WRIGHT STUFF

HOW ONE OF OUR MOST ADORED REALITY TV STARS WENT BACK TO HIS ROOTS... GRASSROOTS

t's a fantasy that has crossed the mind of every grown man in his late twenties who has a normal, run-ofthe-mill, everyday job. It's the thought, 'Perhaps it's not too late to realise every boy's dream and become a professional footballer; perhaps I can still make it.'

That reality TV star and Heart DJ Mark Wright still held those very unfulfilled ambitions is perhaps less of a surprise. He was, after all, on the books of West Ham, Arsenal and Tottenham as a youngster. When released at the age of 18, the left back was picked up by Southend United, but drifted into non-league football as the distractions of nightclub promotion and reality TV came about.

After spells in then Conference with Grays Athletic, Crawley Town and Rushden & Diamonds, the charismatic Essex-born star joined the cast of *TOWIE*. One of the original cast members, he was only with the ITV show a year, but the die was cast, and from *I'm a Celebrity... Get Me Out of Here!* to *Take Me Out: The Gossip*, through presenting jobs on *Mark Wright's Hollywood Nights*, *The Bachelor* and *This Morning*, the husband to actress Michelle Keegan has been a permanent fixture on our screens for a decade. And when adding in his Heart radio show duties – a gig he's had since 2012 – it's any wonder he has any spare time...

But what about those football ambitions?

"I've never got over the fact I didn't make it in the game," he says. "And despite everything I achieved elsewhere, being a professional footballer now would top it all."

In October last year, Wright set out to make one final crack at the game he loves, and a call to John Yems, his former manager at Crawley, saw the now 33-year-old invited to West Sussex to train with the club.

The presenter describes the three months that followed as a whirlwind, combining media duties with a punishing physical routine designed to get his fitness up to League Two standards. His every move has been followed by a BBC film crew, whose iPlayer series *Mark Wright: The Last Chance* has proved a huge hit.

"I never had any expectations, but I always knew I'd give it everything I had, and the welcome I got at the club was tremendous from day one."

In December, Wright's dreams moved a step closer – he signed a contract until the end of the season. And being named on the bench for Crawley's FA Cup fourth round clash with Leeds United on January 10, just two days after his brother Josh signed for the club, set up the most impossible of scenarios. Could he make the comeback of all comebacks?

Crawley strode 3–0 up against their star-studded Premier League visitors, on their way to grabbing all the weekend's giant-killing headlines. A perfect day could only be topped by a call to the bench for a substitution. And so it happened... he may have only come on in the 91st minute, he may have only touched the ball

three times, but a dream was realised on that cold Sunday lunchtime at the People's Pension Stadium.

And it doesn't stop there – the Reds are eyeing up promotion from League Two and there will be no resting on his laurels for Mark Wright... a reality star in every sense.

THE WORLD AROUND US Part 4

In the last part of our environmental series, we look at the final key driver in the health and well-being of the planet: global warming.

The phrase 'climate change denier' has become commonplace in conversations about the gradual warming of the planet and the causes of this. Scientific opinion points to humans and our explosion of population, industry and consumption as the real effects of the Earth increasing in temperature by 1° Celsius since 1880.

It doesn't sound a lot, does it? And yet, a one-to two-degree drop was all it took to plunge the Earth into the Little Ice Age in the Medieval Period.

The platform climate change deniers have generally sees their voices amplified well beyond what they should be. The results of various studies often level out at around the same rate – namely that only two or three people out of 100 will dispute the scientists' theory that humans are the cause of global warming.

With such a large accepting consensus, the drive to combat this gradual warming of Earth has

accelerated in recent years. Equipping ourselves with data, while ensuring we have the ability to interpret it, is vital.

Temperatures across a timespan of a year, five years or even a decade might rise four degrees in one region and drop six in another (which is why anomalies occur, such as Greenland's Jakobshavn Glacier actually increasing in mass since 2016), but overall, there is trouble ahead.

The next, vital step the Earth faces is a willingness of its people to do something about it. For all the UK's action over the past couple of decades, for all the destruction global warming has already contributed, such as coastal erosion, moorlands fires, floods and more, we contribute just 1.2 per cent of the world's total emissions.

It means that, as if it were ever in doubt, a global solution requires a true global investment of action from the planet's inhabitants.

Boatbuilder in the running for national award

Aboatbuilder from Woodbridge could be getting some well-deserved recognition later this year after one of his creations was shortlisted for a national award.

Sam Doman, 31, stripped back, polished and waxed a replica of Atlas, a boat from 1949, to make a mould for The Longshore, which bears the imprints of the original larch grain and nail heads. The new boat has a slightly larger sail area of 120 sq ft and is lighter than the original, so it's ideal for trailing.

Sam and The Longshore will be competing for the Spirit of Tradition Sailing Vessel in the Classic Boat Awards 2021.

He was nominated for the award by a local photographer who sent an image to awards organiser *Classic Boat* magazine.

Sam said: "It was a nice surprise to be nominated and it came out of nowhere. The Longshore is made from fibreglass to look like a traditional boat. It's similar to what the old Thames barges would have had to manoeuvre in shallow water and tight spots. I sail it regularly on the Deben."

Sam built The Longshore in the winter of 2018 and first took it on the water in summer 2019. He works in Melton Boatyard.

The winner is due to be announced in the spring.

Neil Montgomery was a key member of the town council and Woodbridge Rugby Club. He was mayor of Woodbridge between 2003 and 2004.

Caroline Page, county councillor for Woodbridge, was among those to pay tribute.

She said: "Neil was extremely community-minded, and this ran through his many interests. Additionally, he was a guide at Sutton Hoo. As well as being devoted to the ancient heritage of Woodbridge, Neil kick-started some of the new; he was the originator of the plan for the popular Woodbridge Skatepark. He will be much missed."

Mr Montgomery was married to Jane and leaves behind three children and three grandchildren.

Woodpeckers set for epic charity challenge

Since March 2020, to say football has been stopstart is an understatement.

Future of iconic building discussed by councillors

Shire Hall in Woodbridge came under the spotlight at a town council meeting last month.

Over the last year, the council has been made aware that significant repairs are likely to be needed to the Grade I listed building.

At the meeting, the council set its budget. Town mayor Sue Bale said it is not yet clear what repair costs for the building will be, so an assumption was made. The town council considered whether it could afford the repairs without increasing council tax disproportionately and whether it would need to take a loan to cover the repairs. Councillors also considered what other options there were if the council were to move out and what other uses there could be for the building.

She added: "These are discussions brought about by consideration of budget deadlines and forward planning. No final decision would be made without full research and consultation. "

Councillor Bale said there were no immediate plans to change the current use of the hall.

She said: "If a decision were made to transfer the hall to other uses, the importance of it as a building of huge local importance cannot be overstated."

News from Councillor Geoff Holdcroft

Town Councillor for Woodbridge Riverside

Despite being in lockdown since the start of the year, it does feel like spring is just around the corner, both literally and figuratively.

Vaccinations are well under way at the Community Hall and it's been quite a pleasure to be a volunteer marshal in the car park as I get to speak to a lot of people in a four-hour shift, albeit with our masks up.

Despite COVID-19, the work of the council continues as usual, and one controversial matter currently under consideration is the future of the Shire Hall.

The Tide Mill and the Shire Hall are perhaps the two most iconic buildings in Woodbridge, although the Shire Hall postdates the King's Head on the opposite side of Market Hill. Built circa 1575, the Shire Hall started life as Thomas Seckford's courthouse, in the upper storey of a open-sided corn exchange below. Since then, it has had many uses, culminating in its current use as home to Woodbridge Town Council for the past 34 years; the upper storey is presently leased to the Seckford Foundation.

Prior to moving to the Shire Hall, the town council occupied part of Eden Lodge in Cumberland Street, having been created in 1974 following local government reorganisation.

The two issues facing the council now are first how to pay for the maintenance of the Grade I listed building, and second the configuration of the council chamber and the associated offices suitable for a modern council. There are no easy solutions to these issues, but I would be interested in hearing the views of the town.

Brass band members still hitting the right note

Members of Martlesham Brass Band have been busy recently, despite all activities being suspended owing to lockdown.

Members have still been playing, and you can catch the latest videos on the Band's Facebook page, all produced by main bandleader Adam Cable.

• o. what happens in mid-February? Two Othings. Most importantly, the government NEWS has promised that by this date the top four priority groups of people will have got their first COVID-19 jab. That is, care home residents and their carers: over-80s and front-line health and social care workers; those aged 75 and over; and the over-70s and people who are clinically extremely vulnerable.

We are lucky to have use of the large airy Community Hall in Woodbridge for residents to get their jab. I know there have been some complaints and concerns about appointments and about supplies running out, but we must remember this is literally the largest vaccination effort in history, run as a partnership by organisations within the county while supplied from outside by companies busting a gut to make enough to supply

us, and keep the NHS from being overwhelmed. At the moment vaccines represent hope.

The other thing we know is that mid-February is dedicated to St Valentine, patron saint of lovers. Fewer people know he is also patron saint of the plague. Don't you think it is particularly appropriate that his day comes at the same time as we have started to make headway against this modern plaque of ours?

St Valentine is also, unexpectedly, patron saint of epilepsy. And here I come to something that I am raising with the powers that be. It is great that we have this list of people who are prioritised by need, but there are other forgotten people who support those with needs.

The government has singled out front-line health and social care workers but has forgotten (as ever) about the literally millions of carers who look after the clinically vulnerable behind closed doors.

Family carers need to have their jabs at the same time as the person they are caring for. If not, the NHS loses the benefit.

THE DOS AND DON'TS TO ACHIEVING PERFECT UNDERFOOT CONDITIONS

You think splashing the cash on a swanky new length of carpet is the first and last bit of expense you need to worry about, before someone reminds you that carpet without underlay is akin to a new motor without tyres on the wheels. It's recommended that you change your underlay whenever you change your carpet – after all, years of wear, tear, and no small amount of gravity will have squashed the best life out of it.

New underlay will provide for you a number of things – firmness, bounce, insulation, noise reduction, preservation of your new flooring, as well as reinforcing the feeling that your new piece of carpet is worthy of something you'd find on the way into a film premiere.

Premium underlay will set you back up to £10 per metre square, though perfectly good brands can be picked up for less than half that. It's true to say the higher quality your underlay, the longer it will, in turn, look after your carpet.

Typical depth is around 10–13mm, with a lower grade on the stairs. You'll also have to consider the tog rating – anything higher than 2.5 tog will insulate nicely, though if you have heated floors then switch back down to a lower tog of around 1.0.

As for the fabric, PU foam is the most common underlay on the market. It offers a soft feeling underfoot, is made from recycled materials and is a good insulator. Other types are made from rubber, sponge rubber and crumb rubber, the latter being made from car tyres. Felt and wool carpet underlay also come well recommended.

And if you're fitting wood or laminate flooring, then consult a specialist who can bring forward a range of hardfloor-specific underlays that are lighter and thinner, and respect what is an intentionally solid top layer.



Violets typically grow in the wild, although they are decreasing in numbers owing to habitat loss, which means if you want to grow them in your garden, you need to recreate these conditions. Violets thrive in winter and spring sun but need summer shade, so their ideal spot is under a deciduous tree or shrub. Violets will self-sow, but growing your own from seed is a challenge as the seeds need to be fresh. Instead,

WHAT PESTS ARE COMMON TO VIOLETS? If your violet leaves turn yellow, this could be the result of an attack by red spider mites. This pest strikes when your plant becomes too hot or dry. The best remedy is to defoliate the plant completely.

Whether out at night or hiding in plain sight, this sly urban dweller has adapted better than any other animal to human environments.

Perhaps we shouldn't be so surprised when we spot a fox meandering its way through the park, across a garden, or even on the pavement outside where we live. These beautiful creatures are, after all, past masters in urban environments, even if they are just as accustomed to survival in the rugged wild.

For all its impressive presence, your average fox will rarely approach humans or animals – chickens, rabbits and guinea pigs notwithstanding. This sly old foe simply wants to hunt for scraps, play, mate and return to its den to rest and tend to its offspring. Only when threatened will a fox move into offensive mode.

The fact foxes have become so much a part of our urban and suburban lives has a lot to do with the way they feed. They'll consume almost anything they find – from fruit and veg, raw and cooked meat, cheese, bread and even dog biscuits. Increasingly brave around humans, they'll often take food for storage, burying it for later consumption.

That means there's little risk in leaving food out for foxes if you're hoping to get a glimpse of these fiery nocturnal beauties, who will happily roam around in the late afternoon as well.

There is a downside, however. From fouling the garden to chewing shoes left outside, to trampling lawns and even digging up deceased pets, if you encourage foxes in, you'll have to go along with their inquisitive, playful habits. **TOMLINSON GROUNDCARE**

hile the postponement of the Olympic Games in Tokyo proved one of 2020's most frustrating episodes, hosting the Games this coming summer has at least given the International Olympic Committee (IOC) the chance to run its eye over prospective new sports that could be showcased.

And fans of breakdancing – a pursuit created and styled on the mean, urban streets of New York in the 1970s before being exported to a truly global audience – will be glad of the extra time, albeit the first we'll see of it will be in 2024 when Paris hosts.

A movement centred as much on music as it is dance, there are distant similarities with other performance events at the Games, such as synchronised swimming and dressage. In the Olympic format, competitors look likely go up against each other 1v1, as was the case at the 2018 Youth Olympics in Argentina. The success of the event there, some significant backing by Red Bull and a desire by organisers for the Olympics to speak to a younger, more urban demographic, means breakdancing – or 'breaking', as it will be called in event terms – sailed through the trial on its way to debuting at the world's biggest sporting tournament.

It's also significant that the IOC has embraced breaking despite some of the activity's leading purveyors insisting that it needs to retain its artistic and cultural edge, and shouldn't be bracketed

in with the Olympics' sometimes rather formal take on sport. Whether breaking will inspire anyone older than the teenage market to take it up is unclear. If it does, expect sales of paracetamol to soar.





Remembering and reflecting on the life of designer Pierre Cardin, who passed away in December.

ention the name Pierre Cardin and a modern generation of fashionistas will most likely point you to a range of smart casual shirts and t-shirts adorning the racks of retailers over the UK, from House of Fraser to TK Maxx.

> And yet, to think that the French clothing label should end up in such safe, formal surrounds is to besmirch the work of a designer who fairly revolutionised high-street style in the Swinging Sixties.

> > Cardin passed away at the end of December having cast an artistic pencil over the fashion world for more than seven decades. His passing was met with genuine sadness by a list of admirers and proteges, including designer Jean-Paul Gaultier, but his legacy is one to be admired and celebrated.

For starters, Cardin was one of the first designers to display a logo on garments, and a self-titled brand logo at that. The idea of giving a piece of clothing its own status well beyond the cuts of cotton or cashmere was something the industry had not seen before, and it led to a host of other licensed products emerging from the Paris-based fashion house, from pens to perfumes, sunglasses to food.

Cardin's idea was to bring readyto-wear, premium-looking clothes to the everyday market, and at a price that meant people could indulge in the image and grandiosity of the catwalk. Always looking to be different, he revolutionised design with sharp edges, outlandish curves and stylings that border on architecture as much as clothing. Inspiring so many, he dressed everyone from Bardot to The Beatles, all the while satisfying his own desire to be different. What we see in so much of today's collections is more than a little influenced by a humble Frenchman with big ideas, Pierre Cardin.



A level of gadgetry once reserved for Bond films or the mind of Jason Bourne might soon be coming your way, with boffins in Israel having found a way of beaming music into the brain without the need for speakers or headphones.

It goes by the name of soundbeaming, and this futuristic audio technique has the ability to transform the way we listen to music, play computer games, watch TV or process satellite navigation instructions forever.

The product is called a Soundbeamer 1.0 and is made by Noveto. It sits on a desktop and beams sound to the user – and not just any sound, but rich 3D, circling and weaving soundscapes that fill the ear, swirl around the head and infiltrate the brain, without really seeming to come from any one direction.

What's more, there are no implants required – simply, the 3D sensing module locates and tracks your ear position and sends audio via ultrasonic waves, creating sound pockets next to the ear. And because there are no headphones blocking other sounds, you will still pick up what's being spoken in the room, so no need for those awkward taps on the shoulder.

The technology is so new and so advanced that even the company's CEO admits he has struggled to comes to terms with it.

"The brain doesn't understand what it doesn't know," he says. "It sounds like a speaker but it is just you who can hear it, and that's quite something for the brain to come to terms with.

"We have other technologies that happen around us that are difficult to comprehend but vital to our lives – the internet is perhaps a good example – and I hope this will come to be regarded in the same way."

As for when we can get our hands on the Soundbeamer – the company hopes that the first will be available for sale by Christmas 2021.




