MARTIN TYLER'S fantastic finish

elebrating both the career and the caressing tones of Martin Tyler, one of the most revered and celebrated football commentators of the modern era, who has left Sky Sports after 33 years of service.

"Manchester City are still alive here... Balotelli... AGUERROOOOO! I swear you'll never see anything like this again. So, watch it. Drink it in."

Martin Tyler's almost indelible words that accompanied Manchester City's first Premier League title in 2011/12 came more than two decades into his service as lead commentator for Sky Sports, the leading UK broadcaster of the English top-flight since its inception in 1992.

To link the Chester-born wordsmith with the pioneering, game-changing nature of Rupert Murdoch's pay TV revolution is an appropriate fit. Both supported each other in the growth of a football product that, rightfully, was to present our domestic league as the very best in the world.

That piece of iconic commentary came on a day when the blue half of Manchester scored two injury-time goals against QPR to wrestle the title away from their city rivals United. Many regard it as being right up there with the sport's other legendary narratives – from Kenneth Wolstenholme's "They think it's all over... it is now" in the 1966 World Cup Final, to Brian Moore's "It's up for grabs now" as Arsenal won the league title with virtually the last kick of the 1988/89 season at Anfield.

Indeed, that spine-tingling commentary is held so dear by the club's fans that many have it painted on walls, or inscribed on body parts – a goal and a string of words that kicked off a football revolution that now sees Manchester City as truly the dominant side in this country.

Tyler has always seen his vocal variations matched with awards – included in these are multiple gongs for Football Supporters' Federation Commentator of the Year Award, plus the much-cherished Premier League Commentator of the Decade.

Away from the satellite giant, he has voiced for Fox SBS (Australia), was the default commentator on the FIFA video game franchise between 2005 and 2022, and has also worked at the Euros and World Cup, having started out at ITV.

While the broadcaster is associated with the very top rung of the professional game, his inherent football passion comes much further down the ladder, given he is a supporter of National League side Woking.

Upon hanging up his microphone, Tyler said: "It's been a privilege to play a small part in the broadcasting history of the greatest league in the world.

"Working alongside wonderful professionals, I thank them for their support and expertise. It's been an honour as a member of a very gifted team."

Tyler, with his mannerisms, his turn of phrase and his presence that could fill the emptiest of front rooms on a Sunday afternoon, will be a hard act to follow, yet Sky Sports commentary is in good hands as Peter Drury takes the hot seat for the new season, starting in August 2023.



Weird and Wonderful festivals around the world

nummer is the time when crowds flock to music festivals, but did you know there are also a host of weird Oand wonderful festivals and events that take place throughout the year?

INTERNATIONAL HAIR FREEZING CONTEST: In the cold province of Yukon, Canada, the International Hair Freezing Contest takes place every February at the Takhini Hot Springs. With temperatures that reach below -30 degrees Celsius, participants dunk their heads in the hot water of the pools and then create frosty hairdos by shaping their locks as they freeze in the cold air.

BABY JUMPING FESTIVAL: Known to the locals as El Colacho, this unusual event takes place in Spain 60 days after Easter during the feast of Corpus Christi, It involves men dressing in traditional 'devilish' clothing to scare the crowd before running down the street and jumping over carefully placed babies.

> WifE CARRUING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP: Fancy carrying your wife around a 253.5-metre track that is riddled with obstacles? Then you need to head to the two-day Wife Carrying World Championship in Finland. A hugely popular annual event that takes place in late June/early July, the winning team is awarded a prize of their wife's weight in beer.

> LA TOMATINA: You may have heard of this popular Spanish festival that involves A LOT of tomatoes being thrown about the streets of Valencia. Essentially an hourlong tomato fight for the chosen 20,000 participants, this event is held on the last Wednesday in August each year.

MONKEY BUFFET FESTIVAL: The Monkey Buffet Festival in Lopburi, Thailand, is, as the name suggests, a buffet for monkeys that takes place annually among the ruins of a temple on the last Sunday of November. The local monkey population in Lopburi is around 2.000-3.000, and all are

welcome to the annual feast of fruits, cakes, vegetables and candies.



celebration of more than four decades of the term Botham's Ashes – a tribute to a one-man masterclass that turned a dramatic series of matches on its head.

Australia came to England in the summer of 1981 keen to win back the urn, and in a low-scoring first Test at Trent Bridge, they bowled the hosts out for 185 and 125 to seize the initiative.

The second Test was drawn, and the Aussies looked to be coasting to success in the third, at Headingly, as they clocked up 401/9, before skittling England out for just 174. Lord Botham's half-century appeared little more than a consolation, and while a follow-on total of 356 (with the talismanic former footballer 149 not out) had the hosts ahead, it

without Bob Willis MBE's devastating eight wickets

for just 43 runs with the ball, and collapsed to 111 all out, allowing England to level the series. Past that point, it was a Lord Botham masterclass

- he took five wickets in the second innings in the fourth Test at Edgbaston with the Aussies requiring just 150 to win; then bagged a century at Old Trafford as England went 2-1 up. It was his third successive Man of the Match performance.

And in a sixth Test at The Oval, another century from 'Beefy' wrapped up a 3-1 Ashes victory.

From a position of apparent hopelessness, Lord Botham's courage, bullishness, power and fortitude guided England to a sensational series win.



REMOVE THEM QUICKLY

hen a bird decides to lighten its load your nead, it's said to be a sign of good luck. Well, tell that to motor afficionados and they may well disagree, because unequivocally, bird poo is bad for your car's paintwork and should be removed immediately.

The acid in bird poo begins to corrode the shiny coat that sits atop your cherished four wheels within 48 hours. This acid kicks off a rusting process. which can be difficult and expensive to fix.

The fact that birds consume a large amount of gravel in their diet means that not only do you need to be quick in removing deposits, but careful as well, or you'll find that despite being prompt in ridding your paintwork of the mess, it's left behind a horror show of scratch marks too.

Preventing the deposit of bird poo on your car is a near-impossible task, though ensuring you don't park under trees or roofed overhangs will reduce the chance of your car resembling a painter and decorator's radio.

The best and easiest method to get rid of

the mess is simply to spray it with WD-40. This will serve to loosen the droppings. You should then use a sponge or microfibre cloth to pinch them up from the surface of the car.

Baking soda mixed with dish soap and dispensed from a spray bottle can be just as good, while preprepared over-the-counter formulas are expensive. but equally effective.

The real trick to ensuring no long-lasting marks on your vehicle where bird poo is concerned is rapid detection, so keep your eyes peeled and leap into action at the first sign of air attack.





Man admits series of burglaries



A serial burglar has admitted guilt to 13 offences in Braintree.

Shane Smith (pictured above), 31, was responsible for 11 burglaries, one attempted burglary and an associated fraud, which all took place in the Braintree district between August 2022 and March 2023.

Items such as bank cards, phones and televisions were stolen. In one of the burglaries, a West Highland Terrier was also taken, but was quickly recovered.

In one instance, Smith left behind a cap and a metal car jack. A crime scene investigator took DNA from the jack, which led to the identification of Smith.

He was arrested in March and subsequently charged. As the investigation progressed, detectives were able to link him to the 13 offences.

Theatre's £54,000 roof repair completed

The roof at the Empire Theatre in Halstead has been repaired thanks to £54,000 in funding from Halstead Town Council (HTC).

A spokesperson for HTC said: "The council is very pleased to announce that it has recently funded the total replacement of the slate roof at the Empire Theatre. The Empire is owned by HTC, and run by the Empire Theatre Trust (ETT) – a group of volunteers who put on a rich offering of films, shows and activities for members of the community. The trust has been renovating the heating/air-conditioning, while the council replaced the roof, thanks to the expertise of

Essex and Suffolk Roofing."

Mike George, of the ETT, said: "We would like to thank HTC for its continued support and its commitment to the theatre in funding the works."

ETT is continuing to fundraise for a new projector. All the proceeds from its upcoming live production of *Persuasion* on August 30 will go towards the fund.

Council loses appeal against housing plan

Braintree District Council (BDC) has lost its appeal against government plans to house 1,700 male asylum seekers in the local area.

The Ministry of Defence Wethersfield site in Braintree is set to become the UK's largest asylum accommodation centre, and will house 1,700 people.

BDC has been steadfast in its opposition to the plans, stating that the site is unsuitable given the lack of capacity in local services, its isolated location, the size of the site, and the fact that the scale of the development could affect the local community.

The council sought an injunction to stop the plans, but the Court of Appeal dismissed the bid on June 23.

Councillor Graham Butland, Leader of BDC, said: "We are extremely disappointed with this outcome. We continue to stand behind the community on the fact that the site is unsuitable for these plans, and we are doing all we can through legal routes to prevent it from going ahead. This is all while we are continuing to work with our partners to mobilise should the plans progress, to support asylum seekers accommodated and ensure minimal impact on all those involved."

The Home Office has been contacted for comment.





than gleaming, then you will be pleased to hear that this type of footwear is relatively easy to clean. All you need is a few simple ingredients and a little bit of elbow grease.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Baking soda | Toothpaste | Washing-up liquid | Stain remover | Water | A sponge | A nail brush and toothbrush | Cloths | Newspaper

HOW TO CLEAN:

STEP 1: Cleaning the laces

Remove the laces from your Converses and then create a cleaning solution using 50ml of washingup liquid, 1 tbsp toothpaste, 1tbsp baking soda and 200ml of warm water. Soak the laces for two to three hours and then hang to dry.

STEP 2: Cleaning the shoe

Stuff each shoe with newspaper and generously apply toothpaste to the shoe using a toothbrush. Leave for 15 minutes. Wash off all the toothpaste using a nail brush and warm water, then leave to dry in a warm place. Never apply direct heat to your Converse trainers.

STEP 3: Removing tough stains

For any stubborn stains, apply stain remover directly to the affected area. Leave for five to 10 minutes and then wash off using a nail brush. Leave in a warm place to dry. It can be a good idea to test your stain remover on a section of the shoe that is not visible first, such as the outer edge of the tonque.

NB: You should never machine wash or dry Converse trainers as this can damage the shoes.

How to keep white Converses white

If you have recently purchased a pair of white Converse trainers, spray them with a water and stain repellent spray before you wear them. When a stain occurs, spot clean immediately with an equal mix of warm water and washing-up liquid.

BROAD BEANS

f you want to try to eat more seasonally, then now is the time of year to embrace the humble broad bean. They're delicious, nutritious and guaranteed to brighten up your day. Discover two of our favourite broad bean recipes below.







SECURE your canine!

If your pooch loves lolling their head out of a car window, you could be breaking the law.

It's common knowledge that dogs love to hang their furry heads outside car windows in order to absorb all the fragrant wonders of the world passing by, yet did you know that this could actually be breaking the law?

It is a legal requirement as part of the Highway Code to secure a dog – or any other small animal – in a car when driving to prevent them from causing an accident. This is because they could block your vision, jump in the footwell and stop you braking, or generally distract you with their fluffy cuteness.

In the event that an animal is believed to have caused an accident, the driver of the vehicle can face a fine of up to $\mathfrak{L}5,000$ and could receive points on their licence. Worse still, it could also invalidate both your car AND pet insurance – meaning no financial help for Fido should they get hurt.

Mark Tongue, of Select Car Leasing, said: "We'd recommend you don't let your dog

stick its head out of the window.

"Not only does that potentially illustrate that the animal is not restrained properly, but there's also the obvious risk of its head coming into contact with something, like a bush or a tree, resulting in a bad injury. And make no mistake – if you don't have your dog properly restrained, and it's causing distraction, you could be prosecuted by the law.

"Don't take the risk. Make sure both you and your pooch are buckled up properly."

In other words, next time your four-legged friend feels like catching the breeze, make sure you've invested in a dog-friendly harness, or risk finding yourself in the doghouse.



DID YOU KNOW?
