














hile for an entire nation, the world around us has changed in ways more dramatic than we ever thought possible, there have been a couple of unexpected upsides to the terrifying global pandemic.

Firstly, we've seen society return to a much simpler way of life. Many work pressures – right down to the morning commute – have been removed, and with it, the hourly anxieties of jobs, tasks and duties lifted.

Children have enjoyed quality time with parents, and we've caught up with old friends more frequently than ever before, albeit online.

From bike rides to DIY, crafts to baking, health, relaxation and endless spurts of creativity and community spirit, the impact on us, as people, has been profound.

And yet, that is only half of the story. With our physical footprint on the environment lessened, we have seen nature reclaim great swathes of the country.

Car journeys have been minimised, meaning fewer harmful pollutants in the air (carbon dioxide levels have dropped 25 per cent); and there were 67 million fewer flights in the first three months of 2020 compared to the same period last year. Indeed, researchers at Stanford University estimated that improvements in air quality have saved the lives of 20 times the number of people killed by the virus.

Consider too that pollution levels in rivers are down – we all saw the pictures of the crystal clear canals in Venice – and even by Greta Thunberg's own admission, the Climate Crisis is "on hold".

While the positive environmental effects of coronavirus may only be temporary, perhaps the pandemic has opened our eyes to the very real impact we have on the world. And perhaps that, in turn, will ensure that while our investment in community, social distancing and hygiene is forever changed, so may we just give that little bit extra to the natural world too.

Fury as memorial bench gets vandalised

The sister of a man who died nine years ago has hit out at vandals after they destroyed a bench that was installed in his memory earlier this month.

The bench bears a plaque which reads "In Memory of Our Dear Phil We Miss You" and the town council appealed for help in tracking down the family.

Phil Jarrold's sister Vic said she was extremely upset. She commented: "I am shocked people have no respect for other people's feelings. You can see it means something to somebody. It's been nine years, but I still think about him and miss him every day.

"It was nice to have it there to go and sit on. I now have to tell my mum and dad and they will be upset. One mindless act affects a lot of people and I don't

get what joy someone gets out of doing something like this."

Woodbridge Town Council broke the news on social media that the circular bench on Kingston Field had been irreparably damaged.

A post read: "We had made many repairs in the last few years but were obviously fighting a losing battle."

As well as condemning the act, members of the Woodbridge Community Group suggested holding a fundraiser to replace the bench, a move which Vic said she supported.

She added: "Reading the comments helped and shows the majority of people are appalled. To suggest a fundraiser is a lovely idea."

The drama reportedly unfolded next to a footpath near the River Debden.

A Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service spokesman said crews undertook a water rescue to save the individual and the dog.

After she was rescued, the woman was checked by paramedics and she was not injured.

Man who targeted businesses iailed for four vears

A33-year-old man has been sentenced to four years in jail after being charged in connection with a burglary from businesses in Woodbridge and Saxmundham in April this year.

At 11.30pm on Friday, April 3, Darrell Lambert broke into the Seckford Golf Club, Seckford Hall Road, Woodbridge and stole a quantity of alcohol and confectionary.

Police were called just before 2am the day before to reports of a burglary at Martin's Newsagents, Market Place, Saxmundham. A concrete block had been used to smash the front door of the shop and items including cigarettes had been stolen.

At 3.20am on April 3, police in a patrol vehicle in Ipswich spotted a suspicious Volkswagen Golf. The car failed to stop for officers, drove the wrong way at high speed on the one-way traffic system at the waterfront and also mounted the kerb. It came to a stop after colliding with a tree stump. Lambert attempted to make off but was arrested by officers on suspicion of burglary, dangerous driving, failure to provide a specimen of breath and failing to stop. He also stated that he had COVID-19 and threatened to bite and spit at officers.


Lambert, of no fixed address, was taken to Martlesham Police Investigation Centre and charged with burglary, assault and driving offences.

He pleaded guilty to two counts of burglary, two counts of assaulting an emergency worker, driving otherwise than in accordance with a licence and failure to provide a specimen of breath when he appeared before Ipswich Crown Court on May 29. He also asked for two other burglary offences to be taken into consideration.

He was sentenced to four years in prison, disqualified from driving for six years and made to pay a £181 victim surcharge.

News from Councillor Geoff Holdcroft

Town Councillor for Woodbridge Riverside

Not surprisingly the work of Woodbridge Town Council is largely focused on dealing with the ongoing COVID-19 crisis. As I write this article the council are in discussion with East Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council as to best prepare for the opening of most of the retail shops in the coming week. The main principle is creating a safe environment in which shoppers, retailers and their staff feel comfortable in and one in which they can maintain social distancing.

To some the measures that will be put in place will be seen as too draconian whilst others may see them as too lax. What I hope will happen is that everybody will try and respect others and use lots of common sense. One plea I might make is to be careful when talking

and walking; it's far too easy to get caught up in a conversation with either a companion alongside you or on the phone with a loved one, and then walk into the path of someone who is trying to maintain their social distance.

The one area of work that still goes on regardless of COVID-19 is planning. The Planning Committee continues to meet every two weeks, via Zoom, to consider the latest applications. In particular, these past few weeks we have been considering changes to the draft Local Plan recommended by the planning inspector. We have been concerned how many of the green spaces in town can stay protected in the future and are in the process of ensuring just that.

ince I was told to shield in late March I've Owalked over 300 early morning miles, safe from mankind - watching innumerable larks rising, hearing more cuckoos than one would ever think possible, seeing egrets, blackcaps, goldfinch, warblers, linnets, whitethroats nesting and guarrelling, watching raptors circle patiently, and discovering more and

more wrens shrilling and nightingales trilling in secret thickets, while woodpeckers drum overhead. I've seen bees swarming round a hollow tree, measured an oak that was already grown when Richard III came off his horse, spotted a hare hiding in a field (all but his ears), and watched a barn owl float across a field of buttercups. All within walking distance of home.

Even in a pandemic we live in a place that is remarkably blessed - almost, one might say, shielded. But communities are, in many ways, what we make ourselves. Long ago, a man called Colston made a great deal of money out of the slave trade, and, many years after Britain abolished slavery, Bristol put up a statue to him as a 'most virtuous and wise citizen.' It recently - deservedly - has been the centre of much controversy.

In contrast, our corner of Suffolk was home to the two great abolitionist Clarkson brothers: John (who founded Freetown, Sierra Leone) lived in Woodbridge;



while Thomas, his brother, who played a leading part in the abolition of the slave trade, lived at Playford. In Woodbridge we have commemorated both: John with a blue plaque in Church Street, Thomas, memorialised at the top of the Ipswich Road - where the Clarkson Crossing stone has a design of opened shackles. It was Farlingave students who chose the name. They clearly had a different idea of 'virtuous and wise.'

Sometimes in order to be blessed, one needs to swim against a current and shout out against what is wrong. We may be judged indulgently by our contemporaries, but future generations will see us in clear focus.

Landscape painter captures lockdown

While the majority of people are hoping to soon forget the struggles of lockdown, a Woodbridge painter has managed to capture the most positive aspects of

Mark Beesley, 67, a professional artist from Old Barrack Road, painted a new landscape (pictured) from his window over a three-week period early in lockdown.

He said: "I usually paint landscapes based on being outdoors and in natural settings. But I'm pretty much completely self-isolating now, so while I normally wouldn't consider this kind of painting interesting, I decided to do it.

"People will forget fairly quickly about life in lockdown, probably intentionally - but from my window, I could see how different certain things have been. There have been no cars around, and lots of people walking and jogging and speaking to each other.

"There's been a completely different atmosphere, and it's one that I don't think we'll have again when this ends.

"I quite enjoyed painting for those three weeks. It was different from my normal work and I doubt I'll do anything like this again, but I did enjoy it."



hile it's clear the year 2020 is set to be a disastrous one for the sales departments of estate agents, the trend for doing up rather than shipping out is one that began long before coronavirus changed our financial and lifestyle habits.

YOU WILL NEED:

A bandana or square cotton cloth (22 inches x 22 inches) | Rubber bands or hairbands

HOW TO MAKE:

Take the fabric and fold the top and bottom into the centre | Fold the sides towards the centre and loop the rubber bands around the fabric | Tuck one end of the fabric into the other | Lift the mask to your face and loop the bands over your ears | Adjust as needed, ensuring that your nose and mouth are fully covered Photo credit: www.sarahmaker.com

SEW OPTION

YOU WILL NEED:

2 of 10 inches x 6 inches rectangles of fabric – tightly woven cotton is recommended | 2 of 6 inches pieces of elastic or rubber bands | Sewing machine | Needle and thread

HOW TO MAKE:

Stack the two rectangles on top of each other | Fold over the long sides ¼ inch and hem | Fold the double layer of fabric over ½ inch along the short sides and stitch down | Run a piece of elastic through the wide hem on each side of the mask using a large needle | Fasten the ends tightly together in a knot | Gently pull the elastic so the knots are tucked inside the hem | Adjust to fit your face

DIY FACE MASKS SHOULD:

- Fit snugly and always be secured over the face
- ✓ Include multiple layers of fabric
- ✓ Allow you to breathe without restriction
- ✓ Be washed regularly

DIY FACE MASKS SHOULD NOT:

- X Allow too much light to filter through the fabric



PARROTS



Home-made sauces and ideas for superb summer treats



et's be honest, we're all going to be spending a bit more time than we've been used to in the kitchen this summer.

While recreating that true summer vibe somewhere exotic may appear a pipe dream as things stand, that doesn't mean our limited outside space can't host a daring and dazzling array of summer treats, so here are some sauce ideas to get you going:

NUTELLA NICETIES

Perhaps the simplest sauce of them all – just melt three tablespoons of Nutella in a pan, adding a bit of water to keep the mixture moving.

When your sauce is smooth, runny and hot, add nuts, hundreds and thousands or any other textured topping and serve with ice cream or over some sliced banana pieces.




RASPBERRY SALTED CARAMEL SAUCE

This one takes a bit more effort but is well worth it. Take a cup of water and ½ cup of sugar and mix in a heated pan until it boils and the sugar turns brown.

Then add ½ cup of cream and the same quantity of raspberry purée, having first strained it to remove the seeds. Whisk, add 3 tbsp of butter, remove from the heat and add ¾ tsp of sea salt.

Use immediately for a thin sauce or refrigerate overnight for a thicker topping that's a belter on chocolate brownies.



For a more adult twist, adjust the ingredients to create the perfect coffee sauce that's great on cakes, cookies, muffins and more. This time it's one cup of sugar, ½ cup of water (and a further ¼ cup to make your coffee), then ¾ cup of cream. Butter increases to 5 tbsp but sea salt reduces to just ¼ tsp.

Make in much the same way, adding the ¼ cup of coffee where you'd previously introduced the raspberries, with 1/4 tsp of vanilla extract which is the final touch to set the whole thing off in a smoky, dreamy, saucy complexion.



All the fish is brought ashore using the company's two trawler boats, the Diana May and the Silver Harvest.


Regular catches include Dover Sole, Skate and Seabass, as well as occasional offerings of squid, spider crab and cuttlefish.



Of course, the government's drive to limit the possible spread of coronavirus germs via the exchange of physical cash has been a defining factor in the latest spike, continuing an upward trend of contactless payments that was already up 16 per cent year on year. And yet, even before the pandemic, the ease with which we got used to the purchase of goods and services with a simple tap on a card

totally redundant. Contactless payments offer a raft of benefits with very few downsides. There's

reader means we are edging ever closer to a

time when, in some situations, cash may become

the time-saving element - an average of seven seconds are saved per transaction versus chip 'n' pin, and 15 seconds on cash, according to research by Barclaycard. Then there's the removal of the need to carry heavy, dirty coins, or to head to the cashpoint to withdraw notes.

There's also the convenience of having a digital record of all transactions, and even the option to pay using a phone or watch.

And yet, while the drive towards convenience suits most of us, it does not apply to everyone - there are still 1.3 million people in the UK who do not have a bank account. Consumer groups have also noted the dangers of people idly 'tapping' away without any real thought about the money they are spending. And while fraud accounts for only 2.5p in every £100, the ease with which someone can spend on a stolen card is considerable.

What's certain is that as much as the powers that be may want to encourage our spending habits towards a certain way, as with most things,

However, the market fluctuations triggered by the coronavirus outbreak and its impact on the global economy have particular implications for investors taking income from their retirement pots.

There are two related concepts - or risks - at work in retirement investing.

The first is 'pound-cost averaging'. This is the result of buying smaller amount of stocks at different times, perhaps regularly, when building your pension pot; rather than risking making a big investment only to find the market falls.

But when you're withdrawing retirement income in a declining market you have to cash in more of your pot to maintain the same level of income as before. This is known as 'pound-cost ravaging'.

The other is "sequencing risk". This is the risk that a market downturn will happen at a bad time in your drawdown cycle. In a period of prolonged volatility, you may end up taking an unsustainably high amount of cash out of a pot that's dwindling.

When this downturn coincides with the beginning of your retirement, it's when you're most vulnerable because you are no longer working and you have all your retirement years yet to fund.

The good news, however, is there are several ways to help minimise the impacts of these risks.

They include having a cash fund to draw down from in times of volatility, so that equity investments are allowed to fluctuate and weather the storm. While this provides stability, any money held in cash will lose its value in real terms due to inflation.

Another option is to take only 'natural income' such as dividends - rather than drawing from capital. This will mean what you have to spend is variable and will be less when markets are depressed.

You need to be flexible and have several income strategies. The art of managing downturns in retirement is knowing exactly what to do and when - that's where financial advisers earn their stripes.

PENALTY CHARGE VS PARKING CHARGE – WHEN TO PAY AND WHEN TO PLAY

he scourge of the modern motor car is arguably not the cost of petrol, the maintenance or insurance premiums – it's the fact that once we've paid out for all of those elements that keep it on the road, there's actually nowhere to park the damn thing.

The reality is that virtually no cases ever get to court, and these unscrupulous businesses profit only from those who respond. So the next time you get a parking charge, search for the issuer online and check carefully exactly what it is you have in front of you. Motorists are now getting smart to filing these charges where they belong – in the bin – and saving millions in the process.

Imbing's debut in Tokyo reflects our growing love for strength-based pursuits that also require precision, strategy and focus.

That the sport has, over the past two decades, accelerated itself from the most basic of human endeavours to a physical challenge enjoyed both outdoors and indoors by participants of all ages, is testament to the number of activity centres that now provide walls to scale. Many have felt it was only a matter of time before the IOC opened its doors.

A dynamic challenge, the Olympic format will be split into three disciplines - Speed, Bouldering and Lead.

In Bouldering, it's a more challenging 4.5-metre wall, while in Lead, it's a case of

As ever, the vertical walls offer handholds footholds. as well as shapes, sizes, positive sections (slabs) and those with negative aspects (steeps or overhangs), meaning competitors will need to be at their best from the off.

Safety ropes are allowed, though the best competitors will try to limit any lost time and will be harnessing flexibility, skill and no small amount of mental decisiveness in tackling a new Olympic sport expected to thrill at every grab.
