

hen you go out, can you honestly say that you watch your drink at all times? Spiking is currently at high levels in the UK and can happen to anyone.

Find out how to recognise the signs of spiking and what to do if you think your drink has been spiked below.

WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMONLY USED ILLEGAL DRUGS TO SPIKE DRINKS? The most common illegal drugs used to spike drinks are GHB, ketamine and benzodiazepines such as valium and rohypnol.

### HOW TO RECOGNISE IF A DRINK HAS BEEN SPIKED

- 1. It has a foggy appearance
- 2. It has excessive bubbles
- 3. The ice sinks to the bottom
- 4. A change in colour

It is important to know that some of the most regularly used drugs to spike drinks do not produce a smell or taste, meaning it can be difficult to know if your drink has been spiked until it is too late.

### THE MOST COMMON SYMPTOMS OF SOMEONE WHO HAS HAD THEIR DRINK SPIKED ARE...

Dizziness | Difficulty walking | Confusion the next day | Nausea or vomiting | Hallucinations | Tiredness | Blurred vision | Paranoia | Amnesia

### WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK YOU'VE BEEN SPIKED

If you think your drink has been spiked, stop drinking it. Tell someone you trust as soon as possible as spiking substances can take effect very quickly. Be wary of asking strangers for help and instead, if you are alone, seek out security or venue staff. If you need urgent help, call 999 and tell them you think you may have been drugged.

#### HOW TO PREVENT YOUR DRINK BEING SPIKED

- > Do not leave your drink unattended
- > Invest in anti-spiking lids from StopTopps, available from stoptopps.com
- > Do not accept drinks from strangers
- > Be vigilant of changes to your drink
- > Don't drink anyone else's drink.

### **GUIDE TO CLEANING**

### PAINTED WALLS

here is nothing worse than noticing a dirty mark or stain on a freshly painted wall.

Keep your painted walls looking fresh and fabulous for longer with our handy quide.

### HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

- 1 Dust off any excess dirt using a lint-free cloth or a soft broom for hard-to-reach areas.
- 2. Fill a bucket with warm water and a gentle detergent.
- 3. Apply to the walls using a sponge mop or soft sponge.
- 4 Do not oversoak your sponge or mop as this can result in water stains.
- 5. Leave the solution for 10-15 minutes.
- 6. Rinse with clean water and a sponge or mop.
- 7. Dry by placing a microfibre cloth onto a flat-headed mop and gently rubbing over the wall.

#### HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED KITCHEN WALLS

Painted walls in the kitchen are prone to grease. To combat this, apply a gentle degreaser to any affected areas before following the same steps as above.

### HOW TO SPOT CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

To get rid of small stains or marks on your painted walls, apply a mixture of water and baking soda or bicarbonate of soda to the affected area using a soft cloth or towel. Half a cup of baking soda or bicarb in a bucket of warm water will

do the trick.

### HOW TO REMOVE OIL STAINS FROM PAINTED WALLS

- 1. Mix one cup of white wine vinegar into a bucket of warm water.
- 2. Soak a soft sponge and apply to the stain.
- 3. Rub gently until the stain has disappeared.
- 4. You do not need to rinse the area.

### WHAT NOT TO USE

You should not clean your painted walls with any cleaning products that contain alcohol or harsh chemicals, as these ingredients can break down your paint surfaces and leave your walls looking a mess.



A GUIDE TO HELP YOU DECIDE WHEN YOU SHOULDN'T USE YOUR VACUUM WHEN CLEANING

Some people love vacuuming; others can't stand it. Either way, there is no denying how quickly it can clean up your home.

However, did you know that there are some items that you should never hoover up?

### PIECES OF GLASS

If you have smashed a glass, then you may reach for your vacuum cleaner to quickly clear the area. However, large pieces of glass can puncture the bag, get stuck in the hose and damage the interior. Instead, use a dustpan and brush for the large pieces and a damp cloth to pick up small shards. Be sure to wear gloves to protect your hands.

### **FINE DUST**

Have you recently renovated your home? If yes, then your furniture is probably covered in dust particles. Sadly, you should not hoover these up as sanding residue and other tiny particles will clog the filters and cause your hoover to spit dust back into the air.

### **WET FOOD**

Wet food, or anything wet or moist, should not be cleaned up with a vacuum cleaner. This includes soggy cereal, dog food and even small spills. Instead, use some kitchen towels or a tea towel.

### SMALL METAL ITEMS

Small metal items such as paper clips and coins can easily become stuck in the rotating part of your vacuum cleaner and stop it from working properly. They can also sometimes break off plastic pieces from the interior of your appliance.

### MAKE-UP

Dropped an eyeshadow palette on the carpet? Or some foundation? Although you may be tempted to use your hoover, this is not a good idea. Firstly, the vacuum brush could smear the make-up further into the carpet, and secondly, if you do manage to successfully clean it up, it is highly likely to melt once inside the appliance.

### WHAT YOU NEED:

Imitation gold leaf | Sandpaper | Furniture primer | Water-based gilding size | A soft brush | A clear gloss spray scaler or permanent solvent-based varnish

### HOW TO APPLY GOLD LEAF TO FURNITURE:

### Step 1: Prepare your furniture

For wooden furniture, sand down or fill in any bumps or holes so that you have a smooth surface to work with. Then apply your chosen primer to ensure it is not porous. If you are upcycling metal furniture, give the item a dust or clean it with soap and water.

### Step 2: Apply water-based size to the area

Decide where you want to apply the gold leaf and section off this area with masking tape. Then apply a thin and even layer of water-based gilding size. This is the adhesive that will bond the gold leaf to your furniture. Leave this adhesive until it is nearly but not completely dry.

### Step 3: Start adding your gold leaf

Your gold leaf should be backed by tissue so lay it tissueside up and then gently rub the gold onto your furniture. Keep going until the area is completely covered. To avoid any gaps, you can overlap the squares of gold leaf slightly. Leave until fully dry. This can take up to six hours.

### Step 4: Remove any excess gold leaf

Once the area is dry, take your soft brush and gently remove any excess gold leaf. You then need to leave your item for a further 24 hours so that the gold leaf can cure.

### Step 5: Cover with a sealant

The final step is to cover the area with a sealant so that it is protected from chips and scratches, Leave this to dry for 24 hours, and then your gold leaf furniture project is complete.

atthew Williamson, by his own admission, doesn't perhaps have a name that screams 'style, exuberance and panache', and considering this is someone who grew up in the murky confines of 1970s Manchester, there was no indication of the creative elevation that was to come.

And yet, in art just as in physics, equal and opposite reactions can provoke explosions of inspiration from very simple ripples of provenance. That is certainly the case with Williamson, who for more than two decades now has specialised in the wonder of colour.

He is an interior designer of great originality and acclaim, as his recent work with John Lewis determines. He is someone whose passion for colour, aesthetics and design was catalysed by his mother, but who has taken those principles to another level of optimism.

"If you're going to use colour, you have to be an optimist," he says. "You have to look at the beauty

of contrast and the potency of the shades and tones you put together.

"There is no point being afraid of trying things, and you should never enter a project imagining something isn't going to work. Only by trying will you know, and only through knowledge can you grow.

"Of course, it's about mixing up tones, but also enabling a background to act as a template for the colour detail you want to layer on top."

Replicating Williamson's colour-driven style of interior design is no easy task. It has, after all, taken the designer the best part of half a century to refine an interior design ethos that even he admits is still a work in progress. But the Central Saint Martins graduate insists the way to use colour is to follow your smile.

"If it makes you happy, it's working. If it paints pictures and provokes memories and inspires in you ideas to move forward, then you probably have what is right"

# CHINTZ is making a comebach

# 40 years since the FALKLANDS WAR

### A LOOK BACK ON THE FALKLANDS WAR. WHICH ENDED IN JUNE 1982

he commencement of the Falklands War, when Argentina landed on the small island situated 500 miles from its lower-east coast. represented more than simply a country looking to reclaim what it thought it rightfully owned.

On the face of it, that was Argentina's plov. The Falklands, a modest 4,700 square miles, comprising little more than rocky terrain, cliffs. birdlife and cattle, had been appropriated by the British back in 1765.

Within five years, a Spanish commander from Buenos Aires landed with five ships and 1,400 troops to claim possession of the land. And that remained the case until 1883, when the British

The constant power struggle has raged on, though when Argentina relit the blue and white striped touchpaper in 1982 with severe territorial aggression, it surprised many.

A deeper explanation, away from the geographical claims and disputes, lay in the political situation in Argentina, and the economic struggles that besieged South America in the

The three-man military junta that had assumed power in Argentina in 1976 had evolved over the years, and as it looked to build support and legitimacy by claiming a territory that still held considerable emotional ties to the Argentine people, seizing the Falklands was a clever political

On April 2, Argentina invaded, kicking off just over two months of conflict, where the British, led by Margaret Thatcher, responded with air, sea and land attacks. A series of bloody battles raged, with the Battle of Goose Green perhaps the most famous.

Finally, on June 14, Argentina surrendered after British troops vomped across punishing terrain, arriving at East Falkland to find their enemy waving white flags.

While conflict ceased, the ongoing antagonisation between Argentina and the UK (and England in particular) has continued, mostly in sporting rivalries.







### Manjailed for 23 years for attempted murder of child

↑ man has been jailed for 23 years after he admitted Athe attempted murder of a child in Brentwood.

Zach Hughes (pictured left), 27, of Brentwood Road, Romford, was sentenced at Basildon Crown Court on May 6 after being found guilty of attempted murder, causing grievous bodily harm with intent, and possession of an offensive weapon in a public place.

On July 12, 2021, Hughes met up with his victims and another person before they travelled to Brentwood.

As the car was being parked in Brook Street, Hughes went to the rear of the car. He reached inside and attacked the young child and a woman.

They were treated at the scene by paramedics and taken to hospital.

Hughes was arrested the following day and charged. He later pleaded quilty to all three charges.

Detective Inspector Brian Palombella, of Essex Police's Crime and Public Protection Command. said: "I would like to offer my sincere thanks to the first responders and members of the public whose actions were vital in what were traumatising circumstances, and the sentencing reflects that impact."

### **BURGHART for BRENTWOOD**



**Alex Burghart MP for Brentwood and Ongar** 

Nowly but surely. I am hearing about more families Ofrom Ukraine arriving in Brentwood to live with people here who have offered up their spare rooms and homes to those fleeing the horrors of war.

There has been plenty of news coverage of long waits for the Home Office to process visas and provide the 'permission to travel letters' which are needed to allow safe passage of people from Ukraine, or from temporary accommodation in Poland or Romania.

Essex County Council has responsibility for coordinating applications made through the Homes for Ukraine Scheme. So far, 1,788 individuals have applied to come to homes in Essex. Each sponsor household has to be carefully checked by the council before the placement can be agreed and the visas issued.

In the first two months, 30 per cent of those who have applied to come to Essex have arrived, and more visas are being issued each week. Missing documents or travelling with young children can cause delays to individual applications, but the Home Office is stepping up to the plate and ministers are working

exceptionally hard to deal with each and every glitch and bump in the system.

I am being contacted daily by constituents asking for information about 'their' families, and I am passing on as much as I can find out each week. But then more emails arrive thanking me and my team for our assistance, and attaching pictures of smiling sponsors and guests settling into their new homes after such intense disruption to their lives.

I am very proud of what we are doing in Brentwood and Ongar to welcome so many people from Ukraine, and I look forward to meeting some of them when they arrive.

### **Queen makes surprise visit to** opening of new Tube line

I er Majesty The Queen made a surprise visit last month to open the new Elizabeth line, which will connect Brentwood with the London Underground for the very first time.

Joined by youngest son Prince Edward, the Earl of Wessex, at Paddington Station, the Queen and the Earl met with attendees and spoke with staff who are operating the new railway, which opened to the public on May 24.

The Earl also enjoyed a quick trip on the line, which stretches more than 60 miles and required eight tunnel boring machines to excavate more than three million tonnes of earth for construction.

The new line will run all the way from Reading to Shenfield in its fully completed state, but for now it is split in two, with the Paddington route going to both Reading and Heathrow Airport, and the second half going from Liverpool Street to Shenfield.

The Crossrail project has proven a controversial development, especially in recent years, owing to delays and the project going severely over budget, mainly caused by construction difficulties.

### Anti-crime campaign la

ssex Police are supporting a grandmother in her campaign against knife crime, following her visit to a bar in Brentwood to give them a special bleedcontrol kit.

Julie Taylor's grandson, Liam, 19, died after being stabbed in Writtle in January 2020. Three men were jailed for a total of 58-and-a-half years for his murder.

She set up The Liam Taylor Legacy in his memory, pledging to raise money to purchase bleed-control kits for the community.

During the countywide knife amnesty last month, Julie (pictured centre) visited the CKN Bar & Kitchen in King's Road. Brentwood, to present staff with one of the special kits, which contain tourniquets, bandages and chest seals to stop catastrophic bleeding as a result of a knife wound, gunshot wound or road traffic collision.

Sergeant James Bugden, of the Brentwood Local Policing Team, said: "Although we hope these kits will never have to be used, there is no doubt they will help to save lives if they are."

Julie works tirelessly to help distribute the bleedcontrol kits, which are funded by the Daniel Baird Foundation, set up by Daniel's mother, Lynne, after his fatal stabbing in Birmingham in July 2017.

# 40 years since the FALKLANDS WAR

### A LOOK BACK ON THE FALKLANDS WAR, WHICH ENDED IN JUNE 1982

The commencement of the Falklands War, when Argentina landed on the small island situated 500 miles from its lower-east coast, represented more than simply a country looking to reclaim what it thought it rightfully owned.

On the face of it, that was Argentina's ploy. The Falklands, a modest 4,700 square miles, comprising little more than rocky terrain, cliffs, birdlife and cattle, had been appropriated by the British back in 1765.

Within five years, a Spanish commander from Buenos Aires landed with five ships and 1,400 troops to claim possession of the land. And that remained the case until 1883, when the British returned.

The constant power struggle has raged on, though when Argentina relit the blue and white striped touchpaper in 1982 with severe territorial aggression, it surprised many.

A deeper explanation, away from the geographical claims and disputes, lay in the political situation in Argentina, and the economic

struggles that besieged South America in the 1980s.

The three-man military junta that had assumed power in Argentina in 1976 had evolved over the years, and as it looked to build support and legitimacy by claiming a territory that still held considerable emotional ties to the Argentine people, seizing the Falklands was a clever political move.

On April 2, Argentina invaded, kicking off just over two months of conflict, where the British, led by Margaret Thatcher, responded with air, sea and land attacks. A series of bloody battles raged, with the Battle of Goose Green perhaps the most famous.

Finally, on June 14, Argentina surrendered after British troops yomped across punishing terrain, arriving at East Falkland to find their enemy waving white flags.

While conflict ceased, the ongoing antagonisation between Argentina and the UK (and England in particular) has continued, mostly in sporting rivalries.



"I know of no single formula for success," she said, "but over the years I have observed that some attributes of leadership are universal and are often about finding ways of encouraging people to combine their efforts, their talents, their insights, their enthusiasm and their inspiration to work together."

Certainly she has excelled in that, with the Platinum Jubilee, beginning on Thursday, June 2, stretching across a weekend of celebrations. Queen Elizabeth II, family, friends and the nation will look back over seven decades of exemplary rule, and forward to the future.

From Trooping the Colour, which marks the Queen's birthday celebrations with more than 1,400 parading soldiers, 200 horses and 400 musicians, to the traditional RAF flypast, the 1,500 Platinum Jubilee beacons that have been distributed across the UK in a tradition that dates right the way back to 1897, to a thanksgiving service on Friday, June 3, at St Paul's Cathedral, to The Derby at Epsom Downs, the events over Elizabeth's special weekend are as memorable as the thousands of others held during her years on the throne.

And yet the Platinum Jubilee is about much more than just Queen Elizabeth II. It is an opportunity for people across the UK to share in what it means to have a strong, proud, resilient monarch, particularly in an era where so much around us feels restricted or under threat.





Fill up your fttdtr: Birds can find it tough to find food when the ground is dry and worms are scarce. Keep your bird feeder topped up and put out some fruit, such as apples and soaked raisins, for animals on the ground.

Create shaded spots: Animals may struggle to find shade on a hot day, but you can help by putting logs, large rocks or wooden planks around your garden to help create shade.

Kttp your pond topptd up: Remember to keep an eye on your pond and top it up if needed. This will help any fish that you have, as well as other visitors who use your pond as a water source.





This is one of the most important tricks of the trade - any professional car washer worth their salt will remove as much dirt as possible using a hose or jet wash before they start to use their hands to clean a vehicle. This is because both dirt and grime can drag along the exterior and damage the paintwork.

### Use multiple buckets

You should always have two buckets to hand, one that contains your washing solution (ideally you should use car shampoo) and one filled with water for rinsing. It is also advisable to use a grit guard to catch the dirt.

### Invest in a wash mitt

Although you can use a large sponge and still achieve a good finish, if you want optimum results,

you need to invest in a wash mitt. Typically made from lamb's wool or microfibre, these are much less likely to leave surface scratches as the deep and fluffy fabric absorbs the dirt better than a sponge.

### Do not leave to dry naturally

Never leave your car to dry naturally. Instead, use a purpose-built blower, or even a leaf blower, or a triple-layered microfibre cloth to dry your car.

### Avoid extreme heat and direct sunlight

Although you may think that the ideal time to wash your car is when the sun is shining, this is actually not the case. Not only will you have to work harder and faster as your car will dry guicker than normal, but extreme heat can affect the strength of the chemicals in the products you are using. Instead, wash early in the morning or after 5pm.

### 1. CHOOSE AN AQUARIUM



### **B®RGAND MCENR®E**

ach month we look at one of the most significant events in British sporting history. This month, it's the epic encounter between Björn Borg and John McEnroe at Wimbledon on July 5, 1980.

The Championships at Wimbledon have provided countless dramatic sporting memories over the years, and none more special than when British heroes of the ilk of Ann Jones and Andy Murray have lifted the coveted trophy.

Yet perhaps the most remarkable encounter – certainly for sheer blood, guts, aggression and an unrelenting desire for victory – came in 1980 when a Swede faced an American.

Björn Borg had long been painted as the iceman, a Scandinavian purveyor of perfect tennis who was clinical and elegant in his despatching of opponents. John McEnroe, meanwhile, was the sweaty, unkempt brat of the game, with a confrontational,

aggressive game and a temperament to match.

That they collided so spectacularly on that sunny Saturday afternoon on July 5 will go down in SW19 folklore. McEnroe gained the upper hand by winning the opening exchange 6-1, before Borg fought back with 7-5 and 6-3 sets, giving him a 2-1 lead.

Looking to close out the match in the fourth set, Borg had five Championship points in an epic that went well past any reasonably expected distance. Finally, in the 34th game of the set, McEnroe broke the reigning champion – who was looking to win a fifth successive title – and took it 18-16.

Even in the deciding set, the duelling athletes made it to 6-6, though this time Borg broke McEnroe's steely serve, and his resolve, to take the set 8-6, and with it the Wimbledon title.

The epic was recently relived in a 2017 biopic, Borg vs McEnroe, starring Shia LaBeouf and Sverrir Gudnason.

### HAND OF V

### DIEGO MARADONA'S ICONIC HAND OF GOD SHIRT SELLS AT AUCTION

Then England midfielder Steve Hodge swapped shirts with Argentina double-goalscorer Diego Maradona at the end of the World Cup quarter-final at the Estadio Azteca in Mexico in 1986, he was derided by fans, sections of the press and even his own teammates.

The Argentine wizard had just knocked the Three Lions out of the World Cup with a Jekyll and Hyde display of sporting brilliance and brazen opportunism - one of the best goals ever scored at a World Cup, coming minutes after the Hand of God goal that we've all seen replayed hundreds of times.

In swapping shirts, to some, Hodge crossed the line.

Wind forward three-and-a-half decades, and Hodge has the last laugh, after that prized number 10 shirt recently sold at auction for more than £7.1million.

Perhaps one of the most iconic items of sporting memorabilia - the value of which soared after Maradona's death in November 2020 - the shirt made almost twice its guide price, and was sold to someone from Abu Dhabi with links to Manchester City.

The Sotheby's auction process had all the usual twists and turns befitting of Maradona's life. In the lead-up to its sale, the infamous star's family insisted that the shirt was a fake, supposing that the striker swapped shirts at half-time during the game on June 22, 1986, and that Hodge

was in fact in possession of the shirt worn in the first half.

In addition, a late plea materialised from an Argentinian delegation for the C. I. Million shirt to be returned to South America. The group failed with its own bid as the auction price rocketed, though the request remains to display the shirt in Buenos Aires in October, for what would have been Maradona's 62nd birthday.

The sale price mirrors the previous record for any sports memorabilia - the original autographed manuscript of the Olympic Manifesto from 1892, sold by Sotheby's in December 2019.

### 5 DISTURBING FACTS ABOUT

drowning

o raise awareness of Drowning Prevention Week, which takes place between June 18 and 25 this year, we have collated five disturbing facts about drowning that you should be aware of.

### 1. YOU CAN DROWN IN AS LITTLE AS 30ML OF LIQUID

Although most people associate drowning with large bodies of water such as swimming pools and the sea, you can drown in as little as 30ml of liquid. There are reported cases of people, particularly children, drowning in buckets, toilets and even puddles.

#### 2. PEOPLE WHO ARE DROWNING WON'T SHOUT AND WAVE THEIR ARMS

When people are drowning in films, they tend to be shouting for help and waving their arms in the air to attract attention. Sadly, when someone is drowning, this is not physically possible. The body goes into survival mode and prioritises breathing over all other actions.

### 3. MOST DROWNING DEATHS OCCUR WHEN SOMEONE IS INTOXICATED

As many as 70 per cent of deaths caused by drowning in adults and adolescents involve the use of alcohol When you are intoxicated, your judgement, balance and motor skills all become impaired, which puts you a much greater risk of drowning.


#### 4. YOU DROWN DIFFERENTLY IN FRESHWATER AND SEAWATER


While you may think that drowning in the sea would be more common, as many as 90 per cent of drowning cases occur in freshwater. Owing to the composition of freshwater, which is more similar to our own blood than seawater, you can drown in freshwater in as little as two or three minutes. However, drowning in seawater can take up to 10 minutes.

### 5. DELAYED DROWNING CAN OCCUR AFTER YOU GET OUT OF THE WATER

There are two types of delayed drowning: dry drowning and secondary drowning. Dry drowning occurs when you inhale water through the nose or mouth, causing a spasm in the airway and preventing air from entering the lungs. Secondary drowning results from a swelling of the air sacs in the lungs.

Not just great at soothing sunburn and stopping spots, witch hazel is also a natural astringent and an anti-inflammatory, meaning it can soak up excess moisture and kill unwanted bacteria. Plus, it gets rid of odour fast.

Simply place a dab of witch hazel onto a cotton cloth and rub it on your underarm area. Reapply as and when needed.

### Baking soda

Baking soda makes a great natural personal hygiene product and can be highly effective in banishing underarm smells. Mix 1/8 tsp with a little water and rub under your arms. Or to combat perspiration, mix one part baking soda with six parts cornflour and dust the affected area. Avoid if you have sensitive skin.

### Lemon juice

Lemon juice contains citric acid, which has the ability to naturally get rid of odour-causing bacteria. All you need to do is squeeze 1 tsp of lemon juice onto a cotton ball and apply to your underarms. Do not do this directly after shaving.

### Apple cider vinegar

This clever ingredient is antibacterial and is able to both absorb and neutralise unpleasant odours. Simply mix 1 tbsp with 1 tbsp of water and apply under your arms using a clean cloth.

### Coconut oil

Coconut oil is antiviral and antibacterial, so is the perfect ingredient for eliminating odours caused by bacteria. Take 1/4 tsp of coconut oil and rub it directly under your arms using a cotton cloth. Allow to dry completely before dressing as it can stain clothes.

## Robust Cosemary

A hardy herb that will grow with abandon once established, rosemary has a long history of culinary, aromatic and medicinal uses.

### WHAT ARE THE HEALTH BENEFITS OF ROSEMARY?

- > A rich source of antioxidants and antiinflammatory compounds
- > Improves digestion and helps to treat indigestion
- > Enhances memory and concentration
- > Relieves stress and anxiety

### HOW TO USE ROSEMARY IN THE KITCHEN Rosemary salt

To create a rosemary-infused salt, fill a cup with rosemary leaves pulled from the stem and place in a bowl with 3 cups of salt. Stir together, cover and leave to sit for 2-3 weeks.

### Rosemary oil

To make rosemary-infused oil, pour 2 cups of olive oil into a small pan and allow to simmer. Remove from the heat and add 3-4 dry sprigs of rosemary. Pour into a sterilised jar and cover with a lid.

### Rosemary sugar syrup

Rosemary sugar syrup can be drizzled over cakes, vogurt or fresh fruit for a sweet and fragrant twist. Bring 1 cup of water to the boil and add 2 cups of sugar and 3-4 sprigs of rosemary. Once the sugar has dissolved, remove from the heat and take out the rosemary. Pour into a sterilised jar.

### Rosemary lemonade

To make refreshing rosemary lemonade, simply bring 2½ cups of sugar to a boil, remove from the heat and add 9 sprigs of rosemary. Leave to steep for 30 minutes and strain. Add ½ cup of fresh lemon juice and 4 cups of cold water. Chill and serve over ice on its own or with your favourite gin.

### Rosemary butter

Soften a stick of butter (but don't melt it) and blend with rosemary leaves that have been removed from the stem and diced into small pieces. Slather on crackers, bread, meat or fish.





re you fed up with finding soggy, slimy and generally sorry-looking salad in your fridge? Keep your leaves looking (and tasting) lovely for longer with our top tips for how to keep salad fresh.

GIVE IT SOME TLC: If you fling your salad in your shopping bag with heavier food and drink items such as tins and bottles, then your leaves are highly likely to become bruised and battered. Instead, handle your salad with care and it will be less likely to spoil.

DRY YOUR SALAD: Pre-packaged salads are usually ready to eat and do not require washing. However, sometimes the leaves can look a little damp. If this is the case, give them a quick spin in a salad spinner to remove any excess moisture. Alternatively, gently pat them with a dry cloth or tea towel.

REMOVE ANY SPOILT LEAVES: When you get

your salad home from the supermarket, open it up and remove any spoilt or squishy leaves that could potentially cause fresher leaves to wilt. It can also be a good idea to fluff up your salad before storing.

PLACE IN AN AIRTIGHT CONTAINER: Store your salad leaves in an airtight plastic container that has been lined with a paper towel. This will help to absorb any moisture and keep your leaves fresher for longer.

STORE IN THE FRIDGE: Salad leaves should be kept in the crisper drawer of your fridge as this provides the optimal temperature for fresh fruits and vegetables. This should also help to ensure that your salad does not become partially frozen.

FOLLOW THE SEVEN-DAY RULE: Even if you follow the above tips, bagged salad leaves are not designed to last longer than a week. After this time, it is usually a case of use it or lose it.
