HOW TO RECOGNISE IF YOUR DRINK HAS BEEN SPIKED AND HOW TO PREVENT IT FROM HAPPENING

When you go out, can you honestly say that you watch your drink at all times? Spiking is currently at high levels in the UK and can happen to anyone.

Find out how to recognise the signs of spiking and what to do if you think your drink has been spiked below.

WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMONLY USED ILLEGAL DRUGS TO SPIKE DRINKS?

The most common illegal drugs used to spike drinks are GHB, ketamine and benzodiazepines such as valium and rohypnol.

HOW TO RECOGNISE IF A DRINK HAS BEEN SPIKED

- 1. It has a foggy appearance
- 2. It has excessive bubbles
- 3. The ice sinks to the bottom
- 4. A change in colour

It is important to know that some of the most regularly used drugs to spike drinks do not produce a smell or taste, meaning it can be difficult to know if your drink has been spiked until it is too late.

THE MOST COMMON SYMPTOMS OF SOMEONE WHO HAS HAD THEIR DRINK SPIKED ARE...

Dizziness | Difficulty walking | Confusion the next day | Nausea or vomiting | Hallucinations | Tiredness | Blurred vision | Paranoia | Amnesia

WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK YOU'VE BEEN SPIKED

If you think your drink has been spiked, stop drinking it. Tell someone you trust as soon as possible as spiking substances can take effect very quickly. Be wary of asking strangers for help and instead, if you are alone, seek out security or venue staff. If you need urgent help, call 999 and tell them you think you may have been drugged.

HOW TO PREVENT YOUR DRINK BEING SPIKED

- > Do not leave your drink unattended
- > Invest in anti-spiking lids from StopTopps, available from stoptopps.com
- > Do not accept drinks from strangers
- > Be vigilant of changes to your drink
- > Don't drink anyone else's drink.

GUIDE TO CLEANING

PAINTED WALLS

here is nothing worse than noticing a dirty mark or stain on a freshly painted wall.

Keep your painted walls looking fresh and fabulous for longer with our handy guide.

HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

- 1 Dust off any excess dirt using a lint-free cloth or a soft broom for hard-to-reach areas.
- 2. Fill a bucket with warm water and a gentle detergent.
- 3. Apply to the walls using a sponge mop or soft sponge.
- 4 Do not oversoak your sponge or mop as this can result in water stains.
- 5. Leave the solution for 10-15 minutes.
- 6. Rinse with clean water and a sponge or mop.
- 7. Dry by placing a microfibre cloth onto a flat-headed mop and gently rubbing over the wall.

HOW TO CLEAN PAINTED KITCHEN WALLS

Painted walls in the kitchen are prone to grease. To combat this, apply a gentle degreaser to any affected areas before following the same steps as above.

HOW TO SPOT CLEAN PAINTED WALLS

To get rid of small stains or marks on your painted walls, apply a mixture of water and baking soda or bicarbonate of soda to the affected area using a soft cloth or towel. Half a cup of baking soda or bicarb in a bucket of warm water will do the trick.

HOW TO REMOVE OIL STAINS FROM PAINTED WALLS

- 1 Mix one cup of white wine vinegar into a bucket of warm water.
- 2. Soak a soft sponge and apply to the stain.
- 3. Rub gently until the stain has disappeared.
- 4. You do not need to rinse the area.

WHAT NOT TO USE

You should not clean your painted walls with any cleaning products that contain alcohol or harsh chemicals, as these ingredients can break down your paint surfaces and leave your walls looking a mess.

A GUIDE TO HELP YOU DECIDE WHEN YOU SHOULDN'T USE YOUR VACUUM WHEN CLEANING

ome people love vacuuming; others can't stand it. Either way, there is no denying how quickly it can clean up your

However, did you know that there are some items that you should never hoover up?

PIECES OF GLASS

If you have smashed a glass, then you may reach for your vacuum cleaner to quickly clear the area. However, large pieces of glass can puncture the bag, get stuck in the hose and damage the interior. Instead, use a dustpan and brush for the large pieces and a damp cloth to pick up small shards. Be sure to wear gloves to protect your hands.

FINE DUST

Have you recently renovated your home? If yes, then your furniture is probably covered in dust particles. Sadly, you should not hoover these up as sanding residue and other tiny particles will clog the filters and cause your hoover to spit dust back into the air.

WET FOOD


Wet food, or anything wet or moist, should not be cleaned up with a vacuum cleaner. This includes soggy cereal, dog food and even small spills. Instead, use some kitchen towels or a tea towel.

SMALL METAL ITEMS

Small metal items such as paper clips and coins can easily become stuck in the rotating part of your vacuum cleaner and stop it from working properly. They can also sometimes break off plastic pieces from the interior of your appliance.

MAKE-UP

Dropped an eyeshadow palette on the carpet? Or some foundation? Although you may be tempted to use your hoover, this is not a good idea. Firstly, the vacuum brush could smear the make-up further into the carpet, and secondly, if you do manage to successfully clean it up, it is highly likely to melt once inside the appliance.



atthew Williamson, by his own admission, doesn't perhaps have a name that screams 'style, exuberance and panache', and considering this is someone who grew up in the murky confines of 1970s Manchester, there was no indication of the creative elevation that was to come.

And yet, in art just as in physics, equal and opposite reactions can provoke explosions of inspiration from very simple ripples of provenance. That is certainly the case with Williamson, who for more than two decades now has specialised in the wonder of colour.

He is an interior designer of great originality and acclaim, as his recent work with John Lewis determines. He is someone whose passion for colour, aesthetics and design was catalysed by his mother, but who has taken those principles to another level of optimism.

"If you're going to use colour, you have to be an optimist," he says. "You have to look at the beauty

of contrast and the potency of the shades and tones you put together.

"There is no point being afraid of trying things, and you should never enter a project imagining something isn't going to work. Only by trying will you know, and only through knowledge can you grow.

"Of course, it's about mixing up tones, but also enabling a background to act as a template for the colour detail you want to layer on top."

Replicating Williamson's colour-driven style of interior design is no easy task. It has, after all, taken the designer the best part of half a century to refine an interior design ethos that even he admits is still a work in progress. But the Central Saint Martins graduate insists the way to use colour is to follow your smile.

"If it makes you happy, it's working. If it paints pictures and provokes memories and inspires in you ideas to move forward, then you probably have what is right."

Mill Hall given Asset of Community Value status

Rochford District Council (RDC) has recognised Mill Hall in Rayleigh as an Asset of Community Value (ACV), which identifies a building believed to be important to social wellbeing.

The nomination to recognise Mill Hall, submitted by the Save Mill Hall community group, highlighted the range of activities that took place at the Mill Arts and Events Centre when it was open, following controversial plans to redevelop the site.

Councillor Simon Wootton, Leader of RDC, said: "We fully understand how important the range of events and activities that were previously held at Mill Hall are to local people. That is why, as part of the council's Asset Delivery Programme, we are committed to ensuring this site will continue to provide a community facility."

Inflation has just reached nine per cent. This is the highest rate of inflation in the UK for many years, yet this is not just a challenge for us here at home. Across the developed world, inflation has been rising fast over the last year.

There are several reasons for this international spike in inflation. First, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a major knock-on effect on international trade, depressing worldwide growth and disrupting international supply chains. This has now fed through directly to what consumers have to pay.

Second, the war in Ukraine. As the world began to recover from the pandemic and the demand for energy increased accordingly, the

price of major sources of energy was already beginning to rise. The Russian invasion of Ukraine has only served to exacerbate the price of energy worldwide. The effect of the war on agricultural production and exports of key commodities, like wheat and vegetable oil, has served to push up food prices too.

Nevertheless, to help families meet their food

and energy bills, the government has brought in a £22billion package of direct support, including increasing the National Living Wage to £9.50 an hour, reducing the Universal Credit taper rate, offering a cut of £150 a year on council tax bills for families with properties in Bands A to D, and increasing the National Insurance threshold in the Budget to £12,570 (the same as for income tax). Nonetheless, I know from my constituency surgeries and my email inbox that some of my constituents are finding dealing with the cost of living increasingly tough, so I hope that the government will be looking at further measures.

In summary, no single government can control the world price of oil or gas. Yet I believe it is still important to show solidarity with Ukraine, even if it has shortterm consequences for the price of energy and for the supply of some key foodstuffs. Nonetheless, we need to look after our own people back home as well.

Just as VISIONRayleighWickford went to print, the Chancellor announced a further £10billion programme of support, including more than £1,000 for families on the lowest incomes.




ayleigh Recycling Centre is trialling a new booking System for visitors.

Station ticket office could shut under new plans

Wickford Station ticket office could shut under plans for mass closures of more than 1,000 ticket offices across the network.

The National Union of Rail, Maritime and Transport Workers (RMT) last month revealed that the government has amended its guidance relating to changes to ticket office opening hours, which it says has cleared the way for train companies to cut or close ticket offices at rail stations across the country.

It has raised concerns over the loss of jobs and the potential impact of closures on passenger safety.

RMT argues that passenger safety should be a main concern for the industry; as if people do not feel comfortable using the services, a decline in users would be expected.

Mick Lynch, RMT general secretary, said: "The rail industry has made no secret of its goal of closing ticket offices, and the floodgates have now been opened for an annihilation of ticket offices across the network.

"Ticket office staff not only enhance the passenger experience, but they also ensure our railways are safe, secure and accessible. Wholescale ticket office closures would be disastrous for passengers and leave our railway deserted. Disabled and elderly passengers will be particularly affected.

"This once more proves that the government's 'levelling up' agenda is a sham and that England's rail is being downgraded, driving unnecessary social tensions between Britain's nations and demonstrating that a political choice has been made to downgrade England's rail users compared to Wales and Scotland.

"Make no mistake. RMT is ready to use all means at its disposal to fight any attacks on ticket offices; we will be launching a widespread public and political campaign to protect ticket offices and our station staff members' jobs."

Greater Anglia, which is responsible for Wickford Station, has been contacted for comment.

Meat thief banned from town centre for a year



↑ thief who stole meat from a supermarket Ain Wickford has been given a Community Protection Warning and told by police he must not return to the town for one year.

Essex Police officers, who were patrolling the town centre on May 12, responded to the incident quickly and detained the man after he was found hiding in a bush along the tracks at Wickford Train Station.

A spokesperson for Essex Police said: "The Billericay and Wickford Community Policing Team were contacted today [May 12] on the Wickford Town link radio system alerting them to a theft of meat in the Co-op.

"Officers, who were patrolling Wickford at the time, arrived within one minute. A male made off from them but was detained shortly afterwards hiding in a bush in Wickford Train Station, along the train tracks.

"As well as being dealt with for the theft, the male, from Harold Wood, has been given a Community Protection Warning not to return to Wickford. This condition will apply for one year."

Driver banned after driving at 80mph in 30mph zone

Adriver who travelled through Wickford at 80mph in a residential 30mph area has been disqualified from driving for 15 months.

Safer Essex Roads Partnership (SERP) revealed that the driver was also required to take an extended driving test, fined £400 and made to pay £145 in costs and a victim surcharge of £40.

A witness captured the Audi driver on camera in Radwinter Avenue, Wickford, travelling at more than double the legal speed limit, and submitted the footage to the SERP Extra Eyes team, who investigated.

Nicola Foster, chairman of SERP, said: "I was shocked watching this footage as the outcome could have been very different. The driver chose to drive at 80mph in a residential road and passed an island where children would choose to cross as a safe place, while also passing other cars which might hide people waiting to cross or crossing.

"Hopefully in a year's time when the driver can take the extended test to regain their licence, they might possibly reflect on how lucky they were that day that there was no permanently life-changing outcome for themselves or anyone else."

Conservatives keep control of council after local elections

The Conservative Party will continue to run Basildon Borough Council, after the elections on May 5 saw them win all three seats in Wickford.

A third of council seats were up for election, including the wards represented by Conservative leader Andrew Baggott, Labour leader Jack Ferguson and Independent group leader Kerry Smith.

Jack Ferguson lost his seat in the Pitsea North West ward to Conservative Sam Gascoyne.

In Wickford Castledon, Conservative candidate Alex Myers came out on top with 52 per cent of the votes, a total of 1.030. In Wickford North, Conservative Peter Holliman received 1,224 votes, a 42 per cent majority. In Wickford Park, Conservative candidate George Jeffery (pictured below) won with 874 votes, 48 per cent of the votes.

After the results, cllr Jeffery said: "I would like to thank my constituents for giving me the opportunity to continue to serve Wickford Park. As ever, I am contactable on email and mobile, if you need my assistance. Email George.Jeffery@members.Basildon. gov.uk or call 07570 282997."

Across the board, turnout for the election was low at 21 per cent. Wickford residents' attendance was slightly above average, with 31 per cent in Wickford Castledon, 28 per cent in Wickford North and 25 per cent in Wickford Park.





ew would dispute the notion that Queen Elizabeth II is our most impressive monarch ever.

Always carry out a pre-wash

This is one of the most important tricks of the trade – any professional car washer worth their salt will remove as much dirt as possible using a hose or jet wash before they start to use their hands to clean a vehicle. This is because both dirt and grime can drag along the exterior and damage the paintwork.

Use multiple buckets

You should always have two buckets to hand, one that contains your washing solution (ideally you should use car shampoo) and one filled with water for rinsing. It is also advisable to use a grit guard to catch the dirt.

Invest in a wash mitt

Although you can use a large sponge and still achieve a good finish, if you want optimum results,

you need to invest in a wash mitt. Typically made from lamb's wool or microfibre, these are much less likely to leave surface scratches as the deep and fluffy fabric absorbs the dirt better than a sponge.

Do not leave to dry naturally

Never leave your car to dry naturally. Instead, use a purpose-built blower, or even a leaf blower, or a triple-layered microfibre cloth to dry your car.

Avoid extreme heat and direct sunlight

Although you may think that the ideal time to wash your car is when the sun is shining, this is actually not the case. Not only will you have to work harder and faster as your car will dry quicker than normal, but extreme heat can affect the strength of the chemicals in the products you are using. Instead, wash early in the morning or after 5pm.



ach month we look at one of the most significant events in British sporting history. This month, it's the epic encounter between Björn Borg and John McEnroe at Wimbledon on July 5, 1980.

The Championships at Wimbledon have provided countless dramatic sporting memories over the years, and none more special than when British heroes of the ilk of Ann Jones and Andy Murray have lifted the coveted trophy.

Yet perhaps the most remarkable encounter certainly for sheer blood, guts, aggression and an unrelenting desire for victory - came in 1980 when a Swede faced an American.

Björn Borg had long been painted as the iceman. a Scandinavian purveyor of perfect tennis who was clinical and elegant in his despatching of opponents. John McEnroe, meanwhile, was the sweaty, unkempt brat of the game, with a confrontational,

aggressive game and a temperament to match.

That they collided so spectacularly on that sunny Saturday afternoon on July 5 will go down in SW19 folklore. McEnroe gained the upper hand by winning the opening exchange 6-1, before Borg fought back with 7-5 and 6-3 sets, giving him a 2-1 lead.

Looking to close out the match in the fourth set, Borg had five Championship points in an epic that went well past any reasonably expected distance. Finally, in the 34th game of the set, McEnroe broke the reigning champion - who was looking to win a fifth successive title - and took it 18-16.

Even in the deciding set, the duelling athletes made it to 6-6, though this time Borg broke McEnroe's steely serve, and his resolve, to take the set 8-6, and with it the Wimbledon title.

The epic was recently relived in a 2017 biopic, Borg vs McEnroe, starring Shia LaBeouf and Sverrir Gudnason.



AS THE WEATHER HEATS UP, MAKE SURE YOU DO YOUR **BIT FOR LOCAL WILDLIFE**



THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IS ACCELERATING THE ROLL-OUT OF 5G TECHNOLOGY... **COMING TO A BUS SHELTER NEAR YOU**

ake a look at your mobile phone and, if you're in one of the UK's bigger towns or cities at the time, you may see the 5G symbol in the top-right corner (providing you have an up-to-date 5G-enabled phone, that is). This form of telecommunication technology that, at its peak, is 100 times faster than 4G, its rapidly ageing brother, has the capability to completely transform our interconnectivity.

The issue with 5G is that while speeds are seriously impressive, range is not. This is down to the use of millimetre waves, which are a lot shorter than the wavelengths 4G uses.

As a result, the government has been rapidly releasing licences whereby buildings and facilities can be equipped with kit that will boost 5G connectivity.

The good news is that these 'cell sites' can be put up easily and, in most cases, you won't even

know they're there. From streetlights to signposts, bus shelters to CCTV poles, the government has slashed the red tape associated with the roll-out of the project. This is good news for us all - meaning easier installation, quicker connecting of new areas and faster speeds.

In simple usage terms - messaging, checking football scores and so on - you may not notice much difference, but for tasks that used to take hours, such as downloading a HD movie to your phone, the difference is astonishing. A recent survey by Uswitch found that Haul Fryn, a road in Swansea, South Wales, had the fastest download speed of anywhere in the country - 882Mbps, meaning a two-hour HD movie could be downloaded in just

HOW TO USE ROSEMARY IN THE KITCHEN

Rosemary salt

To create a rosemary-infused salt, fill a cup with rosemary leaves pulled from the stem and place in a bowl with 3 cups of salt. Stir together, cover and leave to sit for 2-3 weeks.

Rosemary oil

To make rosemary-infused oil, pour 2 cups of olive oil into a small pan and allow to simmer. Remove from the heat and add 3-4 dry sprigs of rosemary. Pour into a sterilised iar and cover with a lid.

Rosemary sugar syrup

Rosemary sugar syrup can be drizzled over cakes, yogurt or fresh fruit for a sweet and fragrant twist. Bring 1 cup of water to the boil and add 2 cups of sugar and 3-4 sprigs of rosemary. Once the sugar has dissolved, remove from the heat and take out the rosemary. Pour into a sterilised jar.

Rosemary lemonade

To make refreshing rosemary lemonade, simply bring 21/2 cups of sugar to a boil, remove from the heat and add 9 sprigs of rosemary. Leave to steep for 30 minutes and strain. Add ½ cup of fresh lemon juice and 4 cups of cold water. Chill and serve over ice on its own or with your favourite gin.

Rosemary butter

Soften a stick of butter (but don't melt it) and blend with rosemary leaves that have been removed from the stem and diced into small pieces. Slather on crackers, bread, meat or fish.

There are two types of delayed drowning: dry drowning and secondary drowning. Dry drowning occurs when you inhale water through the nose or mouth, causing a spasm in the airway and preventing air from entering the lungs. Secondary drowning results from a swelling of the air sacs in the lungs.







KNOW YOUR BITES

ost of the time, insect bites are more irksome than perilous, but that doesn't mean you shouldn't try to identify what has bitten you. It's always better to be safe than sorry.

Bedbugs Danger rating: 2/5

Bedbugs leave a small bite mark on the skin that can be red and very itchy. They are often found on areas of the body not covered by clothing, such as hands, neck and feet. In rare cases, someone may experience a serious allergic reaction to a bedbug bite.

Bees/Wasps Danger rating: 3/5

Bee stings result in a red skin bump that has a white circle around it. You are also likely to experience swelling, itching and some pain. With a wasp sting, a raised welt will appear around the site and you may feel itching, burning and a sharp pain. A severe allergic reaction to a bee or wasp sting can be life-threatening.

Fleas Danger rating: 1/5

Flea bites are instantly recognisable by an itchy welt on the skin which is surrounded by a red halo. These are often found in clusters on the ankles and legs.

Mosquitos Danger rating: 2/5

Mosquitos leave a raised, itchy, pink skin bump. You may find you have multiple bites in the same area. In rare cases, someone may experience a serious allergic reaction.

Spiders Danger rating: 4/5

Most spider bites cause minor symptoms, such as red skin, swelling and pain at the site. However, some spiders found in the UK are venomous and their bites can cause nausea, vomiting, dizziness and/or sweating. Spider bites can also become infected or cause a severe reaction in some cases that requires immediate medical care.

Ticks Danger rating: 3/5

If you are bitten by a tick, you may notice a red bite, a rash, itching and burning. Around two per cent of tick bites cause Lyme disease, which can result in fever, fatigue and rashes.

Witch hazel

Not just great at soothing sunburn and stopping spots, witch hazel is also a natural astringent and an anti-inflammatory, meaning it can soak up excess moisture and kill unwanted bacteria. Plus, it gets rid of odour fast.

Simply place a dab of witch hazel onto a cotton cloth and rub it on your underarm area. Reapply as and when needed.

Baking soda
