

If you love the current rustic vibe but not the hefty price tags, check out these easy twig projects.

SUNBURST TWIG MIRROR

YOU'LL NEED:

- > Lots of straight twigs of roughly the same size
- > A 25cm round frameless mirror
- > A 35cm circle of corrugated cardboard
- > A hot glue gun

HOW TO MAKE:

- > Glue the mirror in place in the centre of the cardboard circle.
- > Glue the twigs on the cardboard so that one end is right against the mirror edge and the other is sticking straight out, overlapping the cardboard. Layer on enough twigs so that the cardboard is completely covered.
 - For safety reasons, we recommend you prop your mirror on a shelf rather than hang it up.

TWIGGY PHOTO FRAME

YOU'LL NEED: For a 10cm x 15cm (6in x 4in) photo frame:

- >2x 15cm twias
- > 2x 20cm twias
- > Twine
- > PVA alue
- > A piece of baking paper slightly larger than the photo
- > Scissors

HOW TO MAKE:

- > To form the first corner, lay a longer twig on top of a shorter twig, allowing 2.5cm of each twig to stick out where they
- > Wrap the two together so the twine forms a cross shape on top. Tie to secure.
- > Complete this step on all corners in the same way to create a rectangle.
- > Glue the photo onto the baking paper. Then glue the edges of the baking paper to the back of the frame, with the picture facing out.

JEWELLERY TREE

YOU'LL NEED:

- > A strong hardwood branch approx. 25-30cm tall
- > A log slice about 5cm thick and 13-15cm in diameter
- > Epoxy glue (e.g. Araldite)
- > A drill and drill bits suitable for wood

HOW TO MAKE:

- > Drill a hole in the log slice, the same width as the main stem of the branch.
- > Fasten the branch in the hole with the glue and leave it
 - > Hang up your jewellery!

New housing for former homeless individuals



Abuilding in Maldon will be repurposed to provide accommodation for people transitioning out of homelessness.

The Salvation Army Housing Association (saha) has partnered with Maldon District Council (MDC) to convert Cecil Mary House.

Residents will be able to enjoy refurbished and furnished homes, including some with full wet rooms on the ground floor for those with accessibility needs.

Residents can live in the property for up to two years as they prepare to transition into permanent housing and continue progress toward independent living.

Lynne Shea, chief executive of saha, said: "We are delighted to open the doors of Cecil Mary House and give residents in Maldon the services and housing stability they need to move forward."

Councillor Richard Siddall, Leader of MDC, said; "This scheme shows great partnership working between saha and MDC. The new homes will provide both affordable accommodation and support to meet the needs of some of our most vulnerable residents."

Council faces legal costs following planning appeal

Maldon District Council (MDC) may have to pay legal costs after refusing plans for travellers' pitches with "no evidence" to back up their concerns.

The initial hearing took place in June this year, where the applicant said the council had "behaved unreasonably in refusing the application".

In a decision published last month, the appeal was found to be successful. This means that land and buildings lying to the south of Maldon Road will now

potentially be used for two traveller pitches with one mobile home and one touring caravan per pitch.

The final comments from the appeal said: "Unreasonable behaviour resulting in unnecessary or wasted expense has occurred and a partial award of costs is therefore warranted in respect of the costs arising from providing a defence to the council's third reason for refusal relating to undue harm to residential amenity of the neighbouring occupiers, by reason of both noise and outlook."

A spokesperson for MDC said: "MDC can confirm it is in receipt of a partial award of costs through a Costs Decision from the Planning Inspectorate dated August 21, 2023. This relates to a planning appeal in Woodham Mortimer reference APP/X1545/W/22/3308046. The council is engaging with the appellant to reach an agreement on the amount to pay."

Rock legend unveils tribute train at railway museum

↑ rock legend paid a visit to a Burnham-on-Crouch Amuseum earlier this month.

Rick Wakeman CBE (pictured below right), former YES keyboardist, world-renowned solo artist and avid railway enthusiast, unveiled the recently restored 1959 Class 31 locomotive at Mangapps Railway Museum.

Rick revealed this tribute to former pirate radio station Radio Caroline in its striking livery, then drove the train down the track on its inaugural run.

The 126-ton diesel locomotive was built in 1959 and is painted in original British Rail colours. It worked out of London Liverpool Street Station and may well have hauled the trains that took the likes of Radio Caroline presenters Johnnie Walker MBE and Tony Blackburn to Harwich in the Sixties to make their way out to Radio Caroline's pirate radio ship off the coast of Essex.

∧ s the population of our district grows, I am aware Aof the increasing pressure that this is putting on our local health services. This is bound to increase during the winter months as more people become ill with colds, flu and other respiratory infections.

Recently, plans to relocate some of the inpatient services from St Peter's Hospital (pictured) this winter have been announced by NHS clinicians and managers. I understand that this has raised concerns about its future. However, I am assured that these changes reflect the immediate needs of the service, are necessarily temporary in nature and affect only inpatient provision.

A decision has been taken to relocate the birthing unit to the WJC in Braintree, which offers purposebuilt facilities for midwife-led births. I know that St Peter's maternity unit has a long history of serving the population of Maldon - indeed, I led a campaign against its closure many years ago. However, it now only sees an average of six births a month.

St Peter's was built as a workhouse in 1872 and

the building has deteriorated badly in recent years. Having recently visited a friend in one of the wards, I know that the care offered by the staff is superb, but the conditions mean that it will become impossible to sustain a safe and high-quality service. Before any permanent decisions are taken about these and other services, there has to be a full public consultation.

At the same time, plans for new facilities are underway. A new GP health centre in Heybridge will provide considerable extra space for existing practices, and Longfield Medical Centre will also be expanded on its present site.

I will also continue to work with the local NHS, Essex County Council and Maldon District Council to bring about a new health hub to which Blackwater Medical Centre can relocate and which will provide the range of services for the local population currently provided from St Peter's.

I am determined that these developments should give the people of Maldon district the modern and high-quality health facilities they so badly need.

Keeping your dog SAFE IN AUTUMN

utumn is one of the best times of year for long walks with your dog, when the leaves are falling from the trees and the weather has cooled. That being said, there are lots of lurking dangers that you need to be aware of.

ACORNS: Acorns contain a toxic ingredient called tannic acid which can cause damage to your dog's liver and kidneys. When ingested, they can also lead to vomiting, diarrhoea, lethargy and abdominal pain.

CONKERS: Conker seeds boast a spiky green shell that can injure your dog's mouth if picked up and carried around. The shiny brown conker inside can be a choking hazard and, if ingested, can cause vomiting, diarrhoea and sometimes an intestinal blockage.

FALLEN FRUIT: If you take your dog on long country walks, they are highly likely to encounter fallen fruit such as apples and plums. When these fruits fall on the ground, they start to ferment and produce a natural alcoholic substance. If eaten in large quantities, this can cause vomiting and

HARVEST MITES: Harvest mites are tiny red mites that tend to appear at the end of summer and into autumn. They are often found on a dog's coat, in between their toes and in their ear folds. These mites can cause extreme itching and trauma to the skin.

WILD MUSHROOMS: Wild mushrooms come in all sorts of shapes, colours and sizes, which makes it very hard to distinguish between the edible ones and those that are poisonous. If your dog eats an unknown fungus, it may cause a mild stomach upset, or it could be deadly.

SPRING BULBS: Many people plant spring bulbs in autumn, such as daffodil, tulip and spring crocus bulbs. These are all toxic to dogs and can make them very unwell if ingested.



ne ability of animals to explore the world is only bettered by the wanderlust of humans, yet there is still a clutch of species who have never ventured from their home continents and, in some cases, countries. While the Galápagos Islands typically take credit for the planet's most unique array of life, here are some others worth celebrating.

GELADA. ETHIOPIA

A monkey that looks like it's wearing a tuxedo, the gelada is native to the highlands of Ethiopia and has rarely strayed. While other monkey species are known for swinging from trees with reckless abandon, these are happiest on the desert floor, eating grass, seeds, roots and insects.

INACCESSIBLE ISLAND RAIL. INACCESSIBLE

Yes, there is a place called Inaccessible Island - it's in the South Atlantic - and it requires little description. To describe the world's smallest flightless bird (which also takes the 'Inaccessible' name) is undoubtedly to make a straightforward link to how this little creature has never made it to the mainland.

THORNY DEVIL. AUSTRALIA


This lizard looks like something out of a Marvel comic, albeit it's never been exported any further than the Aussie outback. It can drink water through its skin, which is just as well, as there is precious little of the stuff about in the summer heat of the Southern Hemisphere.

Without eyes or skin colour, this peculiar amphibian detects prey by virtue of vibrations around it. It has never made it out of US waters and you're highly unlikely to ever see one in the flesh, since it lives deep underwater in cave networks.

MANX CAT. ISLE OF MAN

Lastly, there's the famous Manx cat. Although these have been brought across to the mainland, they stand apart from other cat species owing to a rare genetic mutation that means they are

■ Trace the shape with glue: The next step is to trace glue along each line of your spiderweb. Again, young children may need help with this if they want to achieve a good spiderweb shape. To make the glue lines as smooth as possible, do not allow the tip of the glue bottle to touch the paper but instead, hover slightly above it.

Cover the spiderweb with salt: Fill a ramekin or small bowl with table salt and then use two fingers to pinch the salt and sprinkle it over the glue. Make sure that you cover each line and curve with enough salt. Leave the glue to fully dry, ideally overnight, before moving on to the next step.

Paint your spiderweb: Now comes the really exciting part: adding colour to your spiderweb. Watercolour paints are perfect for this as they spread well on dried glue and salt. Using a soft brush, plenty of water and your chosen watercolours, add a drop or two of colour to a salt line. Use a light touch and do not scrub



- ► Hummingbirds are the only birds that can fly backwards.
- ▶There are reportedly more than 350 known species of hummingbird, from the giant hummingbird weighing around 20g, to the bee hummingbird which measures less than three inches.
- ► Hummingbirds use their long, thin tongues like straws to drink nectar from flowers.
- ▶Rufous hummingbirds migrate 4,000 miles from Mexico to Alaska every spring.
- Female hummingbirds use spider silk to weave together twigs and leaves for their nests.
- ► Hummingbirds have no sense of smell.
