

A DATE to REMEMBER



CELEBRATING 25 YEARS SINCE THE WOMEN'S INSTITUTE CALENDAR THAT TO DATE HAS RAISED MORE THAN £6MILLION FOR BLOOD CANCER RESEARCH

t happened 25 years ago – a funny, unconventional and cheeky method (in more ways than one), to honour a cancer victim at the Rylstone and District branch of the Women's Institute.

Wind the clock forward and the brilliance of these Yorkshire women has raised millions of pounds, as well as sparking a Hollywood blockbuster.

The story began when Angela Knowles' husband, John, was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin lymphoma in February 1998.

The devastating diagnosis sparked an interesting idea from Angela's daughter-in-law, who suggested they give those close to them a sunflower plant in the hope that when the flowers bloomed, John would be in remission.

Sadly, he died a mere five months later at the age

of 54, on July 22, 1998.

Amid her grief, Angela was looking for something positive to put her energy into. Her friend and fellow Yorkshire Ladies Women's Institute member, Tricia Stewart, suggested they find a fun way to raise money for a new sofa on the ward where John was treated. They settled, as you do, on a Pirelli-style nude calendar!

A suggestion that started as nothing more than a joke had suddenly become serious. With all profits going to Blood Cancer UK (Leukaemia & Lymphoma Research as it was then), a growing party of ladies was ready to take part.

The women tastefully posed nude for the calendar, each covering themselves strategically with items related to their interests or the Women's Institute.

such as baked goods, flower arrangements and knitting. Each picture also included a sunflower, which became the emblem for the Calendar Girls.

The initial plan was to print 1,000 calendars to be sold for £5 each, but the minimum print run was 5,000. Just as well, because by the time the calendar first became available on April 12, 1999, the publicity was so enormous that the first run was soon snapped up. Eventually, they shipped 56,000 calendars, raising £322,000.

The Calendar Girls' story gained more popularity when it was adapted into a successful film in 2003, directed by Nigel Cole and starring the great Dames Helen Mirren DBE and Julie Walters DBE.

In 2012, Gary Barlow OBE and Tim Firth began writing songs for a musical based on the tireless

fundraisers. *The Girls* opened at the Leeds Grand in 2015 and toured across the UK, receiving widespread acclaim. The show hit stages across the country again earlier this year.

Over the years, Angela and her gal pals have released several more calendars (including a 10-year anniversary edition in 2010), and even presented calendars to Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother.

The story resonates with many because of its portrayal of ordinary women doing something extraordinary for a good cause, and certainly John would have been immensely proud of his wife and her friends. A terrible illness, which stole a beloved husband in five months, has been transformed into 25 years of hope for millions.



WHY DOES SIZE MATTER WHEN YOU'RE DEALING WITH BRITAIN'S SMALLEST PUBS

hey say a pint of beer is the perfect representation of something that's small, yet perfectly formed. Extending that idea to the immediate surroundings is the name of the game when it comes to searching out (and getting into) the UK's smallest pubs.

That ultimate accolade goes to The Nutshell in Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk. Measuring 15x7ft, this is a boozer than can only accommodate 15 people at a time (although there is outside seating space). The Victorian pub is plastered with memorabilia and quirky ephemera and is a true gem.

The Nutshell takes the crown because of the offseason closure of The Signal Box Inn in Cleethorpes. No prizes for guessing what clever use has been made of an outdated relic from the golden era of our railways. At just 8ft x 8ft, the knocking of someone's pint with a stray elbow is less a possibility and more an inevitability. Another challenger is The Lakeside Inn on Southport promenade. This place did hold the official record for the UK's smallest pub back in 1989, but has since been trumped by the aforementioned tiny taverns.

A little closer to home, The Rake in Borough Market is miniscule, while if you're ever in Surrey, venture to Claygate to sup a pint at Platform 3, a pub converted from an old station waiting room.

Elsewhere in the capital, The Euston Tap on Euston Road and The Dove in Hammersmith also feature in the top 10.

The seismic achievements of Britain's smallest pubs are a shot (in the arm, and of the alcoholic nature) to the continued popularity of pubs in the UK. At the last count, there were 27,650 small pubs welcoming adventurous lovers of alcohol – albeit for the establishments on this list, it's strictly one-in, one-out!

A GUIDE TO CHOOSING THE RIGHT BELT FOR YOUR **BODY SHAPE**



Then you see hairs popping up on parts of your body where you definitely do not want them, it can be all too tempting to reach for the tweezers and give them a good old pluck. However, there are certain areas of the body where you should not use this hair removal technique.

X NOSE HAIRS: You should never pluck your nose hairs as these are there to prevent bacteria and infections. Instead, if you have very visible hairs growing out of your nose, it is a much better idea to simply trim them.

X HAIR ON MOLES: If you have hairs growing on or around any moles on your body, then you should not pluck these as this can lead to inflammation and can also increase the risk of the area becoming infected.

> X INGROWN HAIRS: Ingrown hairs can be both unsightly and uncomfortable, but that doesn't mean you should go at them with a pair of tweezers. A much safer and more effective solution is to use a combination of steam, scrubs and exfoliation.

X SENSITIVE AREAS OF SKIN: Areas of skin such as under your arms, around your nipples and your bikini line should not be plucked. This is because the skin is incredibly sensitive in these areas and can easily become irritated or scarred.

HOW TO PLUCK EFFECTIVELY:

You can safely pluck other areas of your body, such as your chin, upper lip, eyebrows, toes and knuckles, using the below

- ✓ Always sterilise your tweezers before use or use a brand-
- ✓ Pull out the hair at an angle, following the grain of the hair.
- Pluck after showering for best results.
- ✓ Apply aloe vera lotion after plucking to soothe the skin.
 - √ Take an over-the-counter painkiller 45 minutes before plucking to decrease discomfort.

MAINTENANCE

HOW OFTEN ARE YOU CLEANING AND REPLACING YOUR MAKE-UP BRUSHES?

t can be easy to forget to clean your make-up tools but remember that you use these brushes on your face daily. Would you only clean your face towel once every six months? Of course not. So, treat your make-up brushes in the same way.

How often to clean your make-up brushes

- > Concealer and foundation brushes should be cleaned once a week.
- > Eye shadow brushes should be cleaned fortnightly.
- > If you suffer from breakouts, you should consider washing your brushes after every use.

How to clean your brushes

- > Mix a spoonful of gentle shampoo with a cup of warm (not hot) water.
- > Dip your brushes, one at a time, into the liquid and gently massage the bristles to remove any dirt.
- > Rinse thoroughly with clean water, making sure to squeeze any excess liquid off the bristles.
- > Lay brushes down flat on a towel to dry.

How to store your brushes

- > Make-up brushes need a clean and spacious environment in order to prolong their shelf life.
- > Place your brushes bristle-side up in a sterilised mason jar or container.
- > Do not store too many brushes in any one container.
- > Do not keep your brushes in the bathroom or kitchen where bacteria can be picked up.

Then to replace your make-up brushes

- > If your brush no longer holds its original shape, then it needs to be replaced.
- > If shedding has occurred and your brush no longer has enough bristles to effectively apply your make-up
- > If you have damaged or broken the brush handle as bacteria can form in the cracks and be transported to your face.
- > As a rule, you should look to replacing your brushes every three to six months depending on their condition.

ibromyalgia Awareness Day 2024 is Sunday, May 12, so this month we're looking at the symptoms, causes and treatments. Fibromyalgia is a chronic condition that causes extreme tiredness and widespread pain. While there is no cure for fibromyalgia, you can manage your symptoms with the right treatments and

WHAT IS FIBROMYALGIA?

Fibromyalgia, also known as fibromyalgia syndrome, is a long-term health condition that causes pain all over the body. Other symptoms of fibromyalgia include: Increased sensitivity to pain Extreme fatigue Muscle stiffness Difficulty sleeping Problems with memory and concentration, known as fibro-fog Headaches Irritable bowel syndrome

WHAT CAUSES FIBROMYALGIA?

While the exact cause of fibromyalgia is unknown, it is thought to be linked to abnormal levels of certain chemicals in the brain and changes in the way the central nervous system processes pain

While fibromyalgia can also be inherited through your genes, in many cases, the condition appears to be triggered by a traumatic event, such as:

An injury or infection Childbirth An operation The breakdown of a relationship The death of a loved one

WHO IS MOST LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED?


Anyone can develop fibromyalgia, although this condition is seven times more common in women than it is in men. It most typically develops between the ages of 30 and 50 but can occur in both children and the elderly. An estimated one in 20 people is affected by fibromyalgia in the UK, but this is only a rough estimate as this condition can be hard to diagnose.

HOW IS FIBROMYALGIA TREATED?

As mentioned, there is no cure for fibromyalgia, but it can be managed with the right treatments. These tend to be a combination of:

- Medicines such as antidepressants and painkillers.
- Talking therapies, including cognitive behavioural therapy and counselling.
- Lifestyle changes such as exercise programmes and relaxation techniques.

WHAT IS PADDLEBOARDING?

Paddleboarding, or stand-up paddleboarding, is a water sport that enables you to enjoy and explore various waterways such as lakes, bays, rivers and even the sea. Unlike canoes or kayaks, paddleboards are completely flat and you can choose to stand, kneel or sit on them.

HOW TO STAND ON A PADDLEBOARD:

You need to learn the proper paddleboarding technique if you want to be able to control and manoeuvre the board and get maximum enjoyment and physical benefits from it.

- Stand next to the board in shallow water.
- > Place your paddle down on the board horizontally.
- > Attach the ankle leash if there is one.
- > Place your hands firmly on the paddle and kneel on the board just behind its halfway point.
- > When you feel like you have a good balance, slowly stand up.
- centre of the board which should be completely flat on the water.
- > Your feet should be facing forwards, about hipdistance apart with your knees slightly bent.

HOW TO PAD Engage your core muscles to help maintain

- > Keep your arms straight as you extend the paddle forward for each stroke.
- Make 4-5 short and close strokes on each side of the board and then switch sides, reversing your hand position.
- > To turn your board, keep paddling on one side (paddling on your right will make you turn left and vice versa).

WHERE TO PADDLEBOARD IN THE UK:

- Chichester Harbour, West Sussex Best for nature lovers
- River Fowey, Cornwall Best for stunning scenery
- > Saunton Sands, Devon Best for slow waves

Remember that coastal waters are tidal so always check out the tide times before you set out. Slack > Position yourself so that you are standing at the tides are best for beginners as this is when the tide is moving at its minimum. Always wear a lifejacket when paddleboarding and, if you are worried about safety, choose a beach or other waterway that has a lifequard present.



THE HOMEMADE WAY TO ENJOY **NATIONAL FISH AND CHIP DAY**

- pieces
- > 50g self-raising flour
- > 50g cornflour
- > 1 egg white
- > 125ml sparkling water
- > 600ml sunflower oil for frying
- > 800g unpeeled, even-sized Maris Piper or King Edward potatoes
- > 2 tbs olive oil
- > Salt and pepper to season

HOW TO MAKE THE CHIPS:

- 1. Cut the potatoes into 1.5cm thick chips.
- 2. Add to a saucepan of water, bring to the boil, lower the heat and simmer for 4-5 minutes.
- 3. Drain, pat dry and leave to cool.
- 4. Heat the oven to 220°C/200°C fan/gas mark 7.
- 5. Place a large, shallow roasting tray in the oven

- with 1tbs olive oil and heat for 10 minutes.
- 6. Mix the chips in a bowl with 1 tbs olive oil and then add to the roasting trav.
- 7. Bake for 5 minutes, turn them over and bake for a further 8-10 minutes until crisp.

HOW TO COOK THE FISH:

- 1. Place 1 tbs flour on a plate and coat each piece
- 2. Pour the sunflower oil into a heavy, non-stick wok and heat to 200°C.
- 3. Mix the rest of the flour, cornflour and seasoning.
- 4. Pour the sparkling water into the flour mix and gently whisk.
- 5. Whisk the egg white until frothy.
- 6. Add the egg white to the flour mix and lightly whisk. Try to retain as many bubbles as you can to keep the batter light.
- 7. Fry 2 pieces of fish at a time, dipping them in the batter to coat and then lowering them into the oil using a slotted spoon.
- 8. Fry for 5-6 minutes, turning the fish halfway through to ensure it is golden all over.

Serve your fish and chips with some peas, mushy or normal, and a wedge of lemon.

The cherry ON THE CAKE

hat fruit announces summer better than glossy and ripe British cherries, often grown on family farms or orchards in the south of England, particularly in Kent?

Cherries may be small, but they're also scrumptious - and pack a big nutritional punch. They're one of your five-a-day and packed with vitamins, minerals and antioxidants. This includes vitamins A and C, vital for your skin and immune system, and potassium, essential for heart health and regulating blood pressure.

Cherries, particularly tart cherries, are also great to snack on if you're struggling from sleep disorders. Sweet cherries are high in melatonin, a sleepinducing hormone, so try eating some around an hour before you go to bed.

If you're looking for a sweet treat for your next

BBQ, or feel like making a celebratory bake for any other special occasion this summer, why not indulge in this delectable cherry cake?

YOU WILL NEED:

250g plain flour 2 tsp baking powder 1/2 tsp salt 115g unsalted butter, softened 200g granulated sugar 2 large eggs 120ml milk with 1 tsp vanilla extract added 400g fresh cherries, pitted and chopped | Icing sugar to decorate (optional)

HOW TO MAKE:

PUFFIN PARADISE

ooking for a great place to visit during the May half term? Consider exploring the Farne -Islands, a group of 28 islands a few miles off the Northumberland coast.

WHAT CAN I SEE?

May and June are special in the Farne Islands because that's when puffins come here to have their babies, known as pufflings. There are 37,000 breeding pairs of puffins on the islands - more than anywhere else in the UK. The birds are drawn to the safe nesting sites on the islands' cliff edges and a plentiful supply of sandeels - their favourite food. These are actually a type of fish, not eels.

The best way to see the Farne Islands is to take a boat trip from Seahouses, a small village on the coast. Several companies organise the trips, but it's best to book in advance. You can sail around the islands and, weather permitting, land on one of them, usually Inner Farne.

How to keep your plant LEAVES CLEAN

re the leaves on your indoor plants looking a little dirty and dusty? Do you wish they would return to their original shine? While it can be a tedious job, a clean houseplant is happier, healthier and better equipped to improve the air quality in your home.

√ DO be gentle

When cleaning the leaves of your indoor plants, you need to make sure that you do so gently so that you don't damage them. Use a damp cloth or paper towel to carefully remove any dust and then allow to air dry.

X DON'T buy expensive cleaning sprays

You don't need to buy expensive cleaning sprays to clean your plant leaves. Just add a squirt of liquid washing detergent to a bowl of lukewarm water and gently clean as detailed above. Alternatively, try lemon juice or vinegar for more stubborn residues.

√ DO dust the leaves

As well as washing the leaves when you notice a build-up of dirt, you should regularly dust them. For plants with large leaves, use a feather duster to remove dust. For smaller-leaved plants, a soft make-up brush works well.

X DON'T put your plants in direct sunlight

Although you may be tempted to place your plants in the sun after cleaning to make them dry guicker, this can damage the leaves. This is especially true if you have used any cleaning products that contain chemicals.

When should you clean the leaves on your houseplants?

The best time to clean the leaves on your houseplants is towards the end of the day when the sun is starting to go down. In terms of frequency, the best way to determine when to clean the leaves is by rubbing your fingers gently along them or by looking for signs of dirt and dust.



Nick Berry will be home in a heartbeat

le may have found fame and glory, but for actor Nick Berry, Epping is and always will

There was a period from the mid-80s to late-90s when actor-turned-singer Nick Berry could have stopped traffic – assuming the drivers of the cars were middle-aged women who dutifully set their VCRs to record either EastEnders or Heartbeat.

Berry was born in Woodford but has lived in Epping for most of his life. He is best known for his roles as Simon Wicks in EastEnders and as PC Nick Rowan in ITV countryside police drama, Heartbeat. "Rachel and I have never been into that side of the entertainment industry. I made enough money


to have a comfortable and happy life and for that I will always be grateful, but family is my priority," says Berry.

Medieval church with 600 years of history

iscover the history behind the 600-year-old Leigh-on-Sea church, St Clement's.

Throughout a multitude of significant historical events, St Clement's Church has remained a steadfast presence on Leigh Hill, with its tower serving as a guiding landmark for those travelling along the River Thames to London.

The building's north aisle, dating back to around 1400, is its most ancient section. Legend suggests that the stones used in the church's construction were sourced from the remnants of Hadleigh Castle (though this lacks factual basis).

Notably, the north wall integrates stone steps that once led to a now-removed rood screen (which would have separated the choir from the nave). The north aisle's ceiling – resembling the underside

> of a ship - is speculated to have been crafted by Leigh's medieval shipbuilders.


Over the years, as Leigh's population expanded, so too did the church. Within the next century, the centre aisle and tower were constructed using the same Kentish ragstone. Additionally, a redbrick Tudor porch was added on the southern side of the church.

The 1872 extension of the chancel to the east marked the first significant alteration to the church's layout in almost four centuries, while 25 years later, the south aisle was constructed. Modifications were also made to the south wall to include an arcade.

The Lady Chapel was built in 1913 as a tribute to the revered Bishop of Lincoln Edward King (1829-1910). He was the brother of a former rector, Canon Walker King, and the uncle of the rector at that time, Canon Robert King.

St Clement's has been a silent observer to many pivotal moments, including the advent of the railway connecting Leigh to London, and the profound impact of both World Wars on the local community.

The Resurrection Chapel within the church is a poignant memorial to those we have lost, featuring



- > Dispose of charcoal and ashes safely as these can be harmful if ingested.

 → Have designated pet-free/friendly areas ∠To avoid accidents and to prevent your pets from knocking over the BBQ or getting burnt, it can be a good idea to set up a physical barrier around your grill. You may also want to create

a pet-friendly area in your garden where they have access to shade and water.

3With so much food and drink lying around, you need to ensure that your pet is protected from food poisoning and other potential health problems.

- > Avoid feeding your pet scraps such as cooked meat as these may contain spices, onions, and garlic which are toxic to pets.
- > Keep any alcoholic drinks away from your pets as even small amounts can be toxic when ingested.
- > Dispose of leftover food safely as bones pose a choking hazard.

nsurprisingly, the sport of lawn mower racing was dreamt up while large quantities of beer were being consumed; although the UK's drink drinking laws now require all participants to prove their sobriety!

The roots of the sport – which originated in West Sussex in 1973 – have now spread worldwide.

prevent it from outgrowing your space. For best results, prune English ivy in spring.

- > Trim back any excess growth.
- > Remove any leaves that feature dark spots as these may have a bacterial or fungal infection.

HOW TO PRUNE JASMINE: Some jasmine varieties flower in summer and others in winter both need to be pruned after they have finished blooming to avoid damaging any flower buds.

- > Start by pruning out any dead, diseased or damaged stems.
- > Next, trim out any long, straggling shoots that are growing away from the plant's support.
- > Finally, shorten the stems to the nearest strong side shoot to keep your plant's shape.

HOW TO PRUNE VIRGINIA CREEPER: Virginia creeper should be pruned annually (in winter) to

keep growth in check. This is especially important if you are growing this plant up the side of your home.

- > To start, cut back older or overcrowded stems.
- > Trim back any growth from the gutter, windows and downpipes.
- > Remove dead or diseased vines that have been affected by pests or caused by overwatering.

HOW TO PRUNE JAPANESE QUINCE: Ideally, you should prune this plant in late April or early May, right after spring blossoming. If you prune any earlier than this, you risk losing many of its flowers.

- > Examine the shape of the plant and then select approximately one-third of the branches for removal (make sure these are divided evenly over the shrub).
- > At the same time, remove any dead, diseased or damaged branches.

Animal buns

ave fun in the kitchen with your little ones while making these super-simple and supercute pig and frog burger buns that you and your kids will love creating!

You will need:

100g spinach (frogs) or 100g cooked beetroot (pigs) | 150ml warm milk | 500g strong white bread flour | 10g fine sea salt | 1 sachet dried yeast | 50g unsalted butter, melted and cooled | 125-150ml warm water | 2-3 black pitted olives | Extra milk for glazing

How to make:

- Blend the spinach or beetroot and warm milk in a blender until smooth.
- Add the flour and sea salt to a bowl and dry whisk with a fork.
- 3. Add the yeast and whisk again.
- Gradually mix in the coloured milk, melted butter, and ¹/₃ of the water.
- Bring the ingredients together with your hand until you have a shaggy dough.
- 6. Tip the dough out and knead for 10-12 minutes until springy and shiny.
- Divide the dough into 12 pieces and roll 11 of these into tight balls.
- Place on a baking tray, making sure to leave space between each ball as they will double in

size while baking

- To make the frogs, use the remaining piece of dough to make googly eyes and place a pair on each roll.
- 10. For the pigs, make little blobs for ears and larger blobs for the noses, use a skewer to mark out holes on each, and place them on each roll.
- 11. Cover loosely with oiled clingfilm and put in a warm place to prove for 30-45 minutes.
- 12. Preheat your oven to 200°C/180°C fan/gas mark 6.
- 13. Add the details to each roll slivers of olives for the frogs' eyes and tiny pieces for the nostrils, and two tiny eyes for the pigs.
- **14.** Bake for 12-15 minutes until risen and lightly golden.
- **15.** Leave to cool. Slice and add your filling of choice.
- 16. These can be kept in the freezer for up to three months. Wrap tightly with plastic and then cover with tin foil to seal in moisture and flavour.

ONLY YOU ARE TO BLAME

If I were to be blunt (and I usually am) I would say that if you are 'too busy' you only have yourself to blame! Okay, so I don't know your specific circumstances, identify with the workload that you have taken on or understand the pressure you are under not to let your customers down. Railway Children

ay 2024 marks the centenary of the death of writer E. Nesbit, best known for her children's books. Nesbit's own life was full of ups and downs, much like the tales she wrote. Edith Nesbit was born in London in 1858 and had a tough start. Her father died when she was just four years old. Her mother then moved the family of six children around Europe in search of a climate more suitable for Edith's sickly older sister, Mary.

A WAY OF ESCAPE: At first, writing was a way for Edith to escape her difficult life. Later, it became a way for her to make money when her husband, Hubert Bland, couldn't provide for his family. Hubert wasn't faithful, and Edith ended up supporting not just their three children, but also two children from Hubert's other relationships.

BREAKING THE MOULD: Before Edith's books, most children's literature was about makebelieve or teaching moral lessons. Nesbit changed that. She wrote about children having adventures in places that could be just around the corner.

THE RAILWAY CHILDREN: The Railway Children tells the story of three siblings, Roberta, Peter and Phyllis. They move to a house near a railway after their father is falsely accused of being a spy and sent to prison. Their friendships with the local people and their adventures eventually lead to proving their father's innocence and his return home. In 1970, the story was made into a film, making a star of Jenny Agutter OBE, who played Roberta.

Nesbit didn't just write for children. She also wrote novels and poems for adults. These aren't as famous now, but they show she was adept at writing for different audiences. Her children's books continue to enchant readers to this day, marking her as one of the most significant writers of the 20th century.
