

hen asked, Prince William and Kate Middleton, the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge, would doubtless suggest their first decade together as husband and wife has been wonderfully happy, uplifting and rewarding... albeit not without its challenges.

To most couples in the early throes of wedded bliss, the faint cry of babies and the bringing on of previously untapped levels of tiredness is a challenge enough. Yet it is to the couple's unending credit that they have never swayed away from their other royal duties, while having the ambition to pursue new challenges and initiatives. They are every bit the exemplars of people wanting the best for themselves, their family and those around them.

In isolation, those challenges of early parenthood – when we saw the arrival of Prince George in 2013, Princess Charlotte two years later and, most recently, Prince Louis in 2018 – are considerable, yet in recent years family events have compounded further the complications of life. The Prince Harry and Meghan Markle spat, notably, has left a devastating scar across how we perceive the Royal Family; then there's been the controversy of Prince Andrew and his links to Jeffrey Epstein; while the recent passing of William's grandfather, Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, has further shrouded the institution at a time when the rest of the nation is finally managing to pull away from the darkness.

Regardless, the April 29, 2021, anniversary reaffirms the couple as a modern inspiration. The ceremony, 10 years ago, was a typically lavish affair, albeit laced with the style and individuality that William and Kate have wanted to imprint in the way they go about their duties.

Former Archbishop of Canterbury Rowan Williams conducted the ceremony, as 26 million UK viewers watched it live. The Royal Family and the Middletons picked up the bill for almost 2,000 guests, with 300 special invitees going on to an evening dinner hosted by Prince Charles

Naturally, the day went off without issue, and their work as a couple was only just beginning. Few would disagree now that, during an era when criticism of the royals has been fervent, William and Kate uphold the value and purpose of the Royal Family, even if others in the clan are less proactive.

Over the past decade, the prince has committed huge amounts of time to mental health issues, as well as opening up to a more mainstream audience with his love of sport; while the Duchess of Cambridge's elegant embracing of the mum role model is notable for the familiarity it has with Princess Diana and her boys.

More than anything else, William and Kate speak to the world with the shutters up. Rarely have a royal couple been so close to the people, with honesty, humility and even the ability to laugh at themselves.

It gives all of us hope that not only will the Windsors overcome this recent spate of negative events but, more than that, with William and Kate excellent exemplars, the institution of marriage – itself in decline – once again has those to uphold its values.

"We have always loved being married," says William. "I think we are more in love now than before, and we both truly feel we have found a soulmate who will be there forever."

id you know that you should be cleaning your curtains at least once a year and preferably once every three to six months? Although this may not sound like a lot, can you honestly remember the last time you gave yours a good wash? If not, don't worry. Discover below how to clean your curtains in five simple steps.

STEP ONE. Remove all the hooks and curtain weights and loosen the heading tape. If you are worried about the fabric shrinking, you may want to let down the hem. Take outside and shake well to remove any dust.

STEP TWO: Check the washing label of your curtains to see if they are machine washable. If they are made using a lightweight fabric such as cotton, they probably are. However, if they are large and heavy you may want to have them dry cleaned or wash them by hand. This is also the case for curtains made from velvet, wool, silk or chenille.

STEP THREE: If machine washable, place your curtains in your washing machine and add your usual detergent. Set the machine to either a "delicates" cycle or a cool wash with a slow spin to avoid damage.

STEP FOUR: If you want to iron your curtains, you should do this while they are still damp. Work lengthways, on the wrong side, stretching the fabric gently to prevent seams from puckering. If not, simply hang to dry either outside if the weather permits or inside until they are at least 95 per cent dry. Do not rub or wring out your curtains.

STEP FIVE: Thoroughly dust and clean your curtain tracks, windows and sills before hanging your clean curtains back up. You should also try to incorporate a weekly curtain vacuum into your cleaning schedule to keep them in tip-top condition for longer.

## 5 a ternative uses for nai polish remover

id you know that nail polish remover is not just for nails? Oh no, it can be used for a whole myriad of other purposes around the home.

#### 1. To shine your shoes

Although you may be wary about using acetone on your prized shoe collection, as long as you only use it on patent shoes, you are completely safe. Simply dip a piece of kitchen towel in nail polish remover and gently buff to remove unsightly scuff marks.

#### 2. To clean your china

If you are an avid tea drinker, your china may be prone to the odd mark or two. Remedy this by scrubbing these stubborn stains with a cotton bud soaked in nail polish remover. Wash as normal before using.

#### 3. To remove paint from your windows

Painting your windows can inject a new lease of life into the interior and exterior of your home. However, flicks of paint on your glass are a hazard of the

> job. Remove any wayward paint by applying acetone, letting it settle for five minutes and then rubbing away with a damp cloth.

#### 4. To dissolve superglue

Got a bit overenthusiastic with the superglue? Don't stress. Nail polish remover will quickly and easily unglue your hands or unclog the cap of your glue. Just apply to the affected area for instant

#### 5. To get rid of ink stains

Whether you have spilt ink on your fabric sofa or your child has come home from school with their shirt covered in pen marks, acetone will save the day. Mix one part nail polish remover with two parts water and dab at the stain with a soft cloth.

#### Other uses:

- > To sanitise your beauty tools.
- > To clean blades dip a cotton bud in the remover, apply and rinse with soap
- > To smooth minor watch scratches - drop a tiny amount onto a cloth and gently buff affected area.

## Burglar jailed for more than four years after multiple offences

Aburglar has been jailed following a series of offences in Brentwood.

Between October 26 and November 8 last year, Jamie Estabrook (pictured inset) carried out three burglaries and four robberies at various businesses in Brentwood.

In one incident, he assaulted a shopworker as he was closing up, punching him from behind before grabbing his bag and fleeing.

He also targeted the same Tesco Express store in London Road four times – burgling it three times and also carrying out a robbery there.

Officers were able to identify the 34-year-old after studying CCTV footage.

Officers seized items of clothing worn during the incidents from Estabrook's address in Kings Road,

Brentwood.

He was charged and later admitted three counts of burglary and four counts of robbery.

At Basildon Crown Court on Tuesday, March 30, he was jailed for four and a half years.

Detective sergeant David Wilkinson, from Brentwood CID, said: "Jamie Estabrook is a prolific burglar and robber and has little regard for the possessions of others.

"He will have created a huge amount of fear for those working in the shops during the robberies and no one should be left feeling that way in their workplace.

"Through our thorough investigation, we were able to gather evidence against him which left him with no option but to admit his crimes. He will now spend the foreseeable future in prison."






















#### **Promising future after** council completes purchase



rentwood Borough Council has purchased The Baytree Shopping Centre and Academy Place as part of its commitment to enhance the town centre.

The purchase of The Baytree Shopping Centre will unlock the town centre for redevelopment and help support the borough's economic recovery by becoming a key leisure and retail destination in South

Initial plans indicate the potential for a mixed-use scheme incorporating improved retail, leisure and community space.

Councillor Chris Hossack, Brentwood Borough Council leader, said: "The opportunity to buy The Baytree Centre could not have come at a better time as the Centre is fundamental in supporting the regeneration and transformation plans of our town centre.

"The centre is at the heart of our town's historic and retail core. This acquisition means we now have full control of this important strategic site that is critical to delivering a more vibrant town centre experience for our residents and visitors."

Academy Place, which was built in Brook Street in 1990, is a 1.54-acre site that is currently let out to a range of companies, employing a total of more than 200 people.



### **BURGHART for BRENTWOOD**

Now most of our High Street shops have reopened, the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on some national chains has become clearer. There is no doubt the High Street has lost some beloved names during the pandemic, for a multitude of reasons, but all is not lost.

In Brentwood, we have lost Laura Ashley at the western end of the High Street, while issues with lease negotiations have seen Waterstones, The Edinburgh Woollen Mill and FatFace close for the time being.

However, the investment a couple of years ago by Marks and Spencer in its flagship store in Brentwood means business there has continued to be strong. And the small independent stores – especially those in the increasingly vibrant Crown Street – appear to

have come through, thanks to government support for small businesses, plus the sheer determination by their proprietors to adapt to online sales and click and collect.

Recently, I was able to catch up with Mike Hawkins and Paul Beresford, from Brentwood Business Partnership, and council leader councillor Chris Hossack to discuss the future of Brentwood's High Street and the council's acquisition of The Baytree Shopping Centre.

I heard their concerns that it is now too easy for



landlords to change the use of their high-street properties and offices from retail and business to housing. I'm confident there is room for a mix of residential and retail, creating business for the shops and easy access to goods and services for residents.

With the council now owning The Baytree Shopping Centre, it is a major player on the High Street and can do even more to help shape how our town looks and feels. As the country rebounds from COVID-19 there is an opportunity to safeguard and strengthen our town centres for the decades ahead if we get all stakeholders round the table. I look forward to being part of these discussions in the months to come.

## Man charged with attempted murder

Aman has been charged with a number of offences in connection with a 2017 attempted murder investigation in Brentwood.

Martin Stokes, 27, of no fixed address, was arrested in London on April 10, and has been charged with attempted murder, two counts of ABH, dangerous driving and violent disorder.

His arrest was carried out as part of an investigation into an incident in which three people were involved in a collision with a vehicle outside Sugar Hut in Brentwood High Street, at about 3.10am on Sunday April 2, 2017.

They were all taken to hospital with serious injuries.

Stokes is due to appear in court on May 10 and is currently being remanded in custody.

Historic railway receives cash boost ahead of reopening

The Epping Ongar Railway has received a grant of £62,000 from the government's Culture Recovery Fund to help the organisation reopen after lockdown. Culture Secretary Oliver Dowden CBE MP announced in March that nearly £400million has been awarded to thousands of cultural organisations across the country, including the Epping Ongar Railway, in the latest round of support from the Culture Recovery Fund.

The award will help the railway look ahead to the spring and summer and plan for reopening. It follows a previous grant awarded to the railway in the autumn of last year.

Dean Walton, general manager, said: "The Epping Ongar Railway, its volunteers and supporters are grateful for this significant grant. We will be using it to make final preparations before we reopen, in line with government guidance, in late May."

Oliver Dowden CBE MP said: "Our record-breaking Culture Recovery Fund has already helped thousands of culture and heritage organisations across the country survive the biggest crisis they've ever faced.

"Now we're staying by their side as they prepare to welcome the public back through their doors - helping our cultural gems plan for reopening and thrive in the better times ahead."

## Council vows to fight against kerbstones



The "diabolical" state of verges and broken kerbstones in the parish has been reported to Ongar Town Council, which has vowed to continue to report problem areas.

A resident wrote to the council highlighting the state of the verges and broken kerbstones in Queensway and St Peter's Avenue, after her car hit a kerbstone that was in the middle of the road.

She said: "The kerbstones have been an issue for some time and are progressively getting worse and more of a danger to pedestrians and road users, let alone the eyesore they are for everyone.

"Even when they do get replaced and fixed, the issue is back a short time later because of large and heavy vehicles having to mount the kerbs and pavements to get round the roads."

Town council clerk Michael Letch acknowledged the letter, stating: "The state of the roads on the Shelley Estate are a matter of concern to councillors and they are working to find a way to get the highways authority to prioritise them."

Councillor Lawrence Mendoza said the problem on the Shelley Estate had been reported to Essex County Council deputy leader Kevin Bentley, who replied that the situation would be "monitored".

## Container store for 3Food4U secured by town council

Acontainer for use by the 3Food4U charity to store non-perishable items is to be purchased by Ongar Town Council and sited at Jubilee Park in Ongar.

3Food4U will use the container for the foreseeable future, and when it is no longer required by the charity it will be offered to the Ongar Community Sports Trust which manages the Jubilee Park facilities.

Councillors at a recent town council meeting agreed

to spend up to  $\mathfrak{L}2,000$  on the purchase and siting of the container, subject to planning approval being granted.

3Food4U founder Pesh Kapasiawala told the meeting 3Food4U helps between 50 and 60 families at its weekly Ongar session at Zinc Arts.

Pesh said: "We get huge amounts of donations and need huge amounts to support 300 families a week across the Epping Forest district. It would be tremendous to get some storage."

## Man pleads guilty to seven fly-tipping offences

An unlicensed waste carrier who pleaded guilty to seven counts of fly-tipping in Ongar and Stapleford Tawney has received a prison sentence and a curfew.

Behnam Dehghani, who is now living in Ilford, gave his plea at a court hearing in February 2020, but owing to COVID-19 restrictions, the sentencing hearing was not held until March 2021.

Evidence gathered by the council's Environment and Neighbourhood Team led to the prosecution.

Magistrates sentenced Dehghani to nine months' imprisonment suspended for 12 months, a three-month curfew between 7pm and 7am, a 12-month driving disqualification and a 10-year Criminal Behaviour Order.

He must also pay the prosecution costs of £2,600 and a victim surcharge of £100.

Councillor Holly Whitbread, cabinet member for housing and community services, said: "This council is committed to taking action against fly-tipping. Anyone found fly-tipping, or not complying with their household duty of care, may be given a £400 fixed penalty. But in this case, owing to the prolific nature of Deghani's actions, the matter was prosecuted through the courts.

"Fly-tipping is a blight on the Epping Forest district, and costs landowners across the East of England on average £1,000 for each incident. It costs Essex Council taxpayers more than £1million a year to clear fly-tipping from the highway and other council-owned land."



## ROWNIE & CLYDF

estructive lives combine to fuel a potent love stor





he glamorisation of Bonnie and Clyde in modern culture is certainly at odds with I the murder and robbery spree that led to the FBI pursuing them and, ultimately, effecting their fatal end in 1934.

Having first met four years earlier, Bonnie Parker and Clyde Champion Barrow had both already been on the wrong side of the law, and the signs were there of the peril they could cause to the unsuspecting, not least when Bonnie helped Clyde smuggle a gun into prison in 1930, when he was locked up for a robbery charge. He escaped but was recaptured, yet remarkably was released just 18 months later.

Their crime spree began in earnest in 1932. Joined by three other criminals, they undertook a number of robberies, escaping capture by any means possible. Indeed, by the time their criminal lives were brought to a halt, it's said they had murdered at least 13 people.

As well as seeking financial gains, the couple sought to break convicts out of jail, notably cohort Raymond Hamilton from Eastham State Prison Farm at Waldo, Texas, who was serving sentences totalling in excess of 200 years.

By the middle of April 1934, the FBI had traced the pair to a remote part of Louisiana following the couple's theft of a motor vehicle. Posters were distributed to police staff throughout various states and the hunt was on.

Intelligence suggested they were due to return to the location of a party that was held near Sailes in Louisiana two days previously. On May 23, 1934, officers from the county and neighbouring Texas converged to create an ambush on the side of a highway, concealing themselves in bushes. Bonnie and Clyde appeared in a motor car and, unable to turn and flee, were killed instantly as more than 100 shots rained through the front windscreen of the vehicle.

eticulous, measured, majestic and more than a little eccentric... and that was just the funeral procession - HRH Prince Philip departed these strange shores just two months short of his 100th birthday, leaving behind a partner so hopelessly and publicly bereaved, and a nation of admirers wondering who could live up to the Duke of Edinburgh's lofty lovability.

There was the empty seat on the carriage, decorated with his blanket, flat cap, whip, brown gloves and pot containing a sugar cube for the ponies; then his military cap and sword on a coffin adorned with the most beautiful personal standard flag which referenced his overseas roots, family name and Edinburgh Castle. Meanwhile, various other marine references were present during the ceremony, each a nod to his cherished naval career, which came to an end in 1951.

In truth, there was so much of this special life to be celebrated. He was born on June 10, 1921 in Corfu, his family holding both Greek and Danish royal heritage. Banished from their homeland, he spent parts of his early life in France and Germany before settling in Britain.

It wasn't an easy childhood – his mother was admitted to a psychiatric institution, and he was separated from his family after landing in the UK. He studied at Cheam School before relocating to Scotland. He served in the British Navy during the Second World War, despite members of his family effectively fighting for the opposition as part of the Axis.

He denounced his Greek and Danish titles and adopted the surname Mountbatten – from his mother's side – so he could marry Princess Elizabeth in 1947 at Westminster Abbey, eight years after they had first met.

He was doted on by his four children – Prince Charles, Princess Anne, Prince Andrew and Prince Edward (Prince Edward will now take his title) – and never wavered from his role as the Queen's consort... in fact, the longest in royal history. A passionate supporter of everything she did, he also undertook his own projects, notably the Duke of Edinburgh's Award which, to this day, continues to promote youth achievement across many different disciplines.

He enjoyed polo, boat racing, piloting aeroplanes, painting and antiques, and while deteriorating health in recent years proved concerning, it was supposed he had recovered from a recent stay at St Bartholomew's Hospital; yet he slipped away peacefully on April 9, 2021 at Windsor Castle.

In total, almost 14 million of us watched the Duke of Edinburgh's funeral, and even the staunchest anti-royal must have pitied the senior Windsors being forced to display their grief in public. Such are the realities of a state funeral, and so it is conditioned that the only follow-on from a life played out in the public eye is a memorial on the same terms.

Prince Philip was born of a different time and a different generation of royalty, yet he fit so wonderfully into modern-day society and brought joy to many.

His unique, charismatic, eccentric take on the world is something we just don't see very often these days, with most public figures keeping their cards close to their chests for fear of repercussions.

His truly one-of-a-kind presence will be sorely missed by the Royal Family, the nation and the world.

### WHY PROTECTING THE YOUNG PEOPLE AROUND YOU MEANS INSISTING ON THE RELEVANT CHECKS

n the past decade or so, Criminal Record Checks (CRCs) have become commonplace in situations where organisations need to safeguard the welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults. And this can be the case in everything from 9–5 employers ensuring their staff have been honest in job applications, to volunteers working for charities, right through to local sports teams safeguarding the welfare of young players.

The checks are done by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and take the form of a simple and relatively cheap process that takes a couple of weeks. The application can be submitted by the individual or an employee (but only after an offer of employment has been made – in other words, for a successful applicant, not for an interview candidate).

The request goes to the DBS, where a criminal background check will be made. A certificate is subsequently issued that lists any convictions.

The process has become an essential part of

verifying people who are in positions of responsibility where young and vulnerable people are concerned, and replaces what was previously a somewhat more convoluted process between the Criminal Records Bureau and the Independent Safeguarding Authority. By merging these two organisations into one entity, the DBS, in 2012, the government was able to streamline welfare checks, which meant not only a safer and more comprehensive system, but also one where people could begin helping and assisting youngsters without having to go through swarms of red tape.

Of course, while a DBS check will list noted convictions, organisations can and do undertake additional protection, welfare and safeguarding training. And as ever, as parents, the most effective reference to those helping our children comes through our own communication with both our loved ones and the organisation – it always pays to be vigilant.

#### WHAT ARE THE HEALTH BENEFITS OF JICAMA?

The perfect vegetable for people with diabetes, the jicama is naturally low in sugar but still sweet to taste. It is also high in fibre, a great source of vitamin C and low in fat and calories.

It is worth noting that only the root vegetable of the

jicama plant is safe to eat, as the rest, including the beans and flowers, contain rotenone, a natural insecticide that can be toxic to humans in high doses. You should also remove the brown skin before consuming.

- > Slice thinly and add raw to a vegetable salad or Mexican fruit salad for added crunch
- >Sauté with other veg such as broccoli and carrots
- >Use as a substitute for water chestnuts in a stir-fry
- >Bake in the oven or place in an air fryer for healthy chips

#### **HOW TO STORE JICAMA**

The most important thing to remember when storing jicama is that you must keep it dry, as any moisture can cause rot and mould. Store unwrapped at room temperature if still whole or, once cut, wrap tightly in cling film and store in the fridge for up to one week. Alternatively, wrap a whole jicama in foil and freeze for up to one year.

n annual event, Food Allergy Awareness Week aims to raise awareness of different food allergies and to improve public understanding of what can sometimes be a life-threatening condition. From cow's milk to peanuts, eggs to shellfish, discover the most common food allergies in the UK below.

#### **Peanuts**

Peanut allergy affects around one in 50 children and has seen a significant increase in cases in recent decades. Typically developed in early childhood, symptoms of a peanut allergy usually occur within minutes of contact and can include nausea, shortness of breath and skin reactions such as hives, redness and swelling.



#### Cow's milk

Affecting mostly babies and young children, a cow's milk (protein) allergy is usually outgrown by the age of five. Common symptoms include swelling of the lips or tongue and breathing difficulties, and these can occur within minutes or many hours after ingesting.

Another allergy that is much more common in young children than adults, an egg allergy can mean being allergic to all forms of egg, or only to loosely cooked and raw egg. Egg allergy symptoms include skin inflammation, sneezing, runny nose and shortness of breath and/or chest tightness.



The most common allergy in adults, around 60 per cent of people experience their first allergic reaction to shellfish once they have reached adulthood. Shrimp is the most prevalent shellfish allergen for both children and adults. Allergic reactions to shellfish can be unpredictable, with common symptoms including swelling of the lips, mouth, tongue, throat and face.



#### What is an anaphylactic shock?

Anaphylaxis is a severe and potentially life-threatening reaction to a trigger, such as an allergy. Symptoms include:

> Difficulty breathing

> A fast heartbeat > Confusion and/or anxiety

- > Feeling faint
- > Wheezing
- > Clammy skin
- > Collapsing or losing consciousness

If someone has symptoms of anaphylaxis, you should use an adrenaline auto-injector if they have one and call 999 immediately.

the most urban garden can be a haven for the wonders of wildlife and the nurturing of nature, we look at the role of moisture in this wondrous ecosystem.

While we may be moan the washing getting wet when we forget to bring it indoors, the cycle of moisture in our gardens is perhaps nature's greatest wonder of them all. Consider it - we've all gazed out across our lawns or poked around a plant on a window ledge and known that when nature either dries out or floods, the end is nigh.

On a local level, moisture in our plant soil is the difference between a flowering plant and a wilting one; or perhaps a ripe, juicy tomato and one that fails to develop.

On a national, mass-market scale then, getting the moisture content right means looking after the production of every variety of crop, for both human

And yet, controlling moisture goes far beyond even that, because the density of water in the soil is vital in regulating the exchange of water and heat energy between plants and the atmosphere, via evaporation. This leads to the production of weather patterns all across the world, and especially determines levels of precipitation.

Even on its way into the atmosphere, moisture is stabilising our climate, plus helping animal life that's dependent on perspiration to regulate internal body temperature - something that's key to survival.

It all adds up to the fact that the humble bit of soil around your petunias is, in the most minute of ways, contributing towards the maintenance and welfare of the flora and fauna and of people's lives in towns, villages and cities all across the world, whether their fear is flash floods, droughts or even potential starvation.





While time is undoubtedly the greatest healer, there are a few useful techniques and ideas that can let light come through on even the very darkest days of a relationship break-up:





#### HOW A SHY JAPANESE GOLFER MADE HISTORY AT THE MASTERS

n all honesty, golfer Hideki Matsuyama probably isn't cut out for a life in the spotlight of the sporting world. The 2021 Masters champion, who originates from the place in Japan that gave him his name - Matsuyama is a city in the Ehime region on the island of Shikoku - claimed victory at the iconic Augusta course in April, finishing a shot clear of American voungster Will Zalatoris.

"I am relieved." he said afterwards. "It looked good coming into the final day - the course was playing well for me and I knew I just had to hold my nerve.

"It is the proudest moment of my sporting life."

Success hasn't come quickly or easily. Indeed, Matsuyama has had to wait four painful years to make amends for a catastrophic loss of confidence on the back nine of the 2017 PGA Championship when he seemed set to take the title.

Recovering from hitting five bogeys in the final

trappings that cost him that victory has taken the 29-year-old time, and although he again wobbled on his way to finally setting the record straight as he posted an overall 10 under par, this time he held on to the clamours of delight emanating from his

Japan is a golf-mad country and finally it has a golfing champion to call its own; not just that but a man who values respect and humility. He bowed to the 18th fairway at Augusta as a mark of respect and, despite pocketing the \$2million first prize, still flew back to his homeland alone, on a standard flight. Indeed, perhaps the most iconic image of the whole weekend was Matsuyama sitting at Augusta airport on the Monday, dressed down, checking messages, and that famous green blazer casually draped over a neighbouring seat.

Japan has a champion to be proud of, as does the sport of golf.



#### How modest but magnificent jockey Rachael Blackmore made history

n April 10, Rachael Blackmore stood aloft Minella Times, triumphant in becoming the first female jockey to have ridden a horse to victory at the Grand National.

In 182 years of the world's most famous horse race, never before has a member of the fairer sex come home victorious, though in Blackmore, who hails from Killenaule in County Tipperary, there is a jockey of prolific character, determination and future potential.

Already 10 years on the circuit, having ridden her first winner as an amateur back in February 2011, she truly announced herself at Cheltenham in 2019 when she came home first on A Plus Tard in the Close Brothers Novices' Handicap Chase.

That year she also had her second taste of riding at Aintree and, with each passing iteration, enhanced a game plan that would help her take home the big prize.

"I think as a jockey you are always learning; and although the courses and the horses are different, every race for me has felt like a rehearsal for a big victory."

Cheltenham success this year on favourite Honeysuckle reaffirmed the jockey's status to perform when the pressure was on, though starting out at 11/1 at Aintree in the Grand National left plenty of room for doubt. Those who bet on her to bring home the greatest victory of her career needn't have worried – Blackmore rode an impeccable race as the eight-year-old horse came through in style, winning by six and a half lengths.

"It fell right for me on the day, and that's all you can ask as a jockey," she said with immaculate modesty. "I never at any point thought I had a divine right to win, and nor will I in future – I've always regarded myself as being in the right place at the right time; and I'll hopefully continue to be."
