n an era where a fad is lucky to last a full five minutes, the enduring magic of hand puppet Sooty must be something of a mystery to young audiences. And yet, when faced with his snuggly yellow fur, button eyes and sweet, shy demeanour, they inevitably melt with adoration as generation upon generation of children before them have done.

TURNS SEVENTY-FINE

Discovered by Harry Corbett OBE in a joke shop on Blackpool North Pier on July 19, 1948, 'Teddy' – as he was then known – was purchased for seven shillings and six pence.

Having long harboured ambitions for the stage, Bradford native Corbett first appeared with the silent bear in a 1952 BBC TV show, *Talent Night*. The act was an instant success and Sooty soon became the star of his very own show featuring magic tricks, slapstick comedy and songs – a nod to Corbett's former ambitions as a concert pianist which were thwarted by his being deaf in one ear. Soon afterwards, he was joined by his pals: there was Sweep, a grey male dog who communicated with a squeak, and Soo, a female panda with a human voice.

After suffering a heart attack in 1975, Corbett's son Peter (stage name Matthew) took over as Sooty's friend and keeper. In the ensuing years, and with the character now a mainstay on *Rainbow*, Corbett Senior would make occasional guest appearances on spin-off *Sooty Show* (by this point now airing on ITV) until his death in 1989.

Under Matthew Corbett, Sooty and co. would enjoy enormous success. He changed the format of the show to one of a sitcom but kept the integral elements. Namely, Sooty's wand, the catchphrase 'izzy, wizzy, let's get busy', and the silent bear's enduring love of water pistols and mayhem in general.

In 1998, Corbett was succeeded by Richard Cadell. Only a few weeks into his new role, he found himself at 10 Downing Street for a special awards ceremony honouring brave children, hosted by then Prime Minister Sir Tony Blair and his wife Cherie – who Sooty dutifully squirted with his water pistol.

Sooty and Sweep were also guests at the birthday party of His Majesty Prince Charles, as he was then, in 2018 (Sooty actually being a few months older than our now King). The pair have courted numerous other politicians, musicians and celebrities and even – on the hand of Harry Corbett – shared a giggle with Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

So how is it, then, that a premise so simple remains so beloved in an age of CGI and swanky animation?

"I think the great thing with Sooty – and this is a famous Harry Corbett quote – is that he's never really been in fashion, so he's never really been out," laughs Cadell.

"It's not like one of these children's things that spike and then disappear," explains the 54 year old, who will embark on 75th Birthday Spectacular – a special UK national tour that kicks off on October 21 at Bradford's Alhambra Theatre and runs through until April 2024.

He adds: "Sometimes the things we cherish most as children, and adults, are based in simple entertainment, and I am delighted that fact has held true despite so much else around us changing."

f you love the current rustic vibe but not the hefty price tags, check out these easy twig projects.

SUNBURST TWIG MIRROR YOU'LL NEED:

- > Lots of straight twigs of roughly the same size
- > A 25cm round frameless mirror
- > A 35cm circle of corrugated cardboard

ave you TWIGGED?

> A hot glue gun HOW TO MAKE:

- > Glue the mirror in place in the centre of the cardboard circle.
- > Glue the twigs on the cardboard so that one end is right against the mirror edge and the other is sticking straight out, overlapping the cardboard. Layer on enough twigs so that the cardboard is completely covered.
 - For safety reasons, we recommend you prop your mirror on a shelf rather than hang it up.

TWIGGY PHOTO FRAME

- YOU'LL NEED: For a 10cm x 15cm (6in x 4in) photo frame:
 - >2x 15cm twigs
- > 2x 20cm twias
- > Twine
- > PVA alue
- > A piece of baking paper slightly larger than the photo

> Scissors HOW TO MAKE:

> To form the first corner, lay a longer twig on top of a shorter twig, allowing 2.5cm of each twig to stick out where they overlap.

- > Wrap the two together so the twine forms a cross shape on top. Tie to secure.
- > Complete this step on all corners in the same way to create a rectangle

> Glue the photo onto the baking paper. Then glue the edges of the baking paper to the back of the frame, with the picture facing out.

JEWELLERY TREE

YOU'LL NEED:

- > A strong hardwood branch approx. 25-30cm tall
- > A log slice about 5cm thick and 13-15cm in diameter
- > Epoxy glue (e.g. Araldite)
- > A drill and drill bits suitable for wood

HOW TO MAKE:

- > Drill a hole in the log slice, the same width as the main stem of the branch.
- > Fasten the branch in the hole with the glue and leave it to dry.
 - > Hang up your jewellery!

used as weapons A Brentwood Borough Council Licensing Sub-Committee hearing was held on NEWS September 5, and the decision was made to revoke the bar's licence. The council stated: "Revocation must be a last resort. However, bearing in mind the evidence of management failings - both in the handling of the violent incident on

June 16 and in the subsequent lack of openness with the responsible authorities - the sub-committee considered that the premises licence holder could no longer be trusted to operate the premises consistently with the licensing objectives. Therefore, revocation was the only appropriate option."

Bloc 40 has been contacted for comment.

Conservation works begin on chapel ruins

Onservation work on the ruins of a historic chapel Uin Brentwood began on Monday, September 25. The ruins of the Chapel of St Thomas a Becket date from the 13th century.

Formal consent from Historic England for the works was gained in 2022, while consent from the Chelmsford Diocese was gained in July 2023.

The works, which are expected to take eight weeks, include the removal of vegetation growing on the ruins, repairs of stonemasonry, pointing/repointing, rubble facework and crack repairs.

Councillor David Kendall, chair of Brentwood Borough Council's Finance, Assets, Investment and Recovery Committee, said: "We are committed to protecting important heritage assets in the borough. We hope the ruins remain a prominent feature for many more years to come."

With Halloween just around the corner, the countdown to secure a buyer by Christmas begins. Let's again look at the UK's housing market with a detailed focus on our local market in Brentwood.

House prices

The average price for a property in July was £289,824, up 0.6% year-on-year, and 0.5% on the previous month (ONS).

Economy

The Bank of England has held base rates at 5.25%, ending a cycle of 14 consecutive rate rises, in their attempt to curb inflation. The Bank expects inflation to slow to 5% by the end of the year.

Transactions

Aschool in Ongar has been found to be affected by the government's new reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete (RAAC) guidelines.

Councillor Tony Ball, Essex County Council's cabinet member for education excellence, lifelong learning and employability, said: "I would like to acknowledge that for pupils, parents, school staff and education colleagues at the council, this isn't the start to the autumn term vou expected or will have wanted. I can reassure you that across the council, we are doing all we can to support schools to manage the situation and get affected children safely into schools and learning as quickly as possible."

HALLOWEEN PUMPKIN LANTERNS An Illuminating and Spooky Tale

he origins of Halloween go back around 2,000 years to a Celtic festival called Samhain (pronounced 'sow-in'). The Celts believed that when the harvest ended and winter took hold, the barrier between our world and the spirit world became blurred – and this meant that dead spirits could come back to haunt us. But why pumpkins?

Day) on November 1 – and All Souls' Day, the day after. By the 16th century, the festival was already known as Halloween, taking its name from All Hallows' Eve. And as part of their Halloween celebrations, people in Ireland carved turnips into lanterns to ward off spooky spirits.

AN ENCHANTING STORY FROM IRELAND

Stingy Jack is a character from Irish folk tales who liked playing pranks, even on the devil. One day, Jack tricked the devil into turning into a coin, so he could pay for their drinks. Jack then pocketed the coin, and the devil was trapped. Eventually, he set the devil free but made him promise not to claim his soul. So when Jack died, he couldn't go to hell or to heaven. He was stuck roaming the world with a glowing coal inside a turnip to light his way.

LANTERNS FROM TURNIPS

As time passed, Samhain mixed with Christian traditions such as All Saints' Day (or All Hallows'

PUMPKINS WORK BETTER When Irish people moved to America in the 1800s, they took their Halloween tradition with them. But they soon discovered that pumpkins were much easier to carve than turnips. In honour of Stingy Jack, the carved pumpkins became known as Jack-o'-lanterns.

Today, as we carve our pumpkins to light up the night, we continue to honour customs that have journeyed through time, from our Irish neighbours to America – and, in the 1990s, back over the seas to Britain.

- 5. CHOOSE YOUR VEGGIES (UP TO 3): Carrots | Onion | Peppers | Sweet potatoes | Parsnips | Spinach | Broccoli | Mushrooms
- 6. ADD SOME FLAVOUR: Garlic salt | Cayenne pepper | Cumin Basil | Thyme | Chilli powder

How to make your soup

STEP 1: Heat your fat and sauté your aromatic veggies, such as onion and garlic, for 3-5 minutes.

STEP 2: Add your chosen protein and cook until browned or softened. STEP 3: Add any other vegetables and allow them to soften for 5-10 minutes.

STEP 4: Pour in your base (unless using a cream base; if so save this until step 6), your grain and your selected spices and mix well. **STEP 5**: Bring to the boil, reduce the heat and allow to simmer

for around an hour.

STEP 6: Add cream if you are making a cream-based soup.

STEP 7: Allow to cool, and blend if you want a fully puréed soup.

STEP 8: Garnish with croutons, cheese or a herb-infused oil.

Freezing your soup

You can freeze your soup, ideally on the same day you make it, in an airtight container or freezer bag for 2-3 months. Most soups freeze well, with the exception of cream- or milk-based soups, which tend to separate. Add any fresh herbs or starchy elements such as rice or pasta once thawed and reheated, not before freezing, for optimum results.

BEN STOKES OBE'S INCLUSION IN THE WORLD CUP SQUAD IS GREAT NEWS FOR ENGLAND CRICKET... LESS SO FOR OUR OPPONENTS!

hen Durham and England all-rounder Ben Stokes OBE decided that the gruelling cricketing schedule was too much for him and his body to take, a collective sigh of relief from those who cherish the clack of leather on willow must have been heard all around the world in the sport.

It was July 2022. Stokes had spent the previous three months leading his country in Test cricket after succeeding Joe Root MBE as captain, and things in that regard had started perfectly, with four wins in a row. However, after commenting that he felt playing all three of cricket's formats – Test, ODI and T20 – was "unsustainable", Stokes' last 50-over tussle came against South Africa at his home ground, Durham's Riverside.

Yet a year is a long time in sport, and even longer in the seesaw nature of the Christchurch-born allrounder's career. So roll on 12 months, and despite a huge summer Ashes series ahead, Stokes began speaking to his limited overs captain Jos Buttler MBE and coach Matthew Mott about a quickfire return to the ODI circuit.

Stokes says: "The closer this World Cup got, the more I was becoming interested in having those discussions. And when you consider that we are the defending champions, it almost feels right to want to ensure you defend that crown.

"At the same time, I had to remind myself of the original reason for choosing to retire from this format of the game."

Return he has, with a pledge from the 32-year-old to listen to his body, perhaps better than he has in the past when the almost constant demands of the game have had an impact on not just physical abilities, but the star's mental wellbeing too.

"Let's see how this World Cup goes," he adds, "and I'll decide then if it's my last hurrah."

Had Stokes not chosen to return to the fold, we would have been denied his record-breaking knock against New Zealand in the third ODI at The Kia Oval in September. Coming into bat alongside Dawid Malan with England compromised on 13/2, Stokes was about to rev it up against the Kiwis.

His 15 fours and nine sixes contributed to an almost unimaginable personal total of 182, beating Jason Roy's 180 against Australia in Melbourne in 2018. His efforts saw England reach a mammoth 368 off 48.1 overs. New Zealand could only muster 187 all out and Stokes took a further leap into the echelons of iconic status.

"I need more time to get used to its rhythm, but I think I managed well this time," he said, referencing that spectacular knock. "The announcer mentioned my record just before I was done. I didn't even know about it until then. Jason congratulated me, and I apologised to him," he laughs.

Does Stokes feel that England can become world champions again, and in the process become only the third side to defend the title since its inception in 1975? "Everyone recognises our team's strength, and it's not boastful to admit we have a talented line-up. We're optimistic about our chances, but in World Cup matches, it's all about handling pressure."



nowdrops are one of the first signs of spring and can make a wonderful addition to any garden. Instantly recognisable by their small, white, bell-shaped flowers, snowdrops are easy to grow and will come back year after year.

WHERE TO PLANT SNOWDROPS

Snowdrops thrive in moist but well-drained soil and in partial shade. If you plant snowdrops in soil that is too dry, you risk the bulbs drying out and failing to flower. Choose to grow snowdrops beneath deciduous shrubs or along the front of borders where herbaceous plants can provide ground cover when these flowers are dormant. They also do well planted in grass, in spring border displays and in rock gardens.

HOW TO PLANT SNOWDROPS

Dry snowdrop bulbs can be planted in autumn, but these are often hard to establish. Instead, opt to plant snowdrops in the green in January or February. Simply lift snowdrop plants just after flowering and before the foliage has turned yellow, and replant somewhere else. You can buy snowdrops in the green from your local garden centre or online.

HOW TO CARE FOR SNOWDROPS

Once snowdrops are established, they require no maintenance. Allow the foliage to die back naturally as this will help to ensure that the nutrients from the leaves are returned to the bulbs. Once every two years, divide any established clumps to avoid overcrowding.

HOW TO PROPAGATE SNOWDROPS

To propagate snowdrops, lift and divide established clumps after flowering in either March or April. Using a fork, carefully lift the bulb with the roots intact and the foliage still in place. Replant in the garden immediately and water well. The foliage may appear a little sorry, but it should look healthy by next winter.

Keeping your dog SAFE IN AUTUMN

utumn is one of the best times of year for long walks with your dog, when the leaves are falling from the trees and the weather has cooled. That being said, there are lots of lurking dangers that you need to be aware of.

ACORNS: Acorns contain a toxic ingredient called tannic acid which can cause damage to your dog's liver and kidneys. When ingested, they can also lead to vomiting, diarrhoea, lethargy and abdominal pain.

CONKERS: Conker seeds boast a spiky green shell that can injure your dog's mouth if picked up and carried around. The shiny brown conker inside can be a choking hazard and, if ingested, can cause vomiting, diarrhoea and sometimes an intestinal blockage.

FALLEN FRUIT: If you take your dog on long country walks, they are highly likely to encounter fallen fruit such as apples and plums. When these fruits fall on the ground, they start to ferment and produce a natural alcoholic substance. If eaten in large quantities, this can cause vomiting and diarrhoea.

HARVEST MITES: Harvest mites are tiny red mites that tend to appear at the end of summer and into autumn. They are often found on a dog's coat, in between their toes and in their ear folds. These mites can cause extreme itching and trauma to the skin.

WILD MUSHROOMS: Wild mushrooms come in all sorts of shapes, colours and sizes, which makes it very hard to distinguish between the edible ones and those that are poisonous. If your dog eats an unknown fungus, it may cause a mild stomach upset, or it could be deadly.

SPRING BULBS: Many people plant spring bulbs in autumn, such as daffodil, tulip and spring crocus bulbs. These are all toxic to dogs and can make them very unwell if ingested.

HOW A SCOTTISH CHEMIST DEVISED A FABRIC THAT CHANGED THE COURSE OF FASHION HISTORY

A TECHNOLOGICAL MARVEL

Back in the early 19th century, there were no synthetic fibres available, and keeping clothing waterproof was a constant challenge. But Glasgow-born Charles Macintosh's innovation changed all that. He created a revolutionary material that was made by rubberising cotton cloth, making it waterproof. Macintosh patented his method, and the first 'Mac' hit the market in October 1823. His Mackintosh coat became an instant sensation, and the brand became synonymous with stylish and functional outerwear loved by workers and aristocrats alike.

STRANGE SMELLS AND MELTING COATS

Early Mackintosh coats faced a few issues - they smelled strange, the fabric was stiff, and they sometimes even melted in hot weather. Thankfully, these problems were largely solved in 1844 with the patenting of another groundbreaking innovation: the vulcanising of rubber. This chemical process made the fabric stronger and less sensitive to temperature changes.

BACK FROM THE BRINK

In the 1980s and 1990s, Mackintosh faced challenges from lightweight synthetic waterproof fabrics like Gore-Tex. However, a management buyout in the mid-1990s breathed new life into the brand. It also reclaimed its status as an upmarket brand. collaborating with prestigious fashion houses like Louis Vuitton.

THE MAKING OF A MACKINTOSH

To this day, the coats are still handmade in Cumbernauld, near Glasgow, using a fabric that's very similar to Macintosh's original. Skilled craftsmen and women cut, sew and seal the material by hand, using special rubber-based glue. Each seam is also taped to ensure the coats are 100 per cent waterproof.

Now owned by Japanese firm Yagi Tsusho, the Mackintosh has weathered the storms of fashion and remains a symbol of British style and innovation. If you want one, you'll need to start saving now; a classic trench coat will set you back almost £1,000.

BAD SPORTSMANSHIP:

ERICCANTONA

WW fith true skill, finesse and regular glimpses of genius, when Eric Cantona was good, he was very good. Yet the Frenchman was tainted with a self-destructive element that permeated his game. Cantona was ever the mercurial talent, and was an iconic figure for Manchester United during the club's early glory years under Sir Alex Ferguson CBE.

From the outset of his career, Cantona's undoubted flair was plainly evident, yet so too was his lack of composure.

During a match in 1988 between his club, Auxerre, and Nantes, the Marseille-born forward kung fu kicked Michel Der Zakarian, landing him a three-month ban which was later reduced after the club threatened to withdraw him from French national team selection.

As it would turn out, this would not be an isolated incident. A string of other disciplinary issues in France prompted a move to England, with Leeds United the beneficiaries as they clinched the final First

title before the inception of the Premier League in 1992. A tempestuous time at Elland Road then saw him move to hated rivals Manchester United for a cut price £1.25million. Talent and turbulence would continue at Old Trafford, but never more so than one night in January 1995 in South East London. BRISK WALKING

If you are overweight and have high blood pressure, you may not be able to undergo a vigorous workout regime. Fortunately, studies have shown that multiple short

sessions of brisk walking can be as effective at lowering blood pressure as high-intensity exercises. Aim for three 10-minute walks each day.

SWIMMING

A great form of aerobic exercise, swimming is a good option for older adults and those who require a low-impact fitness regime. For best results, aim for 45 minutes of continuous swimming four or five times per week. Don't worry if you cannot manage 45 minutes right away, as you can gradually build up your fitness and endurance levels.

DANCING

If you get bored easily and like to have fun when working out, then you will be pleased to hear that dancing is a great form

of exercise for people with high blood pressure. Another effective form of aerobic exercise, aim for at least 30 minutes a day, five times per week.

HIKING

For those who like a bit more of a challenge and love the great outdoors, hiking is the physical activity for you. Guaranteed to get your heart rate up and help you lose any excess weight, there are lots of beautiful hiking spots in the UK. This physical pastime has been shown to lower blood pressure by up to 10 points.

RESISTANCE TRAINING

Resistance training can be added to your workout routine to further help with reducing blood pressure. This type of training can be done less frequently than cardio exercises; movements such as squats, push-ups, planks and abdominal crunches should be carried out two or three times a week. For anyone less mobile or who doesn't want to use weights, resistance bands are a good choice as they will not put your body under as much pressure.

Incy wincy Spider

alloween provides the perfect opportunity for you to get crafty with your kids, and this spooky spiderweb doesn't disappoint. Suitable for little ones and older children alike, discover how to make your very own salt and glue spiderweb craft below.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Black paper or card | A pencil | A ruler | PVC or Elmer's glue | Table salt | Watercolour paints | A soft brush

HOW TO MAKE: Draw your spiderweb

design: Your child can do this by hand themselves, depending on their age and ability, using a pencil or ruler, or you can help them with this step. Alternatively, you could print out a spiderweb template to use.

Prace the shape with glue: The next step is to trace glue along each line of your spiderweb. Again, young children may need help with this if they want to achieve a good spiderweb shape. To make the glue lines as smooth as possible, do not allow the tip of the glue bottle to touch the paper but instead, hover slightly above it.

3 Cover the spiderweb with salt: Fill a ramekin or small bowl with table salt and then use two fingers to pinch the salt and sprinkle it over the glue. Make sure that you cover each line and curve with enough salt. Leave the glue to fully dry, ideally overnight, before moving on to the next step.

4 Paint your spiderweb: Now comes the really exciting part: adding colour to your spiderweb. Watercolour paints are perfect for this as they spread well on dried glue and salt. Using a soft brush, plenty of water and your chosen watercolours, add a drop or two of colour to a salt line. Use a light touch and do not scrub as this may dissolve your spiderweb.

MAKE A HANGING SPIDERWEB

Take your craft to the next level by applying the glue and the paint, minus the salt, to a thin plastic sheet, gently peel it off and then fix it to your preferred surface using sticky glue dots or hang around the room with string. Make sure you allow the glue to fully dry before peeling.

Regardless of your thoughts on the controversial expansion of London's Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ), there is a wide selection of cars out there ready to help you bypass this expensive charge.

The extension of ULEZ to encompass the whole of Greater London became operational at the end of August, and not without considerable objection.

Now, petrol vehicles must meet Euro 4 standards, with even tighter Euro 6 requirements for their diesel cousins.

MOTORING

Entering the ULEZ with a non-conforming vehicle invites a daily charge of £12.50, so Mayor of London Sadiq Khan's £2,000 grant for Greater London residents looking to change to a ULEZ-compliant motor is appealing, as are some of the cars that fit the criteria.

For instance, for those desiring a premium touch, the Mercedes-Benz

A-Class hatchback is a worthy contender, boasting advanced technology and a luxurious interior. Models from 2013 hover around the £10,000 mark.

The widely admired Ford Focus has numerous ULEZ-compliant variants. One with fewer than 50,000

miles could be yours for less than £6,000. Or what about the iconic Mazda MX-5? The Japanese brand is revered for superb driving experience and affordability. However, look out for some older versions, as these may not meet ULEZ requirements.

Lastly, the VW Polo, particularly the 1.2 TDI BlueMotion edition of the Mk5, is famously fuel-efficient, boasting up to 91.1mpg on motorways and 67.3mpg in urban settings. With no emission zone charges and some high-mileage models available at under £4,000, it's a sound option.

While virtually all petrol cars sold after 2005 are ULEZ compliant – along with petrol vans after 2006 and motorbikes registered after July 2007 – it ultimately pays to check your vehicle, as well as the status of a potential new one, online at tfl.gov.uk/modes/driving/check-your-vehicle
