














THE WORLD AROUND US Part I

In the first of a new four-part environmental series, we look at the key drivers in the health and well-being of the planet. In this issue, it's animal life, and in particular, the humble cow.

t's not easy being a cow. While farmers are eyeing you up for a trip to the abattoir, those on both sides of the eco debate are ready to slap the blame tag on a little embarrassing flatulence.

Scientists believe the average cow releases between 70kg and 120kg of methane per year. A greenhouse gas, like carbon dioxide and nitrous oxide, methane forms a dangerous blanket around the planet.

A molecule that lasts a decade, in real terms what it contributes to the atmosphere can be equated to little more than two cups of water inside a swimming pool, yet its chemical shape is remarkably effective at trapping heat, thus it has a big impact on how much, and how quickly, the planet warms.

And with 1.5 billion cows on the planet, it's clear there's real environmental interest in reducing the emissions of these animals, who can also lay claim to being the source of two-thirds of all ammonia in the atmosphere.

In 2019, an experiment in New Zealand saw cows given a vaccine to rid them of certain gut microbes responsible for producing methane. Further development of this could drastically reduce cows' impact on the planet, while still allowing our ravenous consumption of meat and dairy foods.

In the UK, farmers mainly use grass-based silage. By changing to a maize compound, a one-tenth drop in methane production could be achieved.

As ever, environmental aims must be balanced with commercial sense. The UK agricultural industry is worth £25billion per year, yet it's clear less-fibrous diets, further vaccine research and other subtle changes – such as introducing seaweed and higher-quality constituents into the food mix

 can lead to more refined systems... and less windy livestock!

Inhether you live in your trusty trainers or you favour a more sophisticated leather shoe, caring for your chosen footwear can be a bit of a nightmare. Fortunately, we are here to help.

Suede & Leather

The first thing you should do if you buy a pair of leather or suede shoes is to treat them with a specialised spray protector, as this will help preserve them for

In terms of cleaning, suede should be gently brushed with a suede brush to remove any dirt or dust without damaging it.

Leather is best cleaned with shoe polish as this will not only clean but also moisturise it, which helps to lengthen the lifespan of the shoes.

If your leather shoes get caught in the rain, place them upside down on dry paper (not newspaper) and leave to dry naturally.

Canvas & Fabric

Slightly easier to take care of, most canvas shoes can be washed in the washing machine, although be sure to let them air dry and never place them in the tumble dryer as this will ruin their shape. If there is only one spot of dirt on your fabric or canvas shoes, simply brush it off with a toothbrush or wash with a sponge dipped in soapy water.

Some trainers can be washed in the washing machine, although always check their label before doing so. It can be a good idea to place your trainers in a pillow case before washing and to wash them with a few towels to avoid your footwear banging around and becoming damaged. Liquid detergent is preferable as powder can get stuck in your trainers.

5 natural BATHSOAKS

Green tea

Baking soda

A store cupboard essential, also known as sodium bicarbonate, this natural ingredient is found in most bath products owing to its exfoliating

Simply mix five tablespoons of baking soda into a warm bath and allow to dissolve.

Not actually a salt but a naturally occurring mineral, Epsom salt is made up of magnesium and sulphate. Ideal for counteracting stress, Epsom salt can also help to ease pain and alleviate sore muscles. Add one or two cups to your bath five minutes before you plan to get in.


Why is vitamin D important?

Vitamin D helps to regulate the amount of calcium and phosphate in the body, both of which are needed for maintaining healthy teeth, bones and muscles. It is also known for improving brain development and reducing inflammation.

A vitamin D deficiency can lead to a loss of bone density which makes you more prone to fractures and osteoporosis. In children, it can cause rickets.

How much sunlight do I need to get sufficient vitamin D?

The main source of vitamin D for our bodies is the sun, yet in winter in the UK we do not get sufficient sunlight to meet our daily requirement of this vital vitamin. In the summer months, a mere 15 minutes of sun at midday is enough exposure, although people with darker skin, such as those of African or South Asian origin, may require a little longer.

Eating right ISN'T COMPLICATED

Top tips on on how you can achieve a healthy and balanced diet

ating a healthy, balanced diet is an important part of maintaining good health, and can help you feel your best. Some basic rules to follow are:

> Have a meal or small snack every three to four hours. This fuels your metabolism and helps prevent binges, and blood sugar levels stay balanced.

- > Combine protein and fibre at every meal.

 This formula provides long-lasting fuel and necessary nutrients for brain, bone and muscle growth.
- > Get up, move around. Sitting for long periods slows the metabolism, which affects the body's ability to regulate blood sugar and blood pressure and to break down body fat.
- > Drink water often. There are specific times throughout the day when drinking water can boost your overall health and cognitive functioning. Drink one glass of water 30 minutes before a meal to help digestion. Remember not

to drink too soon before or after a meal as the water will dilute the digestive juices.

Remember to vary your diet because healthy eating isn't necessarily that healthy if you eat the same things over and over again. Having a healthy, balanced diet is about getting the right types of foods and drinks in the right amounts.

As a rough guide, try to base your portions, with 200g (one cup) being one portion, around these healthy food groups:

- > Fruit and vegetables: 5+ portions per day
- > Starchy carbohydrates: 3-4 portions per day
- > Beans, pulses, fish, eggs, meat and other proteins: 2–3 portions per day
- > Dairy and alternatives: 2–3 portions per day

 Ultimately, in the short term, eating a healthy diet

can help us to feel good, look our best and stay

at a healthy weight. In the long term, a healthy, balanced diet can reduce our risk of heart disease, diabetes, osteoporosis and some cancers.

ast month we celebrated the carrot, praised the parsnip and tackled the turnip. Now it's time to explore the culinary delights of three more tasty and nutritious root vegetables.

BEETROOT

Instantly recognisable by its bright purple hue, the beetroot often gets a bad rap as some believe that it tastes a little too much like the soil in which it is grown. However, it is worth sampling for its health benefits alone, with this root vegetable being rich in antioxidant and anti-inflammatory properties.

HOW TO STORE: Place beetroots in a perforated plastic bag in the vegetable drawer of your fridge. Lifespan: 3 weeks.

HOW TO COOK: The most famous beetroot dish is borscht, an eastern European winter warmer. Alternatively, roast in olive oil and cumin seeds.

JERUSALEM ARTICHOKE

Full of iron, potassium and vitamin B1, the Jerusalem artichoke is reported to be both an aphrodisiac and a natural digestive. In season from November to March, choose artichokes that are firm to touch and pale brown in colour.

HOW TO STORE: Keep in the fridge or in a cool, dark place. Lifespan: 1–2 weeks. HOW TO COOK: Cook Jerusalem artichokes in the same way that you would a potato or parsnip: roasted, sautéed, dipped in batter and fried or puréed into a soup.

SWEET POTATO

Seen as a healthier alternative to potatoes, this root vegetable contains iron, calcium, selenium, vitamin A and C, plus it's full of fibre.

HOW TO STORE: Avoid storing in the fridge as this will result in an unpleasant taste; instead, place in a dry, well-ventilated container away from heat. Lifespan: 3–4 weeks. HOW TO COOK: Although baking sweet potatoes will result in a richer taste, when boiled they have a low glycaemic index (GI).

mixture | Cover with baking paper and tie on securely with string | Place the pudding in a large pan and pour in boiling water until it reaches halfway up the outside of the bowl | Cover with a lid | Steam the pudding for 4 hours making sure it does not boil dry (add water if necessary) | Test if the pudding is cooked by inserting a skewer into it; if it comes out dry, it is done | Leave to cool | Cover with fresh baking paper and wrap tightly in cling film | Store in a cool, dark place for up to 6 weeks | When ready to serve, steam for a further 2 hours | Light using a ladle of warm (not boiling) brandy

YOU WILL NEED:

120g suet | 20g breadcrumbs | 100g flour | 175g soft dark brown sugar | 500g dried fruit (raisins, sultanas, etc) | 25g flaked almonds | 25g candied peel 1 tsp mixed spice 1/2 tsp nutmeg 1/2 tsp cinnamon 1 grated cooking apple | zest of ½ grange zest of ½ lemon | 150ml brandy | 2 eggs optional: coins

HOW TO MAKE:

Combine suet, breadcrumbs. flour, sugar, fruit and spices in a bowl | Add the rest of the ingredients and mix well | Butter

VARIATIONS ON THE TRADITION:

Instead of brandy, try adding rum, stout or sherry For a vegan pudding, leave out the eggs and use vegetable suet with a little bit of soya yogurt Substitute traditional raisins, currants and sultanas for cherries, figs or crystallised ginger

> If you are going to add coins, wrap them in tin foil first to avoid choking.

LEARN HOW TO EXPOSE. PREPARE AND LOOK AFTER A BRICKWORK FEATURE WALL

t's the design feature that flipped on its head the old adage of plastering over walls for a smooth, 'complete' finish.

These days, exposed brickwork is all the rage - a modern take on a feature wall that circumnavigates modern, industrial and rustic.

Preparing an exposed brick wall and looking after it isn't difficult if you follow a few simple steps.

Exposina

Chip away a small section of plaster to check your brickwork is in good order. Cover the floor with sheeting, as removal of plaster will throw up considerable dust. Wearing a dust mask, chisel away sections and finish using a wire brush.

Preparing

Use a mild solution comprising equal parts water, dish soap and salt. Use a clean cloth to apply, allowing the solution to soak into the wall. Leave for 10 minutes so the salt dissolves any remaining plaster particles, then wipe the entire wall using a sponge or wet cloth.

When dry, use an industrial sealant across the entire wall. An acrylic-based application will mean your wall is resistant to scratches, spills and dirt. You'll need to apply at least two coats, ensuring you work the solution into all the gaps.

Looking after

With your pristine wall the envy of visitors, you'll need to make sure you look after it properly. It's inevitable that parts may be fragile and flake off over time, but light cleaning (even with something as simple as a feather duster) will keep particles at bay.

Remember, all brick walls are different, and how they respond will depend on their age, the room temperature and whether they are interior or exterior walls.

The good news is that the matt finish and unpolished look most go for will hide a multitude of sins.



up, accusations of political and social bias, and the move to begin charging over-75s for TV licences - it has left 'Auntie' scratching about for relevance in a changing world where digital and premium channels are taking our attention... and our money.

While the BBC remains one of our country's finest institutions, and excellent value for those who regularly enjoy its diverse range of programming, there have been recent moves to defund the organisation - a Twitter campaign rapidly gained 100,000 followers and continues to apply pressure across social media.

This has led to many looking at the criteria for paying the licence; namely, whether you do indeed need to pay the £157.50 annual charge (£53 for a black and white TV). The answer is yes, if...

> ... you watch or record live TV as it is being transmitted, on any channel

watch or stream programmes live on an online service (such as ITV Hub, All 4, YouTube, Amazon Prime Video, Sky Go, etc)

> ... you download or watch programmes on iPlayer And the above applies to use on any device, from television to computer to games console.

The good news is that the BBC's brilliant range of national and regional radio is exempt.

If you believe you don't need a licence, the process for opting out is simple - simply declare to TV Licensing via its website and cancel any direct debits. That will stop what many describe as a barrage of threatening letters. However, the onus is, of course, on you to reapply for a licence if your watching habits change.

What's clear is that in a changing world the BBC's stranglehold on compulsory payment may well be coming to an end - even more so if Prime Minister Boris Johnson's move to decriminalise non-payment continues to gather pace.

...A GOOD SPORT

rom fashion undergraduate to Sky Sports presenter, it was a curious career trajectory for Kirsty Gallacher, who seemingly had the world of light entertainment at her feet. That was, until a series of events knocked the Edinburgh-born beauty off track. Her recent return to the limelight is tribute to the strength and perseverance of the 44-year-old, but also a marker for us all in these difficult times.

The die was cast relatively early for Kirsty, as the daughter of Scottish Ryder Cup champion Bernard Gallacher, with a career in sport seeming the obvious choice. In reality, however, the presenter endeavoured for the cut and thrust of fashion, even when, still a youngster, the family upped sticks and moved to Wentworth to help her father's golfing ambitions.

Swapping Scotland for Surrey, Kirsty came to count Bruce Forsyth as a neighbour when growing up. And with a golf star for a dad, she was hardly unfamiliar with larger-than-life personalities popping in for coffee.

"I think maybe there was a pressure for me to do something grand," she begins, "but for many years that wasn't really me. I guess in the end I fell into it, but there was no nepotism going on – I was just lucky."

Kirsty recalls the time as a broadcaster with BSkyB when, having climbed to the position of editorial assistant, there came the opportunity to do a screen test.

"I was horribly nervous, but I've always been of the mind that once you are offered something you should always give it a try. Plus, back then, there was still a sense of adversity from traditionalists who didn't believe in women fronting sport, although that has clearly changed now."

Her time on *Sky Sports News* led to onward recognition as she went on to front shows including *Kirsty's Home Videos*, *Kirsty and Phil* and *Soccer Extra*.

So for someone so happy, it was perhaps surprising to see Kirsty's light fade in the midst of her father's poor health, and a painful divorce to ex-rugby pro Paul Sampson, her partner of 13 years, of which they were married for five.

"There were some tough things to process, though rather than take some time off to regroup and look after my boys, I threw myself into work, into new ideas and new projects."

A stint doing *Strictly Come Dancing* saw Gallacher looking desperately thin, and when a drink-driving incident saw her lose her driver's licence for 18 months, the star had hit a new low.

"It's actually really interesting how just when you think you are calm and settled, the carpet can be swept from beneath you," she admits. "It was horrific at the time, truly horrific – but at least now I can see that it was just a few life events colliding together. We are human beings for our ability to ride the rough waves and emerge out the other side stronger, and that's what I've done."

Her focus these days is on celebrating a return to the front line of presenting duties. Her successful podcast, *Stripped Back Sport*, is back on our screens at prime time, and even in a few short years she has witnessed a real evolution in television.

"As far as gender goes, it's definitely played out on more of an equal footing now," she says. "Broadcasting has really undergone a fantastic change over the past 20 years and British television remains the very best in the world. From a purely selfish perspective, it's so great to be back."

↑ man from Hornchurch has been convicted of Aa public order offence after Metropolitan Police officers investigated homophobic behaviour at a West Ham United football match.

Police investigated reports of several men shouting homophobic comments or making homophobic actions towards visiting supporters at the West Ham vs Brighton & Hove Albion game on February 1, 2020.

Two men were arrested during the fixture at the London stadium on the day of the game.

Samuel Marshall, 21, of Hornchurch and Thomas Hill, 25, of Slough appeared recently at Thames Magistrates' Court. They pleaded guilty to an offence under Section 5 of the Public Order Act and were each fined £200 plus costs.

The investigation continued and two other men were summonsed at a later date. At Thames Magistrates' Court, Damian Critten, 24, of Rainham and Jack Wood, 25, of London also pleaded guilty to a public order offence. They were each fined £120 and given three-vear football banning orders.

Chief Inspector Chris Green of Met Operations said: "This investigation and these convictions show that we will not tolerate homophobic behaviour or hate crime at football matches and more broadly in our city.

"If you have information about people committing these types of despicable offences, please share that information with police. These offenders may happen to support the same football team as you, but they do not deserve your support."



Leisure centre sets up **hub to support community**

leisure centre in Hornchurch is helping the local Acommunity by operating a food and PPE support hub out of its sports hall.

The team at Hornchurch Sports Centre, which is managed by Everyone Active in partnership with Havering Council, worked with the local authority to set up a support hub at the centre during its lockdown closure, to provide food packages to shielding residents, local foodbanks and children's centres, and PPE packages to local care homes and key workers.

"There was a core team of four at Everyone Active who were manning the support hub seven days a week, from 6am to 6pm during its peak, and offered out-of-hours cover when it was required too.

"It was fantastic to be able to utilise the centre during the closure to help the local community through such a challenging time for everyone."

Hornchurch and Upminster

As we grapple with the economic impact of the pandemic, my team and I want to do what we can to support residents in finding work. Earlier this month we joined up with our local Jobcentre to hold the first in a series of online events to showcase immediate vacancies with local employers, including

Network Rail, British Transport Police and UPS. The event went really well, and if anyone wants further information on the opportunities discussed during our first event, alongside notice of future events, please visit my website - www.julialopez.co.uk

I know many constituents are worried about delays in getting blood tests. My team and I have been talking to local GPs, our hospital's executive team and the North East London NHS Foundation Trust (NELFT) to find out what has been happening. Constituents can see the response I have received from NELFT's chief executive on my website. They are working up a longterm plan to speed up blood testing. However, I am aware of the immediacy of this issue and continue to push the local NHS for improvements in the meantime.

These difficult times have been made harder to endure by the stopping of many of the things we love, like sports, music and theatre. We are anxious to make sure that vital local organisations can get through this period and are delighted that Hornchurch Football Club has been awarded a £10,000 grant from the Premier League's Matchday Support Fund. This funding will help prepare the club for the resumption of football and the physical return of supporters. The government also announced a new Culture Recovery Fund this month, and I am really pleased that we have been able to get £245,000 in grant funding for Queen's Theatre.

I have been catching up with Nelmes Primary School and the First Step charity in Hornchurch, and we have discussed how we can best support teachers. schools and families with disabled children through the next period.

Now that I am a Minister in the Cabinet Office, I have been getting stuck in with improving governance structures across Whitehall. This month, I launched the



new COVID Fraud Hotline with Crimestoppers to help people report any concerns they have about those who might be misusing the government support schemes that have been put in place during the pandemic. It is an affront both to hardworking taxpayers and to those in genuine need that some people have been exploiting pandemic support schemes to line their own pockets. Criminals and fraudsters must not be allowed to profit from this time of national crisis. If you have any information on COVID fraud that you would like to report anonymously, call Crimestoppers for free on 0800 587 5030.

Finally, several residents have been in touch to express their frustration with the state of the footpath that joins Hillview Avenue with Osborne Road. This footpath is used to get across to the 193 bus stop and public transport to Queen's Hospital and Romford, and by parents taking their children to school. I am pleased to report that this will now be repaired after we made representations. Havering Council will be carrying out maintenance work soon and I hope it makes the crossing easier to use as we head into the wetter autumn weather.

This month I was proud to present to the House of Commons proposed legislation which I know people in Havering will deeply sympathise with, as we are an animal-loving borough.

In what's called a Private Member's Bill, I highlighted the terrible impact that "no pets" policies can have on individuals and families, many of whom are forced to give up their beloved pets when moving into rented accommodation.

More often than not, these policies are completely unnecessary. In cases where the accommodation is suitable and the owner is "responsible" (meaning the pet is vaccinated, microchipped, neutered and so on), I cannot see why landlords should be able to prevent tenants from living with their faithful friend in their new home.

My legislation, to be known as "Jasmine's Law", is backed by a huge number of organisations, including the RSPCA and Battersea Dogs and Cats Home, the former calling my Bill "a big step forward". With more and more in the south of England including in Havering - moving into rented accommodation, it is so important that pet owners have the faith and reassurance that they will be able to keep their beloved pets when they move.

As one of Havering's best-known dog owners, I have great pride that I could bring this proposal to the House of Commons. I hope the government will take this on board and support my Bill, or perhaps bring forward a change of law within their own legislation soon and end this injustice once and for all.

October has nearly passed and the usual festivities of Hallowe'en will be lacklustre. I take it Bonfire Night will also be cancelled. How many can congregate safely in parks? How would you try to enforce social distancing?

On to council-related matters – if you were following the gerrymandering issue raised against the leader of the council, you may well be disappointed with the 'hearing outcome'.

A hearing with a panel of three councillors was set up to review the allegations and decide whether this issue should move forward or not.

The panel was made up of two Conservative councillors and one Independent councillor.

It was known that concerning the issue to be heard, at least one of the two Conservative councillors selected for the hearing was present at the 'secretly recorded' meeting (councillor Ryan was heard speaking, I believe) where gerrymandering was potentially exposed. (The leader was boasting how the CEO of the council was allowing him to make changes that should not happen, and how certain changes were advantageous to the Conservative party.)

Was this just pure incompetence? Was this set up to delay the hearing?

Either way – this meeting cost the taxpayer money. Are these really the people you want in charge of running the council?





SEO 101 A beginner's guide

o the uninitiated, SEO, or search engine optimisation, can seem like a daunting task, and enlisting the services of a professional can be expensive. However, there is no reason why you can't learn to master the art of SEO yourself.

SEARCH FOR KEYWORDS

REMEMBERING THREE DECADES SINCE MODERN GERMANY WAS UNITED ONCE AGAIN

> elebrating the collapse of the Berlin Wall signifies something so expansive and important in the context of both the past and the present, that even some 31 years on, it is a milestone that must not be forgotten.

The Wall has now been removed for longer than it stood - it was constructed in 1961 and pulled down some 28 years later - but the social and political explanation of everything it stood for lives on, Indeed, it shapes the way Germany and Western Europe is today.

To understand the Berlin Wall, it's first necessary to know its purpose, and to discover its foundations ultimately had a lot to do with us here in Britain.

At the cessation of the Second World War, Germany was divided into zones, reflecting the four Allied powers: the United Kingdom, the United States, France and the Soviet Union. Berlin, the capital, despite being fully in the Soviet zone, was similarly split up.

While the principle was to keep the country under the administration of four 'allied' powers, in truth they all stood for very different things. In the developing years under Joseph Stalin, the Soviets attempted to place a firm communist imprint on their East Germany territory, which included the eastern part of Berlin.

Britain, the US and, to a lesser extent, the French, adopted a fierce consumerand business-driven capitalist method, where control, freedom, ambition and selfimprovement was presented to the people.

In the decade after the end of the war, East Germans could see their Western counterparts not just rebuilding, but flourishing under new principles, in the same way that on mainland UK the green shoots of recovery really took hold in the 1960s.

What logically followed then was a mass migration from East Germany to West. much to the chagrin of Stalin, who began to impose tougher restrictions and guotas on those wishing to relocate.

Things reached a head when, in 1952, Stalin created an inner-German border, thus cutting off travel between the two. Berlin, however, represented a major loophole in this plan, given that movement was easily facilitated, not least by train.

When these routes were eventually removed, the Soviets accelerated plans to limit further movement - by 1961, 3.5 million East Germans had fled, totalling 20 per cent of the population. Left behind was an older, poorer demographic, hamstrung by a regime that repressed and stifled capitalism.

The Berlin Wall (in many places two walls and a no man's land) therefore came to represent a physical and social barrier for a divided nation. At a height of 3.6 metres, it spanned 96 miles around West Berlin, containing 20 bunkers and more than 300 watchtowers. Across 28 years its 'death strip' accounted for the lives of 140 people desperate for freedom, vearning to be reunited with loved ones.

However, the opening of the Iron Curtain between Austria and Hungary in August 1989 set in place a chain of events whereby the Eastern Bloc had disintegrated and East Germany, as an entity, was no more. By November 9, the call came for guards to allow free passage of movement, and by that evening tens of thousands took to the streets to begin breaking, hammering and dismantling the Wall.

The united Germany is now an even more enriched, prosperous and tolerant country for its past ills, and the Wall, still present in places, sits as a reminder of past mistakes.



he concept is great - cleaner, cheaper, some may even say smoother driving. Electric cars have given us a new way of getting from A to B, but for many considering investing in one of the greenest advancements ever conceived, the need to recharge at such regular intervals has been a major stumbling block.

And yet, improvements in technology have meant the range of our electric vehicles is better than ever. Take this year's Tesla Model S. for instance. Elon Musk's pioneering vehicle brand is ripping up the rule book and this shimmering, humming piece of tarmac tech will take you 402 miles on a single charge... that's right up there with petrol and diesel vehicles. The only downside is the £75,000 price tag.

And if you fancy a hybrid of electric and traditional fuel, check out the 2018 Toyota Camry LE. This will get you an almost mindboggling 689 miles - that's the equivalent of driving from London to Amsterdam... and back.

If you want to go for a purely electric car without needing to remortgage the house - in other words, steer clear of Teslas, who occupy four of the top five positions for range, with their X (351 miles), 3 (322 miles) and Y (316 miles) models - then have a look at the Chevrolet Bolt EV. You'll be looking at around £30,000 for a car that will take you well over 250 miles on one charge.

Hyundai (the Kona Electric also hits 250 miles) and Kia (the Niro Electric will take you 230 miles before you plug in again) both represent good value, and 2018 models can be picked up second-hand for around £15.000. For those seeking a bit more status, there is of course the ever-popular Jaquar I-PACE. Up to 300 miles in a car that balances eco and image perfectly... what's not to like?





THE AIM: Change the word at the top of the ladder one letter at a time to make the word at the bottom.

HOW TO: Change one letter on each step to make a new word. By the time you reach the end, you should have created the new word.

DO NOT rearrange the order of the letters.

TIP: There is usually more than one way to solve this puzzle.


