Oon, events all over the UK will be celebrating the LGBT community – but even with a growing movement to add a Pride Month to our country's annual calendar of festivities, there's a lot to be desired when it comes to acceptance in the wider Commonwealth and world beyond.

Shortly after winning his fourth Commonwealth Games gold medal, British diving sensation Tom Daley used his platform to draw attention to the fact that 37 of the competing nations at the tournament criminalised homosexuality and LGBT people in some manner.

Describing his impulse to shine a light on this discrimination, Daley highlighted discussions with LGBT activists who had been persecuted while "trying to organise a Pride event and getting thrown into prison for it, as well as being beaten up in the streets".

He continued: "I was sitting there with a gold medal at the Commonwealth Games and I thought: 'How lucky am I, to be sitting here with my husband after just winning a competition and not being worried about any ramifications?'

"It struck me in such a way that I was mortified by it, and I just literally crafted a little sentence on my Instagram post – that was exactly what I was feeling in that moment."

The UK's steadfast commitment to tolerance, respect and acceptance will be best shown later in the year when the multitudinous Pride events begin to take place around the country, most in the peak of summer. They follow some brilliant celebrations marking February's LGBT History Month. In addition, there is hope our cities and towns will follow our transatlantic fellows in observing a Pride Month, in June. With a sitting president for whom gay rights are not top of the agenda, the need for another time to reflect on the prejudices still faced by the LGBT community – even in so-called 'progressive' nations – are profound.

In the UK alone LGBT people are up to seven times more likely to be homeless, while gay couples are still unable to marry in Northern Ireland – the ruling party of whom, the DUP, are currently in coalition with Theresa May's Conservatives. And in the wider UN, homosexuality remains a crime in 40 per cent of countries.

Most pertinently, perhaps, is the treatment of the LGBT community right on Europe's doorstep, in Russia. President Vladimir Putin has enforced stringed anti-homosexual legislation, including new laws that punish anybody disseminating propaganda aimed at the formation of misperceptions of traditional and non-traditional sexual relations. It has also failed to comply with the 2010 judgment at the European Court of Human Rights that requires it to allow gay pride events.

Russia's anti-gay agenda will be a primary focus when they host this year's World Cup, but also the prestigious diving World

Series in which Daley will be competing.

"For me, going there and competing is a message," he said. "I want to urge other LGBT people to compete in Russia."

Tom Daley alone won't change Russia's views, nor those of others still prejudiced towards what accounts for over three million people in the UK – or, put another way, the equivalent of the population of Wales – but perception is shifting, and ambassadors for fairness and acceptance are being heard louder than ever before, and for that we must be glad.






orget diets, follow the healthy eating pyramid for sensible but effective weight loss.

Diets don't work. You know it, I know it and your favourite pair of jeans knows it. And yet, the idea of losing X amount of weight in X number of weeks sure is tempting, particularly as we enter beach season. But before you embark on six weeks of nothing but cabbage soup, consider how much more you would enjoy your summer if you embarked on a healthy, sustainable and delicious eating plan that would not only help you lose weight over time, but also give you glowing skin and an abundance of energy. Welcome to the Pyramid Plan.

The best part about the Pyramid Plan is that it doesn't require you to count calories or restrict beyond what is sensible. Instead, it breaks down foods into categories and then tells how much you should aim to eat for optimum nutrition and energy.



red of spending a fortune on flowers only to watch them wither in days? Here are our top tips to make your bouquet last longer.

one

Sear the stems: If your flowers have been out of water for a while they may be starting to wilt, so rejuvenate them by searing the stems. Simply pour an inch or two of boiling water in a bowl and plunge the ends in for about 10 seconds (be sure to protect the buds from steam if they are near the water).

two

Add a penny: Make your vase a wishing well by throwing in a penny. The copper acts as an acidifier, fighting the bacteria growth in your arrangement.

three

Place them in lemon and sugar water: Strangely, this common pancake topping also keeps your flowers looking healthy. So, add two teaspoons of lemon juice (apple cider vinegar works too) and a teaspoon of sugar to your vase water. This makes a natural plant food, but you could also add half a teaspoon of bleach to prevent mould.

four

Give them a rest: Flowers picked from your garden need to be rested before becoming a bouquet, so place them in a bucket of cold water in a cool place overnight.

five

Keep away from direct sunlight and fruit: Warmth will make them wilt, so keep your beautiful blooms in the shade and away from fruit (ripening fruits release ethylene gas which can compromise your flowers). If you have the space, you could also put them in the fridge overnight.

Freshen and feed: The key to longevity is keeping flowers fed and their environment clean. So, every few days it's worth rinsing out the vase and providing fresh water with plant food (either homemade or bought). Making sure there are no leaves below the water line will also help prevent bacteria growth, meaning your bouquet can brighten up the home for weeks and days, not hours and minutes.

Everyday DTY FOR DUMNIES

on't be a DIY dummy this summer. Instead, why not start learning how to fix the problems you think are hard but are actually easy solved?

No hot water

If you wake up one morning to find you have no hot water or central heating, the first thing you need to do is check the pressure gauge on your combi boiler. This is the big dial on your system, and if it reads lower than 1.5 bar, there's a good chance that lack of pressure is preventing your boiler from firing up. To fix it, look underneath the boiler and locate the two taps on the filling loop. Fully open one of these taps, then carefully open the other, watching the pressure rise until it's over 1.5. Once pressure is achieved, close both taps.



Before you call out a plumber, always check your machine's filter. This is usually located at the front of your machine towards the bottom and is concealed by a small door which needs to be gently eased open. Place a bowl and some towels underneath and gently unscrew the filter. Rinse out any debris or muck under a tap and place back in machine.

A broken fridge light

First find the mechanism in your appliance that triggers the light when you open and close the door. If this pushes in and out easily and there is still no light, it's likely just the bulb that needs changing, so simply locate, turn off your fridge and change it.

A blown fuse in a plua

Some plugs have a fuse holder you can gently prise open, otherwise unscrew your plug with a slot-head screwdriver and work out the fuse before replacing with one of the right amperage for the appliance





If you're prone to screaming into your pillow with frustration, a meditation space may be just what you need to take the edge off life. Yoga mats, mood


lighting and a few well-placed crystals will create peace and serenity, and if you're trained in massage or any other alternative therapy, you could use it as a therapy room too.



Man jailed for several years after car crash

Aman has been jailed for six years after pleading guilty to a series of charges, including stealing the southbound M11, between junctions five and a car which was subsequently involved in a serious

collision on the M11 near Chiqwell and Loughton. The crash happened at around 7pm on July 28.

Francis Covle, from Harlow, was arrested on August 31 by the Metropolitan Police, and charged with robbery, possession of a noxious substance, three counts of attempting to cause GBH with intent, theft of a motor vehicle, aggravated vehicle taking, driving while disqualified and driving without insurance.

Coyle appeared at Chelmsford Magistrates' Court on September 2 where he was remanded in custody to appear in court on November 3.

He pleaded quilty to all charges at Chelmsford Crown Court on Friday, February 9.

Coyle has also been disqualified from driving for five years and will be required to do an extensive driving test, should he decide to retake it in the future.

On that evening in July, officers had been called to reports that a blue VW Golf had been stolen from Queens Road, Buckhurst Hill while its owner was in a barber's shop.

Shortly after, the car was in collision with a lorry on

On August 1, at around 10pm the VW Golf stolen from outside the barber's shop was involved in a collision on the A406.

The vehicle crashed into a taxi driver's car and then three suspects, one of whom was later proven to be Coyle, left the scene.

Coyle was arrested in East London on August 31.

DC Amy Kavanagh from Loughton CID said: "Coyle's actions were chaotic and dangerous and it is lucky that the consequences for those who he put in danger were not graver.

"This was a frightening and confusing ordeal for a number of people and it is satisfying to know that he has been jailed.

"Coyle pleaded guilty but not before he attempted to evade justice."


Coyle was sentenced to three-and-a-half years' imprisonment for his role in the above offences, as well as a further two-and-a-half years for a separate case on behalf of the Metropolitan Police, which took place in Snaresbrook. These sentences are to run consecutively.

Man sentenced for drug offences

Aman has been sentenced to five years in prison for Class A drug offences in Reading.

Amaru Anderson, from Loughton, pleaded guilty to two counts of possession with intent to supply heroin and two counts of possession with intent to supply crack cocaine.

Anderson was sentenced on Monday, April 30 at Reading Crown Court after pleading guilty.

On March 2 last year, police officers saw Anderson carrying out a drug deal, he was stopped and found to be in possession of 91 wraps of cocaine and 23 wraps of heroin in St Giles Close.

On November 5 last year, Anderson was at an address in Albany Road and was found with heroin and cocaine

Investigating officer, Detective Sergeant Brian Simmonds from Reading Police Station, said: "This is an example of the commitment from Thames Valley Police to disrupt the supply of drugs in the area.

"Drug dealers cause significant harm to our community so officers will continue to work hard tackling drug crime and we will continue to work with the Crown Prosecution Service to bring offenders to court.

"We want to protect the most vulnerable people in the community and prevent them from being exploited; while also offering support to those who are suffering from addiction.

"This was a significant operation and should come as a warning to those taking part in illegal activity, officers are working to bring them to justice."

ARE THE DAYS OF GENUINE CROSS-BORDER BARGAINS ON THEIR WAY BACK?

he 1980s was the ultimate era of overseas travel; and with that came a whole new set of rules for duty free goods, where huge savings could be made on everything from booze to cosmetics, fragrances to mighty bars of Toblerone.

We didn't know it at the time, but things were good – whether purchasing at the airport, on a flight or even whilst bobbing across the English Channel on a ferry. But things started to turn in 1999 when the European Union swiped away many of the cost-saving bargains that made arriving back in the country all the more palatable. In real terms then, duty adds around £8 to the price of a bottle of spirits, and accounts for almost 75 per cent of the price of a packet of cigarettes. And you can knock another 20 per cent off those prices given that VAT doesn't apply either.

Naturally, the exact position is one of many to be verified by David Davis and his Brexit team, but airline Ryanair is already thought to have contingency plans for the return of duty free. Prepare to find yourself uttering the words 'booze cruise' again in future.







fter 22 years as manager of Arsenal Football Club, Arsene 'Le Professeur' Wenger has called it a day.

A week is a long time in politics.

And seven days is also a lengthy period in the life of a top-flight football club.

So, when you consider Arsene Wenger has been manager for 22 years you get the sense of what a remarkable achievement the Frenchman can claim.

Some Arsenal fans, no, make that many, will say he went three years or so past his sell-by date.

But even those supporters must recognise the massive impact the club's most successful manager had on the Pride of North London, and indeed his influence on English football.

At his peak he oversaw The Invincibles in 2003/2004 – a side made of driven superstars who went the entire season unbeaten. When you see how good Manchester City have been this season and still managed to taste defeat in two games you get some indicator of how historic that Arsenal team were.

From being a French unknown ridiculed by ignorant sections of the British sports press, Wenger

rose to the top table of managers to have graced the English game.

Along with Sir Alex Ferguson, Jose Mourinho and new boy, Pep Guardiola, Wenger was a manager of the highest order.

But for all his hard work and dedication to Arsenal it still feels like a mission incomplete.

He never tasted European glory and hasn't won the league title since moving to the Emirates Stadium in 2006.

Towards the end of his reign the critics were in the majority. His commitment to a cavalier-playing style which initially and used to win him plaudits was now his Achilles heel.

His ability to develop young talent deserted him, Arsenal's defence and resilience was often found wanting.

But when the history books are read in a few generations time Wenger will be remembered as one of, if not the greatest, Arsenal managers ever.

What next for the Frenchman? A well-earned retirement?

Or even the England job? Surely not, but as one wise old pundit said: "Football, it's a funny old game."



ot just Premier League champions, but record breakers as well, Manchester City swept aside all before them in the 2017/18 domestic campaign. And although their Champions League hopes were dashed at the guarter-final stage, Pep Guardiola's side are arguably the most complete football side in the world right now.

What makes City's Premier League title tilt all the more incredible is that there was a sense of inevitability about their triumph right from the very start of the season. The "noisy neighbours" weren't just winning matches, they were humiliating their opponents.

By Christmas they had one hand on the trophy, and the team have taken to the pitch in the final couple of months very much with record-breaking

Sure enough, they finished with most points (100), most wins (32 from 38 matches), most goals (108), most away victories (16), biggest positive goal difference (79), biggest title-winning margin (19 points) and the least time spent trailing in matches (just 153 minutes across the course of the entire

City also landed a PFA Player of the Year nominee in the form of Kevin de Bruyne, and the record for a side making 1,000 passes in a game.

It was perhaps fitting that in a season of coasting through matches, they were reliant on Gabriel Jesus' 94th-minute winner at Southampton on the final day. Rather than getting lucky, the goal typified City's 'battle to the end' attitude which, combined with a multitude of other talents, sets them apart as arguably the league's greatest ever side.

So how did the Spanish managerial maestro Guardiola do it?

KING KEVIN

The heartbeat of Guardiola's team was undoubtedly peerless playmaker Kevin de Bruyne. The 26-year-old has established himself as one of the best attacking midfielders in the world since his £55million move from Wolfsburg in 2015. And with a league-high 15 assists to his name, the flame-haired footballing whizz is surely a shoe-in for a PFA Player of the Year nomination.

MONEY, MONEY, MONEY

It's no secret that since Sheikh Mansour took control of the club in 2008, City haven't been averse to splashing the cash on new players. But the days of £25million bids for bog-standard players such as Joleon Lescott and Roque Santa Cruz are well behind them.

Most notable was Guardiola's defensive overhaul, which saw Premier League veterans Bacary Sagna, Gael Clichy, Aleksandar Kolarov and Pablo Zabaleta shipped out to make way for Kyle Walker, Benjamin Mendy and Danilo - albeit at an eye-watering cost of £121million. Then there was the £35million acquisition of goalkeeper Ederson in, and the January addition of Spanish £57million.

CITY'S YOUNG GUNS

Towards the end of his predecessor Manuel Pellegrini's reign, Manchester City were relying on a relatively old quard of players. Pep's revolution has seen a lot of the club's over-30s shipped out, favouring some of football's most exciting young prospects, with players like Leroy Sane, Gabriel Jesus. John Stones and Ederson all arriving before their 23rd birthdays.

WHERE NOW?

City may well have run off with the title, but there's still hope for the chasing pack. The recent derby loss having been 2-0 up at half-time pointed to defensive frailties, and Jurgen Klopp stills stands as Guardiola's nemesis when it comes to getting one over on the Spaniard, having engineered a Champions League knockout and the first of City's two domestic losses this term. As for the rest of the Premier League, they'll just be relieved at not having to face City for at least another two months.


