I was saddened to hear the news that The Table would be closing its doors on April 26, just as Woodbridge's hospitality sector will be tentatively reopening its doors. After nearly a decade at the Quay Street site, owner Vernon Blackmore announced that the restaurant would be opening for "one last hurrah" on April 12, before closing down two weeks after.

Woodbridge boasts an impressive number of pubs and restaurants, and I think they contribute greatly to making the town what it is, so losing one of the most famous names is a bitter pill to swallow.

But sadly, it's just the headline of what has been a deeply troubling story for years now - and that is one of small, independent businesses being priced out of our town by greedy landlords.

A concerning number of empty shops have crept onto our Thoroughfare, and COUID-19 has played a role, but the problems run deeper than that. There is a very real danger that, as time goes on, the big national chains will slowly start to dominate our town, and the boutique-y, independent feel that Woodbridge has will be lost forever. This would be a tragedy. It is time landlords start considering what is best for Woodbridge, not how much they can take out of it.

n many ways, the Piers Morgan/Susanna Reid combo shouldn't have worked. The former was an ex-red-top editor decorated in a history of salacious headlines, controversial tabloid practices spar, speak up and fire off each other was borne and a puffed-up sense of self-importance that out in viewing figures that have shown Good flitted between entertaining and aggravating.

The latter, a vastly experienced journalist across many specialisms who, while possessing a chipper, jagged edge, acted as a calming weekday morning influencer, a sympathiser and an empathiser whose delivery was - and still is - effortlessly measured and reassuringly sensible.

Put mildly, Piers and Susanna were poles apart, vet as far as breakfast television went, there was a chaotic chemistry that linked the two and, in the critics, had been his usual animated self as topics of process, knitted together perfectly two and half hours of early-morning chat, debate and news delivery. Perhaps not since the days of Anne

Diamond and Nick Owen had there been a duo who seemed so comfortable, calm and considered as our breakfast companions; and their ability to Morning Britain (GMB) to be making impressive moves in the breakfast TV battle.

Of course, all that came crashing to a sensational halt in the fallout of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle's sensational Oprah interview at the start of

Piers, who had once forged a friendship with the Duchess of Sussex, but in recent times had flipped to become one of her (and Harry's) fiercest racism and mental health rose to the surface of the debate. In the aftermath, it was revealed that Piers' vitriolic assault on both the subjects and the "woke"

around them led to more than 41.000 complaints being lodged with Ofcom. As it was, during an impassioned speech by weather forecaster Alex Beresford on March 9, Piers' patience finally snapped. Without even responding to accusations of his behaviour, he rose from his seat, claiming: "I've had enough of this, I'm off." Later that day his permanent departure was confirmed.

ITV will hope it can find a replacement who courts opinion in the same way, although it'll have a job on its hands when it comes to landing 'the new Piers', with Richard Madeley, Ben Shephard, Eamonn Holmes and Beresford himself the early front runners.

Whoever is chosen, they will have to create immediate synergy with Susanna's punchy, spiky, slightly girl-next-door approach to topical news. Fifty-year-old Susanna first came to our attention in

the early Noughties when she worked for Radio 5 Live, before moving to BBC News 24 and, latterly, BBC Breakfast News. The broadcaster made a controversial switch to ITV in February 2014 as GMB replaced the outgoing Daybreak, and has flourished since.

What made the show work was a 'good cop, bad cop' approach to getting sunrise viewers the news headlines they demand. There's little of the stuffy formality that decorates the styles of Dan Walker, Louise Minchin and others over on the Beeb: instead, issues are tackled using a tried and tested approach which delivers debates without holding

In conclusion, it's fair to say the Piers/Susanna dynamic duo may have seen its time concluded rather abruptly, but we have at least been treated to perhaps the best wake-up call of a generation.

THE LOVE ISLAND DOC HELPING US FIND A HAPPIER REALITY

octor Alex George is the Love Island contestant who wowed viewers with an altogether different take on what constitutes 'national health'. For an army of admirers, his great looks, impeccable shape, well-spoken manner and charm added up to a dream combination. He's also rumoured to be particularly good with a stethoscope.

Moving away from the reality show, the doc has carved for himself an impressive career in the spotlight. And yet, unlike so many other names who have built their brand through reality TV, there is real substance behind the style.

The 30-year-old was announced Youth Mental Health Ambassador by Prime Minister Boris Johnson in February and is a passionate advocate of well-being initiatives, not least because he sees a nation struggling to come to terms with the various effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Indeed, the death of his brother, Llŷr, who took his own life having suffered with depression, only reinforces a desire in the popular doc to open up channels of communication and encourage people to talk.

Alex's five top tips to boost mental health and well-being:

>ONE: Get outside

"Getting natural light and filling our lungs with air is crucial for well-being. It's uplifting and can instantly make us feel better."

>TWO: Exercise

"We've all had those times when we just can't be bothered to get out and exercise, but be it a run, a walk or a bike ride, just 20 minutes per day will boost blood flow and increase endorphins."

>THREE: Call a friend

"Lockdown has been very frustrating and a lonely experience, but staying in touch with friends is essential."

>FOUR: Eat well

"What we consume affects the way we feel, so fuel and replenish your system, and eat as much green stuff as possible."

>FIVE: Sleep routine

"Sleep is very important, but so is resting at regular times, so monitor your sleep habits and ensure you're getting what you need."



Operation Playground to help pirate ship sail again

As children return to school, pupils at St Mary's Primary in Woodbridge need a little bit more of a helping hand after the school's pirate ship climbing frame was condemned.

So the Friends of St Mary's have launched a fundraiser to treat them to a new space to play.

Rachel Pope, co vice-chair, said that physical play is extremely important to children.

She explained: "It helps them run off energy to concentrate in the classroom and we also know that fresh air and exercise does wonders for mental health too. Combine this with imaginative play with their peers and it's easy to see what an important piece of school equipment a climbing frame can be."

The total cost of a new climbing frame is between

£20,00 and £25,000 and the school and Friends are applying for grants and appealing to local businesses and councillors. Rachel said anything people can spare will make a huge difference.

She added: "Right now stress levels for many families are high. And for that reason, we don't want to ask them to DO anything else. No sponsored activities, no collecting money, no nothing. So we have set up this crowdfunder so that together we can quickly and easily send through any contributions we can make."

Thanks to the generosity of local families and businesses, the appeal raised more than £3,000 just days after it was launched last month.

Adrian and Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service Drone Pilots Laurence Dalziel, Mark Daly and Peter Watson-Brown needed to practise with one of the Service's hi-tech drones. The club's three pitches provided just the spot.

Adrian said: "Most of our work is helping the police to find missing persons. This training is vital for that role where during a normal week we can expect to be called upon two or three times, day or night."

Club vice-chairman Simon Bennett commented: "When a local key worker and ex-player needs a favour, we are delighted to play our part."

Shocked pub owner still turning away callers

Despite the nation being in the clutches of its longest COVID-19 lockdown yet, a pub has continued to receive calls from unaware residents wanting to book tables.

Chris Mapey, landlord at The Angel, was baffled to receive a call one Monday morning in February.

He said: "As we live upstairs in the pub, it hasn't been unusual for the phone to still ring, but usually it is family members or friends wanting to contact us for reasons unrelated to the pub.

"But I was surprised to answer the phone to an elderly sounding gentleman who expressed how relieved he was that a local pub had finally answered his call.

"He said he wished to book a table for four people for lunch that day and was rather taken aback when I explained to him that we weren't open because of the lockdown."

It wasn't the first instance either. Chris explained that throughout the lockdown they've had residents

asking to buy wine, phone calls requesting opening hours and people sitting in their beer garden waiting for someone to come and serve them.

Chris continued: "I cannot understand how it could have passed anyone by that we are in a lockdown and that pubs are closed now."

Chris is optimistic, however, that when pubs do finally reopen, it will be for good this time thanks to the impressive roll-out of the vaccine.

Woman arrested after council graffiti attack

Awoman from Woodbridge was one of two arrested after vandals attacked Ipswich Borough Council's Grafton House with pink graffiti last month.

Tina Smith, 40, and Susan Hadley, 65, of Ipswich were later charged with criminal damage.

The incident was part of nationwide action by political party Burning Pink which says its aim is to give power to the people and create citizens' assemblies.


The messages sprayed on the building read "tough love" and "12 demands ultimatum". The party targeted 15 councils across the country in "protest at their treasonous inaction on the climate and ecological emergency".

The two women are due to appear at Ipswich Magistrates' Court on March 26.

An Ipswich Borough Council spokesman said: "Ipswich Borough Council condemns the vandalism of its property. The people who did this breached the lockdown rules to do so. There will be additional and unnecessary costs to clean it up at a time when the Council is already facing a budget shortfall owing to COVID.

"The group that is thought to have carried out this vandalism is making demands around climate change. However, the council has already declared a climate emergency, has been reducing its carbon footprint for years and has a plan to achieve carbon neutrality by 2030."


Following the opening of Woodbridge Community Hall as a COVID-19 vaccination centre in January, the town now has a Community Testing Centre which opened up in The Longshed at Whisstocks Place off Tide Mill Way.

This rapid testing centre is aimed at people who have to leave their home during lockdown, for example owing to work or caring commitments, or for essential shopping. It will help identify and isolate individuals who have COVID-19 but do not have symptoms and may be spreading the virus to other people without knowing.

You can book an appointment at commisceo-pcs. shiftpartner.com or call 0333 772 6144. However, if

you do have symptoms you should not use this service and instead you must book a standard COVID-19 test immediately by visiting www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or calling 119.

While we must all stick to the rules and get vaccinated, Woodbridge Town Council is looking forward to the time when we can all get out and about and enjoy all the facilities the town has to offer. We are considering what events can go ahead this summer, although sadly Woodbridge Regatta won't be going ahead in June as planned. However I am very hopeful that other regular outdoor summer events can, and perhaps even a few new ones.

Stop. Right. There. Don't turn the page. This is not a party-political broadcast. Instead, I'd like to write a bit about democracy, and what

NEWS We've seen the rough side of democracy this year - faced, as we've been, with the double trouble of COVID-19 and Brexit. It's fair to say that these are both areas with very opposing points of view.

Some of this opposition has been based on personal opinion, some on past facts or prejudice, some on present needs, some on future prediction and some on pure fiction.

However, it's clear that everybody – however wrong or misguided - feels strongly that they have a right to have a say. It doesn't matter which camp you're in, the other camp seems always to be wrong and misguided. For example, you would not believe the

fuss when I posted online a medically vetted pattern for homemade masks last March, "Was I trying to kill people?" "Didn't I know that cloth facemasks were dangerous?" "You only need professionalism and handwashing." Yet within months, Woodbridge ERG was funding volunteers to make them in quantities. Views can change.

What we need is for people's wish to "have a say" to be parlayed into an equally strong wish to make a

The greatest winner in the last county elections was the Apathy Party, with 56 per cent of the vote. That's the party of those who say, "I don't vote; it won't change things," or, "Local elections don't matter."

But local elections do matter. A huge amount. Almost all decisions that most affect your daily life are made by the local councils, not the national government. So, if you'd like a say in how our schools, roads, social care and many other things are run, it can only happen if you use your vote. Please do.

Woodpeckers season is over

Owing to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Woodbridge Town FC has announced that the current season has been declared null and void.

However, the club is using this time to start the pitch renewal early, so they can be ready to restart next season on time.

At the time of writing, the £2,500 target to support Families in Need (FIND) Ipswich has been exceeded.

The club aimed to run 2,000 miles in four weeks, raising money to offer a lifeline to local people in despair, as well as to provide food parcels and care

A spokesperson from the club said: "Thanks to the generosity of so many people. After an incredible effort from the club's senior teams, in February the three teams have clocked up more than 2.600 miles, 600 miles over the target.

"For the record, the first team ran 1,027 miles, the ladies team 1,007 miles and reserves 601 miles.

"Congratulations to all for a great effort."

CUTLERY

Inether you use stainless steel, silver-plated or silver cutlery, or a combination of all three, if you want your silverware to last and looks its best for longer, you need to take care of it.

STAINLESS STEEL (UTLERY: The most popular material choice for cutlery, stainless steel is both durable and versatile, but that doesn't mean it is completely stain-resistant.

HOW TO CLEAN: > Rinse before placing in dishwasher

- > Never leave to soak or in damp conditions as this can lead to corrosion
 - > Remove stubborn stains using stainless steel polish and a soft cloth
 - HOW TO STORE: > Store in its original canteen to prevent pieces rubbing together
 - > Can be stored in kitchen drawer but may reduce

SILVER-PLATED (UTLERY: A more decadent choice, silver-plated cutlery is relatively easy to care for but does require some special care.

HOW TO CLEAN: > Keep away from stainless steel cutlery, as contact can cause corrosion

- > Place in dishwasher, but turn off the drying cycle and dry each piece by hand to avoid staining
- > Polish to maintain shine

HOW TO STORE: > Store in a tarnish-proof cutlery roll and then in an airtight container

SILVER CUTLERY: Ideal for use at dinner parties and other special occasions, silver cutlery is both lavish and luxurious.

- HOW TO CLEAN: > Clean as soon as possible after use
- > Wash separately from stainless steel and silver-plated cutlery to avoid
- > Do not put in dishwasher; instead, clean by hand
- > Do not polish too often as this can wear down the finish

HOW TO STORE: > When not in use, roll each piece of silver cutlery in acidfree tissue paper or unbleached cotton muslin and then place in a resealable plastic bag.

> Add a piece of chalk wrapped in cheesecloth to the bag to absorb moisture and prevent tarnishing.

If you want to enjoy an aromatherapy experience at home, then a scented reed diffuser is the ideal choice. However, you don't need to spend your hard-earned cash on shop-bought varieties when you can make them at home with a few simple ingredients and supplies.

WHAT YOU NEED: Small bottle or vase 20-25 drops of your preferred essential oil 1/4 cup of baby oil 3 tbsp of vodka or rubbing alcohol Bamboo skewers or ideally diffuser reeds Zest peels and herbs are optional

HOW TO MAKE: Pour the baby oil into a bowl | Add the rubbing alcohol or vodka Carefully add the drops of essential oil and zest peels and herbs if preferred Pour the mixture into your vase or glass bottle using a funnel until it is 3/4 filled Place five skewers into the vase Cut the skewers to size if necessary so that they stick out roughly 4-6 inches

- 1. Check the liquid quantity monthly and top up if needed
- 2. Rotate the diffuser reeds once a month
- 3. Replace diffuser reeds after 4-6 months
- 4. Recycle a perfume bottle if you don't have a suitable vase
- 5. Cut your skewers carefully to avoid splinters

How to choose essentials oils for each season

Spring: Choose fresh floral notes, such as a mix of citrus, lavender, geranium and jasmine. Summer: Uplift your home with magnolia,

bergamot and lemon.

Autumn: Embrace the cooler weather with a combination of juniper berry, cedarwood. cardamon and cinnamon.

Winter: Cosy up with a warming blend of spruce, patchouli and Douglas fir.

An alternative to reed diffusers

You can purchase an electronic oil diffuser, but make sure to do your research first as they come in different sizes. These diffusers produce a more concentrated fragrance and add moisture to the air, albeit in quite small amounts.

extra cheer this year, so why not have a go at creating your own Easter centrepiece tree, complete with ornamental eggs?

How to create your Easter tree:

For the tree itself, simply gather a selection of branches and place in a vase. The best tree branches to look out for include:

Cherry blossom | Magnolia | Willow | Forsythia | Dogwood

How to hollow out your eggs:

Poke a small hole in the pointier side of an egg and then another, slightly larger, hole on the opposite side. Place your mouth over the smaller hole and blow out the egg. Wash the shell and leave to dry.

Marbled eggs:

Mix 1 cup of hot water with 10 drops of liquid food colouring and 1 tsp of vinegar. Submerge the eggshell in the water for two minutes and leave to cool. This is vour base colour.

Next, fill a bowl with fresh hot water and add a darker food colouring and 1 tbsp of olive oil. Roll your egg around to allow it to absorb the second colour.

If you favour a more natural look, these miniature nests, complete with tiny Easter egg treats, are the perfect decoration for your tree. Gently break away some of the egg shell on the front of your egg, fill with straw and then add a single mini egg to each one.

Glitter eggs:

Create a pattern across your egg using tape, apply PVA glue to the rest of the egg and sprinkle generously with glitter. Leave to dry and remove tape. Choose to paint your eggs first for more a more vibrant end result.

How to hang your eggs:

To finish, simply thread a ribbon or piece of cotton through the top hole of each egg, wiggle it until it pokes out the other side and tie a knot to secure.



- They only take cash Legit breeders want to make sure their pups go to good homes which means offering refunds if the buyer changes their mind. In short, they don't do 'cash and dash'
- They want to meet at a public place Always see your new pet in their natural habitat and meet its mother to ensure reliable provenance.
- They are already vaccinated No dogs ought to be vaccinated until they are at least eight weeks old, so if an ad tells you otherwise, it's a scam.

ARE DAFFODILS EASY TO GROW?

Anyone can grow daffodils in their garden and you can choose to plant your bulbs in beds, borders, grass verges, lawn edges, hedgerows and banks. Plant your bulbs between September and November in well-drained soil and aim to keep your bulbs 4–8 inches apart, as overcrowding can cause daffodil blindness – when daffodils shoot up with foliage but no flower.

HOW TO LOOK AFTER DAFFODIL BULBS FOR ANNUAL GROWTH

- > Allow the leaves to die back naturally before cutting off
- You can lift bulbs between June and August and store in a cool, dry place ready for replanting
- > Apply a rich fertiliser to the soil once you have removed bulbs

In the second of a four-part series that shows how even the most urban garden can be a haven for the wonders of wildlife and the nurturing of nature, we look at the role of trees and fungi below

We view our trees with respect and admiration a fluttering, swaying mass of potency and life that evolves with every passing season, presenting a haven for all manner of wildlife, from insects to birds, plant-life to rodents, as well as being a valuable source of oxygen for all living things.

And yet, the true strength of a tree is not what we see above ground, but its rooted, tangled masses beneath it. At the heart of this are microbes called mycorrhizal fungi.

Once considered an enemy to plant life, in recent decades the fungi - which release hyphae, tying together tree and fungus at cellular level - have been better understood. This mycorrhiza bond links below-surface connections... a 'Wood Wide Web'.

It leads to the creation of one superorganism that looks after, supports and talks to each tree, be that a small crab apple just a few yards away, or a thundering oak several hundred metres down a

The creation of this network is for mass sustainability - the fungi have minerals that the tree needs; the tree has carbon that the fungi need - but the result is a kind of soil socialism that looks after

For so long it was believed that trees and fungi were at war, both looking to snatch what they could from the ground. Now, it's believed that without the mycorrhizal fungi, trees would be toy-sized, and in the case of the 400 species of mycoheterotrophic plants that cannot photosynthesise, they would die

So the next time you stand back and admire the beauty of a tree, perhaps take a respectful glance towards ground level while you're at it.



t's now three decades since British inventor Trevor Baylis CBE came up with a prototype that was to have a profound effect on limiting the spread of AIDS across Africa. Invented in his garage, the wind-up radio took less than an hour to construct, and came about after the then 54-year-old saw a programme on the BBC detailing a devastating swathe of developingworld deaths provoked by poverty and lack of sexual education.

While radios powered by handcranked generators were, in themselves, nothing new, Baylis's modern clockwork model was free of batteries, meaning information could be broadcasted to places in Africa without electricity. A patent was granted the following year.

It wasn't the first time the eccentric inventor had stepped out of the shadows to help those less fortunate than himself. As a young man he was a brilliant swimmer - he narrowly failed to qualify for the 1956 Summer Olympics in Melbourne - and his dexterity led him into stunt work. This in turn exposed him to the needs of disabled people, and he subsequently invented and developed a range of products for the disabled, named Orange Aids.

Wind forward to 10 years after the invention that truly made him famous, and in 2001 Baylis launched a similar energy-generating product in the form of a pair of shoes that produced electricity as people walked. He trialled the invention with a 100-mile walk across the Namib Desert, at the same time raising money for the Mines Advisory Group.

Baylis, who died in March 2018, lived on Eel Pie Island on the River Thames. His fame in later life saw appearances on The Breakfast, and he was awarded an OBE and a CBE for

ANT MIDDLETON'S CLIMB TO PHYSICAL AND MENTAL MAGNIFICENCE

Anyone who has watched his SAS series knows Ant Middleton isn't a guy to be messed with. Grit, steel, determination, power and a large dose of bloody-mindedness have propelled the former military man into the mainstream; and while a new career in the lens suits the 40-year-old Army and Royal Marines veteran nicely, the impact he is having on everyday folk is profound.

For a long time the various fitness, health, strength and well-being trends that have taken up countless column inches and patterned our social media feeds have needed a confident, high-energy figure to take them forward. Yes, we have various reality stars putting out fitness tutorials, and Joe Wicks is always there to advise on the best way to pull off the perfect burpee, but can they do it on a cold Tuesday night in Stoke? The answer, undoubtedly, is no.

Ant Middleton, however... let's just say he makes The Potteries look like a beach holiday in the Maldives. So much of what this inspirational tour de force has done up to now has been about physical determination. His Channel 4 SAS: Who Dares Wins series, which he fronted for five years before announcing recently he will no longer be part of the show due to differences with the production company, is a military training show of brutal extremes, with an adventure/reality crossover that pushes participants to the absolute limits of body endurance.

While this type of programming has seen the Portsmouth-born hardman make his mark, in truth it represents only one half of what it takes to truly ascend to the next level. Thus, squaring the circle in his new project, which centres on a series of talks on the subject of positive mindset, seems the natural progression.

"We all know that physical toughness can only take you so far," says the author of the best-selling book *Zero Negativity*. "You need to have the mental strength to keep pushing on when the body says no.

"The brain can outlast and outpace anything the body can do, so training our minds to interpret, recycle, repair and renew the messages flowing through us means we can achieve things way beyond what our muscles tell us is possible."

Middleton's emergence as a mainstream player is no better exemplified than in the fact he was joined on a recent project by terrestrial TV poster boy Ben Shephard. "Ben's a good guy who has absolute determination in his career. He's a great example of someone who is a winner – we all come in different shapes and sizes."

In a streamed live event that took place at the start of February, Middleton's *Be Prepared* for 2021 did exactly what the title suggested, with an unscripted, unrehearsed and unfiltered conversation designed to unpick the various roadblocks that 2020 had put in the way of so many of us.

"The past year felt like such a crushing low for a lot of people, but rather than dwell on the negativity, as a nation we need to look at the things we learned, and appreciate the positives we took out of the year," he says.

"We need to appreciate how we grew and developed strengths many of us never knew we had.

"This is the road to ensuring 2021 is a better year. We cannot change the world around us, but we can alter the way we decide to tackle its challenges."

o an entire generation of terrestrial TV watchers, the mere sound of Ravel's Boléro will instantly bring about memories of Jayne Torvill OBE and Christopher Dean OBE's incredible gold-medalwinning routines at both the Olympics and the World Championships in 1984.

At both events, the duo performed a modern artistic masterpiece that captivated a generation of fans. The routine had emotion, precision and drama packed into four and a half minutes of twists, turns. lifts and pirouettes.

At the World Championships, in Ottawa, the couple received a standing ovation from the entire crowd as flowers rained down onto the ice. It was the last amateur performance of the greatest ice dancers the world had ever known, performed with such ease that it belied the incredible technicality of a routine coached by Betty Callaway.

scored by any skaters in competition, as the couple, who had been performing together since 1975, truly went out on top of the world, having taken 11 6.0s at the Olympics two months previously.





you to expand your palate and widen your repertoire of recipes. This month we bring you kohlrabi, an undeniably odd-looking vegetable that packs a real punch in terms

Kohlrabi is also known as a cabbage turnip and is very popular in northern and eastern European countries. Part of the broccoli and cabbage family, it can be green, white or purple in colour and is available all year round. When buying kohlrabi whole, look for crisp-looking and vibrant leaves, which

It has a similar flavour to cabbage but with the spicy kick of a radish; the smaller the bulb, the milder the taste. Crunchy when eaten raw, the stems and leaves can also be cooked and eaten;

All edible elements of kohlrabi need to be peeled before cooking to avoid a bitter taste. Once peeled, trim the brown end and separate

Choose to steam, sauté or roast kohlrabi, or you could even hollow out the bulbs and stuff with other vegetables or grains. Alternatively, serve raw in thin slices on a salad or added to coleslaw. You can also steam or sauté the leaves in the same way that you would fresh kale or spinach.

HOW TO STORE KOHLRABI

A kohlrabi bulb can be kept uncovered in the fridge for up to one month. The stems and leaves should be cooked as soon as possible as they wilt within a day

HOW TO SUCCESSFULLY ICE A BIRTHDAY CAKE (NO MATTER YOUR Skill level!)

Step One: Fake it or bake it

buying a pre-made sponge. The benefit of this is that the layers will be perfectly proportioned, making icing easier. On the other hand, a homemade cake is hard to beat, though you will need to trim the top of your cake with a bread knife if it has domed so the surface is perfectly flat and even.

Step Two: Filling fun

If you aren't much of a baker, there really is no harm in Everyone loves the first peek inside a birthday cake, which is why you need to get the filling as even as possible. If you're using jam, spread that first (heat gently in a bowl sat in boiling water to make it more spreadable), before piling your buttercream in the centre of your bottom layer. Now, add your top layer and gently twist with a little pressure to spread the filling across your cakes, removing any excess icing that spills out with a palette knife.



Ever wondered how professional bakers achieve that flawless finish? The answer is the crumb layer - a light layer of icing to catch stray crumbs before the second layer is applied. Place a third of your remaining icing in a separate bowl and move your cake onto a turntable or cake stand. Put a large dollop of buttercream in the centre of the cake and smooth it across the top, repeating the process until it looks even. Then, do the same with the side of the cake, turning it gently to distribute the icing and using your palette knife to flatten. Place your cake in the fridge for two hours to set.


Step Four: Final touches

Repeat the icing process for your final layer, being sure to fully cover the crumb layer beneath, and finish your masterpiece with some decorations. And a final top tip: hundreds and thousands look very impressive when applied liberally.


If diagnosed with an eating disorder, they are likely to be prescribed a treatment plan, which may include talking therapies and medication if they are also suffering with depression.



o, we are not talking about the dance craze that swept the nation in 2018, but the act of cleaning in between your teeth using dental floss.

Sadly, only an estimated 31 per cent of people clean between their teeth on a daily basis. This is despite the fact that the NHS recommends that from the age of 12 people should include flossing in their daily oral health routine.

HOW TO FLOSS: A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

- 1. Break off between 18 and 25 inches of dental
- 2. Wind the floss around both of your middle fingers, leaving between one and two inches for
- 3. Hold the floss taut with your thumbs and index
- 4. Place the dental floss between two teeth
- Gently glide the floss up and down, making sure to rub against both sides of each tooth
- **6.** When the floss reaches your gum, curve the floss

- at the base of your tooth, creating a C shape
- Be careful not to scratch or bruise your gums
- 8. Repeat as you move from tooth to tooth
- 9. Always use a clean piece of floss for each tooth section
- 10. Do not recycle or reuse dental floss as this can redistribute bacteria around your mouth, even if you wash it first

WHEN SHOULD YOU FLOSS?

For optimal oral health, you should always floss first and brush your teeth afterwards. It is recommended that you brush your teeth twice a day and floss once, preferably in the evening.

WHY SHOULD YOU FLOSS?

Flossing helps to remove food and plague from in between your teeth. Brushing alone cannot do this as the bristles are not able to reach deep enough. Regular flossing can result in less dental plaque in your mouth and therefore a lower risk of developing gum disease.

HOW TO DIAGNOSE ONE OF THE MOST COMMON MOTORING ISSUES

he serpentine belt, alternator belt, or fan belt as it is better known, is a peculiar piece of rather essential kit as far as your car engine goes. We all know our car has one, a few of us can locate it, yet very few know what it does.

What's important is that when it does malfunction - usually through being worn out - we can get it fixed cheaply and easily.

THE SIGNS

Most people become aware of fan belt failure when they begin to hear a loud screeching or squealing sound coming from the engine. You may also discover the power steering or air conditioning isn't working, and in really bad cases the engine may

All of these effects result from the fan belt's faulty function, and that function is working with the idler, tensioner and pulleys inside the accessory drive

belt system - essentially, it provides power to key components in the engine.

A dodgy fan belt is bad news, and although the car may be driveable, you're risking a breakdown.

THE DIAGNOSIS

Fan belts can become cracked, split, grazed, misaligned or might fall off completely. Unless your amateur mechanic skills are really up to Henry Ford levels, it's probably best to take your motor to the nearest garage.

THE COST

Thankfully, a faulty fan belt won't see you off the road for too long; nor should it set you back any significant amount. Typically, a new one will cost somewhere in the region of £100-£200. It's a relatively quick job and your garage should be able to turn it around in a couple of hours.



Souring for bargains online will always present one or two sites where the deals appear to be too good to be true, but over the past couple of years, Wish, a retail platform based in China, has cemented its place as being one of the most affordable and diverse sites on the net.

While a good proportion of wish.com caters for the peculiar and the downright perverse, a huge chunk of goods appear well priced and reasonably well made. Its secret is to connect millions of shoppers with sellers all over the world. Different from eBay, sellers are registered companies, and while China and south-east Asia provides a common source for products, it may come as a surprise to hear that the site was actually conceived in Ontario, Canada, back in 2010.

By June 2020, Wish could boast 122 million visits, with almost 70 million of those being unique users. From sportswear to phones, jewellery to lingerie,

tech to trumpets, Wish's diversity is its greatest strength.

And yet, weaknesses are prevalent too.
Such is the breadth of the site – it is a truly global entity – that quality control checks aren't the strongest, and waiting times for the transportation of goods can be long.

You also need to consider that regulations and guidelines for products in the UK won't be the same abroad, so with something like a child's car seat, some imported products might be substandard.

What Wish ultimately represents is another opening-up of trade, often directly between the individual and the product manufacturer and/or retailer.

The world is a much smaller place today, but while that's true, there's nothing to suggest the famous old adage 'buyer beware' isn't as important now as it ever was.


