# SPECULATE TO ACCUMULATE

FROM FLAMETHROWERS TO SPACE ADVENTURE TO TWITTER, ELON MUSK CONTINUES TO REWRITE THE RULE BOOK

e is a tech entrepreneur, an eco exemplar and an ambassador for how we might, as people, forge a future that combines function with fun.

Despite all his innovation – with Tesla and SpaceX particularly, but also across other projects – Elon's is a name to which we have really only become accustomed in the last decade or so.

Tesla, the brand, was incorporated in 2003, yet even after seven years only 5,000 of its vehicles were on the road. The total is now 200 times that, with the two-millionth car set to roll out of the factory this summer. While Musk – who dropped out of Stanford University after just two days – is most renowned for the electric car revolution that promises to define us as motorists across the next generation, his exploration of space through SpaceX, the space vehicle, rocket and communications business, is just as big an achievement.

However, in April, as if yielding the power over the way we explore the world geographically wasn't enough, Musk made perhaps his biggest move yet, reinforcing his icy grip on the digital world with a buyout of Twitter that now sees the 50 year old as an overarching power of social media. Not only is he putting his and investors' money – some \$44billion – behind the acquisition, he also intends to run it himself, which spells trouble for the current incumbents who have frequently been criticised for sidelining those whose political and social walk use don't fit

and social values don't fit.

His move to take over the controversial platform is a shot in the arm for free speech, in an era where the entrepreneur admits he has become tired of cancel culture. While Twitter is arguably his biggest project yet, the South Africa-born entrepreneur has sought out countless other initiatives - from creating and selling his own computer game at age 12, to launching SolarCity, which grew to become the second-biggest provider of solar power systems in the US. Then there was Neuralink, his move into integrating the human brain with artificial intelligence; plus The Boring Company, which digs tunnel systems, and through which he manufactured and sold 2,000 novelty flamethrowers, as inspired by Mel Brooks in the 1987 movie Spaceballs. He has even released music in the rap and dance genres. The fact that Musk is rapidly ascending to a personal fortune topping \$300billion is by virtue of an intense entrepreneurial mind that spreads opportunity and investment across a range of projects. His commitment to Tesla and SpaceX only came about because he'd sold previous start-up Zip2 to HP, and merged his X.com business with PavPal (which led to a payout of \$180million when the money operator was bought by eBay).

As a phrase, 'speculate to accumulate' has never seemed more apt than when applied to the journey taken by Elon Musk, and those supposing his dynamic sideways step into social media is the last piece of the jigsaw would probably do well to think again.

## HOW TO RECOGNISE IF YOUR DRINK HAS BEEN SPIKED AND HOW TO PREVENT IT FROM HAPPENING

hen you go out, can you honestly say that you watch your drink at all times? Spiking is currently at high levels in the UK and can happen to anyone.

Find out how to recognise the signs of spiking and what to do if you think your drink has been spiked below.

WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMONLY USED ILLEGAL DRUGS TO SPIKE DRINKS? The most common illegal drugs used to spike drinks are GHB, ketamine and benzodiazepines such as valium and rohypnol.

HOW TO RECOGNISE IF A DRINK HAS BEEN SPIKED

- 1. It has a foggy appearance
- 2. It has excessive bubbles
- 3. The ice sinks to the bottom
- 4. A change in colour

It is important to know that some of the most regularly used drugs to spike drinks do not produce a smell or taste, meaning it can be difficult to know if your drink has been spiked until it is too late.

## THE MOST COMMON SYMPTOMS OF SOMEONE WHO HAS HAD THEIR DRINK SPIKED ARE...

Dizziness | Difficulty walking | Confusion the next day | Nausea or vomiting | Hallucinations | Tiredness | Blurred vision | Paranoia | Amnesia

## WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK YOU'VE BEEN SPIKED

If you think your drink has been spiked, stop drinking it. Tell someone you trust as soon as possible as spiking substances can take effect very quickly. Be wary of asking strangers for help and instead, if you are alone, seek out security or venue staff. If you need urgent help, call 999 and tell them you think you may have been drugged.

## HOW TO PREVENT YOUR DRINK BEING SPIKED

- > Do not leave your drink unattended
- > Invest in anti-spiking lids from StopTopps, available from stoptopps.com
- > Do not accept drinks from strangers
- > Be vigilant of changes to your drink
- > Don't drink anyone else's drink.

atthew Williamson, by his own admission, doesn't perhaps have a name that screams 'style, exuberance and panache', and considering this is someone who grew up in the murky confines of 1970s Manchester, there was no indication of the creative elevation that was to come. And yet, in art just as in physics, equal and inspiration from very simple ripples of provenance. That is certainly the case with Williamson, who for more than two decades now has specialised in the wonder of colour.

He is an interior designer of great originality and acclaim, as his recent work with John Lewis determines. He is someone whose passion for colour, aesthetics and design was catalysed by his mother, but who has taken those principles to another level of optimism.

"If you're going to use colour, you have to be an optimist," he says. "You have to look at the beauty

of contrast and the potency of the shades and tones you put together.

"There is no point being afraid of trying things, and you should never enter a project imagining something isn't going to work. Only by trying will you know, and only through knowledge can you grow.

"Of course, it's about mixing up tones, but also enabling a background to act as a template for the colour detail you want to layer on top."

Replicating Williamson's colour-driven style of interior design is no easy task. It has, after all, taken the designer the best part of half a century to refine an interior design ethos that even he admits is still a work in progress. But the Central Saint Martins graduate insists the way to use colour is to follow vour smile.

"If it makes you happy, it's working. If it paints pictures and provokes memories and inspires in you ideas to move forward, then you probably have what

# GUIDE TO CLEANING PAINTED WALLS

here is nothing worse than noticing a dirty mark or stain on a freshly painted wall. Keep your painted walls looking fresh and fabulous for longer

## HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

- 1 Dust off any excess dirt using a lint-free cloth or a soft broom for hard-to-reach areas.
- 2. Fill a bucket with warm water and a gentle detergent.
- **5.** Apply to the walls using a sponge mop or soft sponge.
- 4. Do not oversoak your sponge or mop as this can result in water stains.
- 5. Leave the solution for 10-15 minutes.
- 6. Rinse with clean water and a sponge or mop.
- 7. Dry by placing a microfibre cloth onto a flat-headed mop and gently rubbing over the wall.

## HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED KITCHEN WALLS

Painted walls in the kitchen are prone to grease. To combat this, apply a gentle degreaser to any affected areas before following the same steps as above.

## HOW TO SPOT CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

To get rid of small stains or marks on your painted walls, apply a mixture of water and baking soda or bicarbonate of soda to the affected area using a soft cloth or towel. Half a cup of baking soda or bicarb in a bucket of warm water will do the trick.

## HOW TO REMOVE OIL STAINS FROM PAINTED WALLS

- 1. Mix one cup of white wine vinegar into a bucket of warm water.
- 2. Soak a soft sponge and apply to the stain.
- 3. Rub gently until the stain has disappeared.
- 4. You do not need to rinse the area.

## WHAT NOT TO USE

You should not clean your painted walls with any cleaning products that contain alcohol or harsh chemicals, as these ingredients can break down your paint surfaces and leave your walls looking a mess.

# CHINTZ is making a comeback ME

I f you're a millennial or younger, you'd be forgiven for not knowing the word chintz. Often regarded as a dated decor trend, you'll be more likely to see it in your grandmother's house than on Instagram or Pinterest. But could chintz be making a comeback?

## WHAT IS CHINTZ?

Chintz has a very long and fascinating history. It's a cotton textile dating to 4,000 years ago, originating in the Indus Valley between India and Pakistan. Made using a specialist dye method, chintz fabrics typically feature colourful floral designs. As the fabrics were traded around the world, they soon found their way into home textiles, made popular in more recent times by designers such as William Morris.

## WHERE DID IT GO?

In more recent times, chintz was seen as a dated fabric, and it has been declining in popularity since the 1980s. IKEA caused a stir in the 1990s by encouraging people to "chuck out your chintz" in favour of its own interior products, based around simple details and block colours.

For a long time, neutrals have reigned supreme, but now chintz is starting to reappear. This time around, colours are bolder and brighter and patterns are even more lavish.

## BRINGING CHINTZ INTO YOUR HOME

There are a lot of great ways to bring chintz into your home, including:

DENTURE TABLETS

enture tablets can be used to clean so much more than just your dentures. Discover five surprising uses for denture tablets below and you may be tempted to buy some – even if you have all your teeth.

**1. TO CLEAN YOUR KETTLE:** Mineral deposits can quickly build up in your kettle, which can cause your hot beverages to taste less than their best. To combat this, fill your kettle with water, drop in a denture tablet and allow to soak for a few hours. Follow with a good scrub and a thorough rinse.

2. TO REMOVE HARD WATER STAINS: If you are struggling to remove the hard water stains from your toilet bowl, then denture tablets offer the perfect solution. Simply drop in a few tablets, wait for the fizzing to stop and then scrub the bowl using your toilet brush.

3. TO ELIMINATE BURNT FOOD FROM PANS: For times when soaking just isn't enough, add a denture tablet to your sink or a bowl of warm water, drop in your pan and leave to soak for 15-20 minutes. Give the pan a gentle

scrub and the burnt food should slide right off. Do not use denture tablets on cast-iron pans.

**4. TO RESTORE SHINE TO GLASSWARE:** If you find that your glasses often look cloudy after washing, then a denture tablet is all you need to restore them to their original glory. Fill the glass with water, drop in a denture tablet, wait for the fizzing to stop, and rinse.

5. TO BANISH TOMATO STAINS: If you batch cook or take leftovers for lunch, you will know how hard it is to remove tomato stains from plastic containers. Banish these stubborn stains for good by filling the container with water, dropping in a denture tablet and leaving to soak overnight. Come morning, all you need to do is rinse.

## A GUIDE TO HELP YOU DECIDE WHEN YOU SHOULDN'T USE YOUR VACUUM WHEN CLEANING

Some people love vacuuming; others can't stand it. Either way, there is no denying how quickly it can clean up your home.

However, did you know that there are some items that you should never hoover up?

## PIECES OF GLASS

If you have smashed a glass, then you may reach for your vacuum cleaner to quickly clear the area. However, large pieces of glass can puncture the bag, get stuck in the hose and damage the interior. Instead, use a dustpan and brush for the large pieces and a damp cloth to pick up small shards. Be sure to wear gloves to protect your hands.

## **FINE DUST**

Have you recently renovated your home? If yes, then your furniture is probably covered in dust particles. Sadly, you should not hoover these up as sanding residue and other tiny particles will clog the filters and cause your hoover to spit dust back into the air.

## WET FOOD

Wet food, or anything wet or moist, should not be cleaned up with a vacuum cleaner. This includes soggy cereal, dog food and even small spills. Instead, use some kitchen towels or a tea towel.

## SMALL METAL ITEMS

Small metal items such as paper clips and coins can easily become stuck in the rotating part of your vacuum cleaner and stop it from working properly. They can also sometimes break off plastic pieces from the interior of your appliance.

## MAKE-UP

Dropped an eyeshadow palette on the carpet? Or some foundation? Although you may be tempted to use your hoover, this is not a good idea. Firstly, the vacuum brush could smear the make-up further into the carpet, and secondly, if you do manage to successfully clean it up, it is highly likely to melt once inside the appliance.

Chelmsford residents helped raise thousands of pounds for charity through a recent cycling event. More than 800 cyclists took part in the Ride for Helen Essex at Crix in Hatfield Peverel on Sunday, May 15, raising a total of £36,000 for the Helen Rollason Cancer Charity, which is dedicated to supporting those whose lives have been affected by cancer.

There was a choice of cycling routes on offer, ranging from six to 65 miles, allowing both experienced cyclists and youngsters to take part.

Terry Green, 72 (pictured inset), and his grandson Harvey, 13, both from Chelmsford, took part in the 15-mile route.

Terry said: "Many years ago, I purchased a tandem, which at the time I thought was a good idea. One trip around the block and my wife declared never again. So the tandem sat forlorn in the garage. Over the years, the grandchildren have looked at it but none were big enough or enthusiastic enough, until now."

Charlotte Ruston, 23, of Chelmsford, took part in the event alongside 40 of her family members in memory of her father, Neil Ruston, who sadly passed away earlier this year.

Speaking on the day of the ride, Charlotte said: "We have been blown away by the incredible support of everyone here today. Mum and I know my dad would be looking down watching over us, so proud we have completed our ride in his memory."

The event was also attended by former Mayor of Chelmsford, Jude Deakin (pictured fourth from right), who gave out medals to riders and chatted with volunteers and staff about the charity and its services.

Police were called to reports of the incident in Stock Road, Galleywood, at 5.15pm on Friday, May 20.


The victim was taken to hospital but his injuries are not thought to be life-changing or life-threatening.



Recycling our waste and unwanted objects is a way we can all participate in making a difference to the environment. I recently went to the centre in Chelmsford run by Essex County Council to learn more about what happens to the different items and materials that the public bring for disposal. With 12,000 visitors every month, this is a huge task. The council has recently decided to end its contract with an external company and bring the running of these sites back 'in house'. This will save taxpayers' money.

I also recently visited the site where a new country park is proposed near Sandford Mill, where a local resident who is a keen ornithologist has been monitoring the bird life for many years. It is home to many different species of birds and animals, a number of which are on the red list for species that are under threat.

Another visit was with our Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner, Roger Hirst, to see the work that has been done to improve safety on the Bunny Walks in Chelmsford. Last year, when the government announced new funding for Safer Streets, I encouraged Roger to look at whether Chelmsford

could benefit from this funding. He then coordinated a huge number of partners to put together the bid, which has led to more than \$500,000 being invested in safety in Chelmsford.

# Anti-bleed kit donated to pub

A woman whose grandson was killed in a stabbing has brought her Aanti-knife campaign to Chelmsford by donating a special antibleed kit to a local pub.

Julie Taylor (pictured inset) donated the kit to The Garrison Tavern on the High Street, where staff and customers have been campaigning for The Liam Taylor Legacy, set up by Julie in memory of her grandson.

Liam was 19 when he died in a stabbing in Writtle in January 2020. Three men were jailed for a combined total of 58-and-a-half years for his murder.

The Liam Taylor Legacy aims to raise money to buy defibrillators, as well as to distribute anti-bleed kits which are funded by the Daniel Baird Foundation, set up by Daniel's mother, Lynne, after his fatal stabbing in Birmingham in July 2017.

The kits contain tourniquets, bandages and chest seals to stop catastrophic bleeding. Kits have also been presented to bars and schools in Brentwood, Maldon and Braintree.

The boy was taken to hospital with bruising and swelling but was released later that day.


The driver of the Nissan has been described as a





## Police arrest 16 people during popular festival

South Festival in Chelmsford earlier this month.

In the run-up to the festival, which took place from June 2 to 4, Essex Police worked with the organisers, Festival Republic, and Chelmsford City Council, Essex County Fire & Rescue Service, British Transport Police and East of England Ambulance Service.

Policing plans included intelligence checks to disrupt drug activity and disorder, roads policing operations to deal with drug and drink driving, and officers stationed outside to address any antisocial behaviour.

While Festival Republic was responsible for safety

and security at the festival, the police also had a small hub within the venue to allow officers to detain offenders ahead of any requirement for them to be taken to a custody suite.

Officers arrested people on suspicion of offences related to drugs, theft, offences under the Public Order Act, sexual assault and assault.

Superintendent Nick Morris said: "I would like to thank my officers and staff for their hard work in helping to make our policing plans a success. I would like to also praise our partners and Festival Republic in helping to ensure this festival was a safe one."

# **Members of drug gang** jailed for more than 40 years

Members of a drugs gang, including two men from Chelmsford, have been jailed for a combined total of more than 40 years.

The lines had initially been disrupted by the 2020 conviction of Rowan Brown (pictured top left), who was sentenced to five-and-a-half years for the supply of class A drugs. However, Brown was continuing to run the line from his jail cell, with the help of others.

Eight members of the network pleaded guilty to two counts of conspiracy to supply crack cocaine and heroin and were sentenced at Chelmsford Crown Court on Friday, May 6.

Brown was sentenced to 11 years in prison, which he will serve consecutively to his original sentence.

Amy Goldfinch (pictured top centre), 28, of Church Road, London, was sentenced to nine years in prison. Peter Okunzuwa (pictured top right), 32, of Lea Bridge Road, Hackney, was sentenced to six years and nine months in prison.

Dejah Henriques (pictured bottom left), 23, of Digby Road, Hackney, was sentenced to seven years and six months in prison, while Tony Wilde (pictured bottom centre), 55, of Widford Park Place, Chelmsford, received a sentence of 48 months' imprisonment.

Keith Webb (pictured bottom right), 51, of St Marys Mead, Chelmsford, was sentenced to 21 months in prison. Susan Poulton, 40, of Cromwell Close, Boreham, received a 36-month community order and was made the subject of a 12-hour daily curfew. Faith Divine-Mark, 22, of Brook Drive, London, was jailed for 21 months, suspended for two years.

Kevaughn Henriques, 20, of Amersham Avenue, London, who admitted two counts of conspiracy to supply crack cocaine and heroin, and Tonae Reid, 28, of Handel Walk, Colchester, who admitted money laundering, are yet to be sentenced.

ake a look at your mobile phone and, if you're in one of the UK's bigger towns or cities at the time, you may see the 5G symbol in the top-right corner (providing

# 40 years since the FALKLANDS WAR

## A LOOK BACK ON THE FALKLANDS WAR, WHICH ENDED IN JUNE 1982

he commencement of the Falklands War, when Argentina landed on the small island situated 500 miles from its lower-east coast, represented more than simply a country looking to reclaim what it thought it rightfully owned.

On the face of it, that was Argentina's ploy. The Falklands, a modest 4,700 square miles, comprising little more than rocky terrain, cliffs, birdlife and cattle, had been appropriated by the British back in 1765.

Within five years, a Spanish commander from Buenos Aires landed with five ships and 1,400 troops to claim possession of the land. And that remained the case until 1883, when the British returned.

The constant power struggle has raged on, though when Argentina relit the blue and white striped touchpaper in 1982 with severe territorial aggression, it surprised many.

A deeper explanation, away from the geographical claims and disputes, lay in the political situation in Argentina, and the economic

struggles that besieged South America in the 1980s.

The three-man military junta that had assumed power in Argentina in 1976 had evolved over the years, and as it looked to build support and legitimacy by claiming a territory that still held considerable emotional ties to the Argentine people, seizing the Falklands was a clever political move.

On April 2, Argentina invaded, kicking off just over two months of conflict, where the British, led by Margaret Thatcher, responded with air, sea and land attacks. A series of bloody battles raged, with the Battle of Goose Green perhaps the most famous.

Finally, on June 14, Argentina surrendered after British troops yomped across punishing terrain, arriving at East Falkland to find their enemy waving white flags.

While conflict ceased, the ongoing antagonisation between Argentina and the UK (and England in particular) has continued, mostly in sporting rivalries.





## Bees/Wasps Danger rating: 3/5

With a wasp sting, a raised welt will appear around the site and you may feel itching, burning and a sharp pain. A severe allergic reaction to a bee or wasp sting can be life-threatening.

## Fleas Danger rating: 1/5

Flea bites are instantly recognisable by an itchy welt on the skin which is surrounded by a red halo. These are often found in clusters on the ankles and legs.

## Mosquitos Danger rating: 2/5

Mosquitos leave a raised, itchy, pink skin bump. You may find you have multiple bites in the same area. In rare cases, someone may experience a serious allergic reaction.

## Spiders Danger rating: 4/5

Most spider bites cause minor symptoms, such as red skin, swelling and pain at the site. However, some spiders found in the UK are venomous and their bites can cause nausea, vomiting, dizziness and/or sweating. Spider bites can also become infected or cause a severe reaction in some cases that requires immediate medical care.

## Ticks Danger rating: 3/5

If you are bitten by a tick, you may notice a red bite, a rash, itching and burning. Around two per cent of tick bites cause Lyme disease, which can result in fever, fatigue and rashes.

For every pound you spend, you are paid a percentage back by the card provider. Typical rates are one per cent, but bigger rewards and other initiatives are available if you shop around.

## WHEN CASHBACK CREDIT CARDS WORK

Cashback credit cards should only be used for things you are going to buy anyway, and never as a method for justifying a purchase because it in effect offers a small discount.

Consider your ability to clear the credit card balance, too – if what you're putting on a card is going to be paid off, then there's no reason not to sign up to a cashback deal... providing you only buy

things you'd be equally happy to purchase for cash.

The harsh reality is lenders will quickly tap into the psychology of people not only getting money back on a purchase, but also not having to pay for 30 days or more, and that leads to treating ourselves when there's little justification, and making expensive purchases that we may come to regret. To

ensure you are clearing the balance, consider setting up a direct debit.

## WHEN CASHBACK CREDIT CARDS DON'T WORK

If you're not clearing your balance each month, or you pay an annual fee for your card, the amount you will pay will very likely wipe out the cashback earned on your card, making it a false economy. Explore the various rates and do the maths.

A cashback credit card needs to be handled by someone who is regimented, knows their numbers and can exercise self-control. Many of us just aren't configured that way... and if that's you, steer clear.

## **Rosemary oil**

To make rosemary-infused oil, pour 2 cups of olive oil into a small pan and allow to simmer. Remove from the heat and add 3-4 dry sprigs of rosemary. Pour into a sterilised jar and cover with a lid.

## Rosemary sugar syrup

Rosemary sugar syrup can be drizzled over cakes, yogurt or fresh fruit for a sweet and fragrant twist. Bring 1 cup of water to the boil and add 2 cups of sugar and 3-4 sprigs of rosemary. Once the sugar has dissolved, remove from the heat and take out the rosemary. Pour into a sterilised jar.

## **Rosemary lemonade**

To make refreshing rosemary lemonade, simply bring 2½ cups of sugar to a boil, remove from the heat and add 9 sprigs of rosemary. Leave to steep for 30 minutes and strain. Add ½ cup of fresh lemon juice and 4 cups of cold water. Chill and serve over ice on its own or with your favourite gin.

## **Rosemary butter**

Soften a stick of butter (but don't melt it) and blend with rosemary leaves that have been removed from the stem and diced into small pieces. Slather on crackers, bread, meat or fish.



## AS THE WEATHER HEATS UP, MAKE SURE YOU DO YOUR BIT FOR LOCAL WILDLIFE

The temperature is hotting up, and while most of us welcome these sunnier days, the same isn't always true for our community critters. The good news is that there are a lot of things you can do for wildlife in the hot weather to help keep them safe from the sun.

Provide fresh water: Spells without rain can mean that a lot of natural water sources have dried up for your garden visitors. Putting out some fresh water will help thirsty animals and insects. Keep it shallow and put some rocks in there to help insects get out if they fall in.

Put in a bird bath: A bird bath is a great way for birds to keep clean and cool. You can buy them at garden centres and other retailers, or you could make your own as a fun DIY project. Fill UP UPUT fttdtr: Birds can find it tough to find food when the ground is dry and worms are scarce. Keep your bird feeder topped up and put out some fruit, such as apples and soaked raisins, for animals on the ground.

**Create Shaded Spots**: Animals may struggle to find shade on a hot day, but you can help by putting logs, large rocks or wooden planks around your garden to help create shade.

Ktcp your pond topped up: Remember to keep an eye on your pond and top it up if needed. This will help any fish that you have, as well as other visitors who use your pond as a water source.

These simple steps will make a big difference to your local wildlife.

## BRITAIN'S GREATEST SPORTING MOMENTS.

## **B®RG AND MCENR●E**

ach month we look at one of the most significant events in British sporting history. This month, it's the epic encounter between Björn Borg and John McEnroe at Wimbledon on July 5, 1980.

The Championships at Wimbledon have provided countless dramatic sporting memories over the years, and none more special than when British heroes of the ilk of Ann Jones and Andy Murray have lifted the coveted trophy.

Yet perhaps the most remarkable encounter – certainly for sheer blood, guts, aggression and an unrelenting desire for victory – came in 1980 when a Swede faced an American.

Björn Borg had long been painted as the iceman, a Scandinavian purveyor of perfect tennis who was clinical and elegant in his despatching of opponents. John McEnroe, meanwhile, was the sweaty, unkempt brat of the game, with a confrontational, aggressive game and a temperament to match.

That they collided so spectacularly on that sunny Saturday afternoon on July 5 will go down in SW19 folklore. McEnroe gained the upper hand by winning the opening exchange 6-1, before Borg fought back with 7-5 and 6-3 sets, giving him a 2-1 lead.

Looking to close out the match in the fourth set, Borg had five Championship points in an epic that went well past any reasonably expected distance. Finally, in the 34th game of the set, McEnroe broke the reigning champion – who was looking to win a fifth successive title – and took it 18-16.

Even in the deciding set, the duelling athletes made it to 6-6, though this time Borg broke McEnroe's steely serve, and his resolve, to take the set 8-6, and with it the Wimbledon title.

# HAND OF WA

## DIEGO MARADONA'S ICONIC HAND OF GOD SHIRT SELLS AT AUCTION

Ihen England midfielder Steve Hodge swapped shirts with Argentina double-goalscorer Diego Maradona at the end of the World Cup quarter-final at the Estadio Azteca in Mexico in 1986, he was derided by fans, sections of the press and even his own teammates.

The Argentine wizard had just knocked the Three Lions out of the World Cup with a Jekyll and Hyde display of sporting brilliance and brazen opportunism - one of the best goals ever scored at a World Cup, coming minutes after the Hand of God goal that we've all seen replayed hundreds of times.

In swapping shirts, to some, Hodge crossed the line.

Wind forward three-and-a-half decades, and Hodge has the last laugh, after that prized number 10 shirt recently sold at auction for more than £7.1million.

Perhaps one of the most iconic items of sporting memorabilia - the value of which soared after Maradona's death in November 2020 - the shirt made almost twice its guide price, and was sold to someone from Abu Dhabi with links to Manchester City.

The Sotheby's auction process had all the usual twists and turns befitting of Maradona's life. In the lead-up to its sale, the infamous star's family insisted that the shirt was a fake, supposing that the striker swapped shirts at half-time during the game on June 22, 1986, and that Hodge

was in fact in possession of the shirt worn in the first half. In addition, a late plea materialised from an Argentinian delegation for the

shirt to be returned to South America. The group failed with its own bid \$1.111.01 as the auction price rocketed, though the request remains to display the shirt in Buenos Aires in October, for what would have been Maradona's 62nd birthday.

The sale price mirrors the previous record for any sports memorabilia - the original autographed manuscript of the Olympic Manifesto from 1892, sold by Sotheby's in December 2019.

# CLEAN YOUR CAR

THERE IS NOTHING LIKE THE LOOK OF A CLEAN CAR. HOWEVER, IT TAKES MORE THAN JUST A BUCKET OF WATER AND AN OLD RAG TO ACHIEVE A SHOWROOM FINISH



Always carry out a pre-wash This is one of the most important tricks of the trade – any professional car washer worth their salt will remove as much dirt as possible using a hose or jet wash before they start to use their hands to clean a vehicle. This is because both dirt and grime can drag along the exterior and damage the paintwork.

## Use multiple buckets

You should always have two buckets to hand, one that contains your washing solution (ideally you should use car shampoo) and one filled with water for rinsing. It is also advisable to use a grit guard to catch the dirt.

## Invest in a wash mitt

Although you can use a large sponge and still achieve a good finish, if you want optimum results,

you need to invest in a wash mitt. Typically made from lamb's wool or microfibre, these are much less likely to leave surface scratches as the deep and fluffy fabric absorbs the dirt better than a sponge.

**Do not leave to dry naturally** Never leave your car to dry naturally. Instead, use a purpose-built blower, or even a leaf blower, or a triple-layered microfibre cloth to dry your car.

## Avoid extreme heat and direct sunlight

Although you may think that the ideal time to wash your car is when the sun is shining, this is actually not the case. Not only will you have to work harder and faster as your car will dry quicker than normal, but extreme heat can affect the strength of the chemicals in the products you are using. Instead, wash early in the morning or after 5pm.
