VOICE OF FOOTBALL JOHN MOTSON OBE

n occasion, sports commentators can be more famous than the very stars they report on. John Motson OBE ascended to such a level – larger than life in the best sense, instantly recognisable by sight or voice, and arguably the most iconic football reporter the country has ever produced. His death in February may have saddened the nation, but his legacy lives on.

"Oh, what a goal! What a goal! Radford the scorer. Ronnie Radford! And the crowd... the crowd are invading the pitch..."

These are the magical words that John Motson uttered as Hereford United legend Ronnie Radford – who himself passed away just three months before Motty – thundered an equaliser into the top corner, on a quagmire of a pitch, in an FA Cup third round reply against Newcastle United in February 1972.

The Salford-born Motson has since described this as the moment he put himself on the map at the BBC, as those in power quickly pushed a three-year contract his way and promoted him to their commentary team for high-profile matches.

Motty's contribution to English and international football folklore past that point is mesmerising. He covered 29 FA Cup finals, 10 FIFA World Cups, 10 UEFA European Championships, and more than 200 England national team matches.

Motson's first work with the BBC was as a sports presenter on Radio 2, in 1968. He stepped up for his first radio commentary game a year later, in December 1969, as World Cup winner Alan Ball scored the only goal in Everton's victory over Derby County at Goodison Park.

"It felt like the start of something big for me," Motty said in a recent interview, "and really it was my absolute dream to be commentating on football.

"Whether it was Wembley in front of 90,000 or a non-league game in front of a few hundred, the pleasure was in covering every shot, every run, every pass. I do believe I have been so, so lucky."

While fans can reel off Motty's commentary to accompany special moments for their respective sides, there were darker moments in the broadcaster's career too. Indeed, on April 15, 1989, during an FA Cup semi-final between Liverpool and Nottingham Forest, Motson had to draw upon professionalism and humanitarianism, while keeping his emotions intact, as the horrific events of Hillsborough unfolded in front of him. He later appeared as a witness at the Hillsborough inquiry.

While his own club allegiances were kept secret for much of his professional career – which also branched out into radio commentary for BBC 5 Live and talkSPORT – Motty actually revealed in his book that he was a Chelsea fan.

"When I got to *Match of the Day* in 1971, Chelsea was my first commentary. Somehow, my Chelsea loyalties were pushed into the background, as I always wanted to be unbiased and neutral.

"I deliberately avoided answering honestly when someone enquired who I supported. 'Barnet' was my usual response!"

Motson, who was famous for his sheepskin coat, had an encyclopaedic knowledge of the game, and always carried with him his own self-penned book of statistics relating to the clubs he was covering.

He passed away peacefully on February 23, 2023, aged 77 years old, thus concluding more than half a decade of exemplary service.

The influence he had over the modern game has been immense, and will continue to be even after his passing.

MEET THE MIGHTY TITANOSAUR

magine coming face-to-face with a creature four times as long as a London bus and weighing as much as 15 African elephants.

Sadly, the colossal titanosaur that meets this description, probably the largest-ever land creature, died out about 66 million years ago. But from March 31, the Patagotitan mayorum will be displayed in Europe for the first time at London's Natural History Museum.

So what can you expect to see? For starters, you can walk beneath the spectacular titanosaur cast, moulded from the most complete fossil specimen ever discovered. But there's so much more to this interactive exhibition than that.

While you're gawping in awe at the Patagotitan, you can also check out the plants and animals that were around at the time by admiring the surrounding illustrations. And you can follow the life history of a titanosaur on film, from its birth from a football-sized egg to a fully grown adult.

You can also handle fossil specimens, stare into the creature's giant skull, measure yourself against its massive thigh bone, and even smell its poo.

The original Patagotitan fossil consists of bones from seven creatures, found in the same area just nine years ago. It all began when an Argentinian farmer spotted his lost sheep on an odd-looking rocky ledge. Dinosaur finds in the area aren't rare, so he called the scientists in to get their thoughts. The rocky ridge turned out to be a thigh bone of a new species – the biggest dinosaur ever.

Life as the Biggest Dinosaur is open from March 31, 2023, till January 7, 2024, at the Waterhouse Gallery, National History Museum, South Kensington. The exhibition is suitable for children aged five and over. Tickets cost £16 for adults and £9 for children. Concessions and family tickets are available.

orget weird little pompom creatures with googly eyes.; these fuzzy balls of fun have just got a whole lot cooler.

Pompoms have been decorating the tops of hats for centuries; even Vikings wore them. More recently, they've been spotted on the hats of soldiers, sailors, priests, and all manner of berets and beanies.

How To make.

Traditionally, pompoms are made using two cardboard circles.

- For a 6cm diameter pompom, draw and cut out two cardboard circles, each 5.5cm diameter.
- Then draw and cut a section out of the circles and cut a 2cm hole in the
- Place the two circles together.
- Using long lengths of yarn, feed your yarn through the centre hole and wrap all the way around the edges of the circles and back up. Continue till the hole is nearly full.
 - Break the yarn, then push your scissors between the two circles from the outside edge and cut through the varn all the way around.
 - Tie a length of yarn very tightly around the middle then remove the
 - To finish, just give your pompom a neat haircut.

To speed things up, get hold of some pompom makers from your local craft shop or online: they only cost a few pounds.

Pompom ideas:

- Use your pompoms to create furry animal decorations add googly eves and even little ears and tails cut out of card
- Hang them on a key to make a keyring
- Make a pair of dangly earrings
- Thread them on a long piece of varn to make a garland
- Sew a large pompom or three smaller ones onto the corners of a plain cushion
 - Attach them around the top of a plain basket
 - For some simple wall art, hang a few lengths of yarn from a piece of dowel and thread a few pompoms on each.

Police officer is commended for service



Achelmsford police officer who prevented a woman jumping from a bridge has received a commendation for his compassion and quick thinking.

PC Dave Endersby (pictured right), of the Chelmsford Local Policing Team, helped to pull the woman to safety.

He was deployed to the incident with a colleague on September 1, 2022. When they arrived, they found the woman standing on the wrong side of the railings on a bridge across a busy road.

PC Endersby said: "She was on the phone in floods of tears and I knew I had to get her talking. Then, she turned to me, handed me the phone and asked me to talk to the person on the other end.

"Instead of taking her phone, I took the opportunity to grab her and pull her back against the railings. She tried to jump but I lifted her up with the help of a member of the public who had approached, and pulled her back over the railings to safety.

"I feel very proud to receive a commendation. When police officers do things like this, it's part of the job. It's only later, when you start thinking about how you've had an impact on that person's life, that what you've done really hits home."

Drug dealers jailed after 10-month investigation

wo drug dealers operating in Chelmsford have been iailed.

A 10-month investigation into an organised crime group was launched in 2021. Two members, Mirel Zeneli, 33, of Hutton Road, Shenfield, and Ben

Chadwick, 23, of Stock Road, Billericay, were arrested after warrants led to Essex Police seizing cocaine estimated to have a street value of almost $\mathfrak{L}110,000$, several thousand pounds' worth of cannabis and around $\mathfrak{L}10,000$ in cash.

On March 31, Zeneli was jailed for six years for conspiracy to supply cocaine and Chadwick was jailed for three years for conspiracy to supply cocaine and cannabis.

A third man, Laurie Landman, 24, of The Foxgloves, Billericay, was handed a two-year sentence suspended for two years for conspiracy to supply cocaine and cannabis.

New exhibit celebrates community spirit

Anew exhibition at Chelmsford Museum commemorates a festival that brought the local community together.

Chelmsford Council for Voluntary Service, in collaboration with international arts company Kinetika, launched Chelmsford 100 in 2022 with the aim of uniting a range of individuals and community groups. People were asked share a story about what living in Chelmsford means to them.

Each of the 100 stories was turned into its own handpainted silk batik flag to create a mobile installation of 100 works of art. The flags were then carried by volunteers on 100 miles of local walking routes.

A museum spokesperson said: "This exhibition will showcase a selection of the flags alongside film footage and photographs of some of the 100 miles they have journeyed. The display will explain how the flags were made and visitors will be able to read each of the 100 stories that inspired them."

The exhibition is open until June 4.

It was very exciting to spend a morning being shown the huge construction project underway at Beaulieu Park Station, Engineers from Network Rail and the contractors Murphy's told me how, on recent weekends, they have been starting work at 2am each Saturday and continuing non-stop until the early hours of Monday. Recently, they have been lifting the existing Great Eastern Main Line in 75-metre-long sections. This has enabled them to rebuild the subsurface under the track in readiness for the new platforms and shifting of the tracks, which will happen in later phases.

Many residents enjoy Chelmsford's vibrant nighttime economy. I recently joined a Night of Action in Chelmsford on a busy Saturday night. The significant police presence and deployment of mobile metal detectors targeted anyone with knives or other weapons. Many people, especially women and girls, told me how pleased they were to see the enhanced focus on safety and how reassured they were.

We were honoured that the Prime Minister (pictured below right) chose Chelmsford to launch a new Anti-Social Behaviour Action Plan. Chelmsford is by and large a calm and peaceful place, with crime rates dropping. But, when anti-social behaviour occurs, it can be devastating for those affected. The Action Plan will enable more hotspot policing, easier reporting for witnesses and enhanced police targeting of areas where anti-social behaviour occurs. A youth guarantee will mean every young person can access a regular club, activities or opportunities to volunteer.


CHELMSFORD HIGH STREET MARKET



An ancient forest with sinister secrets



A SLICE OF HISTORY, Simhel Cace

here are some stories you wish were true

– and the myth behind Simnel cake, the
marzipan-covered fruitcake popular at Easter,
is one of these.

Back in the mists of time, a certain Simon and Nelly apparently fell out while making a fruitcake. One said it should be boiled; the other wanted to bake it. After a squabble, they settled on using both cooking methods. The resulting cake was named after both of them.

Simnel cake dates back to the 17th century when live-in staff returned to their families around Lent, often bringing food with them. By the 19th century, Simnel cakes looked like the cakes we know today, complete with 11 balls of marzipan to represent Jesus' apostles – minus Judas, the traitor.


INGREDIENTS

FOR THE CAKE: 175g light brown soft sugar | 175g soft butter (plus extra for greasing) | 175g self-raising flour | 3 large eggs | 50g ground almonds | 3 tbsp milk | 200g mixed dried fruit | 100g glacé cherries, quartered | 2 tsp mixed spice powder

FOR THE TOPPING: 450g golden marzipan 3 tbsp apricot jam 1 egg, beaten

HOW TO MAKE:

- > Preheat the oven to 160°C/Fan 140°C/Gas 3.
- Grease a deep 20cm/8in cake tin and line it with baking paper.
- > Put all the cake ingredients into a large bowl and beat well.



- >Bake for 1.5-2 hours till golden brown.
- > Remove from the tin and cool.
- > Warm the apricot jam over a gentle heat on the hob before using to brush the top of the cake.
 - > Roll half of the remaining marzipan into a circle, just bigger than the cake. Place it on top and crimp around the edges.
 - Make 11 balls from the remaining marzipan and place them around the edge of the cake.
 - > Lightly brush the marzipan with the egg and grill carefully for about five minutes.


Keep a close check on luggage allowance, and remember that the items you carry on board need to be scrutinised. Liquids of no more than 100ml should be kept in a single, transparent, resealable plastic bag which holds no more than a litre and measures approximately 20cm by 20cm. This should be placed at the top of your hand luggage, together with any electrical items.

However, restrictions on liquids and electrical items are on their way out. Airports in the UK have until June 2024 to install new security technology, which will mean passengers can carry up to two litres of liquids and large electrical items in cabin luggage as they go through security. London City Airport has already put this new technology in place, thereby reducing hassle for passengers.

DON'T overdo the shopping

While it's tempting to pick up booze, fragrances and all manner of other discounted items in the departure lounge, it's much smarter to do this on your return journey. Anything you buy in the airport before your outbound flight will contribute to your baggage allowance on your return flight. Whereas if you save your airport shopping for before your inbound flight, anything you buy can go in your hand luggage.



very vear, on the last Sunday in March or the first Sunday in April, two of Britain's most prestigious universities battle it out in a gruelling 4.2-mile Boat Race along the Thames.

On March 26 this year, the eight Cambridge men plus a coxswain were first across the finishing line and now have 85 victories compared with Oxford's 81. Only once has there been a dead heat – back in 1877.

WHY ALL THE FUSS? The Boat Race is a symbol of fierce academic and sporting rivalry between the two universities. It's also a tough test of strength, endurance and strategy. Rowers spend months ensuring they're at peak mental and physical fitness on race day.

The Boat Race is also steeped in history and tradition. The first event was held in 1829 and has been held almost every year since, except during the First and Second World Wars and the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020.

Watching the race live makes an exciting and lowcost day out, and every year thousands of people line the riverbank and stand on the bridges to watch the event.

WHAT'S THE ROUTE? The race starts at Putney Bridge and the teams navigate several bridges, including Hammersmith Bridge and Barnes Bridge, before reaching the finish line at Chiswick Bridge.

One of the most challenging parts of the course is the stretch of the river known as the Tideway, near the Houses of Parliament and the London Eve. This part of the river is subject to strong currents and tidal changes, making rowing difficult.

IS IT JUST FOR MEN? Not anymore. The first women's race was held in 1964, and since 2015 the women's course has been identical to the men's. That said, the men's race is still the one that makes the headlines. This year saw the Cambridge women win the Boat Race, marking their sixth straight win.






