SPARE?

AMID THE RELEASE OF HARRY AND MEGHAN'S TRIO OF PROJECTS, WE LOOK AT HOW THE 'SPARE' AND HIS WIFE HAVE BEGUN TO TELL THEIR TRUTH

Since their unexpected flight from both British shores and the working Royal Family in January 2020, Prince Harry and his wife Meghan have caused quite the stir, constructing a new narrative that neither they nor the Royal Family can be certain of recovering from.

First came a biography of the pair, *Finding Freedom*, written by close confidante Omid Scobie, which hinted at unease within the royal ranks. Then, in March 2021, their shock interview with TV talk show maven Oprah Winfrey aired to global comment on both sides of the Atlantic.

Since then, things have been reasonably quiet and calm as the Sussexes have settled into their Los Angeles lifestyle and adjusted to family life with their two children, Archie, aged three, and 18-monthold Lilibet. However, as several multimillion-dollar deals reach their point of fruition, our red-headed prince and his raven-maned wife are once again back in the spotlight.

Last month, their six-part Netflix documentary *Harry & Meghan* was released, which saw the Duke and Duchess of Sussex attempt to tell their side of the story. Capturing the couple from their earliest days together right up to the period after Prince Philip's death, the series has certainly split opinion. While some find it to be insightful and informative, others believe it to be shocking and villainous. Or in some cases, opinions have flipped completely, and those who might not have supported them before have now gone to the other side and have begun to empathise with the pair.

To add to any nerves the Royal Family may have already been experiencing, Harry's book, *Spare*, is released this month. The title alone conveys the Duke's deep disconnection from his own family, one that doesn't appear as if it will be healed anytime soon.

All things come in threes, and Netflix has announced it is also behind the couple's other new project, entitled *Live to Lead*. It showcases inspirational figures – from climate change activist Greta Thunberg to New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern, to South Africa rugby star Siya Kolisi, the first-ever black captain of the side. Harry was inspired by the efforts of Nelson Mandela, and true to the former president's lifelong aspirations, the series of interviews is positioned to offer hope, vision, perspective and understanding... arguably at a time when the world needs it most.

Hopefully Harry himself will find in 2023 ways to reconcile what has been a turbulent and heart-wrenching year for the royals. He and Meghan's latest moves won't have done much to repair relations, but his transparency and clarity over how he feels hard done by may indeed act as a line in the sand, from where a new vista may emerge for the outliers, even if he questions the possibility of that.

"I've had to make peace with the fact that we're probably never going to get genuine accountability or a genuine apology [from my family]," says Harry in the documentary. "My wife and I, we're moving on. We're focused on what's coming next."

Such sentiments have been uttered by many of us regarding our own families, and unequivocally this shows us that when it comes to matters of the heart, the Windsor family, for all their wealth, prestige and glory, really are just like the rest of us. But is this family's broken relationship past the point of repair?





Winnie-Lhe-Pooh A bear of very little brain

Www.innie-the-Pooh might not seem smart, and he certainly gets himself into some scrapes. But there's no doubt he's also friendly, kind and thoughtful – and comes up with some great ideas to get his friends out of trouble. And did you know he has his own special day on January 18? All things Pooh Bear are celebrated then because it's when Pooh's creator A.A. Milne was born, back in 1882. To join in the fun, why not organise a teddy bears' picnic, watch a Pooh movie, or just eat a load of honey?

Pooh was named after the teddy owned by author A.A. Milne's son, Christopher Robin – who also stars in the Pooh books. But the original drawings were based on Growler, the teddy owned by the son of the book's illustrator, E.H. Shepard. Milne's tubby creation made his first appearance in print in a 1924 edition of

Punch magazine. And two years after that, the first collection of Pooh stories appeared in an eponymously titled book, *Winnie-the-Pooh*.

Piglet, Eeyore, Kanga, Roo and Tigger – as well as Pooh – were all based on toys owned by young Christopher Milne. But Owl and Rabbit were the author's own inventions.

The Hundred Acre Wood, where Pooh and his friends lived, is Milne's version of Ashdown Forest in East Sussex, where the family bought a house in 1925. Perhaps Pooh's most outstanding achievement was inventing the game of Pooh sticks. Standing on a bridge over running water, each player drops a stick on

the upstream side, and the winner is the one whose stick appears first on the downstream side. Or perhaps his greatest achievement was being one of the highest-earning literary characters ever. The rights to Pooh were sold to Disney in 2001 for a staggering \$350million. Not a bad achievement for a bear of supposedly very little brain.

THE STORY BEHIND BRITAIN'S ICONIC VACUUM CLEANER

e's not the most aesthetically pleasing member of the household cleaning family, nor the most powerful, and as far as cutting-edge technology goes, he pre-dates even the era of the mobile phone and internet connectivity.

Yet despite all of that, our love affair for Henry lives on, more than 40 years since the compact and affordable vacuum cleaner was launched by Numatic International.

Its founder, Chris Duncan, first started toying with his vacuum cleaner concept back in 1969, when he dressed up one of his standard vacuum cleaners with a Union Jack, hat and smiley face during a particularly long night at a trade show.

The response from visitors was a revelation for the inventor, who discovered that taking an inanimate object and giving it a personality enchanted people who were looking for something different from the standard cleaning devices.

Henry

Of course, the cleaner plays its part where performance is concerned

too, using large-capacity microfibre dust bags encased in a shell that is built for longevity and durability.

Since the machine was officially launched in 1981, sales continue to accelerate and now frequently exceed the one million mark each year. While Numatic has never advertised the machine, nor does it employ the services of a PR agency, an estimated 20 million have been sold in the UK to date.

Henry isn't the only named machine in the range. Previous versions have been called James, Charles, Nuvac, George, David, William, Edward, Basil, Wendy, Harry and Jack, while limited-edition models have been launched for B&Q, Screwfix and John Lewis.

It has also led to spinoff designs, notably the Henry and Hetty Spray Mops.

In 2023, it is the only massproduced consumer vacuum cleaner still made in Britain, and has made its founder a millionaire many times over.





He has now been called up for the 2023 International Ice Hockey Federation U20 World Championships, which will take place in Istanbul from January 26 to February 2.



Tributes paid to 'dedicated' family man

rentwood-born firefighter David Lambert (pictured Dtop left) has passed away aged 46 following a cancer diagnosis last year.

David, whose funeral took place on December 21, was a dedicated family man and leaves behind his mother, siblings and three children.

He was a firefighter in Potters Bar for more than 25 years and a devoted Southend United fan. Pottars Bar Fire Station have named one of their fire engines after David.

Brett Shohet, a friend of David's, said: "He was a dedicated father and a family man, besotted with his children and tremendously loyal to his family.

"He took so much pleasure helping people and would have a conversation with anyone."

At Southend United's 2-2 draw with Altrincham on Saturday, December 3, his family and friends wore specially made scarves and t-shirts emblazoned with his nickname, 'Elmo'.

Brett added: "The memorial couldn't have gone better. The club was amazing with how they helped.

"We got personalised scarves and t-shirts made. We had a picture of him printed, a testimonial piece in the programme, and the announcer read out the statement at half-time."

A statement in the Southend United programme said: "David was a well-known, loveable character in the East Stand as well as the far post bar.

"He is being remembered here today by his family and friends."

Car park prices see further increase

Parking in some Brentwood car parks have become more expensive this year.

Brentwood Borough Council is hoping to raise £900.000 through increased parking prices at William Hunter Way Car Park, with prices rising from £1 per hour to £1.10.

Meanwhile, the Coptfold Road Multi-Storey Car Park remains at £1, with the price for all-day parking reducing from £8 to £6. The council says this is to provide workers with cheaper parking.

The £2 per night charge is also being scrapped, and drivers arriving at 7pm who park for six hours will now pay £6.60.

Leader of the council. councillor Chris Hossack. said: "This is not aimed at penalising residents. This is aimed very much at people who are coming to the high street, whether day or night.

"What we want to do is incentivise those people into using the multistorey to free up William Hunter Way and Chatham Road."

BURGHART for BRENTWOOD



Alex Burghart MP for Brentwood and Ongar

The devastating effect of motor neurone disease (MND) on individuals and families has been brought to the forefront of our attention recently by the well-documented experience of former professional rugby league player Rob Burrow, as the disease has taken his movement and voice from him, and the sad death last year of his friend Doddie Weir.

MND is a condition that affects the brain and nerves, and 5,000 people in the UK are thought to have the condition. There is currently only one drug licensed in the UK to treat MND, Riluzole, which slows the progression of the disease and extends someone's life by a few months.

A small group of constituents who are affected by MND are in regular contact with me about government funding for more research, so it is good to start 2023 knowing £50million has been

made available to meet those requests. This will be used to fund specialist research centres and partnerships with leading researchers, and to accelerate work on the most promising treatments.

The government will cut red tape in order to speed up research into MND across the UK, with immediate investment so NHS patients can benefit from cutting-edge treatment and medicines. The National Institute for Health and Care Research and Medical Research Council will work together to ensure proposals are referred to the most appropriate scheme for consideration at the early idea stage.

It means some of the UK's brightest and best scientific minds are battling to find treatments – and one day, a cure – for the cruel and devastating condition that is MND.



Puppy found with cropped ears

The RSPCA has launched an appeal for information after a puppy with her ears illegally cropped was bought in Brentwood.

Lira, a four-month-old bull breed, was bought in the Brentwood area by her new owners, who contacted the RSPA after they became concerned.

The puppy is currently under the care of the RSPCA and is undergoing veterinary treatment, though the animal welfare charity has been unable to trace who was responsible for Lira at the time of her illegal surgery. Ear cropping, an entirely aesthetic and completely unnecessary process whereby part or all of the ear is removed, is illegal in England and Wales under the Animal Welfare Act.

RSPCA inspector Chris McGreal said: "We are trying to find out who was responsible for this pup when she had her ears cropped. Her owner has told us she was bought from a stranger with her ears already cropped in a field around Hutton Mount, Brentwood.

"If anyone can help us, please call us on our inspectorate appeals line on 0300 123 8018."

"Delilah didn't do either of those things and this hearing loss makes her achievements all the more remarkable. I am incredibly proud of Delilah's drive, determination and organisation."

Parents push for road safety near schools

Parents are pushing for further improvements on a busy Brentwood road. St Thomas of Canterbury Church of England Junior School, St Helen's Catholic Junior School Academy, Grove House School, and Becket Keys Church of England School are all located on Sawyers Hall Lane.

Traffic during the school run remains an issue, as reported in **VISION**BrentwoodOngar September 2022 edition, with some parents parking on the side of the road when picking up their children from school.

Essex County Council (ECC) has since removed 26 waiting and parking spaces from the road to allow for a widened footway to increase safety standards, but parents say this doesn't go far enough.

A spokesperson for ECC said: "Initial measures to improve the walking environment of Sawyers Hall Lane were installed over the summer.

"Further measures are under consideration and are being discussed by the Brentwood Active Travel steering group.

"Further interventions are subject to funding being available."

Police Station goes up for sale to raise money

The former Ongar police station will be put up for sale to raise funds for front-line policing.

The High Street building closed in 2011 and the intention to sell it was announced in 2015 to allow for reinvestment in other areas of the force.

Now, despite residents' fears over the decreasing visibility of police in Ongar, it has been confirmed that the police station will be sold.

Essex Police have sought to allay concerns following the news.

Chief Inspector Tina Cooper, District Commander for Brentwood and Epping Forest, said: "We know that police stations are symbolically important, but the reality is it is police officers who catch criminals, protect victims, prevent crime and engage with our communities."

Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner for Essex, Roger Hirst, said: "Police officers prevent crime and keep people safe, not buildings, and there are now more police officers in Essex than ever before, protecting our community.

"This is because of both our and the government's continued investment in policing over the past five years. The sale of the former Ongar police station, which hasn't been open to the public for more than a decade, will bring significant money back into the force which will be invested straight back into front-line policing."

High Street is not omitted from bike ride

The RideLondon-Essex cycle ride in May 2023 will continue its established route through Ongar, despite requests for the High Street to be omitted.

A series of community consultation events were previously held in Ongar and elsewhere in Essex to query residents about their concerns. However, organiser London Marathon Events has announced no changes to its proposed route.

Organisers considered omitting Ongar High Street from the route, with proposed variations marked on posters displayed at the public engagement sessions. However, Essex County Council (ECC) has agreed that the event will continue on the same route as in 2022.

A report to Epping Forest District Council said:

"Details of road closures will follow, along with information about community engagement plans."

Reactions to the announcement have been largely negative, with one resident saving; "I really am at a loss. What on earth does ECC think this event could ever achieve in the face of such near unanimous disapproval?"

Another resident said: "What's worse is that hordes of cyclists use this route to practise on every weekend, so it isn't just a problem for one day. They hold up traffic every weekend. No fun for anyone all vear round."

ECC and London Marathon Events have been contacted for comment.

BRITISH BUSINESS Survivors

FIVE AGE-OLD BRITISH COMPANIES STILL WITH US TODAY

Substrate the set of t

The oldest surviving British company is The Royal Mint. It opened in 1279 and, for several hundred years, was based at the Tower of London. In the early 1800s, it moved over the road. But by 1975, it had completed its move to its current home in Llantrisant, Wales. The Mint makes more than 3.3 billion coins and blanks yearly – for the UK and more than 30 other countries.

With the dwindling use of cash, the Mint has expanded into other areas, including precious metals investment, historic coins and luxury collectibles. And it's doing pretty well.

Cambridge University Press, the world's first publishing company, was founded in 1534 and publishes academic and educational texts.

Moving down the years, Royal Mail, as it's now known, was founded in 1586. For almost 500 years, it was owned by the state. But by 2015, it was fully privatised. At one stage in the early 20th century, the company had 22,000 pigeons. And someone's gone to the trouble of counting how many elastic bands it currently uses to bundle mail – apparently 342 million a year.

Barclays Bank was founded in London in 1690. The institution's long history is contained in an archive of photos, letters and curiosities housed in the Barclays Group Archives in Manchester.

In 1706, Thomas Twining bought a coffee shop in London's Strand and began to sell tea. Back then, tea was very costly. But Twining spotted a trend. And when he started selling loose tea leaves, as well as cups of the beverage itself, business boomed. By 1717, he'd bought additional space next door – and the shop's still open for business today.

DANNY DYER'S EXIT FROM *EASTENDERS* MARKS ALMOST A DECADE OF THRILLING DRAMA IN THE SQUARE

hat Danny Dyer evolved so admirably from regal cockney to Queen Vic landlord Mick Carter is one of the more celebrated evolutions of British celebrity culture.

The East London-born West Ham United superfan has waved goodbye after almost a decade on Albert Square – a solid commitment to E20 and the drinks industry that has seen the once-derided actor and presenter rise to the cream of the soap opera fraternity.

Dyer emerged as a spiky, punchy, salt-of-the-Earth type who passed up an interest in usual working-class opportunities to embark on acting classes. Bullied at school for his passion for drama, Dyer soon had the last laugh, appearing in *Prime Suspect 3* at the age of 16.

Terrestrial gigs in *Cadfael, A Touch of Frost, Loved Up, Highlander, Soldier Soldier* and *Skins* followed, before his big film break came in *Human Traffic*, an iconic coming-of-age clubbing movie that also saw the emergence of John Simm.

Soon after, he was asked to front Bravo documentary series *The Real Football Factories* (a real-life take on *The Football Factory* movie he had previously starred in), which proved to be a big hit in an era where terrace casuals were still prevalent in the Premier League and beyond (as the subsequent *The Real Football Factories International* proved).

This was followed by *Danny Dyer's Deadliest Men*, in which he interviewed Britain's most notorious gangsters.

He turned down the chance to join the cast in Walford in 2009, citing fears of being too exposed in the public eye, but having experimented with a number of low-budget film projects, was lured to *EastEnders* in 2013 as Queen Vic landlord Mick Carter.

Enjoying a bevy of controversial storylines, he has clinched three awards in the role, including Best Serial Drama Performance at the National Television Awards. Along the way, he has made the change from the rough and ready hard man of the Square to someone capable of carrying through a wealth of poignant and emotive storylines. Having spent years develping his skills, he now looks to take that forward with other projects.

"EastEnders has been amazing for me," says Dyer. "I'm grateful for the beautiful years I've had there. I'm going to miss the people massively."

Talking about what comes next, the 45 year old says: "I know the landscape has changed slightly, but I want to go out there and have another go, and the only way I can do that is if I decide to walk away from the job."

Dyer will next be seen in a four-part Channel 5 drama called *Heat*, for which filming is to begin shortly in Australia.

Ahead of his Albert Square exit, executives were tight-lipped on how the storyline would develop, but there was all the drama expected of an *EastEnders* Christmas special – including a car chase, a clifftop brawl, and ultimately tragedy as Mick met his watery end.

Perhaps the true tragedy is that one of the true mainstays of the British landscape is gone... for now, but maybe not forever.



HOW TO GET THE BEST OUT OF YOUR GARDEN IN THE COLD WINTER MONTHS

Some of us may regard winter as the season when our desire to venture out into the garden wanes completely. Yet whether we're negotiating a path across a frosty lawn, or simply viewing nature from the warmth and comfort of the indoors, making your garden into a winter wonderland is a rewarding task.

TREMENDOUS TREES

Stripped of their summer decoration, let skeletal trees stand out against a snowy backdrop. Mixed up with evergreens, you can create a brilliant contrast.

FANTASTIC FEASTS

Finally, don't assume your winter garden can't put produce on the table. Carrots and fava beans will still thrive throughout the winter, and you can extend the growing period of a number of other varieties of fruit and veg if you keep your greenhouse operational throughout the cold months.

PRUNED

f you want to enjoy a good fruit cycle, you need to prune your apple and pear trees over the winter. For those who are new to fruit pruning, this stepby-step guide tells you all you need to know.

GET THE RIGHT TOOLS

You need to have clean, sharp tools that are designed for pruning, such as secateurs, loppers or a pruning saw if you have a larger pear or apple tree. Make sure you sharpen them before use.

CUT BACK SUCKERS AND LOWER BRANCHES

Use secateurs to cut back any suckers. These are unwanted shoots that grow near the base of the trunk. Also, cut back lower branches as these do not get sufficient light to bear good fruit.

REMOVE DEAD OR DISEASED WOOD

Remove all branches with discoloured or flaking bark towards the base of the branch by making a cut above an outward-facing bud (one that is on the opposite side of the stem to the main trunk). If there are no buds, remove the entire branch.

CREATE A VASE SHAPE FRAMEWORK

Ideally, you want four or five main branches that help pi

to create an open vase shape. If you have more than five, remove some at the base by cutting 6mm from the branch collar – this refers to the bulbous area that is attached to the trunk.

Avoid removing more than 25 per cent of the branches in one go as this can affect the tree's health and fruit production.

REMOVE CROSSING OR RUBBING BRANCHES

Remove any branches that are growing into the centre of the tree as this will allow for better air circulation. If two branches are crossing, keep the one that best retains the vase shape of the tree and remove the other one.

SHORTEN THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S GROWTH ON EACH BRANCH BY ONE-THIRD

Cut just above an outward-facing bud on each main branch so that new branches grow outwards. This will help the tree to develop into a healthy shape and prevent congestion.



KISS A

CELEBRATE KISS

n January 12, it's Kiss A Ginger Day – the perfect time to show redheads some love. But you might need to take a good look around – because red hair is rare. Only two in every 100 people are natural redheads, making it the rarest hair colour in the world. And the rarest people of all are redheads with blue eyes.

The genes responsible for red hair are recessive. This means that to have a red-haired baby, both parents must carry a red-haired gene. If both parents carry the gene but don't have red hair themselves, they'll have around a one in four chance of having a red-haired baby. If one of the parents is a redhead and the other is a carrier of the gene but doesn't have red hair, the chances go up to around one in two. And if both parents have ginger locks, chances are that all their children will have red hair too.

to be witches and were shunned by society. These days, things have thankfully improved – although some people still think natural gingers are brash and hot-headed. That's not true, of course. But recent studies have shown that redheads require more anaesthetic than people with other hair colours. YOU WILL NEED:

- Some sheets of paper (A4 paper makes a lantern about 20cm tall, and A5 paper makes a lantern about 14cm tall). You can use different coloured or patterned paper
- > A ruler, pencil and eraser
- A glue stick
- > Scissors
- Extra decorations such as stick-on shapes, sequins, braid or ribbon (optional)

HOW TO MAK

- Fold your paper in half lengthways so you have a long, slim rectangle.
- Draw a line parallel with the long edge, where the two sides of the paper meet. This line should be about 2.5cm away from the edge.
- Starting about 2.5cm in from one of the short edges, draw a series of parallel lines across the rectangle, from the folded edge up to the long line you've just drawn. These lines should be about 2.5cm apart.
- Out along each of the short lines.
- Erase any noticeable pencil marks, then unfold the paper.

 Run your gluestick along one short side of the lantern. Form the paper into a tube shape, then glue the two short sides together.

However, if you're unsure what to serve for that special someone come February 14, here are five of the most popular types of shellfish, as well as how to serve them.

Mell

OYSTERS

Oysters are the most nutrient-rich shellfish available and also the most expensive. With a reputation as an aphrodisiac, oysters have a gooey texture and a salty flavour. Most commonly served raw on ice, you can fill their shells with lemon, butter, hot sauce or a zingy mixture made from shallots and vinegar. Alternatively, they can be grilled, baked or fried.

MUSSELS

One of the easiest shellfish to prepare and cook, mussels are usually steamed in flavoured broth or sauce. Mussels need to be kept alive before they are cooked and can only be refrigerated for one or two days. Any mussels with broken shells or ones with open shells and that don't close when tapped should be discarded. Enjoy moules frites (steamed mussels and fries), served with a huge chunk of crusty bread.

CRAB

Crabs take a bit more effort to prepare and cook, but it's definitely worth it as you'll be rewarded with tender, delicious meat. You can boil, roast, steam or grill crab and this shellfish is commonly used in dips, pastas, seafood dishes and salads. White crab meat boasts a meaty texture and a more delicate flavour, whereas brown meat is softer with an almost pâté-like consistency.

SCALLOPS

Another highly tender and succulent type of shellfish, scallops make the perfect starter. Boasting a rich, buttery flavour, you can choose between small and sweet bay scallops or big and bold sea scallops. Pan-seared scallops with peas and mint are our go-to recipe at any time of year.

LOBSTER

Known for its melt-in-the-mouth texture, lobster is the epitome of elegance. Lobster can be cooked whole, and the most succulent meat is found in the tails, legs and claws. Try garlic herb butter lobster tail as a delicious starter or lobster risotto as a main course.

t's only five years since Ben Stokes OBE found himself facing not just exclusion from the sport he loved, but also potentially a prison sentence, having been charged with affray outside a Bristol nightclub.

'Bazball', as it is referred to, is a driven, dynamic and outlandishly positive method of playing the game, the like of which five-day Test cricket has never seen. This cricket revolution epitomises not just Stokes' captaincy, but also his approach to life itself.

As inspirational English sportspeople go, there are few who can rival Stokes' efforts.

Further proof of this was offered when Stokes was named as runner-up in the 2022 BBC Sports Personality of the Year Award. Though he didn't win, his nomination is evidence enough of his incredible success.

Thile no one expects to be involved in a car accident, these types of incidents can happen in the blink of an eye and, if you don't know what to do next, can cause you untold stress and expense.

Here's everything you need to know about DOI HAVE TO MAKE A CLAIM AFTER AN making a claim following an accident.

WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO MAKE A CLAIM?

If you are involved in a motoring incident with another person, you should do your best to obtain the below information on the scene:

- > Their full name
- > Their vehicle registration
- > A contact telephone number

It can also be a good idea to find out their address and details of their insurance provider. If there are any witnesses, try to get their details as well. When you phone your insurance company, they are likely to ask you for your policy number, so make sure you have this to hand.

WHEN DO I NEED TO MAKE A CLAIM?

Although it can vary from one insurance provider to the next, typically you have 24 to 48 hours to inform them if you are involved in a motoring

accident. This is regardless of whether the incident was your fault or caused by another party. Where possible, you should call them while still at the scene.

ACCIDENT?

There is no rule that says you have to make a claim after a road accident, but you are required by law to tell your insurer about what has happened.

DO I NEED TO CALL THE POLICE AFTER A CAR ACCIDENT?

According to the Road Traffic Act, you must report a car accident to a local police station within 24 hours. You can do this using the nonemergency number 101. If there is an injury or the road is blocked, call 999 immediately.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T WANT TO MAKE A CLAIM?

You may choose not to make a claim. This will allow you to keep your no-claims discount intact, although you will have to pay for any necessary repairs to your vehicle yourself. It is worth knowing that, even if you do not make a claim, the other driver involved may still do so.
