm is a squealer's delight. But perhaps we've been misunderstanding these garden dwellers for too long?

Ask any wildlife expert and they will tell you foxes are actually just curious, nocturnal creatures on the lookout for food. They are playful, like dogs and cats, and can become surprisingly comfortable around humans and other animals. They can be docile, only ever showing aggression when threatened, and will more likely flee at the first sign of trouble.

If rabbits and other pets are locked away, the only threat a fox may pose is to your outside space, but don't think they have it in for you - the average

fox's territory will encompass 40 acres and 400 gardens. Plants, flowerbed and lawns may all show signs of a fox's and using an ultrasonic deterrent, you can protect vour space.

If you've no animals to protect, welcome them in they are nature's own pest controllers when it comes to rats and feral pigeons. Remember too, foxes are simply looking for food and shelter. Their presence in our urban areas reflects their bravery, but they largely want to keep to themselves.

Worms are a less obvious presence and have a much more obvious benefit on soil and earth. Their burrowing and tunnelling helps break up ground matter, allowing water and air to get to roots of plants and new seedings.

Worms also eat leaves, decaying insects and minute pieces of food, including the peel of fruit and vegetables, egg shells and even tea bags.

They are a creature that should be welcomed into your garden... entirely good for the soil, if not the temperaments of small

he results are in – this year saw the publication of the largest ever pet census in the UK, and it seems, as expected, we are truly a nation of dog and cat lovers... with the odd rodent thrown in for good measure.

DNE DOGS

It's little surprise to hear that dogs topped the mostkept pet list with 67 per cent of the 60.000 people surveyed owning a canine. The 12 per cent caring for Labrador Retrievers made the breed the most popular in the country, and in total it's believed there are approaching nine million dogs

in the UK.

TWO: CATS

In second place is the humble feline, although a published poll by the leading vet charity PDSA last year had cat ownership just above that of dogs. In any case, Just over half of our feline friends are moggies, with one in four a British Shorthair. Cats typically get a bad press, and are accused of being selfish and antisocial, but most owners know differently.

THREE: FISH

Low maintenance, low cost and endlessly enchanting, fish come in third on the list. The simple goldfish is the country's most popular. though Bloodfin Tetras and White Clouds have seen popularity boom in recent years.

OTHERS (in order):

FOUR: Rabbits | FIVE: Horses | SIX: Reptiles SEVEN: Rodents | ETGHT: Birds

Overall, it's supposed there are 51 million pets in the UK - on average, over one per household. The survey also brought up a few interesting findings. For instance, 31 per cent of pet owners have both a dog and a cat: while 84 per cent of those who own horses also keep a dog. In addition, the only place in the UK where there are more cats than dogs is London.

In terms of our psychology towards pets, 49 per cent of respondents regard their pet as a fullyfledged part of the family and only one per cent

regard them as less important than

SKIN TAGS... Why they matter

kin tags are small growths that hang off your skin. They are common and essentially harmless, but can be removed if they bother you.

What skin tags look like

Skin tags are small, soft, skin-coloured growths on your skin. They can vary in colour and size – from a few millimetres up to 5cm (about 2 inches) wide.

They are usually found on the neck, armpits, around the groin, or under the breasts, but they can also grow on the eyelids or under the folds of the buttocks.

They can look like warts, but skin tags are usually smooth and soft (whereas warts tend to be rougher with an irregular surface).

Skin tags are knobbly and hang off the skin (whereas warts are usually slightly raised or flat)

Skin tags are not contagious (whereas warts spread very easily, so a sudden outbreak or cluster of growths is more likely to be warts)

NB: Skin tags do not usually cause any pain or discomfort.

Why skin tags occur

Skin tags are made of loose collagen fibres and

blood vessels surrounded by skin.

Collagen is a type of protein found throughout the body.

Both men and women can develop skin tags. They tend to occur in older people and (significantly) people who are obese or have type 2 diabetes.

Why skin tags matter

If you have a diet high in carbs and sugars, your insulin will be high as a result. (Insulin controls blood sugar, so more sugar equals more insulin). But insulin has numerous actions on the body, one of which is cell-proliferation (important for example at puberty, when the body grows rapidly).

Uncontrolled cell-growth is a bad thing however, which is why people with type 2 diabetes are more prone to cancer. Skin tags are benign and harmless but they DO indicate that your insulin levels are probably too high. NB: Never attempt to remove large skin tags yourself because they'll bleed heavily.



The Northern Lights are one of Planet Earth's most amazing natural phenomena, having drawn in, enchanted and amazed generations of travellers to Scandinavia and North America for hundreds of years.

First witnessed by astronomers Gassendi and Galilei in 1621, the stunning, dancing sprays of neon light, almost extra-terrestrial in their appearance, form when charged particles are emitted from the sun at the time of a solar flare. These penetrate the earth's magnetic shield, then collide with atoms and molecules in the atmosphere.

The key areas for seeing these displays of nature's beauty can be found in a zone within northern Scandinavia, between is on 66°N and 69°N, otherwise known as the Aurora Zone. The band can become larger when there is high activity of geomagnetic action which is why the lights can, on occasions, even be visible from north-west

Traditionally, it's been said the best places to

witness the Northern Lights were Sweden and Norway, but Finland, Iceland and Greenland can all lay claim to offering stunning tourist experiences. Much of this factors in the tranquil majesty of surroundings lakes, forests and fells which, while almost completely devoid of light pollution, also add to the mystical air of this remarkable sight.

In recent times, northern territories in Canada have also attempted to take advantage of what is now a global fascination for the Northern Lights. The Yukon provides wild animals, scattered towns and villages and delicate snowfall against a backdrop of shimmering lights.

And the display isn't just a visual treat to those in the Northern Hemisphere. The Southern Lights (Aurora Australis) are rarer in their visibility but can be spied from Australia, New Zealand and South

It's also known that similar displays can be seen above Jupiter and Saturn, although tourism numbers, thus far, have been disappointingly low.



This recipe contains a large amount of tomatoes which have numerous health benefits. These include improved eye sight, a good stomach health and reduced blood pressure.

Tomatoes contain a large number of antioxidants that have been proven to fight different forms of cancers. They are also a rich source of vitamins and minerals.

SHAKSHUKA - serves 6

INGREDIENTS:

- > 2 tbsps olive oil
- > 2 diced onions
- > 2 red peppers, cut into strips
- > 3 tins chopped tomatoes (1.2kg)
- > 1 1/2 tsp garlic purée
- > 1 tbsp tomato purée

- > 6 large eggs
- > Salt and pepper to taste
- > Handful fresh parsley

METHOD:

- > In a lathe deep frying pan, fry the onions in the olive oil until translucent.
- > Add the peppers and continue frying until they are
- > Stir in the tomatoes, Shakshuka Fast Gourmet mix, tomato and garlic purée, salt and pepper and simmer for 30 minutes. The mixture will thicken.
- > With the back of a ladle, make six small indentations in the sauce and break the eggs into them.

THE RISE


But the trouble with sourdough is it's a slow rise; it takes patience. Instant yeast transformed the way we made bread when it was developed in the 19th century, thanks to its ability to guarantee fast and reliable leavening. But that speed and consistency comes at a cost, which is precisely why sourdough is popular once more. Not only does it have a lot more flavour than regular white bread, thanks to the lactic acidproducing organisms that help it rise, it will also leave you feeling less bloated.

THE SECRET BEHIND THE ORIGINAL RAISED

You don't even need to go to a fancy bakery to buy it, as once you've mastered a sourdough starter you can replace instant yeast in the bread you make at home. You can even use it to make pizza dough, waffles, pancakes and doughnuts, for a more flavoursome life.

HOW TO MAKE A SOURDOUGH STARTER

- Grate one organic apple (skin but not core) and mix with 1kg strong white bread flour and 360ml tepid water. Tip into an airtight container and mark the level outside. Leave to ferment for three days.
- Discard half the mix and add another 250g bread flour and 170ml water - this is called 'feeding'. Mix thoroughly in the bowl. Tip back into the container and leave for a further two days.
- Once your starter is active, discard half of it, as before, and mix in another 250g bread flour and enough water to return it to the consistency of a very wet dough. Leave for 24 hours.
- Provided your starter is bubbling, it is now ready to use.
- Cooking temperatures and timings may vary depending on your plan on using the dough, double check specific recipes before baking.

One

S for security

When visiting a site, in the web address at the top, look for an 's' after 'http' at the beginning of the line. The lack of an 's' doesn't directly imply you are on a scam website, but it is telling you that the security certificate is inadequate, and you should refrain from entering personal information.

Some browsers - Google Chrome being one - add a padlock icon denoting any website that is fully secure, or the web address could be shown in green. The highest form of encryption for any site will also show the website name before the address.

Too good to be true?

On the internet, just as in real life, if something you see online appears too good to be true - particularly if you've clicked on an advert or had a pop-up appear on your screen - it probably is.

Three

You have my word

Consider as well the trustworthiness of sites that have poor spelling or grammar. Very few scammers are fully adept in the finer workings of the English language, particularly if that site is being run many thousands of miles from the UK. Authentic marketing will almost always look professional in style and content.

Google away

Finally, if a site looks suspicious, put its name into Google. If it's a known roque business then there's a good chance it's being discussed across the web.

INVESTMENT JARGON MADE SIMPLE

VOLATILITY

You will probably have heard this term quite a lot recently. Volatility refers to the rate at which the price of an investment moves up and down. or the motoring enthusiast, there are few things in life
more pleasurable than an open road, a fast car and a
bit of Canned Heat on the stereo.

While many of the UK's best roads wind their way through, along and on top of stunning geological features, mostly in the north of England or Scotland, there may be some 'must-drive' routes a little closer to home:

ONE: A838, Laxford Bridge to Tongue, Scotland

Let's start right at the top, and a road that pivots through the Highlands' incredible natural beauty. At 77 miles long it is the perfect distance to savour sea vistas and mountain landscapes, yet with an average of just 96 vehicles using it each day, you really will feel you have your own slice of tarmac.

TWO: The M6 Toll

For those who have driven through the mess that is the M6, the sheer joy of gliding along the M6 Toll is a sensation like no other. Always clear of incidents, its winding, graceful curves allow fast and satisfying driving. In fact, a recent poll found the average speed of all vehicles on the road to be 76mph, a full 6mph above the speed limit.

THREE: A40, Wales/England Border

On the face of it a dual carriageway linking two countries, the road that skips through Pencraig, Whitchurch and Monmouth burrows deep into the Wye Valley, flanking its river and can be likened to the experience of a rollercoaster ride through the Canadian Rockies.

FOUR: A592. Windermere to Penrith

Better known as the Kirkstone Pass, this incredible route reaches almost 1,500ft, with spectacular valley views, drystone walls and wonderful winding roads.

The Snake Pass

Edging through the Peak District towards Glossop, the Snake Pass is true to its name in offering a slithering track often seen on car adverts. The tranquillity of the spot is what draws drivers in, with elevation and adverse cambers testing driving skills to the max.





LEAVING IT, ALL The recent death of young Renault driver Anthoine on the track

Hubert brought home the startling reality that although

motor racing is as safe as it's ever been, the race track remains sport's most dangerous arena.

August 31, will go down as a sad day for motor racing. Anthoine Hubert, just 22, lost his life following a horrific 170mph crash at Spa-Francorchamps circuit in Belgium. It was a reminder of the perils that these individuals face every time they step into a high-performance car, with the Frenchman becoming the 52nd driver to have been involved in a fatal car accident in high-performance competition since 1952.

UK test driver Cameron Earl was the first – the Yorkshireman was killed at the MIRA circuit in Nuneaton. A total of 14 drivers would lose their lives during the 1950s alone, with the

Indianapolis Motor Speedway responsible for more than a third.

In 1982, Canadian Gilles Villeneuve also passed away following a crash in Belgium, but at the older Circuit Zolder. The most notable loss of life came in a horror weekend at the San Marino GP at Imola 12 years later, when three-time world F1 champion and legendary Brazilian driver Ayrton Senna died instantly when his steering column broke.

His death came just 24 hours after the Austrian Simtek driver Roland Raztenberger was also killed.

Hubert's death was, at least, the first since Jules Bianchi succumbed a full nine months after injuries he sustained in a collision with a track rescue crane at the Japanese Suzuka circuit, in 2014.

The truth is, manufacturers are being pushed to ensure their machines are as safe as they can possibly be, and while performance has been affected by the imposing of new controls, you can be sure no dving driver would ever want the sport to die with him.

DEAD AND BURY-D

he sad demise of a once proud football club and what it means for 91 other Football League members.

In September, and in a scenario football fans have seen played out countless times, most expected the white knight to ride in and save Bury Football Club's 125-year membership of the Football League.

The nearer the deadline became, perversely, the more belief grew that things would resolve themselves. And yet, there was no white knight, there were no further stays of execution, and having failed to prove funds were in place for them to survive the season whilst taking care of the Company Voluntary Arrangement agreed a few months previously with creditors, Bury Football Club were expelled from the world's richest football league.

On the face of it, to let a former FA Cup winner wilt for the equivalent of two weeks of Alexis Sanchez's wages is preposterous, but the Shakers' plight is a stark reminder that self-sufficiency is a requirement, not an option, and the Lancashire club's drive for higher division football – and the wages that accompany it – must be a salient warning to all clubs.

Emotionally, the situation was made worse for the Gigg Lane outfit by local rivals Bolton Wanderers' survival, though this isn't necessarily the end for Bury. They exist still as a business, with owner Steve Dale seemingly desperate to relinquish all ties as the club seek entry at a much lower level – probably the Northern Premier League – for the 2020/21 season.

What's left is very much the same as before. The pursuit of the riches at the top of the game is as fervent as ever in English football, and clubs will continue to gamble big time in pursuing that. What's changed is that chairman and owners know the trap door is no longer bolted shut.
