The task was never going to be easy, particularly when main rivals, Liverpool, were a revitalised side looking to get back to the top table of British football for the first time in 30 years.

Pep Guardiola's men lost four times across the 38 games, but crucially, drew only two of the other 32, and while only a solitary defeat blemished Liverpool's season record (to Manchester City in January), it was the Blues' ability to turn draws into wins that saw them home.

Even when 10 points adrift of Liverpool, ice-cool Pep continued to let his side's ability do the talking. "Football matches can be won in the changing room, in the tunnel, on the pitch," he said at Christmas. "The good sides make sure it is on the pitch, and I think we will prove that."

Sure enough, in 2019, the Cityzens failed to win only three of 31 matches in 90 minutes, in all competitions. The exceptions were the 0-0 draw in the League Cup final – which mattered not as they beat Chelsea 4-3 on penalties anyway – an under-par 2-1 defeat at Newcastle United, and that 1-0 loss in the first leg of their Champions League quarter-final match against Spurs (in which they missed an early penalty).

In almost every other game they breezed past opponents with an air of fiery football finesse. It is a method of match mindfulness that only Liverpool under Jurgen Klopp can rival, and winning their final 14 league matches saw them take the Premier League crown by a solitary point.

And when the pressure was off, the prowess of Sterling, Aguero, Kompany and the Silvas (David and Bernardo) shone greater than ever – no better witnessed in that destructive 6-0 Wembley win against Watford, the match which sealed the 'treble' with the addition of the FA Cup to the season's silverware.

While some will point to City's failure to make their mark in the Champions League, did they actually do any worse than the supposed 'big two', Real Madrid and Barcelona? Both achieved catastrophic capitulations when it mattered, whereas Guardiola's men bowed out in a titanic battle against Tottenham, and were a VAR decision away from qualifying.

If the last two seasons are anything to go by, Manchester City will again be the team to beat next year. Rivals will be encouraged to see inspirational captain Vincent Kompany return to his native Belgium, but the club's pitch riches run embarrassingly deep, and in Phil Foden, Oleksandr Zinchenko and Lukas Nmecha, a new breed of youngster is emerging to make the challenge for others even greater.

£15million project sale could face judicial review

nale land to sell part of a £15million boatyard redevelopment in Woodbridge could face a judicial review after the proposal caused local concern.

Last month, Woodbridge Town Council held a special meeting to discuss challenging the revisions to the Whisstocks development, which would see the restaurant split into smaller units and holiday accommodation.

The £15million project was completed in December 2017 and saw the transformation of a derelict boatyard by the famous Tide Mill into a new heritage hub, including a mixture of homes, businesses and community buildings.

Developers, FW Properties claimed the scheme would bring economic vitality to the area, describing it as the "jewel" of Woodbridge.

The 2013 planning application specifically highlighted the community benefits to Woodbridge with more job opportunities.

However, a major part of the development, a two-

storey restaurant called The Chandlery that was said to offer dining views over the River Deben, has remained vacant.

FW Properties claim the building was too big for a single restaurant and in December 2018, applied to change its use by allowing the ground floor to be split into two retail units with holiday accommodation on the first floor.

In April 2019, East Suffolk Council approved the application which has caused local people to take action, particularly as they claim the decision being taken by officers and not planning committee members as it should have been.

A spokesperson for East Suffolk Council said: "We are confident that this matter was handled properly, under the legislation relating to planning, and we will vigorously defend our position at any review."

During the Woodbridge Town Council meeting, the council voted 7-2 in favour of supporting a judicial review against the Whisstocks planning decision.



# Sunsets on charity 10K for another year

There was another successful turnout for the 38th annual Woodbridge 'round the town' charity races, held this year on Sunday, May 19.

Once again the streets of Woodbridge were lined with hundreds of spectators and well-wishers for the races that help to raise money for local charities.

The six charities being supported by the 2019 races were East Anglian Air Ambulance, Fresh Start New Beginnings, Just42, Lapwing Education, MIND and Suffolk Accident Rescue Service.

With the generosity of the 26 sponsors, and the runners' entry fees, £12,000 was raised, which is split equally between six charities, bringing the total charitable donations over the 38 years to more than £103,500.

The race is organised by the Woodbridge Shufflers Running Club (WSRC). From arranging the road closures to entries to marshalling and filling goody bags, the club spends many months putting the race on the road, supported by its army of volunteers.

With over 100 runners, this year Woodbridge saw Benjamin Carpendale win the race but not without an exciting head-to-head with runner-up, Matthew Spencer.

However, it was Helen Davies who caught the eyes of onlookers as she broke the female course record and finished in third place overall.

Roger Ackerley, president of the WSRC, said: "Helen's record was a truly historic moment in the history of the race.

"It took me back to the 1980s when Glynis Penny dominated our women's race. Like Helen, she represented GB and finished third in the 1983 London Marathon."

# Town left without water after pump failure

Alarge area of Woodbridge was left without water after a pump failure.

The issue occurred at around lunchtime on May 29 and homes and businesses were affected with very low water pressure or in some areas, no water at all.

Engineers from Anglian Water tried fixing the problem and anticipated the water being turned back on around 6pm.

An Anglian Water spokesperson said: "Our teams successfully repaired a pump in the Woodbridge area which left a small number of properties experiencing some low water pressure.

"The pump was repaired and water supply was returned to normal as quickly as possible. We're sorry for any inconvenience that may have been caused and we'd like to thank residents for their patience while our teams made these vital repairs."





I've just been abroad visiting my mother's older sister, my aunt Anne. My mother was born in 1924, so any older sister of hers must be really quite old indeed. Anne is 96 next month.

I hadn't seen her for years (family carers will know that one of the huge constraints is our inability to leave home). Anne's deafness makes phoning difficult, and she doesn't 'do' social media, so we've written letters – usually about my mother, chair-bound for several years. I was expecting a replica of her, in slightly better health.

So I was totally startled by the woman who answered the door - young, sprightly, alert. A woman who held herself tall and walked easily. She looked many years younger than her sister, my mother. And her brain was as active as her body. It was a delight and a privilege to meet and talk to her, of things past and present.

But afterwards I wondered, why it was that Anne - two years older than my mother - should enjoy so much better health. After all, they'd had the same parents, upbringing, ate the same food, took the same exercise. They had the same genes. What was the difference?

Was it that, while my mother rather did as she pleased. Anne had needed to work hard throughout



her life? And like everyone who works, she'd often had to do things that were difficult, or uncomfortable. Is this good for you? Anne had been a nurse, a midwife, later ran a clinic, whilst looking after her own mother, a brood of grandchildren, and her muchloved husband with Alzheimer's. She swam daily in the sea till recently. Even today she walks two miles to the shops as often as possible.

It would be nice to think that hard unacknowledged work is good for your health.


# High flying for unruly pig chef







All animals can suffer from too much sun exposure, especially dogs with a short or light-coloured coat and white cats, so it is important that you keep them out of direct sunlight at the hottest part of the day. Also, ask your vet about sun cream specifically designed for pets.

#### 2. KEEP YOUR PET SAFE FROM PARASITES

Fleas, ticks and mosquitos are rife in the summer. so it is vital that your pet is given the appropriate treatment to prevent them catching a whole host of diseases including Lyme disease and Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever.

#### 3. BE AWARE OF THE RISK OF DROWNING

If you have a paddling pool or swimming pool in your garden, make sure that you cover it overnight and are vigilant during the daytime.

#### 4. ALWAYS PROVIDE YOUR PET WITH SHADE AND FRESH WATER

This may seem like an obvious one, but not all animals will have the sense to move themselves out of the sun and into the shade so you may need to give them a helping hand.

#### **5. BE VIGILANT AROUND OPEN WINDOWS**

This one is specifically for cats, as there is a risk of them falling out and injuring themselves.

#### 6. CHECK FOR SIGNS OF FLY STRIKE

Rabbits and guinea pigs are susceptible to flies laying eggs in their fur if they are dirty which will lead to maggots attacking them. Ensure their fur is clean and free from eggs.

#### TIPS AND TECHNIQUES TO MAKE YOUR GARDEN SEEM BIGGER









ntil those lottery numbers come in, many of us are happy to accept the fact that what we can do with our front and – in particular – back gardens has limitations. Perhaps

our property backs onto our neighbours', perhaps we're living in a built-up area where even the smallest patch of grass is to be cherished. Whatever the case, there are a few choice techniques that can make your humble plot seem like the perfect place to stretch out, unwind and soak up nature.

#### PLANT ALONG EDGES

Our perception of size is largely guided by the way our eyes see lines. If you can disguise the line where a patio meets a wall, for example, you are playing with the perception of your garden's end point and it will appear to increase in size.

#### **DIAGONALS AND LAYERS**

The use of diagonals, particularly where paths are concerned, is great to send the eye into the distance. In the same way, layer plants to create the idea of exploration and depth.

#### GO UP, NOT OUT

If space left and right is at a premium, consider reaching up and planting tall, diverting the eyeline away from borders and into the sky.

#### **MIRROR MIRROR**

Subtle use of mirrors (so that they don't directly reflect back onto people), is arguably the simplest way of expanding space and is a technique employed by many of the best designers.

#### **LET THERE BE LIGHT**

As well as mirrors, using bright painted shades (on fences, walls and even the floor) can light your garden and give the impression of space. In contrast, dark tones offer shadows and a feeling of the walls coming in, so avoid at all costs.

#### DECLUTTER

Finally, leave as best you can your garden as a paradise for plants, flowers and very little else in order to increase space. The kids' toys can be put elsewhere!



#### THE 10 MOST COMMON MISTAKES WE MAKE WHEN GARDENING

#### 1. TOO MUCH OF A GOOD THING

Less is more when it comes to good gardening. If you cram too much together it will look a mess, or worse still, die.

#### 2. OVER- AND UNDER-WATERING

Be regimented over your watering routine and adjust it depending on rainfall to ensure your garden is nicely hydrated at all times.

#### 3. WEEDING THEM OUT?

Ensure what you're pulling up are weeds and not slow-developing flowers. Remember, everything grows at a different rate and sometimes the most mundane of plants will become the most beautiful flowers... but only if they're left in the ground!

#### 4. FAILING TO PREPARE (YOUR SOIL)

Give your plants a chance by ensuring the soil is in good condition. A simple testing kit will let you know if you need to re-compost, add fertiliser, or simply switch to a different soil type.

#### 5. INVITING IN A BULLY

Ensure what you're planting doesn't have the ability to take over your entire plot.

#### 6. ANIMAL LIFE

Plants and flowers may be pleasing on the eye, but for local wildlife they represent dinner, so ensure your investments are well-protected or they may end up an evening meal for a squirrel or rabbit.

#### 7. HERE COMES THE SUN

Ensure plants are in the right areas to either soak up or be protected from the sun – it's a life-source and a killer in equal measure.

#### 8. SOWING YOUR SEED

Follow seeding instructions carefully or, much like fast-growing trellis plants, your garden floor could become a maze for all sorts.

#### 9. PESTICIDE PERIL

Consider that while pesticides will kill pests, they will also do real harm to your soil and grass if you use too much.

#### 10. SPREAD THE WEALTH

For a pleasing finish, try to tend to all your garden space in equal measure rather than blowing all your budget on one flowerbed.

Je all know how important sun cream is, but do we really know what type we should be using, how much we should be applying and whether spending a bit more really will save our skin in the long run?

UVB rays are responsible for the reddening of your skin and the unpleasant feeling of being sunburnt whereas UVA rays cause more long-term damage as they penetrate deeper into your skin and cause premature ageing. UVA stars are visible on all UK sun creams and indicate the percentage of UVA radiation absorbed in comparison to UVB. You should always pick a sunscreen that has between four and five UVA stars.

SPF stands for sun protection factor and is the measure of how much protection a sun cream gives against harmful UVB rays. SPF 15 filters out approximately 93 per cent of all UVB rays, SPF 30 keeps out 97 per cent and factor 50 manages to prevent a whopping 98



Most people actually massively underapply when it comes to sun cream, but it is essential that you apply the correct amount which is 1oz per application. You should also apply at least 30 minutes before going out in the sun and should always reapply every two hours and immediately after swimming.

It can be tempting to use last year's bottle if you have some left over but most sun creams only last between 12 to 18 months and this can be even less if they have been exposed to high temperatures or direct sunlight.

Recent testing by Which? found that many supermarket-branded sun creams were equally, if not more effective than some of the best sellers.



If you have Arthritis, a work-out may be the last thing on your mind. But maybe it shouldn't be, writes fitness instructor, *Julie Foster*.

Exercise is crucial for people living with arthritis, which may seem contradictory. When your joints are already painful, the last thing you want to do is exercise, but exercise has been proven to reduce the pain of arthritis and improve function.

Arthritis is the inflammation of one, or more joints. If inflammation in the joints becomes extreme, it can cause pain, stiffness and swelling.

There are an estimated ten million people with some form of arthritis living in the UK. The most common misconception about arthritis, is that it is only found in older people. In fact, arthritis can affect people of all ages.

Exercise increases strength and reduces joint pain, which can help combat fatigue and low mood.

Endorphins are released when we exercise, these are our body's natural pain killers. By exercising, we see benefits of reduced pain, increased function and mobility, increased energy levels, weight loss, which will in turn take pressure off of joints, improved ligament strength and muscle tone.

If we start to avoid exercise, for fear of doing our joints more harm, then this will cause our muscles to weaken, and our joints to become stiffer.

You should always start slowly, and gradually increase the amount of exercise that you do, working at your own pace. I would always recommend that you speak to your GP before partaking in any exercise regime, to seek advice.

Exercise doesn't need to be vigorous. You don't need to run 10k to feel the benefits, you could start with some simple stretching at home, and work up to taking a short walk.


Keeping up momentum is an important part of exercising, so choose something fun, that you will enjoy doing, and you will be more likely to stick to it. Don't forget to rest when you need to, and drink plenty of fluid.

Simply mix 300g flour, 7g fast-action yeast, 6g salt, 15g caster sugar, 15g softened butter, 170ml milk and one egg to form a soft dough.

Knead for 10 minutes, then leave to prove in a lightly oiled bowl for an hour.

Dust your work surface with polenta and flour before rolling your dough to 2.5cm thick. Then cut out eight muffin shapes and prove for a further 30 minutes.

Finally, griddle the muffins for five minutes on both sides.



Combine 650g flour, 7g fast-action yeast, 2tsp of salt, 50ml milk and 25ml olive oil in a bowl, before slowly adding 325ml of warm water.

Knead on a floured surface for five minutes, before proving until doubled in size. Knock back the dough and knead till smooth then prove for a further hour.

Divide into six balls which can be rolled into pizzas, add your favourite toppings, then cook in the oven for 12 minutes at 200 degrees celsuis or gas mark 6. Voila!



Combine 500g flour, 50g sugar and 1½ tsp salt with 300ml of cold water and 14g fast-action yeast to form a dough which must be kneaded for five minutes then chilled.

Now flatten 300g butter between two pieces of baking paper into a rectangle about 20x15cm and chill. Next, roll out your chilled dough and place your butter in the centre before folding over the four corners to envelop the butter. Repeat this chilling and folding process twice more before chilling overnight.

On the morning you want to bake, cut your dough into six thin triangles which can be rolled up, left to prove for two hours and then baked for 15 to 18 minutes at 200 degrees celsuis or gas mark 6.

For chocolate croissant follow the same recipe as above but conceal pieces of dark chocolate within the rolls of your croissant.





#### WHY AN EIGHT-YEAR-OLD FROM CALIFORNIA IS BEING LABELLED THE PEWDIEPIE OF THE TOY WORLD

f we told you that the highest-earner on YouTube raked in over £17million in the 12 months leading up to June 2018, you'd be forgiven for expecting some young, trendy, Generation Z type, with a smattering of tattoos and a trendy hairstyle.

Well... you'd be correct on the 'young' bit, at least.

In actual fact, the influencer in question is eight years old, reviews toys, and in the past couple of years has elevated his status to become one of the industry's most powerful marketing men (boys).

It all started when Ryan Kaji was four years old. He asked his parents why he couldn't do his own reviews of toys like so many others online. By March 2015 he was producing rather runof-the-mill video material, starting with a Lego train set.

While his channel, Ryan ToysReview, had got off to a somewhat inauspicious start, in July that year, one video – where he opened a box containing over 100 items from the Pixar Cars collection – went viral, clocking

up 935million views.

Not long afterwards, a video that combined, of all things, a water slide, giant eggs, Disney cars and *Paw Patrol* toys did even better. To date, it has achieved 1.8billion views.

These days, content focuses on toys new to the market, with food videos included too. The careful curation of the brand has led to 19million subscribers, product endorsements and launches, and guest appearances.

Naturally, the reaction of many is to turn a nose up at this latest breed of 'celebrity'. Except consider this – across hundreds of videos, thousands of hours and countless cheesy grins, there is zero violence, zero prejudice, and definitely no mention of Brexit.

If Ryan is a beacon of hope in the simple, innocent pursuit of joy through toys, perhaps we should all applaud him for that.

# THE GERMAN GIA

Bayerische Motoren Werke. It may not roll off the tongue, but it forms the acronym for one of the motoring industry's most recognisable brands. It began as three separate manufacturers - two in Bavaria, Rapp Motorenwerke and Bayerische Flugzeugwerke (BFw); and in Thuringia, Fahrzeugfabrik Eisenach.

The first of those companies, Rapp Motorenwerke was an aircraft engine manufacturer. It had launched in 1913 but had struggled and was then drafted in to help the Germans' war effort. Only an order of 600 engines in 1916 saved the company from closure although its fortunes then continued to improve, despite the country's catastrophic defeat in World War I. A merger with BFw (which later became Bayerische Motoren Werke), combined with Germany's agreement to cease plane production, saw a move to new premises and an extended product list that included cars

The BMW name only became relevant to automobiles in 1929 when the company purchased

Fahrzeugfabrik Eisenach, who at the time were making Austin Sevens. BMW's engineers then took that idea a step further and began making luxury cars, starting with the BMW 328.

Car production ended at the time of World War Il when aircraft engines again took priority, for obvious reasons. The company was responsible for the inner workings of the notorious Nazi fighter Focke-Wulf FW-190, but despite another military defeat, the quality of production and workmanship ensured there was still a demand for the German company's goods.

Several of BMW's 'signatures' from those early days still remain - the 'kidney grille' was first introduced on the 303 in 1933 and the famous logo incorporates the flag of Bavaria.

And in the years that have followed, the manufacturer has consistently reinforced its ability to create the very best cars and bikes, moving into a luxury market which, alongside other German brands Audi and Mercedes, it looks likely to forever be a part of.


