collection of events that celebrate the progress and popularity of the LGBTQ+ movement, actually comes from a place of conflict.

Certainly, our modern interpretation of Pride and, by association, LGBTQ+ Pride Month, which took place in June, is one where people can express their sexuality in a way that brings it into mainstream conversation.

It wasn't always like this. Back in 1969, and under the moniker Stonewall, a series of riots around Manhattan provided a watershed moment. The name referenced the Stonewall Inn, a gay bar in Greenwich Village where transgender people rioted following a raid by police.

Looking now at the way Pride is encouraged in al its forms, it's clear we have come a

long way since then.

In the UK, parades in London and Brighton are some of the most popular of any live events held to celebrate Pride. Across the pond, various US presidents have committed to referencing and promoting Pride Month, while corporations the world over throw their collective marketing might behind that familiar multicoloured flag.

What's more, last year the United Arab Emirates supported the LGBTQ+ community in a way they had never before by raising the rainbow flag to celebrate Pride Month; and with the World Cup due to be held in Qatar at the end of the year, the Middle East remains under

significant pressure to uphold its renewed pledge for dignity and equality.

These days, Pride is more than a dress code, a parade or a festival. It is a 24/7 lifestyle that encompasses people of all different persuasions, in pursuit of respect, tolerance and understanding. And it's a battle that's being won.



Community champion recognised in Honours List

A Halstead resident who set up a group to care for elderly and vulnerable people during the pandemic said she was "shocked" to receive a Member of the Order of the British Empire (MBE) in the Queen's Birthday Honours.

Cherry McKean MBE (pictured left) formed the COVID-19 Community Action Response Group in Earls Colne in the first lockdown to make sure people who were living on their own were not completely isolated.

She said: "I needed to set up a group to make sure people living by themselves could get help and talk to their families and friends. Everybody really pulled together as a team. We had people volunteering to drop their phone numbers through the doors of all the houses on one road, and Earls Colne Parish Council also designed a leaflet which went to every household.

"It's such an honour to receive the MBE but I was shocked when the email came through – I thought it was a scam. I've known about it since the end of April

and have had to keep the biggest news of my life a secret since then."

Cherry praised the efforts of volunteers who gave up their time to help run the group.

She said: "It was an amazing, lovely atmosphere at such a dark time. People were shopping for strangers they had never met. We set up a vaccination hub and people were quick to offer to help."

Cherry was also honoured for her efforts in championing environmental causes. In 2019, she established the Eco Colnes and Halstead Grass Roots Community Group for local people to share tips on how to be more sustainable.

She has also set up the Ecolnes Refillery in Earls Colne, a minimal waste store and sustainable living hub which aims to help its customers reduce the amount of plastic packaging they use.

Looking ahead, Cherry would also like to set up a community hub and a community fridge to share surplus food for free.

Plansfor73 homes to be considered by council

↑ housing developer has submitted plans for 73 Anew homes on land at Mount Hill in Halstead.

In an application submitted to Braintree District Council, developers Orchestra Land have proposed to build much-needed housing for the area between Halstead Hall Care Home and Blamsters Farm.

This follows discussions with Braintree District Council to reduce the number of homes from 130 to 73 after members of the public raised concerns over the impact the development would have on the environment and local infrastructure.

Bassil Aslam, director of Orchestra Land, said: "We have worked hard to improve our proposals in response to comments from council officers and other consultees, including a reduction from 130 to 73 homes. Almost half the site is now proposed for public open space, community orchard, providing a new play area and enabling biodiversity enhancements.

"The proposals will meet policy requirements in all areas, including parking standards and drainage, and will deliver 30 per cent affordable housing as well as self-build housing plots. Financial contributions will also be made towards local healthcare and education services, and towards highway improvements such as improved crossing facilities on the A131."

A spokesperson for Braintree District Council said: "The applicant has sought outline planning permission for this site under application 20/01493/OUT.

"Our planning committee will consider the concerns raised when this application is put before them."

New bench installed to honour Queen's Jubilee

lalstead will have a permanent reminder of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee after a new bench was installed in the Public Gardens.

This is one of three benches installed by Braintree District Council to mark 70 years since the Queen's accession to the throne. Benches have also been installed in Weavers Park, Braintree, and Witham Town Park.

A display of red, white and blue summer flowers has been created in Halstead Public Gardens, as well as Braintree and Bocking Public Gardens and Witham Memorial Gardens.

Councillors Frankie Ricci (pictured left), Andrew Hensman (pictured centre) and Wendy Schmitt (pictured right) have praised the initiative.

Cllr Ricci said: "The Platinum Jubilee is a momentous occasion for the nation and residents across our district. These commemorative benches will add a lasting touch to remember the Jubilee for years to come."

New addition to Second World War Memorial

Wisitors to Halstead Public Gardens will notice a new addition to the Second World War Memorial.

There has been a plane made from wood, chicken wire and moss flying over the memorial since 2014 thanks to Joan Gibson, a florist and artist who designs floral displays for Halstead in Bloom.

After the weather damaged the display, it was decided to replace the structure with a permanent metal plane created by Graham Smith, which was installed in time for the Platinum Jubilee.

Julia, Graham's wife, said: "I bought an Airfix kit of a Spitfire for Graham for Christmas and it is based on that model. The silhouette was to shadow the model of a First World War soldier in the gardens."

Graham spent around 30 hours building the plane, and has also been busy elsewhere.

Julia added: "Graham has made a Tommy display at St Andrew's Church, and at Halstead Hospital there is a replica weaving loom to honour the Courtauld family. In Butler Road car park, there is a replica of a Portway Tortoise Stove he made."

Council to improve park thanks to £250,000 fund



Praintree District Council has secured funding to improve Ramsey Road Recreation Ground in Halstead.

After a recent inspection revealed that the surface of the half-pipe ramp in the skate park was severely damaged, a sum of £250,000 Section 106 funding – made up of contributions sought from developers towards the costs of providing community infrastructure – will be used to improve the park and create new facilities.

When the council assigned a metalwork company to carry out the maintenance works on the half-pipe ramp, it was advised that the metal had corroded to the extent that the item was unrepairable. As a result, it will be removed from the park.

In 2019, the council ran a public consultation to give everyone who uses the recreation ground or lives in the surrounding area the opportunity to share their thoughts on the park.

This feedback will help the council shape the design and layout of the new facilities at the park, with design concepts being prepared in the coming months.

Councillor Wendy Schmitt, cabinet member for climate change and the environment at Braintree District Council, said: "We appreciate that the half-pipe ramp at Ramsey Road SkatePark may be sorely missed. However, there are plans in the pipeline to improve the park and create new facilities that are modern, fun and safe to use, as well as providing an environment for those who use the park for other outdoor activities."

Mary, 77, a resident and former volunteer for Halstead in Bloom, planted a cherry tree and installed a commemorative plague as part of the celebrations.


Christine, 90, told stories of attending parties in the gardens of the Bowes-Lyon estate with Princess Elizabeth and Princess Margaret.



SUE BARKER CBE CALLS TIME ON WIMBLEDON AFTER THREE DECADES OF IMPECCABLE SERVICE ue Barker's decision to step away from presenting duties after this year's Wimbledon championships has perhaps sounded another death knell for the BBC, whose pursuit of relevance in an everchanging media landscape continues to take away more from the organisation than it gives. As far as the 66 year old is concerned, Barker appears to have reached this endgame herself, rather than having the rug pulled from under her, as she did last year when, after 24 years of A Question of Sport, the Beeb's drive for diversity and representation saw her ousted from the show. And of course, there is an argument to say that freshening things up is a necessity. After all, the BBC's Wimbledon coverage seems to largely feature stars of a very bygone era, the 1970s and 80s, with the likes of John McEnroe, Björn Borg, Billie Jean King and Martina Navratilova representing a generation of expert summarisers that few young tennis fans can relate to. That said, the A Question of Sport experiment, now fronted by Paddy McGuinness, has failed as far as viewing figures go, and BBC executives will no doubt be wary of that as they begin to search for a replacement for someone who many feel is irreplaceable. The BBC will have some faith that possible new presenter Annabel Croft, or perhaps Clare Balding CBE, or Andrew Castle, can go a long way towards filling the void, even if Barker's contribution and presence has always been huge. Not only does she convey events with brightness, humour and warmth, but she makes her guests feel reassured and comfortable too. That mum-like demeanour feels increasingly rare in an era of television where high-octane, maximum impact entertainment is the norm, and her ability to play that out across other projects, including Sports Personality of the Year, plus athletics and Olympics coverage, sees her regarded as one of the very best of a generation. Of course, the presenter was a brilliant tennis player herself back in the 1970s. She turned pro at the age of 17, and captured the hearts of the nation three years later when she won the French Open, defeating Renáta Tomanová in the final. On home soil. Barker reached the Wimbledon semi-finals in 1977, but was surprisingly beaten by Betty Stöve. She retired aged 28 after a series of injuries, having claimed 15 singles and 12 doubles titles across her career, and seamlessly made her way into the media world, initially with Australia's Channel 7. After three years at BskyB, she ioined the BBC in 1993. In 2021, Barker was presented with a CBE for services to broadcasting and charity, having previously been given an MBE in the year 2000 and an OBE six years ago. What lies in wait next for the broadcaster, who is married to landscape gardener Lance Tankard and lives in the Cotswolds, is unknown, but what is certain is the fact she will be in high demand.

s your garden more shady than sunny? While it can be a struggle to create a blooming outdoor space with limited sunlight, it can be done. Discover below five pretty plants that thrive in the shade.

STINKING IRIS: Although this may not be the most pleasantsounding plant, stinking iris can actually make a very beautiful addition to a shady garden, especially in autumn, when its large seedpods split open to reveal orange-red seeds. Plant in full shade for best results.

WOOD SPURGE: There are many different varieties of spurge, but our favourite has to be Euphorbia amygdaloides var. robbiae. From late spring, this pretty plant bears lime-green flowers above dark green leaves. Plant in dry, shady spots such as underneath trees or along woodland borders.

\$10WDROPS: Snowdrops appear at the end of winter and bloom beautifully for weeks until your spring bulbs start to flourish. Delicate and dainty, snowdrops thrive in full shade and particularly in heavy, moist soils.

BELLFLOWER: If you are looking for a plant that will attract bees and other pollinators to your garden, then bellflower is a great choice. Ideal for growing at the back of a border, this attractive plant displays clusters of purple-blue bell-shaped flowers from summer through until autumn.

FOXGLOVE: As a woodland plant, foxgloves thrive in dappled or partial shade, so they do require a little bit of sun. There are many different varieties to choose from, with colours including bright pink, purple and peach.

OUR TOP TIPS FOR GROWING IN THE SHADE:

- > Improve the soil with lots of organic matter before planting
- > When planting under trees, remove any dry, impoverished soil between the large roots
- > Apply weathered wood ash from a bonfire or log burner to increase the potash in the soil
- > Mulch the whole area after planting with garden compost or composted bark chippings.



WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND OUR KIDS' PERCEPTION OF MONEY

here's no parent who hasn't encountered the incessant pleading or hopeful yearning of a child who, while being commended for his or her persistence, has desperately failed to appreciate the value of something we all need perspective on - money.

While in the past the subject of finances was one largely kept clear of kids, experts now believe it's of real value to educate our voungsters as far as the daily cut and thrust of cash goes.

To do so, it is key to understand what our kids perceive as the value of money. It follows, then, that we can better manage expectations if we pinpoint their perspective. Past the age of 10, kids glean how work interacts with money and the fact it can be preserved with good habits (or lost easily with bad ones). With that in mind, having a jar where kids can save money, see it accumulate and then spend it on a reward is one of the best introductions.


Parents or guardians should also use a scheme of rewarding tasks (or commissions) rather than the typical pocket money format where, effectively, a child is rewarded no matter what they do.

JAKE DANIELS BECOMES THE UK'S FIRST OPENLY GAY FOOTBALLER IN THREE DECADES

They say young footballers go about their craft with a sense of fearlessness, and that's certainly the case where Blackpool forward Jake Daniels is concerned.

The 17-year-old, who signed pro terms with the Championship club in 2022, is yet to make a league appearance for the Seasiders, though he has singlehandedly cultivated more column inches than any of his vastly more experienced teammates by coming out as the English Football League's only gay footballer.

For many years, conjecture over the possible treatment of gay footballers - in an environment where terrace banter very often crosses the line between acceptable and not - has clearly led to a huge number of gay footballers afraid to fly their true colours.

That's what makes Jake's revelation all the more brave - namely that someone right at the start of his football career has the confidence and honesty to nail his LGBT colours to the mast and

declare, as would Gloria Gaynor, "I am what I am".

He said: "I can't really put a date on it, but I was probably five or six years old when I knew I was gay, so it's been a long time that I have been living with the lie.

"Now is the right time to speak. I feel like I am ready to tell people my story. I want people to know the real me.


"I have been thinking for a long time about how I want to do it, when I want to do it. I know now is the time. I am ready to be myself, be free and be confident with it all."

The UK's first openly gay footballer since Justin Fashanu way back in 1990, Jake is correct in his assertion that attitudes and values have changed. And while the late

Fashanu was derided for his honesty and bravery, the fact Jake Daniels has been roundly praised shows just how far society has come since then.


