HOW THE SPECTRE OF COVID-19 COULD, EVENTUALLY, START TO SAVE LIVES

hile in the short-term at least it feels as though the coronavirus pandemic has restricted and impacted the lives we for so long took for granted, scientists believe the messenger ribonucleic acid (mRNA) technology used to create the COVID-19 vaccine may have truly ground-breaking effects on our ability to fend off fatal diseases in the future.

At the heart of this theory is the way mRNA vaccines are being regarded as a breakthrough in modern medicine. This is because the mRNA works in a different way from traditional vaccines - namely that instead of implanting a tiny piece of the virus for our bodies to counter, it simply supplies information about what the virus looks like.

The body is told what the spike protein resembles. and it is this spike that provides the route for

COVID-19 to infect our cells.

The mRNA vaccine subsequently gives our body the information which teaches our cells how to make the protein that triggers an immune response inside our bodies. Extending the usefulness of this means personalised vaccines can, in theory, be developed so our immune systems can attack and kill off an illness that is specifically ours. So that could mean the potential to be able to cure everything from cancer to HIV to autoimmune diseases.

Scientists have been cautious not to overstate the theory, particularly because cancer, for instance, constantly mutates, and no two cancers are the

What is clear, however, is that this could be a major game-changer for the preservation of life... and we would have COVID-19 to thank for it.

FASHION



SQUARE

A square nail is straight with sharp edges that are squared off at the tip. This nail shape suits those with a shorter nail. Although you may be told that shorter nails do not suit darker shades, this nail shape can actually accommodate all polish colours.

An oval nail is round in shape with corners that curve inwards. Ideal if you are growing a manicure out, this nail shape suits those with medium length nails and narrow nail beds. You can rock any shade with oval nails.

COFFIN

Similar to the square shape but slightly more angular, a coffin nail has a straight-edged tip that is tapered in. To achieve this shape, a long nail is needed. Dark shades can look harsh on coffin nails, so opt for lighter colours.

ROUND


A round nail has straight sides that round up with a flat-edged tip. Best if you need short nails for work, round nails are easy to get used to and lend themselves well to bright-coloured polish and nail art.

ALMOND

An almond nail is essentially an oval shape that comes to a soft point. Suited to medium nails, this shape helps to slenderise wide fingers and to give the appearance of slimmer hands. Pair with a neutral polish.

STILETTO

Definitely one of the most eye-catching nail shapes, a stiletto nail is long and spiky, with the point curving to the base like a triangle. You must have long nails to achieve this shape. Not suited to those who type for a living or carry out manual labour, red is definitely the couleur du jour for stiletto nails.



EYE EXERCISE 1: Palming

- Rub your hands together for 10 seconds to create heat and energy
- Look straight ahead and gently place your palms over your closed eyes
- Take a few deep breaths and allow the darkness and heat to soothe your eves
- Leave until the warmth fades

EYE EXERCISE 2: Blinking

- Sit with your shoulders relaxed and your neck
- Blink your eyes very fast for 10-15 seconds
- Gently allow your eyes to close and settle
- Repeat every hour if using a screen all day

EYE EXERCISE 3: Zooming

- Sit in a comfortable position
- Focus on an object in the distance for five seconds
- Move your focus to a closer object for a further five seconds

- Move your focus to something very close to you, such as your hand, for five seconds
- Reverse your gaze back to the middle object and then to the one furthest away
- Repeat for two minutes

EYE EXERCISE 4: Rolling

- Sit with your shoulders relaxed and your neck
- Look to the right and then slowly roll your eyes up towards the ceiling
- Roll your eyes down to your left and then down to the floor
- Do this in both clockwise and anticlockwise directions

EYE EXERCISE 5: Figure of Eight

- Sit in a comfortable position
- Raise your hand in front of you at eye level
- Extend your thumb and focus on it
- Start to move your arm in a figure of eight shape
- Keep tracing for 30 seconds and then switch directions

WHY WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND THE HUGE IMPACT OF THE MEAT INDUSTRY

hough we may still umm and ahh over the full implications of climate change, there is one fact we are no longer able to deny, and that is that eating meat is not good for the environment. In an era when our food comes perfectly packaged

in innocent-looking fillet and steak packs, it is easy to detach ourselves from the reality of what we are consuming. Unfortunately, though, industrial meat farming has very real implications for our natural world.

For starters, there's the questionable treatment of animals being farmed on a large scale. Often kept in cramped and unsanitary conditions, these creatures have a poor quality of life and weak immune systems, which makes them more vulnerable to illness and the potential to spread disease.

Second, eating meat has a negative impact on climate change. Industrial meat is the biggest cause

of deforestation globally, as farmers in countries such as Brazil start forest fires to make room for cattle grazing and to grow industrial animal feed, such as soya. Removing the trees' ability to turn CO2 into oxygen, these fires also release huge quantities of carbon dioxide into the air.

Finally, meat-eating is inefficient. It takes up to seven kilograms of grain to produce one kilogram of beef, which is incredibly wasteful in comparison to eating vegetables or grains, which we grow and then eat, cutting out the middleman (or cow).

However, dyed-in-the-wool carnivores need not fret, for no one is suggesting to remove meat entirely from your diet. Recent campaigns prefer to focus on the consideration of small changes, with quality over quantity. Eating local meat from a trusted and ethical farm is a great place to start, as is abstaining from the pleasure perhaps one day each week.

Mangosteen

n undeniably attractive fruit, the bright purple mangosteen is so much more I than just a pretty face. With a mouthwatering, fragrant flavour and a multitude of health benefits, this tropical fruit is definitely one you should try this summer.

Described as a delicious combination of lychee, peach, strawberry and pineapple, the mangosteen boasts a slightly sweet and sour flavour which is quite unlike any fruit you have tasted before.

Offering a rich supply of nutrients, fibre and unique antioxidants, the mangosteen is low in calories and fat, making it a great snack for those who crave a sweet fix during the day.

Although this fruit is easy to eat and prepare, it can be a little bit more difficult to find, as mangosteen is only in season for a short period of time. Your best bet is to head to your local Asian market, or you may be able to find it frozen or canned at the supermarket.

To remove the fruit, cut a circle into the thick skin around the stalk and lift it off like a lid. This will reveal the segments of mangosteen, which resemble those of an orange, but are bright white in colour. The seeds are soft and edible so do not need to be taken out.

- > Eat fresh either on its own or combined with other fruits in a fruit salad
- > Juice them
- > Blend and make sorbet or ice cream
- > Add to a curry

Ripe, whole mangosteen will last a few days at room temperature, whereas unripe mangosteen can last 1-2 weeks. Store in the fridge for 3-4 weeks. Do not freeze as this will damage the flesh.

THE SAFETY MEASURES YOU NEED TO PUT IN PLACE WHEN PURCHASING A TRAMPOLINE

n the face of it, it's hard to believe that trampolining is one of the more hazardous leisure pursuits out there; yet the activity accounts for almost 100,000 injuries requiring medical attention every year. Put another way, more than half of parents with children aged 12 have said their child has come to harm at some point.

The reality is, while the spring-mounted tarpaulin offers the softest of landings, kids are making contact from considerable height, and with others close by. And with a prevalence of injuries being caused by freak, awkward landings - sprains and strains account for almost half of injuries recorded - even the most cautious of happy hoppers can come unstuck.

Of course, there are a few measures you can take in order to minimise the risk of injury:

BOUNCE ALONE

Guidelines suggest kids should trampoline by themselves rather than with buddies. Colliding with others in a confined space is common and dangerous, and the trampoline canvas will most

likely knock a juvenile jumper off their feet if a friend lands a split-second earlier.

☑ PROTECTIVE WALL

Most trampolines nowadays come with 360-degree netting around the edges, eliminating the danger of kids being propelled off the apparatus and into nearby hedges. If any part of the edging is broken, however, your safety net is gone, both metaphorically and literally.

✓ SIX OF ONE

It's recommended that no children 'bounce' if under the age of six. The reason for this is vounger kids lack the muscular strength to be able to trampoline safely, leaving them more likely to come to harm.

✓ SUPERVISION

Perhaps the greatest deterrent of all is adult supervision. Sure, you may not want to spend your summer afternoons watching kids bounce up and down repetitively, but it's sure as hell a better sight than the inside of the A&E department.

hatever style blinds you have, and in whichever material, discover how to banish dirt and dust without breaking a sweat.

FABRIC BLINDS

Start by dusting your fabric blinds from top to bottom. You can use a vacuum cleaner to save time. Next, spot clean your blinds using a mild detergent solution. If your fabric blinds are really grubby, you may prefer to take them down and soak in the bath with three tablespoons of washing-up liquid. Leave to soak for half an hour to an hour and then clean with a soft brush.

Suitable for vertical, roman, roller, panel and pleated-style blinds.

WOODEN BLINDS

Real wood blinds do not like moisture so you should focus on maintaining a consistent dusting routine above all else. If your wooden blinds do

require more than just a dust, use a very slightly moist cloth to remove any dirt or grime. Be sure not to rub the slats too aggressively as this can ruin the wood stain.

This method is suitable for both vertical and horizontal slats.

FAUX WOOD BLINDS

The good news is that faux wood blinds are made from plastic and are therefore not susceptible to water damage. This means that once you have dusted your blinds, you can wash them thoroughly with a bowl of warm, soapy water and a cloth. Blot dry with a soft cloth or kitchen roll.

METAL BLINDS

The easiest way to clean metal blinds is by taking them down and placing them in a bathtub filled with warm water, a few squirts of washing-up liquid and a cup of baking soda. Leave to soak for about an hour and then rinse with warm water.

SIX ALTERNATIVE USES FOR FABRIC SOFTENER AROUND THE HOME

Ithough its main purpose is to condition your clothes, fabric softener has the ability to facilitate many other household tasks. Check out our favourite ways to use this cheap and cheerful liquid below.

1. TO STRIP WALLPAPER

Once you have scoured your wallpaper, mix one cap full of fabric softener into 1/4 litre of water and apply with a sponge to the wall. Leave to sit for 20 minutes and then you should be able to scrape off the wallpaper with ease.

2. TO ELIMINATE HARD-WATER STAINS

If you struggle to remove hard-water stains from your glassware, apply undiluted fabric softener to the stain, leave for 10 minutes and wipe off with a cloth. Wash and rinse before use.

3. TO REMOVE BURNT FOOD

To remove burnt food without ruining your pots and pans, fill them with warm water and then add a few drops of fabric softener. Let them sit for an hour and any burnt food should wipe straight off. Wash and rinse before use.

4. TO CLEAN PAINT BRUSHES

Fabric softener is a surfactant, meaning it makes water wetter, and is therefore ideal for removing water-based paint from your brushes. Mix one cup of water and one teaspoon of fabric softener and dip your brushes in for up to 30 seconds.

5. TO MAKE HOME-MADE ROOM FRESHENER

Save money on room fresheners by mixing one part fabric softener and two parts water with two tablespoons of baking soda. Pour into a spray bottle and spray liberally around your home. This can also be used to repel insects.

6. TO BANISH DUST

Hard surfaces in your home are prone to dust. Minimise these pesky particles by creating a spray solution that is made from 1/4 cup of fabric softener and one cup of water. Spray onto the surface and wipe away with a dry cloth.

One of the stars of I'm a Celebrity...Get Me Out of Here! in 2019 – he finished third behind Andrew Whyment and Jacqueline Jossa - the talented presenter has drawn on profound personal upset in putting together a recent BBC3 documentary. Roman Kemp: Our Silent Emergency, which was released in March 2021, has been nominated for a National Television Award.

"I come at this from the perspective of having known someone who took his own life, and having

off depression myself where, in my darkest hours. I have considered

Kemp said that his mum, famous saved his life. At his darkest moment, she made sure he wasn't alone and allowed him to confide in her about his suicidal thoughts. When he called her in crisis, she stayed on the phone with him as she travelled to London to be by his side.

Kemp was devastated by the loss

of his close friend and fellow Capital Breakfast colleague, Joe Lyons, in August 2020. Recognising when friends are in trouble and encouraging people to open up about their emotions is at the heart of Kemp's work across both TV and radio. championing a trend for people to be outspoken and honest about their feelings.

He said: "It shook me back then and it continues to now. I still have days where I can't believe he isn't here, and I didn't see the signs.

"I actually think we're in a much better place than we were 10 years ago when it comes to speaking out and having the confidence to say what's really on our minds, what's really troubling us.

"The problem, I feel, is that this is being counterbalanced by so many other pressures, and lots of those stem from social media. I don't think we can change how Twitter, Facebook and Instagram have altered our lives, yet we can teach people to approach and view those influences in different ways. Obviously, the strands run much deeper than just that, but it is a good place to start.

"We all need to play our part. It's an old cliché, but to save just one life makes it all worthwhile."

She explained: "First Step has given us hope and gotten us prepared for Freya to start a mainstream nursery soon.





Hornchurch and Upminster

By the time this column is published, we shall know whether Hornchurch FC have been victorious in the FA Trophy Final at Wembley. Win or lose against Hereford, however, making it to the final is a tremendous achievement and the community spirit that has been shown in supporting the Mighty Urchins has been fantastic. My team and I have worked with the club's supporters' association leading up to the match to help get everyone involved in the celebrations, and local businesses in Hornchurch High Street and beyond have really stepped up. Whatever the result, this will be a community event to remember for a long time.

I know how glad and relieved everyone was that we could move ahead with Step 3 of the roadmap on May 17 and get indoor hospitality back open and households mixing again. Ahead of that step, I met the chief executive and chairman of Queen's Hospital to get the latest picture on COVID-19 locally, which was much more positive. We reflected on how far we have come since our difficult meetings over Christmas, and spoke about the urgent work that now needs to be done to tackle backloas.

Since my last column, we have also begun a new session of Parliament with the Queen's Speech on May 11. The government has set out an exciting agenda. I spoke in the debates about our new lifetime skills guarantee to enable flexible access to highquality education and training throughout people's lives. More support will be given to the NHS, police will be given a range of new powers to fight crime, asylum laws will be overhauled, and new planning laws will boost housebuilding. I am ministerial sponsor for the Procurement Bill, which we hope will give small and medium-sized UK businesses more opportunities to bid for government contracts now that we are out of the EU. We will also invest huge amounts in research and development to boost our reputation as a scientific superpower.

Ahead of the G7 and COP26 climate conference, I spoke to a group of local residents about plans in the Queen's Speech to improve our environment. I know that residents are also very interested in animal welfare



and will welcome new laws to promote the highest standards.

So there is a lot to be getting on with, using our recovery from the pandemic as a catalyst to do things differently and better in the future in a whole range of areas.

In May 2022, there will be local elections across Havering. This time, residents will be electing councillors for new wards, with new boundaries and names that truly reflect their historic character. For too long, the powers that be have discarded neighbourhood, parish and historic names. Wards like Brooklands.

Pettits and Havering Park had names that did not represent the true identity of these communities, so change was needed, and I proposed all the changes that have now been adopted.

The Boundary Commission has done excellent work drawing up the new wards, uniting local communities within the same area, with sensible geographical boundaries and names that make sense to local people.

The wonderfully historic name of Havering-atte-Bower will, at last, have a ward named after the village. St Edward's is also returning to the map, which is only right, given St Edward is Romford's patron saint, along with St Albans, both named after town centre parishes, replacing the old ward of Romford Town.

Brooklands Ward has gone but has been replaced by the much more appropriate name of Rush Green and Crowlands, giving both communities equal recognition. Pettits is also scrapped, but the new name of Marshalls and Rise Park really does represent actual names of the neighbourhoods within that ward, replicating the names of two popular local schools as well. Mawneys Ward keeps its name, but takes in more of Collier Row.

Squirrels Heath was due for the chop originally, but after my campaign, the ward and this popular name have been saved, keeping the communities of Gidea Park, Ardleigh Green and Heath Park together in one ward. In Hornchurch, Hylands will be renamed Hylands and Harrow Lodge, referring to local parks that are treasured by our community. These changes will form part of our electoral map probably for the next 20 years, so it was important to get it right.

Armed robber jailed for 16 years

An armed robber from Hornchurch who targeted two banks and a post office in Redbridge has been jailed.

Steven Ifield, 52, of Park Lane, Hornchurch, appeared at Snaresbrook Crown Court recently. He was found guilty of two counts of robbery, one count of attempted robbery, and three counts of possession of an imitation firearm. He was sentenced to 16 years' imprisonment.

The charges are in relation to incidents between October 7 and November 7, 2019, during which Ifield targeted two banks and a post office in Gants Hill and Wanstead.

On two occasions, he produced an imitation handgun.

On the third occasion, he used a folded walking stick concealed inside a carrier bag and held it as if he were carrying a shotgun.

After demanding cash, he made off with £3,230 from one bank and £1,360 from the other.

His attempt to rob the post office was foiled when staff refused to open the till, telling him it was on a time lock.

Detectives identified Ifield after tracing the route he took as he fled the scene of each robbery.



Life is a rollercoaster

By the time you read this, the third (of four) steps of the lockdown relaxation would have been in effect for a few weeks. This is the most dangerous step by far. Bars and restaurants will reopen for people to sit inside. Why is this dangerous? In the open air, the COVID-19 particles are blown away and the chance of someone becoming infected is very much reduced. Inside, the particles can build up; they can land or pass onto other surfaces where they can be picked up.

Fingers crossed, the number of people who have been vaccinated will prevent the spread of the virus.

It will be great to finally see the back of the pandemic. Please keep aware, wear a mask, wash your hands regularly, and avoid touching your face.

Give an inch and they take a mile

Parking bays were made free for a month from April 17. This included all on-street parking bays and council-owned car parks.

While this was a good offer from the council to encourage us to come back to the shops, some people took advantage of this generosity and parked their vehicles all day outside the shops and were not staying local.

This had the opposite effect to what was hoped for. Next time, the council may have to rethink the offer; perhaps free parking with a time limit requiring the resident to claim a new ticket every two hours.

Sainsbury's recycling - not what it used to be

The recycling bins disappeared from Sainsbury's on Hornchurch High Street a couple of months ago. I enquired why and was told that Sainsbury's UK had



started a new contract with a different recycling bin supplier.

When the new bins were finally delivered, after a delay, they were woefully inadequate. The bins had less than one-quarter of the previous bins' capacity.

I have been in touch with the management to discuss options available. The situation is being monitored. With luck, further capacity will be added.

In the meantime, if the bins are full, please do not leave your rubbish and recycling next to the bin. This is fly tipping.

There are several alternative recycling areas not too far away, including in Fentiman Way, Elm Park Library car park, Tesco Roneo Corner, Gallows Corner and Airfield Estate.

Traffic safety measure introduced

Anew experimental traffic measure at a busy Hornchurch junction has been introduced.

Havering Council has confirmed that there will be new traffic measures aimed at improving road safety at the junction of Wingletve Lane and Minster Way.

This will mean that motorists will have to turn left from Minster Way onto Wingletye Lane, and there will be no left turn from Wingletye Lane onto Minster Way.

The new traffic measure will last a maximum of 18 months, with residents invited to comment during the first six months of the scheme going live.

Councillor Osman Dervish, Havering's cabinet member for environment, said the scheme has been introduced in response to concerns from residents.



If you are not sure if a particular plant needs watering, simply test the soil using your finger. Poke down a few inches below the stem to check the root zone. If it feels dry below the surface, get out your hose. Alternatively, use a soil moisture meter.

The best time to water your plants is first thing in the morning, as this will allow the water to soak in before it evaporates either from heat or wind. Avoid watering in the heat of the day.

3. AIM FOR THE BASE OF THE PLANT

Always water your plants at their base and avoid getting the leaves, fruits or vegetables wet. This helps prevent diseases that thrive on moisture, such as powdery mildew.

4. PROVIDE A SLOW AND DEEP WATERING Plants benefit more from a slow and deep watering keep going until water starts to run from the bottom. For plants that are bedded in the garden, water until the soil is wet six inches below the surface.

5. USE THE RIGHT TOOLS

For best results, water your garden using a watering wand, a long-neck watering can, a soaker hose or a drip system. Alternatively, recycled plastic bottles make a great deep watering system. Simply cut the bottom off and bury upside down next to your plants. Add water to the bottle through the top and the water will be absorbed more deeply into the soil.

QUICK TOP TIPS:

- > Brown leaf edges or yellow leaves can indicate overwatering
- > Apply 2–3 inches of organic mulch to retain more
- > Fruit and vegetable plants need a consistent supply of water to produce well.



Bobby TO BORIS

MARKING 300 YEARS SINCE THE UK'S FIRST PRIME MINISTER

I hile the supposition – usually by members of the party in opposition, predictably – is that modern politics is decorated with elected representatives engaged in poor behaviour, underhand dealings and general miscreant activity, the reality is that this has been going on for centuries - all the way back to the time of Sir Robert Walpole.

"Who is he?" you ask. Well none other than the United Kingdom's first Prime Minister.

This year marks the 300th anniversary of his appointment – a stirring rise to the top for someone born in 1676 to a wealthy landowning family in Norfolk.

Cambridge-educated, Walpole was named member of parliament for Castle Rising in 1701 for the Whigs; and while he briefly lost elected power when the Tories won a General Election in 1710 - at which point he was imprisoned briefly on charges of corruption - he returned to front-line duties when George I came to the throne in 1714.

His ascent was built on a desire for peace abroad, low taxation and a reduction of the national debt; and while he became embroiled in various scandals as First Lord of the Treasury, Chancellor of the Exchequer and Paymaster General, his ability to speak for both the people and the upper-class elite who ran the country ultimately preserved his time at the top table. It also ensured a gift from George II of 10 Downing Street, where the current Prime Minister still resides today.

Walpole was comfortable in his role until the late 1730s, when pressure began to build from within his party. A poor election result in 1741 followed and he resigned from his post shortly afterwards. Within three years he was dead, though his political legacy lives on.





Refund rules

Te've all had purchases go bad, and when that happens the immediate fear is whether we'll get our money back

In most instances, the answer is "yes". Certainly, if you buy anything online you are protected by the 2015 Consumer Rights Act. That means, for whatever reason including simply changing your mind - you will be able to return your goods. You'll usually need to do this within 14 days in order to get a full refund, and obviously items must be sent back in the same condition as they were received.

When purchasing in store, things become a little different. You will struggle to get refunds for perishables unless you are returning in an almost immediate timeframe - such as buying a sandwich only to immediately discover the bread is stale.

In other situations, the product will need to be defective or not fit for purpose, at which point the retailer is allowed to attempt to repair or replace. Be warned, though, simply having changed your mind isn't a verified reason for a refund, and vou may discover some pushback.

Of course, while these hard and fast rules reflect a stated code of conduct when it comes to refund rights, things can often veer either side of the line. You may sometimes encounter an overly officious staff member or customer service agent who makes life difficult; though more likely you'll find retailers going the extra yard to refund in some circumstances when they perhaps don't need to

legally. Ultimately, good publicity - and bad - travels.

VIRGINIA WADE

Courting triumph, celebrating a golden day in 1977... Wade cementing her place in tennis folklore

ack in 1977, England's Virginia Wade was on the verge of completing a specular Grand Slam quadruplet. Already with US Open (1968), Australian Open (1972) and French Open (1973) titles to her name across singles and doubles, she just required victory at SW19 to complete a clean sweep of major honours.

There were times during her run to the final at Wimbledon when it seemed that elusive title would evade her, though, In the fourth round, and before the days of tie-breaks, she needed nine games to win the first set against Romanian Mariana Simionescu; while she recovered from a set down in the semi-final against Chris Evert.

The final itself, held on July 2, had an air of Britishness about it. The Queen's Silver Jubilee had taken place not five months previously, and Elizabeth II was present on Centre Court to witness, she hoped, a homegrown champion.

away from Wade when she lost the first set 6-4 to Betty Stöve. However, the Bournemouth-born star, who studied mathematics and physics at the University of Sussex before turning pro, came back 6-3 in the second after producing an array of dazzling winners.

In the deciding set, the electric atmosphere coupled with the pinpoint, aggressive shot-making that was such an important part of her game, saw the Brit home, as she demolished her Dutch rival 6-1 Wade had done it.

Celebrating her 32nd birthday a week after the championships ended, she remains one of the oldest female Wimbledon champions.

Wade, who had been world number one in 1975. didn't spend a single day outside the top 10 in a 12-year period beginning in 1967, and finally retired in 1985. She moved into media work and, to this

CELEBRATING 50 YEARS OF THE ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL

It shows you just how far cricket has come when you consider that when England played Australia in the first ever ODI - that is, a 'One Day International', comprising 40 overs per side - the concept was seen as being

> as a money-making exercise Down Under after the Third Ashes test of 1971 had fallen foul of the weather.

> > To think that a new format could come into play to disrupt the five-day sensibilities of 'traditional cricket'. where batsmen and bowlers would toil endlessly in a match lasting almost three-quarters of a week (with a common outcome being a draw), was churlish.

Indeed, the ODI, from the outset. wasn't hugely popular. Australia won that first landmark game, predictably, and other nations around the world were nervous to throw caution to the wind in the same way as might a limitedover batsman tasked with both accelerated run-scoring and wicket preservation.

As time went on, the ODI set-up found its popularity climb thanks to World Cup cricket, particularly during the 1980s; and, of course, as long-suffering England fans, we had to wait until 2019 when Ben Stokes, Jos Buttler and co snatched a stunning victory against New Zealand at Lord's to finally bring the trophy back to the shores where this great game was invented.

England have remained right up there with the world's best at the one-day format, despite minor aberrations in form of late.

Its future does appear somewhat cloudy, though, given the popularity of T20 cricket and the emergence of The Hundred - both shorter, punchier forms of the game. Though like a middle-distance runner sneering at both

sprinters and marathon runners alike as he pursues a measured, masterful, classy approach to his craft, so too does the ODI package occupy a middle ground that now feels as much a part of our cricket heritage as leather, willow, pads, stumps and endless rain delays.



t was back in 2017 that former Transport Secretary Chris Grayling MP announced that self-driving cars could be present on UK roads by the year 2021, a claim reinforced by the head of the Society of Motor Manufacturers and Traders as being a realistic aim.

In reality, we won't be seeing fleets of driverless cars tearing down our A roads in 2021, but we can expect the first few to pop up later in the year. Perhaps this delay is a result of lockdown, perhaps the dramatic slowing of the motor industry as a whole in light of the global pandemic.


And yet, the idea of self-driving cars still holds firm, and it may not be long until we do see highend manufacturers fully embracing what will be the most dramatic motoring ever. The benefits include fewer incidents on the road (94 per cent of accidents are caused by human error), less congestion and improved transport connectivity, not to mention greater mobility options for elderly, disabled and

young users.

The UK wants to be regarded as a leader in this field, with the prediction being that by 2035 more than 40 per cent of new cars will have self-driving capabilities. Automated Vehicle (AV) technology could be worth more than £40billion, and will bring 40,000 jobs to the country.

More than £200million has been invested so far in start-ups looking to fuel this motoring revolution, with the advancement of Intelligent Roads helping to move ideas forward.

There is just one issue though – AVs work perfectly when surrounded by other AVs. It is only when these brilliant computers are asked to interact with human drivers that potential collisions occur. It seems the scientists will have to overcome this somewhat fundamental flaw before we can call on our trusty computerised four-wheeled motors to deposit us home safely.
