





Calling all SHOPPING ADDICTS

n a recent study, London has been named the second best city for shopping in the world, with an overall shopping score of 8/10. The results come just days after the capital was crowned the third most popular city on the planet.

HOW DID THE STILDY SCORE EACH CITY

The study analysed cities all around the world based on the number of shopping locations, number of fashion shops within one mile, number of shopping malls within one mile, number of boutiques within one mile, and number of designer boutiques in the city.

HOW DID LONDON FARE?

London ranked in second place due to gaining the second highest number of shopping locations (1,221) and its number of boutique stores within one mile (102). The researchers were particularly impressed by London's variety, saying: "London is one of the fashion capitals of the world,

and its place as one of the world's most ideal cities for shopping is well established."

The study also revealed that London has a whopping 19 Rolex retailers.

WHO TOOK THE TOP SPOT?

Tokyo was crowned the number one shopping city in the world, with an overall shopping score of 9/10, boasting an impressive 1,970 shopping locations and 240 shopping malls and fashion shops within one mile. Paris took the third spot, with Sydney, New York and Boston also ranking strongly.

WHO CAME OUT WORST?

Vienna was named the worst city to shop in the world, with just 267 locations. Munich scored nearly as badly, with only 15 shopping malls and six boutique stores within a one-mile radius of the city centre.

ART THERAPY

with Repecca Sicardi

WHY REBECCA SICARDI'S DESIGN VISION IS GOOD FOR THE HOME AND THE MIND

e can all relate to a piece of furniture, or a space, or an entire house transporting us to a place of mindful calm, but designer Rebecca Sicardi took the concept one step further when launching her interior design business in 2017.

Despite studying History of Modern Art at Manchester University, it was only when she began decorating her duplex apartment in Hackney that the concept of satisfaction and gratification really came to the fore for the designer, who prioritises subtlety, restfulness, neutral shades and strippedback finishes in order to promote a place of sanctity, harmony and calm.

She explains: "I don't think it's a secret that most of us will respond well to relaxed, subtle shades and tones, and they really are at the heart of what I create as a template for thought.

"On top of that, I will add context, detail and stimulation in the form of statement pieces or effects that really stand out."

By the designer's own admission, it's not a revolutionary way of thinking; however, in an era where we are impacted by so many modes and messages, reconnecting with sanity, clarity and a sense of clearness could be the ultimate antidote to the world's ills.

The words 'sensitivity' and 'sanctuary' permeate so much of what Sicardi styles, with pastels, wood, stone and rattan offering a base on which everything else can be constructed.

As for Sicardi's recommendations for others looking to follow her design style, she suggests always checking colours carefully, especially 'off-whites', valuing texture and materiality over almost anything else, and using a pared-back palette as a starting point before adding on top, while always telling a story through the art and furniture you select.

She adds: "Don't expect it to work first time. Persist with what feels as if it might work, because with persistence, it will."

Farmers' market to close for a 'few months'

eigh Farmers' Market will temporarily close owing to dwindling stalls and visitors.

The market, which takes place monthly at Leigh Community Centre, announced on June 17 that it would be closed for a "few months", although it did state that it hopes to reopen in the autumn.

The market first opened in 2000 and is one of the longest-running markets in Essex.

Owing to COVID-19 restrictions, the market was closed for around 18 months before relaunching for its 21st anniversary in July 2021.

Although the relaunch was a great success, with a variety of stalls and a good turnout from the public, the market has struggled to continue this success over the last year.


Leigh-on-Sea Town Council (LoSTC), which

organises the market, believes this is owing to a number of factors, with a decline in stalls, especially the loss of a meat and bread stall, decline in footfall. the frequency of the market and the cost-of-living crisis all contributing to the market not being as popular as it once was.

Staff have trialled running the market on Saturdays as well as organising themed seasonal events, but these have also suffered from poor attendance.

A spokesperson for LoSTC said: "The stallholders would like to thank all our customers for their loyal custom in the past and assure you of our intention to continue to supply our customers in the interim period and moving forward.

"We feel passionately this market has an important role to play in the local community."

Residents and visitors were warned not to go into the sea at Thorpe Bay Beach during the recent heatwave for safety reasons.

Southend-on-Sea City Council issued the warning on June 16, when temperatures reached more than 30 degrees Celsius, following reports of algal blooms.

Blooms of toxic algae are rare in English coastal waters; however, government advice urges caution as it is difficult to tell if the algae is toxic by looking at it.

Subsequently, Southend-on-Sea City Council made the difficult decision to warn people not to go into the water on a section of Thorpe Bay beach near Roslin Beach Hotel following the reports.

A spokesperson for the council said: "This is a natural occurrence and increases rapidly in hot weather.

"This will clear naturally but we are advising residents and visitors to avoid swimming at this section until it clears."

Thorpe Bay resident, John Elphwick, said: "It is a real shame, especially as the weather is so good, but safety has to come first.

"It's not as if you can't swim in other sections of the beach nearby. There will be plenty of places to go swimming and cool off."

JAMES DUDDRIDGE MP



Member of Parliament for Rochford and Southend East



It was fantastic to see the Southend Half Marathon returning to the seafront after a twoyear postponement owing to the pandemic.

It was a very warm occasion for the 1,500-plus runners who took part – and for the spectators who lined the route in their masses from Shoebury East Beach down to Sealife Adventure.

I would like to say thanks to the events team at Havens Hospices, who did another wonderful job in organising the 13.1-mile run, supported by the local cadets, marshals and other volunteers too.

Let's hope lots of money was raised for this good local cause.

Elsewhere, Southend's police officers received special praise at a meeting of senior members of the government – including the Prime Minister – recently.

Home Secretary Priti Patel told the Cabinet that

our local force had been a national success story in tackling violent crime.

This comes after the city's police were the first in the country to pilot the Grip programme, which involves police forces operating high-visibility foot patrols for short periods of time within specific areas where data shows there is a risk of serious violence.

The tactic resulted in a 73 per cent drop in violent crime and a 31 per cent fall in street crime in the 20 highest crime hot spots in Southend on days when patrols visited, compared with days they did not.

Following its success in Southend, the government has since announced an additional £30million of funding for the enforcement programme nationwide.

Thank you and well done to our officers – I'm proud to see their work being recognised.





Southend-on-Sea City Council (SoSCC) has said it is committed to improving housing across the borough, including in Thorpe Bay.

SoSCC has spent £12million on housing in the last year and says it will invest more as it strives for everyone to have "a good-quality, sustainable home that meets their needs".

The £12million already spent includes £6.8million on refurbishing existing council housing, £3.8million to buy 23 homes – nine for council housing and 14 under the Next Steps Accommodation programme for people moving on from homelessness – and


£1.3million for building new council homes.

SoSCC says it will now aim to build more council homes in 2022/23, with plans to deliver 29 homes across five disused garage sites.

Councillor lan Gilbert, cabinet member for housing and regeneration, said: "Creating more affordable housing is a key priority, and it is vitally important that the homes we have are of a decent standard.

"I'm pleased that not only are we investing in additional council homes, but that we're also doing what we can to tackle homelessness and bring the homes we already own up to a decent living standard."

SUE BARKER CBE CALLS TIME ON WIMBLEDON AFTER THREE DECADES OF IMPECCABLE SERVICE ue Barker's decision to step away from presenting duties after this year's Wimbledon championships has perhaps sounded another death knell for the BBC, whose pursuit of relevance in an everchanging media landscape continues to take away more from the organisation than it gives. As far as the 66 year old is concerned, Barker appears to have reached this endgame herself, rather than having the rug pulled from under her, as she did last year when, after 24 years of A Question of Sport, the Beeb's drive for diversity and representation saw her ousted from the show. And of course, there is an argument to say that freshening things up is a necessity. After all, the BBC's Wimbledon coverage seems to largely feature stars of a very bygone era, the 1970s and 80s, with the likes of John McEnroe, Björn Borg, Billie Jean King and Martina Navratilova representing a generation of expert summarisers that few young tennis fans can relate to. That said, the A Question of Sport experiment, now fronted by Paddy McGuinness, has failed as far as viewing figures go, and BBC executives will no doubt be wary of that as they begin to search for a replacement for someone who many feel is irreplaceable. The BBC will have some faith that possible new presenter Annabel Croft, or perhaps Clare Balding CBE, or Andrew Castle, can go a long way towards filling the void, even if Barker's contribution and presence has always been huge. Not only does she convey events with brightness, humour and warmth, but she makes her guests feel reassured and comfortable too. That mum-like demeanour feels increasingly rare in an era of television where high-octane, maximum impact entertainment is the norm, and her ability to play that out across other projects, including Sports Personality of the Year, plus athletics and Olympics coverage, sees her regarded as one of the very best of a generation. Of course, the presenter was a brilliant tennis player herself back in the 1970s. She turned pro at the age of 17, and captured the hearts of the nation three years later when she won the French Open, defeating Renáta Tomanová in the final. On home soil. Barker reached the Wimbledon semi-finals in 1977, but was surprisingly beaten by Betty Stöve. She retired aged 28 after a series of injuries, having claimed 15 singles and 12 doubles titles across her career, and seamlessly made her way into the media world, initially with Australia's Channel 7. After three years at BskyB, she ioined the BBC in 1993. In 2021, Barker was presented with a CBE for services to broadcasting and charity, having previously been given an MBE in the year 2000 and an OBE six years ago. What lies in wait next for the broadcaster, who is married to landscape gardener Lance Tankard and lives in the Cotswolds, is unknown, but what is certain is the fact she will be in high demand.



Bumblebees will create homes underground.

They have less of a need to build high as they're not protecting a mass of honey, so will typically use abandoned burrows or holes underground.

JOB

Honeybees, as the name suggests, produce honey. Bumblebees, on the other hand, are responsible for transferring nectar from flowers.

STING

We all know the peril of a bee sting, though it's only a honeybee sting that's terminal... for the bee. Bumblebees have the ability to sting many times – vou've been warned.

HIBERNATION

While bumblebees will see out the cold of winter in a safe, warm space, honeybees do not hibernate and will keep going throughout the cold months. They will rely on pre-stored food to last them through to the spring.

s your garden more shady than sunny? While it can be a struggle to create a blooming outdoor space with limited sunlight, it can be done. Discover below five pretty plants that thrive in the shade.

STINKING IRIS: Although this may not be the most pleasantsounding plant, stinking iris can actually make a very beautiful addition to a shady garden, especially in autumn, when its large seedpods split open to reveal orange-red seeds. Plant in full shade for best results.

WOOD SPURGE: There are many different varieties of spurge, but our favourite has to be Euphorbia amygdaloides var. robbiae. From late spring, this pretty plant bears lime-green flowers above dark green leaves. Plant in dry, shady spots such as underneath trees or along woodland borders.

\$10WDROPS: Snowdrops appear at the end of winter and bloom beautifully for weeks until your spring bulbs start to flourish. Delicate and dainty, snowdrops thrive in full shade and particularly in heavy, moist soils.

BELLFLOWER: If you are looking for a plant that will attract bees and other pollinators to your garden, then bellflower is a great choice. Ideal for growing at the back of a border, this attractive plant displays clusters of purple-blue bell-shaped flowers from summer through until autumn.

FOXGLOVE: As a woodland plant, foxgloves thrive in dappled or partial shade, so they do require a little bit of sun. There are many different varieties to choose from, with colours including bright pink, purple and peach.

OUR TOP TIPS FOR GROWING IN THE SHADE:

- > Improve the soil with lots of organic matter before planting
- > When planting under trees, remove any dry, impoverished soil between the large roots
- > Apply weathered wood ash from a bonfire or log burner to increase the potash in the soil
- > Mulch the whole area after planting with garden compost or composted bark chippings.

HORTICULTURAL HERO

THE CONTEMPORARY GARDENER WHOSE PATH IS WELL DEFINED

In a post-COVID era where we appreciate the benefit of outside space in ways we have probably never done before, the appeal of young, energetic, stylish gardeners has never been so great. With that in mind, it's easy to see why Tom Massey has found himself riding a wave of popularity.

The London College of Garden Design graduate is best known as presenter of *Your Garden Made Perfect*, a show that uses virtual reality and the ideas of rival garden gurus to shape horticultural solutions for frustrated homeowners.

The success of the show has led Massey into fronting a variety of other projects, from hosting parts of the Royal Horticultural Show to being asked to design and install a moveable orchard near the Olympic Park. He also works privately for a number of clients.

"I think people are really starting to appreciate the flexibility of their gardens in a way they have never done before," he says. "There is so much technology that we can bring into our outside spaces, from lighting to entertainment systems to eco-friendly heating solutions, meaning longer nights outdoors rather than always having to migrate inside.

"Gardens have always been peaceful, restorative places, but making them social spaces too is a new trend that is great to see."

When designing gardens for private clients, Massey likes to combine lawned areas with statement architecture, often guiding the eye through the space, as if going on a journey. From wildflowers to wrought iron, his contemporary ideas are striking a chord with a new generation of homeowner.

He explains: "In the past, gardens had to be soft, flowing, purely natural spaces. While that's great for nature, it's not so practical for people.

"In my opinion, we should give ourselves the freedom to live in our gardens, using materials and ideas that are attractive and offer us the opportunity to relax."

WHY IS IT CALLED BUBBLE TEA?

It is the tasty tapioca pearls that sit at the bottom of bubble tea and the floating bubbles that are created by vigorous shaking that give this increasingly popular drink its name.

Bubble tea can be served hot or cold, but always in a transparent cup and with a thick straw so that the pearls can be seen and sucked up with ease.

WHAT DOES BUBBLE TEA TASTE LIKE?

There are lots of different flavours of bubble tea that you can try, and you can even get various flavours of tapioca pearls. These pearls have a chewy

consistency that is somewhere between jelly and chewing gum.

HOW TO MAKE BUBBLE TEA

You will need:

Tea | Milk | Tapioca pearls | Honey or agave

How to make:

- Bring 3 cups of water to the boil and add 1 cup of tapioca pearls.
- Simmer until the pearls float to the top.
- Brew your chosen tea and allow to steep for 5 minutes.
- Chill the tea in the fridge or pour over ice to cool.
- Place the cooked pearls in a tall glass.
- Add honey or agave to sweeten if desired
- Pour your chilled tea two-thirds of the way up the glass.
- Add a splash of milk if you want a creamier drink.
- Stir and enjoy with a thick straw.

BEGINNER'S GUIDE TO COOKING WITH

e are literally going bananas for banana leaves. Beautiful to look at, fun to use and easy to cook with, once you've finished reading the below, you'll wonder why you didn't take advantage of these cheap and plentiful cooking aids before.

HOW TO PREPARE BANANA LEAVES FOR COOKING

- > Gently wash the leaves and then cut off the thick spine.
- > Pass over an open flame quickly until the leaf turns bright green and glossy. This will soften the leaves for folding. Make sure to wear heat-resistant gloves when doing this and keep any flammable items out the way.
- > Place on a chopping board and cut to the desired size.

TO STEAM FISH

A banana leaf makes a fragrant and convenient steaming packet that will ensure your preferred fish is both succulent and tasty. Wrap the leaf around any kind of firm-fleshed fish, such as halibut or snapper, and then simply add your favourite herbs and spices as well as some form of moisture, such as broth, wine or lemon juice. Secure with toothpicks. You can also use banana leaves to steam rice and meat.

TO GRILL VEGGIES

If your vegetables always stick to the grill, then a banana leaf provides the perfect solution. Just place the leaf on the grill first and then arrange your vegetables on top of it. This method will also add a mellow, smoky-sweet flavour to your vegetables. Also great for grilling prawns and other shellfish.

TO SERVE SUSTAINABLY

Banana leaves aren't just for cooking with; they also make great biodegradable serving platters, place settings and even linens for formal tables. Banana leaf boats make pretty bowls for rice, salads and desserts.

- > Although not toxic, banana leaves are hard to digest, so you should not eat them.
- > Banana leaves are porous, so if you are baking, place the leaf packets in a pan to catch leaking juices.
- > Banana leaves freeze really well. Blanch first and then wrap in greaseproof paper and place in freezer bags.

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND OUR KIDS' PERCEPTION OF MONEY

here's no parent who hasn't encountered the incessant pleading or hopeful yearning of a child who. while being commended for his or her persistence, has desperately failed to appreciate the value of something we all need perspective on - money.

While in the past the subject of finances was one largely kept clear of kids, experts now believe it's of real value to educate our voungsters as far as the daily cut and thrust of cash goes.

To do so, it is key to understand what our kids perceive as the value of money. It follows, then, that we can better manage expectations if we pinpoint their perspective. For instance, children under the age of seven will understand the concept of money and its function, but only later do they gather the sense of exchange, the idea of borrowing and the fact it comes in various forms.


Past the age of 10, kids glean how work interacts with money and the fact it can be preserved with good habits (or lost easily with bad ones). With that in mind, having a jar where kids can save money, see it accumulate and then spend it on a reward is one of the best introductions.

Parents or guardians should also use a scheme of rewarding tasks (or commissions) rather than the typical pocket money format where, effectively, a child is rewarded no matter what they do.

The importance of giving should also be emphasised, as well as opportunity cost - "If you buy this, you won't be able to buy that."

Early money management offers great practice for later life where, as we will all testify, temptations become much greater.



JAKE DANIELS BECOMES THE UK'S FIRST OPENLY GAY FOOTBALLER IN THREE DECADES

They say young footballers go about their craft with a sense of fearlessness, and that's certainly the case where Blackpool forward Jake Daniels is concerned.

The 17-year-old, who signed pro terms with the Championship club in 2022, is yet to make a league appearance for the Seasiders, though he has singlehandedly cultivated more column inches than any of his vastly more experienced teammates by coming out as the English Football League's only gay footballer.

For many years, conjecture over the possible treatment of gay footballers - in an environment where terrace banter very often crosses the line between acceptable and not - has clearly led to a huge number of gay footballers afraid to fly their true colours.

That's what makes Jake's revelation all the more brave - namely that someone right at the start of his football career has the confidence and honesty to nail his LGBT colours to the mast and

declare, as would Gloria Gaynor, "I am what I am".

He said: "I can't really put a date on it, but I was probably five or six years old when I knew I was gay, so it's been a long time that I have been living with the lie.

"Now is the right time to speak. I feel like I am ready to tell people my story. I want people to know the real me.

"I have been thinking for a long time about how I want to do it, when I want to do it. I know now is the

time. I am ready to be myself, be free and be confident with it all." The UK's first openly gay footballer since Justin Fashanu way back in 1990, Jake is correct in his assertion

that attitudes and values have changed. And while the late Fashanu was derided for his honesty and bravery, the fact Jake Daniels has been roundly praised

shows just how far society has

come since then.


